OPENING KICKOFF

- Fresh off a wild, back-and-forth last second victory over Cornell, Brown will hit the road for the second straight week with a visit to Penn on Saturday.
- Brown's three-highest scoring outputs this season (31 vs. Colgate, 42 vs. Princeton, and 49 at Cornell) have come in its last three games, moving the team to an average of 32.0 points per game.
- Penn has dropped its last two games, both on the road at Columbia (23-14) and last week at Yale (42-28).
- Saturday will be the 92nd matchup all-time between the two schools on the gridiron, with Penn holding a 62-27-2 edge in the series.

STRONG START FOR THE IVIES

- Five Ivy League schools are either ranked (No. 15 Princeton, No. 25 Harvard), or receiving votes (Columbia, Yale, Dartmouth) in the FCS Coaches Poll.
- For the first time since 1968, three Ivies (Dartmouth, Harvard and Princeton) started the season 5-0.

PERRY TRADES BROWN HELMET FOR GOLD

• Senior QB EJ Perry was named the winner of this week's Gold Helmet Award from the New England Football Writers Association following his strong performance in Brown's 49-45 win at Cornell. Perry was 23-of-36 passing for 275 and four touchdowns, and also rushed for 80 yards and one score. He was crucial in leading Brown to 21 points in the fourth quarter, including hitting Graham Walker for a game-winning 30-yard touchdown strike with 29 seconds left.

OFFENSE HEATING UP

- Brown's three-highest scoring outputs have all come in the last three games with 31 vs. Colgate, 42 vs. Princeton and 49 at Cornell.
- The last two games have seen the Bears put up two of their top three outputs for offensive yards in a single game this season. Brown put up 490 yards of total offense and 159 rushing yards (both their 3rd-highest totals this season) against Princeton, who entered the game with the second-best scoring defense (8.8 pg) in FCS and ranked No. 1 in rush defense (28.2 ypg).
- Brown followed that up by posting season-highs of 587 total yards and 312 rushing yards at Cornell, while scoring a season-high 49 points.
- Brown's 587 yards of offense was its most in a game since posting 559 at Brown Stadium on Oct. 3, 2015 in a 41-31 win over URI.
- Brown has not totaled over 600 yards of offense since putting up 627 on Nov. 23, 2013 at Columbia in a 48-7 win.

TURNING THE CORNER

- Brown's offense has seen a tremendous turnaround over the last three seasons.
- Brown has scored 192 points this season. They scored 143 points through the first five games of 2021, which matched their point total through all 10 games of

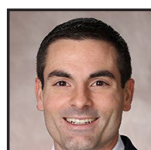

- After averaging 14.30 points per game in 2018, Brown scored 30.0 points per game on average in 2019 and is averaging 32.0 through the first six games of the 2021 season.

DEFENSE CREATING OFFENSE

- Brown has scored a defensive touchdown in two of the last three games.
- Against Princeton, Joseph Shell scooped up a fumble and returned it 71 yards for a touchdown to move the Bears within 42-28 late in the third quarter.
- Shane Prevot picked up a fumble (forced by Camden Gagnon) and returned it 74 yards to paydirt to give Brown a 10-0 lead in the first quarter against Colgate.
- The Bears also got a touchdown from defensive lineman Brooks Jones against Colgate, who lined up as an eligible receiver and caught a touchdown pass from Perry in the fourth quarter to extend the Brown lead to 24-3.

EXTENDING DRIVES

- Brown is 46-for-93 (.495) on third down conversions this season, good for tops in the Ivy League and 4th in FCS.
- The Bears are even better on 4th down conversions this year, going 13-for-17 (.765), ninth in the nation and second in the Ivy behind Columbia.

