2025 FAN GUIDE

ADMISSION

- Gates at Richard Gouse Field at Brown Stadium will open 90 minutes prior to the start of all home games.
- All spectators must have a valid ticket and are encouraged to enter the stadium prior to kickoff to ease congestion at the gates.
- NO RE-ENTRY: Brown Stadium has a no re-entry policy. Fans will not be allowed to re-enter the facility once they leave.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

- Alcoholic beverages will be available for sale at Bruno's Bar underneath the main grandstand, and at the Narragansett Beer Garden on the visitor's side adjacent to the north end zone.
- Bruno Brew, Brown Athletics' officially licensed beer is available for purchase along with other alcoholic beverages.
- Patrons must be 21 years of age or older to purchase, possess or consume alcohol and must present valid photo ID to purchase.
- No outside alcoholic beverages are allowed to be brought inside the stadium.

ANIMALS

- Only service animals are allowed inside Brown Stadium. Emotional support animals are not considered service animals. For more information, please see Brown University's policy on Service and Support Animals.

APPAREL/TEAM STORE

- The Brown Bookstore Team Shop will be located on the visitor's side of the stadium behind Section O.

BAG POLICY

- All bags are subject to search upon entry and at any time by security and stadium personnel.

BANNERS AND SIGNS

- Banners and signs are allowed inside the stadium, but should not obstruct the view of other fans during the game and should not contain offensive language or imagery.
- Any sign failing to comply subject to confiscation by security, stadium or athletic department personnel.

BEER GARDEN

- The Narragansett Beer Garden is open to all stadium patrons on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- Bruno Brew, Brown Athletics' new officially licensed beer is available for purchase along with other alcoholic beverages.

BRUNO'S BACKYARD

- Bruno's Backyard is a family-friendly area located at the north end of the stadium by Section M.
- Features lawn games, inflatables, photo opportunities, designated photo opportunities with Bruno, and more.

CONCESSIONS

- Food and non-alcoholic beverages are available courtesy of Brown Dining Services at three concession stands located on the concourse underneath the main grandstand.
- Food trucks will also be available on-site at several locations around the stadium.
- Alcoholic beverages will be available for purchase at Bruno's Bar on the main concourse underneath the main grandstand, as well as at the Narragansett Beer Garden on the visitor's side adjacent to the north end zone. For more information, see *Alcoholic Beverages*.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS/ADDRESS

Richard Gouse Field at Brown Stadium 400 Elmgrove Avenue Providence. RI 02906

From the North: Take 95 South to Branch Avenue (Exit 24). Turn left onto Branch Avenue and proceed to the traffic light. Cross intersection and go up Cypress Street to light at Hope Street. Go straight through intersection at Cypress and Hope to the end of Cypress, where it meets Morris Avenue. Turn right onto Morris Avenue. At the stop sign, take a left onto Doyle Avenue and make the first left onto Elmgrove Avenue. Brown Stadium is on the left.

From the South: Take 95 North into Rhode Island. Once in Providence, take the Branch Avenue exit (Exit 24). Turn right onto Branch Avenue and proceed to the traffic light. Cross the intersection and go up Cypress Street to the light at Hope Street. Go straight through the intersection at Cypress and Hope to the end of Cypress, where it meets Morris Avenue. Turn right onto Morris Avenue. At the stop sign, take a left onto Doyle Avenue and make the first left onto Elmgrove Avenue. Brown Stadium is on the left.

From the East: Take Route 195 West to the Gano Street exit (Exit 2) in Providence. Turn right onto Gano Street, which becomes Taber Avenue after crossing Angell Street. Turn right onto Lloyd Avenue and make the first left onto Elmgrove Avenue. Drive approximately one mile and Brown Stadium is on the left.

From the West: Take Route 6 into Providence and exit for 95 North. Take 95 to the Branch Avenue exit (Exit 24). Turn left onto Branch Avenue and proceed to the traffic light. Cross the intersection and go up Cypress Street to the light at Hope Street. Go straight through the intersection at Cypress and Hope to the end of Cypress, where it meets Morris Avenue. Turn right onto Morris Avenue. At the stop sign, take a left onto Doyle Avenue and make the first left onto Elmgrove Avenue. Brown Stadium is on the left.

