TIP-OFF

- >> Brown will tip-off its 2025-26 season at home against Siena (Nov. 7) and Vermont (Nov. 9), this is the first time Brown will open the season at home against a Division I opponent since the 2014-15 season.
- >> Brown will look to win its first season opener since the 2021-22 campaign.
- >> Last season, finished the season with a 14-13 record and 6-8 record in Ivy League action.
- >> The Bears went 8-6 inside the Pizzitola Sports Center last season, the most home wins in a season since the 2019-20 season.
- >> Brown returned 11 players from the 2024-25 squad.

GAME NOTES

2024-25 RECAP

- >> Brown finished the 2024-25 season 14-13 overall and 6-8 in Ivy League play.
- >> The Bears finished non-conference play with an 8-5 mark, it was the ninth time they finished their non-conference schedule with a winning record under Martin.
- >> The Bears' 8-5 non-conference record was the best under Martin.
- >> Brown's six-game winning streak in non-conference play was the second time under Martin that the Bears won six consecutive games and the second time in as many seasons, Brown ended the 2023-24 regular season on a six-game winning streak.

PROTECTING THE RIM

- >> Brown was one of the premier shot blocking teams in the nation last season, they rejected at least five shots in 17 out of 27 games and consistently ranking among the top 15 teams nationally.
- >> The Bears' 142 blocks was the most by an Ivy League team, the second-most was Yale with 108, Brown's 5.26 blocks was the most in the Ivy League by 1.66 blocks per game (Yale 3.60).
- >> Brown's 11 blocks against Rhode Island last season were the most in a single game by an Ivy League team.
- >> N'famara Dabo (1.8) and Landon Lewis (1.6) ranked first and second in the Ivy League in blocks per game last season.

VETERAN FRONT COURT

- >> Brown returns four members of its front court from last season in Landon Lewis, N'famara Dabo, David Rochester, and Wyatt DeGraaf.
- >> Lewis averaged a career-high 13.7 points, 6.8 rebounds, and 1.6 blocks per game in 28.9 minutes per game. Lewis had two games with five blocks
- >> Dabo had five or more blocks in four separate games last season, he shot 57.1 percent from the floor.
- >> Rochester made 23 appearances as a freshman last season, he shot 38.9 percent from the floor.
- >> DeGraaf appeared in 12 games as a freshman in 2024-25, he shot 61.5 percent from the floor.

MALCOLM'S 2024-25 JUMP

- >> Malcolm Wrisby-Jefferson appeared in all 27 games for Brown last season while making 19 starts, both were a career high.
- >> Wrisby-Jefferson averaged 5.4 points, 3.4 rebounds, and 2.2 assists on 53.3 shooting from the floor last season.

NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULE

- >> Brown will play 14 non-conference games this season, including seven inside the Pizzitola Sports Center.
- >> The Bears will play all three Division I Rhode Island programs in December at Rhode Island (Dec. 2), against Bryant (Dec. 5) and at Providence (Dec. 9).
- >> Brown will also host the Brown Bears Invitational against Hampton (Nov. 14) and Holy Cross (Nov. 18).
- >> The Bears will travel to USC on Dec. 21.

IVY LEAGUE PRESEASON POLL

- >> Brown was selected sixth in the Ivy League Preseason Poll, which was released on Oct. 23.
- >> In the poll, Brown received 68 total votes.

IVY LEAGUE MEDIA DAY

- >> "We have 11 returners from last year and four new freshmen. In a lot of ways, we are able to build a culture of continuity and stability and we talk about a brotherhood of Brown basketball players. That's real here because they know who their teammates are from year to year and our alumni comes back and they're engaged and they want to help these guys." - Men's Basketball Head Coaching Chair Mike Martin '04

NEW FACES FOR THE BEARS

- >> Brown welcomed four newcomers ahead of the 2025-26 season in Jonah Drezner, Isaiah Langham, Brady Loughlin, and Charlie O'Sullivan.

RETURNING FACES FOR THE BEARS

- >> Brown returns 11 players from the 2024-25 squad, 10 out of 11 returners saw action last season.
- >> Six out of 11 returners made 20 or more appearances last season.

LILLY TO EUROPE

- >> Former Brown men's basketball standout Kino Lilly Jr. '25 signed a professional contract with the Surrey 89ers, the 89ers play in the Super League Basketball in Great Britain.
- >> The 2025-26 season will be the second-ever season for the 89ers and the second-ever season of Super League Basketball. Super League Basketball is the top-level basketball league in Great Britain.
- >> Lilly inked his deal with the 89ers after earning a spot on the San Antonio Spurs' 2025 Summer League roster.
- >> Lilly Jr. concluded his career first in program history in three pointers made (328), second in program history in points (1,878), and in field goals made (648). He is the only player in program history, and the third player in Ivy League history to make over 300 three-pointers.

GAINEY IN THE PROS

- >> Jaylan Gainey '22 inked a Summer League contract with the Utah Jazz after spending the 2024-25 season with Utah's G-League affiliate Salt Lake City Stars.
- >> Gainey also signed a contract with the Brampton Honey Badgers in May, the Honey Badgers play in the Canadian Elite Basketball League.

