Previewing the Cardinals

>> Ball State features a revamped roster bolstered by five incoming transfers and three true freshmen while returning a majority of the frontcourt from last season's team including Mickey Pearson Jr., Ben Hendriks and Mason Jones. The Cardinals were picked to finish sixth in the Mid-American Conference by the Blue Ribbon College Basketball Yearbook and seventh by the league's head coaches in the preseason poll released in late October.

Experienced Group

>> The Cardinals' roster is deep in experience with four sixth-year seniors in Ethan Brittain-Watts, Ben Hendriks, Jeremiah Hernandez and Mickey Pearson Jr. Ball State has the most student-athletes in their sixth year of college of any men's basketball team in NCAA Division I (Southern Miss has three sixth-year and two seventh-year seniors).

>> Ball State's student-athletes have played in 603 games and made 254 starts at the Division I level entering the season, while Hernandez and Payton Sparks have been All-Conference performers. Sparks was recently picked First Team All-MAC in the preseason poll after being a two-time Second Team selection in his first two seasons in Muncie. Hernandez averaged 17.2 points and 3.3 rebounds per game last season at USI to be named First Team All-Ohio Valley Conference.

LAST TIME OUT

AKRON, Ohio – The Ball State men's basketball team was within striking distance with five minutes to play at Akron but the host Zips pulled out an 81-73 win on Tuesday night at James A. Rhodes Arena.

The Cardinals (10-12, 4-6 Mid-American Conference) trailed 68-66 at the 5:45 mark of the second half following a layup from Joey Hart, but Akron (17-5, 10-0 MAC) scored eight straight points to open up a 10-point edge and would lead by at least eight the rest of the way.

Neither team led by more than four points through the game's first 28 minutes, as the Zips took a 38-36 lead into the halftime break. Ball State had eight different scorers in the opening period, as Jermahri Hill led the Cardinals in scoring with seven.

Hill tallied 19 points, seven rebounds and four assists for the game, while Payton Sparks (15 points, three rebounds) and Mickey Pearson Jr. (12 points, four rebounds) joined him in double figures scoring for the visitors. Hart and Ethan Brittain-Watts added seven points each, while Jeremiah Hernandez put in six points and Mason Jones five points and four rebounds.

Sharron Young led the Akron offense with 18 points and five assists while the Zips held a 31-28 edge in rebounding and committed two fewer turnovers (10-8).

Ball State shot 54.9 percent (28-51) from the field, 29.4 percent (5-17) on 3-pointers and 60 percent (12-20) on free throws. Akron hit 53.8 percent (35-65) of its field goal attempts including 25 percent (7-28) from distance to remain unbeaten in conference play.

The Cardinals take a break from MAC opponents when they host Southern Miss at 2 p.m. on Saturday for the MAC-SBC Challenge.

GAME NOTES

SEEMS LIKE AWHILE AGO: Ball State hosted Old Dominion in the inaugural MAC-SBC Challenge for the Cardinals back on Nov. 11, 2023.

The Cardinals have played two Sun Belt teams on the road and it's been 51 overall games since the matchup with the Monarchs.

HART HEATING UP: Sophomore guard Joey Hart has put together 3 of his 6 highest scoring performances in the most recent three games.

The Linton, Ind., native scored seven points on Tuesday at Akron after putting up a season-best eight at Buffalo and on Jan. 28 five points against Western Michigan. Hart has gone an efficient 7-for-11 from the field including 3-for-4 from distance in that time stretch.

BIG WEEK FOR THE BIG MAN: Senior center Payton Sparks averaged 23.0 points and 15.5 rebounds in two games last week to earn a Mid-American Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week honor and increase his season averages to 12.8 points and a team-best 8.1 rebounds per game.

In MAC play, Sparks is second on the team with 15.9 points per game while averaging a team-high 10.7 rebounds per game average.

COMEBACK CARDS: Ball State rallied from a 10-point deficit last Saturday at Buffalo for its second double-digit comeback of the year.

The Cardinals trailed 25-15 midway through the first half but used a 30-7 scoring run to claim a 45-32 lead at halftime. The biggest comeback of the year was from 13 points down at Central Michigan on Jan. 21.

CLUTCH ON THE ROAD: Mickey Pearson Jr. averages 13.7 points and 6.3 rebounds in 10 true road games this year, which are higher than his home averages of 10.2 and 4.6 per game.

The forward's two highest scoring outputs of the year have occurred on the road (19 at Buffalo on Saturday and Ohio on Jan. 14). Pearson has scored in double figures in seven straight road games

SPREAD OUT THE SCORING: Six Cardinals scored in double figures in Ball State's 82-80 triumph at Central Michigan on Jan. 21: Mickey Pearson Jr. (16 points), Jeremiah Hernandez (15), Jermahri Hill (14), Payton Sparks (14), Ethan Brittain-Watts (13), and Juanse Gorosito (10).

