### BALL STATE FOOTBALL QUICK FACTS

⇒ Ball State suffered a 34-23 loss at Toledo Sept. 20, before enjoying a bye week . . . The Toledo game included a two hour and 40 minute weather delay.

⇒ Ball State has allowed only 22.2 points per game this season, which ranks 46th in the country in scoring defense . . . Ball State allowed Colgate to score only 10 points in the season opener, which marked the fewest points scored by a Ball State opponent in the Pete Lembo era and the fewest since the Cardinals held Buffalo to three points in 2010.

⇒ Ball State ranks 16th in the nation in red zone defense, having allowed opponents to score on only 68.8 percent of trips inside the 20-yard line, including a touchdown in only 8-of-16 trips in the red zone . . . The Cardinals limited Big Ten Conference foe Iowa to only three scores in the Hawkeyes' six trips inside the red zone.

⇒ The Cardinals rank 23rd in the nation in fewest penalties per game, while also ranking 31st in the country in time of possession . . . Ball State is averaging only 5.0 penalties per contest and holding the ball for an average of 31:33 per contest.

⇒ Ball State is 17-5 in its last 22 regular season games and suffered a loss in its Mid-American Conference opener in the Toledo contest Sept. 20, for the first time since the 2009 season when the Cardinals fell to Toledo, 37-30, in Muncie, Ind.

⇒ The Cardinals competed in the GoDaddy Bowl after the 2013 season to mark back-to-back bowl appearances for only the second time in the school's 90-year history of football . . . The only other time Ball State has played in back-to-back bowls was after the 2007 and 2008 seasons.

⇒ Ball State posted 10 victories in 2013, which marks only the third time in the school's football history the Cardinals have won at least 10 games in a season . . . The Cardinals were 10-1 overall in 1978 . . . Ball State was 12-2 overall in 2008.

⇒ Ball State's seven MAC wins last season marks only the fifth time since joining the league in 1975 the Cardinals have tallied at least seven wins in the MAC . . . The Cardinals were 8-0 in 1978 and 2008, 7-0-1 in 1993 and 7-1 in 1996.

⇒ Ball State finished second in the MAC's West Division in 2013, which was the best finish for the program since winning the West in 2008.

⇒ Ball State reached bowl eligibility for a third straight season in 2013 . . . The last time the Cardinals won at least six games in three straight seasons came when the team reached the mark in four straight campaigns from 1988-91 . . . Ball State won six games in 2011, nine games in 2012 and 10 in 2013.

## Ball State News and Notes

**2014 Team Captains:** Jahwan Edwards, Ben Ingle, Brian Jones, Nick Miles and Jacob Richard are serving as the Ball State team captains this season.

**Always Improving:** According to [footballscoop.com](http://footballscoop.com), Ball State is the only Football Bowl Subdivision school in the country to have upped its season win totals every year from 2010 to 2013 . . . After tallying a 2-10 record in 2009, the Cardinals improved to four wins in 2010, six victories in 2011, nine wins in 2012 and 10 in 2013.

**What a Way to Start a Career:** **Dedrick Cromartie**, a true freshman from St. Louis, Mo., was forced into service due to some injuries to the Ball State safeties in the Toledo game . . . In his first snap from scrimmage as a member of the Cardinals, Cromartie intercepted a second quarter pass . . . It marked the first interception for Ball State's defense this season, and he became one of only 20 true freshmen in the nation to record an interception this year.

**Leading the D:** **Ben Ingle** led the Cardinals with a career-high 14 tackles at Toledo . . . It marked the second time this season he has led the team in tackles (11 vs. Colgate), and he tied for second in tackles at Iowa (9) and vs. Indiana State (6) . . . Ingle leads Ball State with 40 tackles this season plus has registered one tackle for loss, one pass breakup and one quarterback hurry . . . He ranks 32nd in the latest NCAA statistics in total tackles.

**Defensive Notes:** **Michael Ayers** ranks second for Ball State with 23 tackles on the season, while **Martez Hester**, who led the Cardinals with nine tackles vs. Indiana State, is third with 21 stops this season . . . **Zack Ryan**, who recorded the second fumble recovery of his career at Toledo, and **Eric Patterson** have 20 tackles apiece in 2014 . . . Patterson and Ayers lead the team with two tackles for loss apiece, while **Darius Conaway** has a team best three pass breakups.

