## QUICK HITS

- Coming off of a bye week, the Blue Devils play their second consecutive road contest
- Today's game is the second consecutive appearance on ESPN+ for the Blue Devils
- Davion Johnson leads the team in rushing yards (136) and receptions (13)
- Kimal Clark has double-digit tackles in each of the last two games, with a career-high 13 stops at Kent State
- CCSU is one of three teams with two blocked kicks this season (UNH, Youngstown St.)
- Tavian Montgomery recorded the Blue Devils first interception of the season at Kent State
- Ricky Ortega is the only Blue Devil with multiple touchdowns this fall, with two of the team's nine scores

# **NOTABLES**

- The CCSU defense is eighth in FCS football allowing 133.3 passing yard per game, which is second in the NEC. Brown ranks first in the nation at 359 yards in the air per game.

- Davion Johnson is 42nd nationally, third in the NEC, with 105.67 all-purpose yards per game. He is the team's leading rusher, with 136 net yards and a touchdown. He leads the team with 13 receptions and is second at 44.3 yards per game receiving. Johnson also has a pair of kick returns for 48 yards and a team-best 24.0 yards per return average.

- Dan Toatley and Ahmad Craig rank first and third in the NEC in sacks per games. Toatley is tops with .83 per outing and Craig is averaging 0.67 per game. The team is 22nd nationally, second in the NEC, averaging 2.67 sacks per game.

- Matt Jenner made his first CCSU start at Kent State on September 16th. He has played in two games this year, completing five passes. He has rushed the ball seven times for 30 yards.

- Kimal Clark had a career-high 13 stops at Kent State, his second consecutive double-digit tackle effort - and second career single-game effort in a row. Against Stonehill he became the first Blue Devil to record double-digit tackles in a game, making 10 stops. He ranks first in the NEC, 14th in FCS, with 6.0 solo stops per game, and is 20th nationally, first in the NEC, with 10.0 tackles an outing.

- The Blue Devils have the top total offense number, 367 yards per game, in the NEC. The Blue Devils had 528 yards in the opener and 420 in week two. CCSU's 28.0 points/game also leads the NEC.

- The Blue Devil defense has broken up 12 passes this season, with one interception. Seven players have at least one PBU, with Gavin Bryson leading the way with three.

- Tavian Montgomery leads the NEC at 14.7 yards per punt return, a number that is 11th in the NCAA. He had a season-long 49 yard return in the opening night win over AIC. On defense, Montgomery, a transfer from Northern Arizona, has made 11 tackles - eight solo and recorded an INT and two PBU's.

- The probable starting five on the offensive line (Alec Ambrosia, Isaiah DeLoatch, Jordin Martell, Mason Schloop, and Reis Spicer), have combined to play in 101 career games. Of that total, 90 have come since 2021.

- Malik Thomas has carried the ball 25 times for 116 yards. He ran for 80 yards and a touchdown on 13 carries in the opener.

- Jack Barnum has accounted for 20 points this season, with 4-6 FG's and 8-8 PAT. He is the first Blue Devil kicker since 2006 to connect on two field goals of 40+ yards in a season opener and the only person since at least 2001 to do so in his CCSU debut. He connected from 48 and 45 yards in the win over AIC. Barnum is the third player to have multiple 40+ yard field goals in the

program since 2001. Derek Pearson made seven 40+ yard field goals from 2002-06, including two in the 2006 season opener. Francis Cole made four of 40+ in 2018-19, including a program-record 50 yarder against Lafayette in 2018.

- CCSU has tallied 47 of its 84 points, 56 percent, in the fourth quarter.

- Elijah Howard has returned five kicks for 105 yards this season, an average of 21 yard per return. He also has one catch for 15 yards.

- The Blue Devils are 2-2 on two point conversions this season

- Aiden Clark averaged a season-best 40.7 yards per punt versus Stonehill, with three punts for 122 yards, with a touchback and one inside the 20. He is averaging 39.6 yards per punt this season, slightly better than his 51.2 a season ago, that ranked 51st nationally. Clark had four punts, in 2022, of 50+ yards, including a 69-yard boot against Brown that was four-yards shy of the school-record.

