BISON NOTES

BUCKNELL AT A GLANCE

- Bucknell is hosting its home opener, senior night and Military and First Responders game presented by Belfor on Saturday, Sept. 5 at 6 p.m. in Christy Mathewson-Memorial Stadium. The Bison will take on No. 17/18 Villanova.
- The Bison are coming off of 35-14 road loss to Richmond. In the loss, Sam Milligan and Michael Cadden each had a receiving touchdown. The Bison defense held the Spiders scoreless in third quarter while forcing and recovering a fumble.
- Sam Milligan (WR) and Brandon Biagiarelli (LB) earned 2026 Preseason All-Patriot League Team honors.
- Ahead of the 2026 season, Milligan was named to the Walter Payton Award Preseason Watch List and the 2026 Stats Perform FCS Preseason All-America Second Team.
- The Bison were picked to finish 10th in the 2026 Preseason All-Patriot League Poll.
- Bucknell returns just one of their four 2025 All-Patriot League players as Sam Milligan, who earned First Team All-Patriot League Special Teams Non-Specialist and Second Team All-Patriot League Wide Receiver returns for his senior season in 2026.
- The Bison are entering their first season under head coach Jeff Behrman. This new era of Bison football also comes with a mostly new coaching staff under Behrman with the lone returner to the staff being safeties coach McNeil Parker.
- Rounding out the coaching staff are new additions to the Bison family; Travis James (OC/OL), Jeffrey Long Jr. (DC), Rex Rover (WR/Recruiting Coordinator), Mac Austin (TE), Joe Collins (QB), Joseph Torok (RB), Anthony Trotta (DL), Jason Nelson (CB), Tyler Hughes (DOFO/Video Operations) and Kendrick O'Mary (strength & conditioning coach).
- Bucknell returned a total of 65 players from the 2025 season and lost 32 athletes from the roster. The Bison rounded out the roster with 35 newcomers ahead of the 2026 season.
- Patriot League Football, much like Bucknell Football, are entering a new era this season. With the additions of Villanova and William & Mary, the league has announced a new slogan; "The Power of 10".

A BISON WIN WOULD...

- Earn Bucknell its first overall win, home win and conference win of the season.
- Give Bucknell its first win over Villanova since 1944 and improve the Bison's overall record against Villanova to 12-15-2.
- Put Bucknell 9-8 against the Wildcats at home.
- Earn head coach Jeff Behrman his first win at the helm of Bucknell football.

INSIDE THE 2026 SCHEDULE

- This is the 141st season of football at Bucknell. The Bison played their first-ever game in 1883 and have been playing a consistent schedule since 1887.
- Bucknell is scheduled to play 12 games for just the fifth time in program history. With the additions of Villanova and William & Mary to the Patriot League, the Bison have a record-high nine conference games in 2026, with just five home games.
- The Bison open the 2026 season with back-to-back Patriot League night games. First up was Richmond on the road on Saturday, Aug. 29 at 6 p.m. and then Bucknell holds its home opener in Christy on Saturday, Sept. 5 at 6 p.m.
- Week three features VMI on the road on Saturday, Sept. 12 at 1:30 before heading home to face Penn on Saturday Sept. 19 at 3 p.m. in Christy.
- Bucknell then faces an ACC opponent in Pitt for the first time since 1945, the last time these two teams met. They then have a bye week before getting back on the road to face Patriot League opponent Georgetown on Saturday, Oct. 10 at 12:30 p.m.
- On Saturday, Oct. 24 at 1 p.m. Bucknell hosts Lafayette at 3 p.m. in Christy before taking on Holy Cross and Lehigh on the road.
- The Bison then host Fordham on November 7, take to the road on November 14 against newly added Patriot League member William & Mary and end the season at home on Saturday, Nov. 21 at 1 p.m. against Colgate.

