The Starting 5 - The Top 5 Storylines For This Game

1. CARDS AND OHIO - THE SERIES

Friday's matchup is the **86th meeting between between the two schools**, with Ohio leading 50-35. The Bobcats have won three of the last four in the series, including a win in Muncie earlier this month. Ball State's last win at Ohio came on Jan. 9, 2018 - a 75-68 win where BSU held Ohio to 38% shooting. **Only one active player on either team** played in that game three years ago: Ishmael El-Amin.

2. TUESDAY NIGHT IN MIAMI

If someone predicted Ball State would go to Miami and shoot a better field goal percentage than MU, grab more rebounds, shoot 42% from 3-point range and make all 19 of its free throws...all of those suggest Ball State won the game. However, pressure defense by Miami resulting in a 25-6 edge in points of turnovers and Miami shooting 38 free throws would be too much to overcome. Ball State led by seven at one point early and led 36-35 at halftime before Miami shot 27 foul shots in the second half.

3. CONFERENCE CALL

A road win at Ohio keeps the Cardinals squarely in the hunt for top-4 positioning in the MAC standings, and gives the Cards a fourth league win on the road. Only Toledo, Bowling Green and Ball State own three MAC road wins this year. Individually, Mirnye Thomas - a 6-8 forward - leads the conference in 3-point shooting (.531). He would be **the first non-guard to lead the conference in 3FG% since 2013-14** when Eastern Michigan's Karrington Ward led the league. Ishmael El-Amin is in the MAC rankings in FT% (4th), steals (T-4th), assists (10th) and scoring (12th).

4. THIS OHIO GAME MIGHT LOOK A LITTLE DIFFERENT

Ball State and Ohio played just 20 days ago, but both teams will look different Friday night in Athens. Ohio is expected to have star guard Jason Preston (18.3 ppg, 6.0 rpg) back. He didn't play in the game at BSU. Ball State was missing Jarron Coleman and Blake Huggins in the first meeting.

5. STARTING FOR YOUR CARDINALS???

It's not secret the roster juggling many teams across the country are having to do, and Ball State is no different. Ball State has used four different starting lineups in 12 games, and three of those combinations just twice or once each. The three guards (Walton, El-Amin, Bumbalough) have stay in place each game while Brachen Hazen, Mirnye Thomas, Blake Huggins, Zach Gunn and Ben Hendriks have all started at different times throughout the season. Thomas and Hazen have stated alongside each other seven times, but not since the previous Ohio game on Jan. 2.

Some Numbers Inside Friday's Matchup With Ohio

Ball State is quite good at defending the 3-ball, holding opponents to .310 shooting (5th in the league). Ohio makes 9.15 3FG per game and is second in 3FG percentage. Overall, Ohio leads the conference in shooting percentage and is second in effective shooting percentage. Ball State will need to find the defensive prowess it had in the Bowling Green win nine days ago against OU.

BSU To Host March Madness At Bankers Life

Ball State University has been selected as a host institution for the 2021 NCAA Tournament. BSU will be the host school for any games played at **Bankers Life Fieldhouse in Indianapolis**. The venues hosting games in addition to BLF are: Lucas Oil Stadium, Assembly Hall at IU, Mackey Arena at Purdue, Butler's Hinkle Fieldhouse and the Indiana State Farm Coliseum.

Walton Has Seen Some Things

In his sixth college season, K.J. Walton has played in 117 games and counting - **tied for 11th among active players in Division I**. The next highest total in the MAC is Toledo's Marreon Jackson (113 games). The national active leader in career games played is D'Mitrik Trice of Wisconsin (127 games).

1K For KJ...

K.J. Walton surpassed the 1,000-point mark for his career in the win at WMU in December and he **now has 1,071 career points**. Walton, a 6th-year guard from Indy, scored 378 points in two seasons at Missouri and has 693 points and counting at Ball State.

... And Soon For Ish

And expected soon to join Walton on that list is Ishmael El-Amin. The senior guard from Minnesota is up to 889 career points over 93 career games.