It was the second time in four games six Cardinals have scored in double figures (Jan. 11 vs Bowling Green). Ball State had five in double digits in the scoring column on Jan. 18 against Toledo and on Jan. 25 at NIU.

PAYTON POUNDING THE GLASS: Sparks pulled down 14 rebounds along with putting up a career-high 27 points in last Saturday's win at Buffalo.

The Winchester, Ind., native leads the league in rebounding overall (7.9 per game) and in conference games (10.7). Sparks is the 10th Ball State men's basketball player in program history to reach 1,000 career points and 700 career rebounds for the Cardinals.

MORE GAME NOTES

GETTING FAMILIAR WITH THE FREE THROW LINE: Junior guard Jermahri Hill (159) and Sparks (151) are first and second in the league in free throw attempts, respectively.

The two are No. 1 and No. 4 in the conference in free throws made, with 105 for Hill and 91 for Sparks, while Pearson Jr. (73) is sixth in the MAC.

MILESTONE WATCH: After Sparks (currently 1,164 points) reached the milestone on New Year's Eve, Hernandez (988) and Pearson Jr. (984) are each closing in on scoring 1,000 points in his Division I career.

Sparks (705 rebounds) is currently No. 11 in Ball State program history for a career.

GETTING TO THE LINE: The Cardinals pace the Mid-American Conference in both free throw attempts per game (26.5) and free throws made per game (18.1) through the season's first 22 games.

Ball State ranks No. 8 and No. 11 in those categories in NCAA Division I, respectively. The total tallies (582 attempts and 398 makes) outpace the next-closest MAC team (Toledo) by 98 attempts and 40 makes.

GORO-THREE-TO: Junior guard Juanse Gorosito had made multiple 3-pointers in 15 games this season, including a season-best seven on Dec. 14 at Bellarmine to lead the Cardinals to an 86-82 win and eventually being named the MAC Player of the Week for the performance.

Gorosito is third in the conference in 3-pointers made (54) and third in shooting percentage (40.0) from distance among those who've made at least two per game.

HOME STATE HEROES: Brittain-Watts (2019), Zane Doughty, Joey Hart and Mason Jones (2023) were each named Indiana High School All-Stars, while three more Cardinals also had ties to the state before arriving in Muncie.

Ball State has the second-most players from Indiana high schools among Indiana-based Division I teams behind Purdue.

WORLD FLYERS: The 2024-25 Ball State roster consists of student-athletes from three different countries in addition to the United States of America.

Gorosito (Argentina), Hendriks (Canada) and Jurica Zagorsak (Croatia) are international Cardinals this season. Interestingly, Juanse, Ben and Jurica were born on different continents, so Ball State has student-athletes from North America, South America and Europe on the team.

TRANSFERS FROM ALL OVER: Each of Ball State's seven student-athletes who have transferred into the program have come from different college basketball conferences.

The list includes Ethan Brittain-Watts (Patriot League, Boston), Gorosito (West Coast Conference, Portland), Hart (SEC, Kentucky), Hernandez (Ohio Valley Conference, USI), Pearson Jr. (Big 12, TCU), Sparks (Big Ten, Indiana) and Hill who played junior college ball at South Plains in Levelland, Texas.

Michael Lewis was introduced as head coach of the Ball State men's basketball team on March 25, 2022. Lewis became the 20th head coach in men's basketball history.

Coach Lewis is the first, first-year head coach to produce a seven-game winning streak. Ball State started 16-7 overall, which is the best start since the 1999-2000 season. The 17-7 record is the best start since the Cardinals started 1997-98 with a 21-7 record. He is the second coach in BSU history to win the regular season opener and the MAC opener in their first season as a head coach. He joins Rick Majerus in achieving the feat. Ball State has won 20 games for just the 13th time in program history.

In three seasons at UCLA, Lewis helped guide the Bruins to a 68-29 overall record and two NCAA Tournament appearances, which included a historic run to the 2021 Final Four in which the team won five consecutive games in a 13-day span. Lewis and UCLA took on North Carolina in a Sweet 16 matchup in 2021-22.

While with the Bruins, Lewis played a key role in the development of guards Tyger Campbell, Jaime Jaquez Jr. and Johnny Juzang, all of which were named All-Pac-12 honorees in the 2020-21 and 2021-22 seasons.

Lewis helped bring in a plethora of talent during his stint in Los Angeles, culminating in a top-10 recruiting class during his final campaign.

Prior to UCLA, Lewis was an assistant coach for three seasons at Nebraska. He served as the program's offensive play-caller in 2017-18 and 2018-19, guiding Nebraska to 41 wins in those two seasons. That marked Nebraska's best two-year win total since compiling 45 wins in 1990-91 and 1991-92. In three seasons in Lincoln, Nebraska, Lewis helped the Huskers to a 53-47 mark, the program's best three-year win total in nearly 10 years.