THE LAST TIME OUT: RICHMOND 35, BUCKNELL 14

- Despite a late-game push with two consecutive touchdown drives across the third and fourth quarter to make it a two-score game, Bucknell football (0-1, 0-1PL) dropped its season and conference opener to Richmond (1-0, 1-0PL) 35-14 on Saturday evening.
- Coming out of halftime with a 28-0 deficit, the Bison defense held strong and over 12 minutes went by completely scoreless until Bucknell was able to find its first score on a 51-yard Chris Dietrich to Michael Cadden connection. Bucknell coupled that with a forced fumble recovery and a second consecutive touchdown when Dietrich found Sam Milligan on 4th down to make it a two score game. The Spiders then secured the win with a one-play, 75-yard touchdown reception to squash the Bison momentum and make it 35-14. The remaining 13 minutes went scoreless with both defensive units standing tall through the end.
- The Bison receiving group was led by Sam Milligan, who finished with 70 yards and a touchdown. Bucknell's running backs were led by Michael Cadden, who rushed for 24 yards and found 57 yards and a touchdown through the air. Chris Dietrich went 16-for-30 for 155 yards and two touchdowns.
- On the defensive side of the ball, Ayden Murray led the crew with six total tackles with five solo tackles and one tackle for loss in a pivotal part of the game for the Bison. Takai Whitmore also stood out with four solo tackles, three of which were for loss. Deuce Geter recorded Bucknell's lone forced fumble of the night with Jack Inserra securing the fumble recovery. Freshman Lucas Rost recorded his first collegiate start, tackle and pass breakup in the game.
- The Spiders out-paced the Bison in total net yards 393 to 187 as both its rushing and receiving found success throughout the full game. Bryce Allen and Aziz Foster-Powell both surpassed 100 yards, Allen receiving and Foster-Powell rushing. Richmond quarterback Ashton Snelsire went 17-for-28 for 199 yards and three touchdowns. Foster-Powell and Allen also led the Spider scoring with two touchdowns apiece in the contest.

- Brandon Biagiarelli is 9 tackles away from 150 career total tackles
- Michael Cadden is 24 yards away from 500 career rushing yards
- Nick Hoying is six solo tackles away from 100 career solo tackles

ON RECORD WATCH

- Sam Milligan is two touchdown catches away from most touchdown catches in a career (18; held by Tom Mitchell '65, Lester Erb '90 and Will Carter '16).

INSIDE THE RECORD BOOK

- Sam Milligan ranks first in touchdown catches in a single game with four against VMI on Saturday, Sept. 13. He also ranks sixth all-time in receiving yards in a single game with 192 yards in that VMI win for Bucknell.
- Milligan is currently tied for third in career touchdown catches with 15 and is tied for second in season touchdown catches with 10 in 2025.
- TJ Cadden tied for the longest kickoff return (100 yds) and holds the records for most punt return touchdowns in a season (2) and most total return touchdowns (3; two punt return and one kickoff return).

HEAD COACH JEFF BEHRMAN



Jeff Behrman, a 30-year veteran in the college football coaching ranks who won more than 72 percent of his games as a head coach at John Carroll and Union, was named the 28th Bob Odell Head Football Coach at Bucknell on Jan. 1, 2026.

Behrman (pronounced BEAR-man) came to Bucknell from his alma mater, John Carroll, where he guided the Blue Streaks to a 29-7 record in his three seasons as head coach. Behrman was named the Division III Region 4 Coach of the Year this fall after his top-10 team finished 12-2, won the North Coast Athletic Conference title, and made

a run to the NCAA semifinals. John Carroll beat three ranked teams along the way, including a double-overtime thriller over No. 2 Mount Union, which has won a record 13 Division III national championships.

Behrman previously spent seven seasons as the head coach at Union. He inherited a team that had been 0-10 the year before his arrival, and by his fourth season the squad started 10-0, won the Liberty League crown, and reached the second round of the NCAA Division III playoffs.

All told, Behrman has a 71-27 record as a head coach, including a 5-3 record in the NCAA Division III playoffs. Prior to his hiring at Union in 2016, Behrman was the offensive coordinator at Division I FCS Stony Brook for 10 seasons. He also had assistant coaching stops at Trinity, Hofstra, Blackburn, Glenville State, and Clarion.

"Jeff Behrman has a three-decade track record as an impactful leader of student-athletes who have achieved tremendous success both on and off the football field, and I am thrilled to welcome Jeff and his family to Bucknell," said Pavlechko. "Jeff's record as a head coach speaks for itself – a .724 winning percentage with numerous conference championships, NCAA appearances, and records broken – but what stands out the most is the value he places on developing a team culture defined by accountability, competitiveness, and care for student-athletes, which then serves as the foundation for championship success."

