The Starting 5 - The Top 5 Storylines For This Game

1. CARDS AND FALCONS - THE SERIES

Tuesday night's game in Ohio will be **the 89th meeting between Ball State and Bowling Green**, a series that began in 1965. BG has won four straight in the series, including a 77-71 win at Worthen last year, which was Ball State's only conference loss at home last season. BSU is looking to snap that streak, though recent meetings between the two schools have been very close. The **average margin of victory is 5.8 points between BSU and BG over the last seven meetings**. Ball State's best stretch ever against Bowling Green came from 1997-05, when the Cards won 10 of 13 meetings.

2. INSIDE THE NUMBERS: TUESDAY'S MATCHUP

Bowling Green is the MAC's top scoring team at 83.7 points per game and is near the top in shooting percentage categories. Ball State has been pretty good at defending the '3' which is something BG does well (.372). Both teams are in the bottom half of the league in rebounding. As far as getting good looks goes, BG is last in the conference in blocked shots and Ball State is among the nation's best teams (58th nationally) in not having its shots blocked. Ball State needs to defend well to slow BG's attack and hit those open shots Tuesday night.

3. EASTERN BLOC TO START 2021

Tuesday's game at BG is the third in a row against a MAC East opponent - BSU just played Ohio and Buffalo while the scheduled game against western division foe WMU was postponed. Ball State returns to play against the western half of the league this Saturday when Northern Illinois comes to Worthen at 1 p.m.

4. NEXT MAN UP

Shorthanded in recent weeks - and really the entire season - Ball State had a few bright spots as players stepped up and took on bigger roles. Saturday's game at Buffalo was the **first time since last year's finale at Northern Illinois that five different BSU players scored 8+ points in the same game**. K.J. Walton scored 17 to lead the Cardinals, followed by Luke Bumbalough's 14 and Brachen Hazen with 11. Zach Gunn and Ben Hendriks each score eight to help provide balance.

5. MARQUEE MATCHUP IN THE BACKCOURT

Ball State-Bowling Green will feature some really solid guard play. Each team has one of the league's leading scorers and there will be no shortage of playmaking guards on the floor Tuesday night. K.J. Walton (17.7 ppg) and Ishmael El-Amin (14.7 ppg) have been among the MAC's top duos all season, and Luke Bumbalough (7.4) has strung together several double-digit scoring outings while increasing his assist totals. Bowling Green counters with All-MAC player Justin Turner (20.9 ppg) and two other starting guards who combine for 19.9 points per game.



Seeking Some Revenge

Twice over the last six years Bowling Green has ended Ball State's season. In 2019, the Cards won a road tournament game to advance to Cleveland but lost to #2 seed Bowling Green 99-86. In the 2015 conference tourney, BG beat BSU 88-75.

BSU To Host March Madness At Bankers Life

Ball State University has been selected as a host institution for the 2021 NCAA Tournament. BSU will be the host school for any games played at Bankers Life Fieldhouse in Indianapolis. The venues hosting games in addition to BLF are: Lucas Oil Stadium, Assembly Hall at IU, Mackey Arena at Purdue, Butler's Hinkle Fieldhouse and the Indiana State Farm Coliseum.

1K For KJ

K.J. Walton surpassed the 1,000-point mark for his career in the win at WMU and he now has 1,030 career points. Walton, a 6th-year guard from Indy, scored 378 points in two seasons at Missouri and has 627 points and counting at Ball State.

Cards Perched Atop The MAC West

Winning games like Tuesday's game is how Ball State has won the MAC West division in 2016, 2018 and 2020. BSU went 11-7 in conference play last year and tied atop the division with Northern Illinois, but Ball State won both meetings over NIU to break the standings tie. Ball State won four of its last five games last year before the season was stopped short.

Miryne Sticks The '3' Like A Jab

A former standout Gold Gloves boxer in his youth, Miryne Thomas's sweet science now is shooting the 3-pointer. **Thomas leads the MAC in 3-pointer percentage (.500)**. He is 10-for-20 from 3-point range, which helps cause matchup problems and bring opposing bigs away from the basket. Thomas actually shoots a higher mark from 3-point range than he does inside the arc (.438).

Luke In The State Of Michigan

Ball State has two scheduled games remaining in the state of Michigan (Feb. 9 at Central and Feb. 13 at Eastern) and Luke Bumbalough probably has those dates circled on a calendar. Bumbalough's two best games have come at Michigan and at Western Michigan:

Bumbalough at UM/WMU: 10-16 FG (7-10 3FG), 3-5 FT, 15 ppg, 3 apg **Other 7 games:** 14-49 FG (5-31 3FG), 4-12 FT, 5.3 ppg, 2 apg

Luke Growing As A Playmaker

Now 40 games into his college career, Luke Bumbalough has become a more prolific playmaker. His assists per game mark is up 49.7% from last season and he has 13 assists against 4 turnovers. over the last three games. Bumbalough has the best assist:turnover ratio on the team at 2.5:1 and has 66 career assists against 34 career turnovers.

100th Season For Ball State Basketball


This very strange season happens to be the 100th varsity men's basketball campaign at BSU. Ball State's **all-time record through 99+ seasons is 1,253-1,159-1** (the single tie came in 1923). The Cardinals have posted 45 seasons at .500 or better and 12 20-win seasons (2 under James Whitford).

Brachen Making It Happen

Brachen Hazen is so far having his best college season, posting career highs in all major categories. He tied his career high with 15 points at WMU and had a double-double (14 & 11) vs. Illinois State. **Ball State is 7-2 when Hazen scores in double figures**, including 3-2 this season.

The Block Stops Here

The Cardinals are among the nation's best teams in getting a shot off. **BSU is 58th nationally in offensive block percentage**, meaning its opponents rarely block a Ball State shot attempt. Opponents block just 6.4% of Ball State shots, 36% lower than the national average for that metric.

Local Stars Find A Home At BSU

In the college hoops season in basketball-crazed Indiana, Ball State and Indiana have kept the most guys home. Ball State and Indiana are tied with nine homegrown players on their roster, the most in the state. There are 135 Division I players who played high school ball in Indiana.

Who's Coming In?

Ball State basketball bolstered both its frontcourt and backcourt in the early signing period, adding 6-9 Payton Sparks and 6-4 Jaylin Sellers. Both will suit up for the Cardinals in 2021.

Not Playing With A Full Deck Of Cards

The deck of cards for Ball State is getting closer to being full after BSU was bitten by the injury bug in the preseason. Notably, 2020 MAC Freshman of the Year Jarron Coleman is still out after having foot surgery in October, but is making progress and may return very soon. Transfer Reggie Jones, who scored 723 career points at Western Michigan and Tulsa, is also out with a lower body injury. Blake Huggins missed the Ohio game with a finger injury but returned at Buffalo and Ball State was without three guards in the second half at Buffalo.

Zach's First Start

It may not matter who plays the first minute of a game, especially when you're a proven rotation player, but Zach Gunn made his first career start at Buffalo. He scored eight points in 20 minutes. Gunn, who has played in 61 games at BSU, is third on the team with 11 made 3-pointers.

Ish's Leadership Off The Court

This past June following the killing of George Floyd, Ishmael El-Amin organized a peaceful protest in Muncie. Nearly 3,000 people attended and marched from the BSU campus to downtown Muncie.

Waived In Just In Time

Ball State got good news a week before the season when Jalen Windham was issued immediate eligibility for this season. He came to BSU this offseason after playing in 16 games at Creighton. 