- CJ Duell's was solid in the first two games, his first collegiate starts. His 169.4 passing efficiency was 12th in FCS and tops in the NEC at that time. He completed 17 passes in week one and 18 in week two, including a 51-yard TD versus Stonehill. Before his injury he connected on 35-53 passes, 66%, for 534 yards.

- Trey Howe picked up NEC Rookie of the Week accolades after blocking a punt and returning it for a touchdown. It is the redshirt-freshmen's first-ever block or TD.

- Paul Marsh, Jr., Cortaz Williams, and Elijah Howard all had their first career touchdowns as Blue Devils in the win over AIC. Trey Howe, Naj Johnson and Ricky Ortega joined that list in the Stonehill game.

- Davian Johnson was an NEC Prime Performer for his 156 all-purpose yards effort in the season opener.

- The 44 points the Blue Devils scored in the opener is the most since putting up 49 at Merrimack in 2021. It is the most points at home since a 49-point effort against Robert Morris during the 2019 championship season, a year they eclipsed 40 five times

- Jack Barnum's 48-yard field goal was one of the five longest in the FCS in week one. He was named NEC Special Teams Player of the Week and earned FCS National Special Teams Player of the Week honorable mention.

- The Blue Devils season opening win was the first since 26-23 win over Fordham in 2019 in the Bronx, NY and defeated Fordham 26-23. Coach Lechtenberg is now 2-1 in opening games while with CCSU, 1-1 as an assistant, in 2010-11.

- Mason Schloop, a graduate student in his sixth season with the Blue Devils was named the Northeast Conference Scholar-Athlete

of the Year in June 2022. He is the first male CCSU student-athlete to earn the annual award, and is also the first NEC Football player to earn the accolade. He was selected from a group of nominees all of whom had perfect academic records at graduation. ([Read More](#))

• Jadd Dolegala, Shayne Manson, Mason Schloop and Dan Toatley were selected by their teammates to serve as the 2023 team captains.

• Assistant Coach Charles Williams, outside linebackers, was selected as a Bill Walsh Coaching Fellow for the second year. He spent a week as a coaching intern with the Pittsburgh Steelers in 2022 and this season was with the San Francisco 49ers during NFL preseason camp.

• CCSU football games will air on NECFrontRow.com with Bruce Biel and Marc Robbins on the call. All CCSU home games, with the exception of the October 26th game versus LIU will be available for free on NEC Front Row.

• Four Blue Devils earned preseason All-NEC recognition this season from the league's head coaches. Reis Spicer offensive line, and Isiah Williams, wide receiver, represented the offense while defensive lineman Shayne Manson and linebacker Luquay Washington earned spots on the defensive side of the ball.

• CCSU will host LIU on CBS Sports Network, Thursday, October 26th, in the first nationally televised linear game from Arute Field in program history.

• Jake Dolegala is starting at QB for Saskatchewan in the CFL. In seven games he is 116-185 passing, for 1,377 yards and nine touchdowns. Chizi Umunakwe played in three games, making seven tackles and recording a sack for Ottawa.

• CCSU has won eight straight games decided by one point. The streak dates back to a 14-13 loss to Monmouth in 1994 season.

• The Blue Devils played one of the most memorable games in program history in 2017 topping Wagner 51-45 in 4OT on Staten Island. The game is the longest in school history and the ninth-ever overtime game for CCSU. The Blue Devils are now 7-3 all-time in overtime including a 38-31 won at home over Saint Francis on Nov. 9, 2019.

• Senior Jadd Dolegala is the third member of his family to suit up for CCSU. He started on the defensive line, but moved to tight end for the 2021 campaign. He made 11 catches, for 148 yards and had his first career touchdown vs. Columbia. His older brothers Jarrett (2016-17) and Jake (2015-18) played together for two seasons at CCSU. Jarrett made seven catches in 21 games, while Jake left school as the all-time leader in passing yardage & touchdowns, becoming just the fifth quarterback in league history to throw for over 8,000 yards. He threw for 48 career TD's. He set the school-record with 2,934 passing yards in 2016, completing 258-of-432 passes, with only nine interceptions. He also rushed for 452 yards in his career, including 18 TD. Jake has been on four NFL rosters (Bengals, Patriots, Packers, Dolphins) since leaving campus.