"Becoming the head football coach at Bucknell is an incredible honor, and I am sincerely grateful to president John Bravman and vice president Tim Pavlechko for their trust and support," said Behrman. "Bucknell represents excellence, toughness, and integrity, and our goal will be to build a disciplined, competitive program that develops men the right way. My family and I are excited to join the Bucknell community."

At John Carroll, Behrman led the Blue Streaks to three winning seasons and an NCAC championship in his three years with the program. In his first year at the helm, Behrman guided the Blue Streaks to an 8-2 record, and John Carroll finished 20th in the D3football.com Top 25. He continued to build upon those efforts in his second season, as he led the Blue Streaks to a 9-3 ledger and their first NCAA playoff berth since 2018, where they won a first-round game. This past fall, Behrman led his team to a No. 9 national ranking and a 12-2 record that included an undefeated conference record and the historic run to the NCAA semifinals.

Behrman is known for bringing the best out of his offenses, and John Carroll ranked highly in several categories in every season under his direction. The Blue Streaks ranked in the top-10 nationally in team passing efficiency (5th, 2023) (4th, 2024) (6th, 2025), team completion percentage (5th, 2023) (2nd, 2024) (1st, 2025), and third-down conversion percentage (3rd, 2023) (6th, 2025).

John Carroll players ranked at the top of their positions each year in statistics such as completion percentage, pass efficiency, and receiving yards. Behrman also oversaw a defense that ranked eighth nationally in total defense and fifth nationally in rushing defense in 2025.

Behrman's John Carroll teams broke 11 school records, and he coached four All-Americans, including Bucknell graduate Nick Semptimphelter (QB) and Tyren Montgomery (WR) this past season. He also mentored a Gagliardi Trophy (D3 Player of Year) semifinalist, a Rimington Award (nation's top center) winner, and three conference players of the year, as well as 37 all-conference, 13 all-region, 48 academic all-conference, 15 CSC Academic All-District, and three CSC Academic All-America honorees. The coaching staff also earned major awards in 2025, including NCAC Coaching Staff of the Year and Behrman's D3football.com Region 4 2025 Coach of the Year honor.

Prior to his time at John Carroll, Behrman completed a remarkable rebuild at Union, where he flipped a winless team into a conference champion and NCAA qualifier in a span of four seasons. He tallied an overall 42-20 record during his time in Schenectady.

Behrman proved to be an adept recruiter at Union, and he won the 2019 AFCA Region 1 Coach of the Year, the Liberty League Coach of the Year, and the ECAC Division III Coach of the Year awards. The Dutchmen won a school-record 21 straight regular-season games from 2018-21. Additionally, he served as a board member for the Capital District Chapter of the National Football Foundation.

The Dutchmen won the 2019 Liberty League title and advanced to the second round of the Division III playoffs after recording the 10th undefeated regular season in school history. During his tenure, Union registered three All-America selections, 16 all-region honorees, 87 All-Liberty League selections (league record 21 in 2019), two CSC Academic All-Americans, 15 CSC Academic All-District selections, 33 National Football Foundation Honor Society selections, over 125 Academic All-Liberty League qualifiers, one Liberty League Offensive Player of the Year, two Liberty League Rookies of the Year, and two ECAC Rookies of the Year. The 2019 coaching staff also earned the Liberty League Coaching Staff of the Year honor.

Before earning the head job at Union, the seasoned veteran spent 10 seasons as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Stony Brook from 2006-15. The Seawolves won four Big South titles and reached the quarterfinals of the FCS playoffs in 2011 and 2012. Behrman helped to mentor tight end Will Tye, who became the first Stony Brook alum to play in an NFL game.

In between a pair of two-season stints at Trinity College (the latter as the offensive coordinator), Behrman worked as the wide receivers coach at Hofstra for two seasons. During his second stint at Trinity, the Bantams went undefeated in back-to-back seasons.

He saw his first stint as an offensive coordinator at Blackburn College for the 1999 season.

Behrman's coaching career started at Clarion, where he served as a graduate assistant during the 1996 season. Behrman then headed to Glenville State for the 1997 and 1998 seasons, where he worked as a wide receivers and tight ends coach.

All told, Behrman has coached 10 players who have gone on to play in the NFL or CFL, including former Hofstra star Marques Colston, who became the New Orleans Saints' all-time leading receiver. Behrman has been a part of 10 conference championships during his coaching career.