**Edwards' 100-Yard Games:** **Jahwan Edwards** rushed for 125 yards at Toledo, which marked the 14th time in his career he has rushed for 100 or more yards in a game . . . He ranks fourth in Ball State history for 100-yard rushing games in a career and needs one more to tie for second with Bernie Parmalee (1986-89) and MiQuale Lewis (2006-09).

**Edwards' Career Record Chase:** **Jahwan Edwards** ranks third on Ball State's career rushing chart with 3,696 rushing yards . . . Edwards trails only Marcus Merriweather (4,002 from 1999-2002) and MiQuale Lewis (3,748 from 2006-10) . . . He needs 53 yards to move into second and pass Lewis . . . With his 390 rushing yards on the season, Edwards ranks 41st in the nation in rushing yards and 32nd with 97.5 rushing yards per game.

**Edwards' Career Record Chase Part Two:** **Jahwan Edwards** moved into fifth place on Ball State's list for career rushing attempts in the Cardinals' game vs. Indiana State and now has 706 in his career . . . With his 21 rushing attempts at Toledo, Edwards became only the fifth player in Ball State's history to tally at least 700 rushing attempts in a career . . . He needs 17 rushing attempts to move into fourth on the Ball State chart.

**Touchdown Machine:** **Jahwan Edwards**, who ranked 19th in the nation in rushing touchdowns in 2013, set the Ball State record for total touchdowns in a career with 39 as a junior last season . . . He scored the 40th TD of his career in the season opener vs. Colgate and the 41st of his career vs. Indiana State . . . Edwards has scored all 41 of his record-setting TDs on the ground and also holds the school record for rushing touchdowns in a career.

**The QB's First Season:** **Ozzie Mann**, a redshirt sophomore quarterback for the Cardinals, made the first start of his career in the season opener vs. Colgate and has started all four games this season . . . Mann, who graduated from the same high school as offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach and former Ball State QB Joey Lynch, has completed 74-of-135 passes for 774 yards with five touchdowns and only one interception this season.

**Mabon Leading The Receiving Corps:** **KeVonn Mabon**, who received a medical redshirt after being sidelined with an injury after three games in 2013, leads the Cardinals with 25 catches for 292 yards and two touchdowns this season . . . Mabon ranks 32nd in the nation with 6.3 receptions per game.

**Kicking Game:** **Scott Secor** connected on 3-of-4 field goals at Toledo and improved to 29-of-33 in his career on field goals of 45 yards or less . . . He made a career-long 49 yarder at Toledo . . . Secor had a string of 13 consecutive field goals made in 2013, which marks the second longest streak in Ball State history . . . Secor ranks first in the nation with 2.5 field goals per game, 40th with a .769 field goal percentage and 36th in scoring at 9.5 points per game . . . **Eric Patterson** ranks 36th in the NCAA with a 25.4 kickoff return average.

### Ball State vs. Army

• **Scouting Army:** The Black Knights fell to 1-3 on the season after suffering a 49-43 overtime loss at Yale Saturday . . . Army opened the season with a 47-39 win at Buffalo before losing at Stanford (35-0) and at Wake Forest (24-21) . . . Larry Dixon leads the Army attack with 62 rushes for 338 yards and four touchdowns, while quarterback Angel Santiago has rushed 50 times for 271 yards with four TDs . . . Santiago has completed 16-of-20 passes for 240 yards on the year, while A.J. Schurr has completed 7-of-15 passes for 123 yards with one touchdown and one interception.

• **Series vs. Army:** Ball State and Army have met five times in a series that dates back to 1999 . . . Army won the first two meetings -- 41-21 in 1999 at Army and 24-17 in 2009 at Army . . . Ball State has won the last three meetings -- 48-21 at Ball State in 2011, 30-22 at Army in 2012 and 40-14 at Ball State last season . . . In games played at Army, the Black Knights hold a 2-1 all-time advantage.