In 2017-18, Nebraska recorded its highest scoring average in 22 seasons, as the Huskers finished fourth in the Big Ten Conference with a school-record 13 league victories before reaching

the National Invitational Tournament (NIT). Lewis helped to develop James Palmer Jr., who secured first-team All-Big Ten acclaim and averaged 17.2 points per game in his first season with Nebraska. In 2017, Tai Webster captured second-team all-league honors, having set career highs in both scoring and assists. Glynn Watson was among the Big Ten's leaders in scoring and steals.

Lewis was instrumental in Butler's success during a five-year stint with the Bulldogs from 2011-16. Through those five seasons, Butler went 108-63 and had four postseason appearances, including three NCAA Tournament berths. The Bulldogs won at least 20 games in four of Lewis' five seasons on the coaching staff, including a 27-win campaign in 2012-13. While at Butler, Lewis worked on coaching staffs for head coaches Brad Stevens (2012-13), Brandon Miller (2013-14) and Chris Holtmann (2014-16).

In each of three trips to the NCAA Tournament while at Butler, the Bulldogs won at least one game, including victories over Texas in 2015 and Texas Tech in 2016. He was also part of a Butler squad that orchestrated the fourth-best win improvement in Big East history (2014-15).

Lewis coached four players at Butler who combined for six all-conference awards, including a trio of first-team selections. Three of his players garnered CoSIDA Academic All-America accolades, while Kellen Dunham and Alex Barlow combined to earn three consecutive Big East Scholar-Athlete of the Year awards during Lewis' tenure at Butler.

Gudino spent the previous four seasons at Wichita State before coming to Muncie. While with the Shockers, he helped coach six all-conference selections, including the Defensive Player of the Year, Sixth-Man of the Year and Co-

Player of the Year.

Gudino helped Wichita State reach the NIT semifinals in his first season in 2018-19. During the 2019-20 season, he aided in one of the best starts the Shockers have seen with a 15-1 mark, which saw the squad ranked in national polls for six weeks. The 2020-21 Shockers won their first American Athletic Conference regular season title and advanced to the NCAA tournament. Sophomore Tyson Etienne was conference co-player of the year and point guard Alterique Gilbert was named all-conference and signed a contract with the Atlanta Hawks. Gudino also coached Jaime Echenique, who played for the Wizards last season.



BEN BOTT

Assistant Coach | 7th Season
Alma Mater: Fort Wayne '11

Muncie native Ben Botts joined the Ball State men's basketball staff in May 2018 after spending the previous four years as an assistant with his alma mater Fort Wayne.

Botts helped guide the Mastodons to four consecutive postseason appearances, with the school's first-ever NIT berth in 2016 and three trips to the CIT. Fort Wayne also notched a pair of memorable victories over Indiana. Botts finished his playing career fourth on Fort Wayne's career scoring list with 1,400 points. He graduated from Muncie Central High School in 2006 after back-to-back appearances in the Class 4A state championship game.



JUSTIN BROWN

Assistant Coach | 1st Season
Alma Mater: Southwest Baptist '09

Brown arrived in Muncie in 2024 after serving three seasons at Pacific as an assistant and before that on the Eastern Illinois staff for a trio of seasons (2018-21). Overall, the Chicago native has 14 years of coaching experience at the collegiate level.

A guard on NCAA Division II Southwest Baptist University who played on back-to-back Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association championship teams in 2008 and 2009, Brown joined the coaching staff at his alma mater for the 2009-10 campaign. He returned to his hometown in 2010-11 to be the boys basketball coach at Perspective Charter High School.

Brown has also spent four seasons on the coaching staff at South Plains Junior College and three at Utah State University-East Utah in his time on the sidelines.



BUZZY CARUTHERS

Assistant Coach | 1st Season
Alma Mater: Hampton '06

Caruthers helped Missouri State to 34 wins over the last two seasons, including 19 of them at home which helped extend the program's 54-year streak of consecutive winning seasons in its home arena. Caruthers accepted a new position at Texas Rio Grande Valley in May, before landing this position with Lewis and Ball State.

Last season, Caruthers guided Alston Mason to All-Missouri Valley Conference (MVC) honors as he led the Bears and ranked third in the MVC with 17.6 points per game. In his first season with Missouri State, Caruthers helped Donovan Clay to All-MVC Second Team and MVC All-Defensive Team honors after leading the team with 11.9 points and 5.5 rebounds per game.

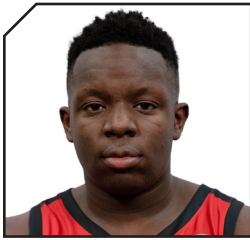