FINISHING STRONG

- Brown is outscoring opponents 95-39 in the fourth quarter.
- Brown has yet to be outscored in the fourth quarter of any game this season.
- The Bears have scored at least 14 points in the fourth quarter in four of their six games this season, and 21+ twice.
- Trailing 33-0 at the start of the third quarter against Bryant on Oct. 2, Brown scored 29 points in the final frame, including 22 unanswered to pull within 36-29 with 2:06 remaining.
- Brown scored three touchdowns over a span of 3:32 to pull within seven points, recovering two onside kicks during that span.
- The 29 points are also the most scored by Brown in a single quarter in at least a decade.

LUCKY BOUNCES

- Brown recovered a pair of onside kicks in the fourth quarter on Oct. 2 at Bryant, both of which led to touchdowns. It marked the first time the Bears had recovered an onside kick since 2017.

STAYING DISCIPLINED

- The Bears rank 12th in the nation in fewest penalties (31 total), 29th in fewest penalties per game (5.17), and 26th in fewest penalty yards per game (45.67).

WIDE RECEIVER U.

- Brown continues to live up to its old nickname of Wide Receiver U. this season, with 15 different receivers having at least one reception, several of whom rank among the Ivy League and nation's leaders.
- Brown is averaging 325.5 yards through the air this season, the most in the Ivy League and seventh-most in FCS.

- Wes Rockett

- Rockett has registered at least 68 yards receiving in four games this season, and at least 75 yards three times.
- He ranks second on the squad with 36 catches and five TDs, and leads the way with 451 total receiving yards.
- Rockett recorded his first career multi-touchdown game against Princeton, scoring touchdowns on three of his five receptions.

- Hayes Sutton

- Sutton is coming off a career-best three touchdown performance last weekend at Cornell.
- He leads Brown with six TD catches and 39 receptions this season.
- Sutton has registered four games this season with at least 69 yards receiving.

- Graham Walker

- Walker has two games with at least 89 yards receiving, and has four TDs this season.
- Walker scored the game-winning touchdown at Cornell, a 30-yard reception on a leaping catch over the defender with 29 seconds left.
- Brown lost its top six receivers from the 2019 squad that ranked second in the Ivy League with 301.1 receiving yards/game.
- Sutton led all returning receivers with 15 catches for 163 yards in 2019.
- Entering this season, RB Allen Smith was the only member of the Bears roster to have at least one career touchdown reception. He tallied two in 2019 and one in 2018.

JASON MEDEIROS

• Senior linebacker Jason Medeiros is tied for second on the team with 32 total tackles, and leads the squad with 5.5 tackles-for-loss and 3.0 sacks. His TFLs and sacks are both career single-season highs.

TURNOVERS

- Brown has turned the ball over 18 times this season, resulting in 64 points off turnovers. However, the Bears have only allowed 10 points off turnovers their last three games, compared to allowing 54 points through their first three games.
- Brown’s turnover margin is -12, with its -2.17 turnover margin/game ranking 122nd of 123 in FCS.
- Points allowed off turnovers: URI- 24, Harvard- 24, Bryant- 6, Colgate-3, Princeton-0, Cornell- 10

OH CAPTAIN MY CAPTAIN!

- Brown will be served by two senior captains for the 2021 season in quarterback EJ Perry and running back Allen Smith.
- Brown has also added a third game captain for each game since their matchup with Colgate on Oct. 9.

RISING TO NEW HOECHTS

- Brown alum Michael Hoecht is currently on the LA Rams 53-man roster. Hoecht made the Rams’ practice squad last season before being named to the active roster out of training camp in 2021.
- He has appeared in all seven games this season for the Rams, and made three starts.
- The defensive lineman made his first career NFL tackle in a Week 2 win over the Colts.
- A native of Oakwood, Ohio, Hoecht played in 37 games from 2016-19 with Brown, recording 174 tackles and 16.5 sacks, while recovering four fumbles.