• **Familiar Faces:** Army has three members of its coaching staff that are former assistant coaches at Ball State . . . Defensive Coordinator **Jay Bateman** was the Cardinals' defensive coordinator from 2011-13 under the tutelage of Ball State head coach Pete Lembo . . . In addition, Bateman and Lembo worked together at Lehigh (2005) and Elon (2006-10) . . . Bateman helped Ball State to the Beef 'O' Brady's Bowl St. Petersburg after the 2012 season and the GoDaddy Bowl after the 2013 campaign . . . Defensive line coach **Ray McCartney** was an assistant at Ball State from 1989-94 and was a part of the Cardinals' Mid-American Conference Championship teams in 1989 and 1993 . . . McCartney helped the Cardinals to the 1989 California Raisin Bowl and the 1993 Las Vegas Bowl . . . **Kyle Hoke**, who played for the Cardinals from 2008-11, is a quality control coach for the Black Knights . . . Hoke is the son of former Ball State letterwinner Jon Hoke and the nephew of Ball State football alum and former football coach Brady Hoke, who is currently the head coach at Michigan.

• Ball State sophomore football student-athlete **Darius Conaway** has been suspended from the team for two games due to a violation of team rules, according to Ball State head football coach Pete Lembo.

## CAREER COACHING HIGHLIGHTS AT BALL STATE

- Added the title of associate athletics director to his head football coaching position in March of 2014.
- Has led Ball State to a 17-5 record in the last 22 regular season games and a 12-2 Mid-American Conference mark in the last 14 league tilts.
- Improved his career record to 11-3 in season openers after leading Ball State to a 30-10 victory over Colgate in the first game of 2014. Won his first game as a head coach at all three schools he has coached and guided the Cardinals to wins in all four season openers at Ball State.
- Guided the Cardinals to a 10-3 overall record in 2013, including a second straight bowl appearance when Ball State played in the GoDaddy Bowl. It marks only the second time in 89 years of football the Cardinals have played in back-to-back bowl games.
- One of 20 coaches in country named to the 2013 Paul Bear Bryant National Coach of the Year Award Watch List.
- Earned his 100th career victory with a 27-24 win over Kent State in Ball State's 87th Homecoming Game in 2013.
- Coached Ball State to a 48-27 win at Atlantic Coast Conference member Virginia in 2013 for his fourth win over a school from a Football Bowl Subdivision automatic qualifying conference in his first three seasons at Ball State. One of only six Mid-American Conference head coaches since the advent of the Bowl Championship Series to have won four or more games against teams from automatic qualifying conferences.
- Led the Cardinals to a 7-1 MAC record in 2013 -- only the fifth 7-1 or better league mark since joining the MAC in 1975.
- Led Ball State to a 10-3 record in 2013, which marks only the third time in the Cardinals' 89 years of football with 10 or more wins in a single season.
- Led the Cardinals to a school record 501 points in 2013, breaking the previous Ball State mark of 489 in 14 games in the 2008 season.
- Led Ball State to a 9-4 overall record and a 6-2 Mid-American Conference mark in his second season in 2012. The nine wins tied for the third most in a single season in school history, while the six MAC wins marked the second highest total since 1996.
- 2011-12 APR was 966 -- the highest in Ball State history and tied for first in the Mid-American Conference among football programs.
- Coached Cardinals to back-to-back wins over teams from the Bowl Championship Subdivision automatic qualifying conferences -- Indiana (Big Ten), 41-39, and South Florida (Big East), 31-27, in 2012.
- Coached Briggs Orsbon and Zane Fakes, who were named to the 2011 and 2013 Capital One Academic All-America Teams, respectively. Also has coached 18 Ball State student-athletes who have received Academic All-MAC honors in the last three seasons, including eight first-team selections.
- Led Ball State to back-to-back wins over Indiana -- 2011 (27-20 at Lucas Oil Stadium in Indianapolis, Ind.) and 2012 (41-39 at Bloomington, Ind.). Coached the Cardinals to two wins over teams from BCS automatic qualifying conferences in the same year for the first time in school history in 2012.
- Led Ball State to a 34-27 win over nationally ranked Toledo in 2012, which marked the Cardinals' first win over a ranked opponent since 2001. Toledo entered the game ranked No. 23 by The Associated Press.