MARTIN APPROACHING 100 AT THE PIZZ

- >> Already the winningest coach in program history, Head Men's Basketball Coaching Chair Mike Martin '04 is one victory away from 100 inside the Pizzitola Sports Center.

40TH ANNIVERSARY

- >> Brown will celebrate the 40th anniversary of the 1986 team that earned the program's first Ivy League Championship.
- >> Alumni weekend will take place on Jan. 30 & Jan. 31.

NBA CHAMPIONS!

- >> David Mitchell '22 and Obi Okolie '19 helped lead the Oklahoma City Thunder to the 2025 NBA Championship.
- >> Mitchell is a video analyst with the Thunder and Okolie is a scouting coordinator.

WNBA CHAMPION!

- >> Larry Lewis, the father of senior forward Landon Lewis, is an assistant coach with the Las Vegas Aces of the WNBA.
- >> Lewis helped lead the Aces to its third WNBA Championship in the last four seasons with the 2025 crown.

NEW FACES ON THE BENCH

- >> Martin '04 announced the addition of Omar Lowery and Ta-Rel Franklin to the program's coaching staff.
- >> Lowery joins the program as an Assistant Coach, and Franklin joins the program as the Operations Coordinator.

SAME FACES, DIFFERENT POSITIONS

- >> Martin '04 announced the promotions of Tyson Wheeler and DeVon Price ahead of the 2025-26 season.
- >> Wheeler will be the Associate Head Coach and Price will serve as an Assistant Coach.

FAMILY TIES

- >> Brown Manager of Broadcasting and Voice of Men's Basketball Scott Cordischi and basketball student manager Jack Cordischi work with the Brown Bears men's basketball program.
- >> Cordischi was one of the nominees for the 2024 National Sports Media Association Rhode Island Sportscaster of the Year.

COURT DEDICATION

- >> The New London Community Center has a new name for its basketball court, named after Brown's associate head coach, Tyson Wheeler Court debuted on June 25 in New London, Conn.

RUNS IN THE FAMILY

- >> Freshman Jonah Drezner's father, Jon, graduated from Brown in 1999.
- >> Jon Drezner played three varsity seasons with the Bears and averaged 7.3 points, 4.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists, 0.9 steals per game.

NDUR TO THE WIZARDS

- >> Malachi Ndur '24, has been working with the Washington Wizards as a video coordinator.

COOLEY TO THE CAVS

- >> Following graduation in May 2025, Aaron Cooley '25 was hired by the Cleveland Cavaliers as an assistant video coordinator.

GAME NOTES

GONE BUT NEVER FORGOTTEN

>> Mike Cingiser '62, a member of the Brown Athletic Hall of Fame and Head Coach of the 1986 Ivy League Championship Team, passed away in late December at the age of 84. Cingiser played for the Bears from 1959-62 before being the head coach of the Bears from 1981-91.

>> Mike Cingiser was named First Team All-Ivy League in all three varsity seasons with the Bears, one of only nine players in Ivy League history to be so honored at the time. Cingiser graduated as Brown's leading scorer in scoring (1,331 points) and field goals made (490). Cingiser's 17.8 points per game still ranks tied for fourth in program history. Cingiser was also named to the Brown 100th Season's All-Decade Team (1960's).

>> While in school, Cingiser helped the United States to a gold medal at the 1961 Maccabiah Games alongside Larry Brown, who would become the only coach to win an NCAA national championship and an NBA title.

>> After graduating with a bachelor's degree in English Literature from Brown University in 1962, Cingiser was selected in the ninth round of the NBA draft by the Boston Celtics but instead chose to coach and teach. He spent 11 years as head coach and English teacher at Lynbrook (NY) High School, winning two Long Island South Shore Championships and twice being named Long Island Coach of the Year. Cingiser also spent two years at Hofstra University as an assistant coach, winning back-to-back East Coast Conference Championships and appearing in two NCAA Tournaments.

>> Cingiser returned to his alma mater in 1981 and coached the Bears for 10 seasons, the third-longest tenure in program history behind his own head coach L. Stanley Ward and current Head Men's Basketball Coaching Chair Mike Martin '04. Cingiser's 93 total wins at the helm of his alma mater are tied for the third-most wins for a head coach in program history. Paramount among Cingiser's accomplishments as head coach in Providence was leading the Bears to their lone Ivy League championship and an NCAA Tournament appearance in 1985-86, Brown's first NCAA postseason berth since 1938-39.

- After graduating from Brown, Martin spent the 2004-05 season playing professionally for Dart Killester in Ireland's top division of professional basketball.

Martin launched his coaching career at Brown on head coach Glen Miller's staff as an assistant coach in 2005-2006. He joined Miller at Penn in 2006-2007 as an assistant coach and enjoyed a memorable season, with the Quakers posting a 22-9 record, winning the Ivy League Championship with a 13-1 League mark, and advancing to the NCAA Tournament.

At Penn, he helped head coach Jerome Allen and the Quakers post 20 wins overall in 2011-2012 for the first time since 2006-07, finishing second in the Ivy League at 11-3, one game behind Harvard in the standings. Penn then played in the postseason College Basketball Invitational, defeating Quinnipiac in the opening round before falling to Butler in the quarterfinal round.