EJ PERRY PROFILE

2021 SEASON.

- In Brown’s win over Cornell, Perry hit 80 yards rushing for the second consecutive week and was 23-for-36 for 275 yards through the air.
- Prior to the win at Cornell, Perry had thrown for 300 yards in eight consecutive games dating back to Nov. 9, 2019 at Yale.
- Threw a career-high five touchdown passes against Princeton on 34-for-51 passing, while rushing for a season-high 82 yards.
- Perry threw for 351 yards and two TDs, and rushed for another in Brown’s 31-10 win over Colgate. His 351 yards were the most this season and fourth-most in a single game in his career.
- Threw for 346 yards on 34-of-45 passing and two touchdowns at Harvard.
- Completed a season-high 37 passes on 61 attempts for 344 yards and two scores against URI in the season-opener.
- Stats Perform Preseason Third Team All-America honors (QB)...Named to the Walter Payton Award Watch List...Named to the NFLPA Collegiate Preseason Big Board.

2020 SEASON

- Stats Perform FCS Preseason Second Team All-American (All-Purpose)...Phil Steele’s Preseason Ivy League Offensive Player of the Year...Semifinalist for William V. Campbell Trophy.

2019 SEASON

- Named a finalist for the Asa Bushnell Cup as Ivy League Offensive Player of the Year...First Team All-Ivy League
- Third player in Brown history to lead the team in both rushing (730 yds) and passing (2,948) yards.
- Led the nation in total offense (367.8 yards per game) and set an Ivy League record for total offense (3,678 yards) in 2019.
- His 2,948 passing yards ranked fifth all-time at Brown and 15th in Ivy League history for a single season.
- His 251 completions rank sixth all-time for a single season in Brown program history (and 10th on Brown’s all-time list); 12th in Ivy League single-season history.

- Served as the backup QB at Boston College, appearing in six games over two seasons. Appeared in five games in 2018, completing 69.2 percent of his passes for 277 yards and two TDs, and added one rushing TD.

SCOUTING PENN

- Penn sits at 0-3 on the season in Ivy League play, dropping games to Cornell and Yale in its last two contests.
- The Quakers have been plagued by slow starts this season, being outscored by opponents 23-17 in the first quarter and 62-41 in the second quarter.
- The rushing attack has been the bread and butter for the Penn offense during the last three games. Penn has rushed for 328, 185 and 121 yards in their last three contests, respectively. In each of the last three games, Penn has rushed for two rushing touchdowns. Before rushing for 328 yards and two scores against Lehigh, Penn ran for just 11 yards against Lafayette and 35 yards against Dartmouth.
- Isaiah Malcome is the leading rusher for the Quakers with 505 yards (84.2/game) and is tied for the team lead with Trey Flowers with four rushing touchdowns. Malcome has rushed for at least 80 yards in four of the six games this season with his best performance being a 201-yard performance against Lehigh. Malcome has reached the end zone in each of the last four games.
- John Quinnelly has started in five of the six games but did not play in Penn's last game against Yale. Quinnelly is the leading passer for Penn, averaging 156.4 yards per game. The senior has thrown three touchdowns and five interceptions this season.
- Aidan Sayin made his first-career start in Penn's game at Yale. Sayin went 12-for-28 with 114 yards, two touchdowns and an interception.
- Penn's defense had 13 sacks through the first four games of the season, collecting four each in games against Bucknell, Lafayette and Lehigh. In the three Ivy League games this season, Penn only has one sack (against Dartmouth) and did not record a sack against either Columbia or Yale.
- Penn has scored a touchdown in each of its last five trips into the red zone. Penn's opponents have scored touchdowns in nine of their 21 visits to the red zone. Yale scored touchdowns in all five attempts to the red zone in Penn's last game. In the game against Columbia, the Lions got to the red zone three times but kicked field goals on all three trips.
- In the last meeting between Penn and Brown (Nov. 2, 2019), Penn won the game on a 22-yard field goal with two seconds left. Brown was down 35-19 in the third quarter before taking the lead on an EJ Perry touchdown run with 8:40 left in the game.