DRONE POLICY

- The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) regulates the use of all aircraft, including UASs, in the National Airspace System. Brown University faculty, staff, students, vendors or agents who wish to use UASs on or over University Property or in connection with University Related Activities must send an application to Environmental Health & Safety (EHS) to seek approval for the use of a UAS in support of University Related Activities.
- EHS must approve all UAS uses on or over University Property or in connection with University Related Activities, whether outdoors or indoors, prior to such use.

EVACUATION PROCEDURE

In the event Brown deems it necessary to evacuate Brown Stadium, an announcement will be made via the public address system and information will be displayed on the stadium's video board. Guests are asked to exit in an orderly fashion. Security personnel will be on hand to direct and assist guests. Guests are to exit through the nearest portal and proceed to the nearest stadium exit.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE

- No outside food or beverages are allowed inside Brown Stadium and are subject to confiscation. For information on food and beverage sales, see *Concessions*.

HANDICAPPED/ADA SEATING

- Handicapped/ADA seating is available in Section L of the main grandstand. Limited handicapped/ADA parking is available in Lot C. Please see *Parking* for more information.

PARKING

- Parking lots for Richard Gouse Field at Brown Stadium will open three (3) hours prior to kickoff.
- Passenger cars only. No RVs or truck/U-Haul rentals will be permitted without advanced, written permission.
- Parking lots will close 2 hours after the conclusion of the game, or at sunset, whichever comes first.
- Stadium parking is very limited. Single game parking passes are available for purchase online at BrownBears.com/tickets. If there is single game parking available on gameday, it is first come, first serve at the entrance to Lot A.
- **Handicapped Parking:** Handicapped parking is available in Lot C, located behind the home side bleachers. Entry into Lot C can be accessed from Sessions Street. Handicapped parking in Lot C is a paid lot and must be purchased in advance at 401-863-2773 or athtickets@brown.edu.
- **Street Parking:** Spectators can park on surrounding streets that are not closed to traffic. Please be mindful of all posted parking restrictions and regulations that apply to surrounding streets.


RADIO/INTERNET AUDIO

- All Brown home games can be listened to via a free audio livestream at BrownBears.com/audio.
- Games will not be available on the radio in 2024.

RESTROOMS

- Restrooms are located on both sides of the stadium, including underneath the main grandstand.

SHUTTLES TO FOOTBALL GAMES

- Brown Athletics also provides free Football Gameday Shuttles to Brown Stadium from Faunce Arch, starting 2 hours prior to kickoff.

TAILGATING

- Tailgating is allowed in Lot A, which opens three (3) hours prior to kickoff.
- All tailgating activities must end at the time of kickoff. Parking lots will close 2 hours after the conclusion of the game, or at sunset, whichever occurs first.
- Passenger cars only. No RVs, rentals/UHauls will be permitted without advanced, written permission.
- No generators allowed.
- No electricity will be provided by Brown University.
- In order to be in compliance with Rhode Island state laws, all patrons must be at least 21 years of age in order to consume alcohol.
- Vehicles and/or fans carrying beer kegs and/or excessive quantities of alcohol (wine, spirits and/or beer) will not be allowed into parking lots.

TELEVISION/LIVESTREAMING

- All home football games will be streamed live via ESPN+. Check BrownBears.com for specific game listings.

TICKETS AND WILL CALL

- All tickets sales are final.
- Tickets can be purchased online at BrownBears.com/tickets.
- Brown students can use their student ID to scan into any home athletic event! Students no longer need to claim a ticket before an event. Entry will be on a first-come first-serve basis.
- Tickets can also be purchased on gameday at Brown Stadium at the ticket booth located next to Lot A on the visitors side of the stadium.
- Will Call is located at the ticket booth next to Lot A on the visitor's side of the stadium.
- Athletic schedules are subject to change (including game dates, times and opponents). If the event specified on your ticket is rescheduled, your ticket will remain valid for the rescheduled event date and time.
- The Athletics Ticket Office will be happy to work with you on equal-value exchanges.

VICTORY CLUB

- The Lexus of Warwick Victory Club is an invite-only hospitality area located between the video board and north end zone of the stadium. Fans that are provided a credential will have access to complimentary food and beverage options, in addition to a premium location for watching the game on field level.

WEATHER

- In the event of inclement weather during the game, teams will return to their locker rooms and fans will be asked to take shelter either underneath the main grandstand, or return to their vehicles.
- Emergency instructions/updates will be delivered via the public address system, stadium video board, and @BrownU_Football on social media.
- Fans who leave Brown Stadium due to a weather emergency can re-enter the stadium by showing their ticket stub or electronic ticket to the event.