Miryne Stinging Like A Bee - Best In The MAC

A former standout Gold Gloves boxer in his youth, Miryne Thomas's sweet science now is shooting the 3-pointer. **The 6-8 forward is leading the MAC in 3-point percentage (.531)**. He is 17-for-32 from 3-point range, including a 4-for-4 day vs. NIU. Thomas's long-range shooting helps cause matchup problems and brings opposing bigs away from the basket. Thomas nearly had a perfect day against NIU, shooting 6-for-7 (4-for-4 3FG) and 4-for-5 from the foul line. Ironically, his only miss was a layup.

Luke Growing As A Playmaker

Now 43 games into his college career, Luke Bumbalough has become a more prolific playmaker. His **assists per game mark is up 74% from last season and he has 24 assists against 7 turnovers over the last six games**. Bumbalough has the best assist:turnover ratio on the team at 2.8:1 and has 77 career assists against 37 career turnovers.

This very strange season happens to be the 100th varsity men's basketball campaign at BSU. Ball State's **all-time record through 99+ seasons is 1,255-1,160-1** (the single tie came in 1923). The Cardinals have posted 45 seasons at .500 or better and 12 20-win seasons (2 under James Whitford).

Brachen Making It Happen

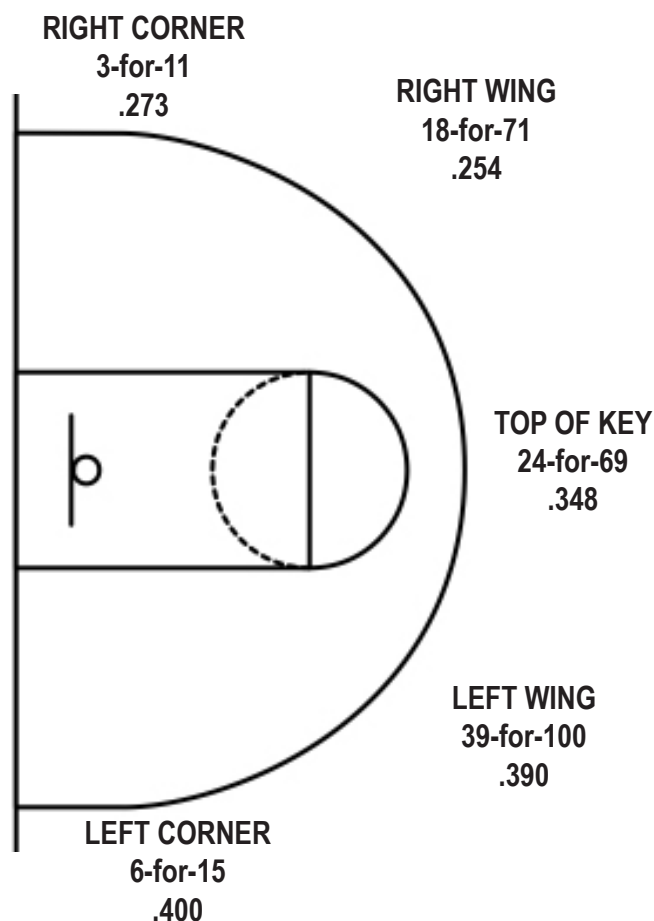
Brachen Hazen, who missed Saturday's game with back soreness, is so far having his best college season. The 6-8 Hazen posted career highs in all major categories. He tied his career high with 15 points at WMU and had a double-double (14 & 11) vs. Illinois State. Hazen scored 14 points on 5-for-7 shooting and grabbed eight boards at Bowling Green. **Ball State is 8-2 when Hazen scores in double figures**, including 4-2 this season.

When Ish Gets 20

The Cardinals have fared well when Ishmael El-Amin scores. The senior guard, who has 863 career points, has seven career 20-point games and **Ball State has won six of those games**. Ball State is also 23-17 when El-Amin scores in double figures.

Not Playing With A Full Deck Of Cards