Following a prolific basketball and football career at Stow High School in Ohio, Behrman played quarterback during his undergraduate days at John Carroll. He was elected team captain as a redshirt senior in 1995 and started the season opener at Ohio Wesleyan, however he suffered a broken ankle during the 28-13 win. After spending eight weeks in rehab with eight screws and a metal plate in his ankle, he managed to play a series in each of the final two games of the campaign. Behrman's comeback story earned him recognition as a 1995 NSCA All-American Strength & Conditioning Athlete of the Year.

Behrman earned a number of accolades during his playing career at John Carroll, including the team's Leadership Award and Loyalty Award following the 1995 campaign. He notched Academic All-OAC honors and won the Jerry D. Keller

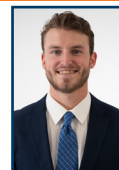

No. 11/12 Villanova downed the Bucknell football team, 55-3, on Saturday night at Villanova Stadium.

The Wildcats (2-0, 0-0 CAA) scored early and often en route to their ninth-straight victory over the Bison (0-2, 0-0 PL). Their high-powered offense logged 378 yards while their stingy defense only allowed 89 over the course of the contest.

Bucknell got on the board with 12:17 remaining in regulation, snapping a scoreless streak of 107:43 to open its 2021 campaign. Ryan Schatzel's 35-yard field goal, the first of his collegiate career, capped a 12-play, 58-yard scoring drive orchestrated by Tyler Beverett. During that drive, Beverett passed for 32 yards and added 13 on the ground; the highlight was a 17-yard throw to fellow sophomore Christian Tait.

At halftime, Villanova held a 45-0 advantage. The Wildcats built sizable edges in total offense (240-3) and first downs (13-4) during the first two stanzas, notably preventing the Bison from advancing past midfield for their duration.

Villanova's longest scoring drive in the first half took just 3:15 off of the clock. Four of the six were shorter than two minutes, including the first which came following an interception and the third which came after a failed fake punt. Christian Benford logged two interceptions, one of which he returned for a 19-yard touchdown.

In the second half, the Wildcats tacked on a five-yard touchdown rush that capped a 14-play, 78-yard drive and a 26-yard field goal that completed an 11-play, 51-yard march. Both of those drives took more than six minutes off of the clock, with the former draining 9:08.

Bucknell's youth movement continued on Saturday. Sophomores Nick Semptimphelter, a quarterback, and Jack Wall, an offensive lineman, started in the place of injured captains Tarrin Earle and Jacob Russ respectively; their fellow captains Grayson Cherubino and Dominic Lyles also missed their second-consecutive game. As in the 2021 opener at Sacred Heart, only five of the 22 Bison who started had at least five career starts under their belt entering the game.

For Bucknell, freshmen Jack Barnes (7) and John Schlendorff (6) led the way in tackles. Beverett posted 36 yards through the air and 16 on the ground in relief of Semptimphelter, who threw for 32 yards. Damian Harris logged a team-best 31 receiving yards while Beverett's 16 rushing yards paced the Bison.

For Villanova, Daniel Smith, who was named to the Walter Payton Award Watch List, threw for three touchdowns. Jalen Jackson (70), T.D. Ayo-Durojaiye (65) and Justin Covington (59) all exceed 50 rushing yards while Rayoun Pringle caught three passes for 69 yards and two touchdowns.

The Wildcats finished with overall advantages in total offense (378-89), first downs (21-11) and time of possession (30:53-29:07). They went 6-for-6 on their trips to the red zone compared to Bucknell's 1-for-1.

This was the Bison's 11th-straight loss to a nationally ranked opponent and 13th-straight downing by a current member of the CAA.

Despite a late-game push with two consecutive touchdown drives across the third and fourth quarter to make it a two-score game, Bucknell football (0-1, 0-1PL) dropped its season and conference opener to Richmond (1-0, 1-0PL) 35-14 on Saturday evening.

Coming out of halftime with a 28-0 deficit, the Bison defense held strong and over 12 minutes went by completely scoreless until Bucknell was able to find its first score on a 51-yard Chris Dietrich to Michael Cadden connection. Bucknell coupled that with a forced fumble recovery and a second consecutive touchdown when Dietrich found Sam Milligan on 4th down to make it a two score game. The Spiders then secured the win with a one-play, 75-yard touchdown reception to squash the Bison momentum and make it 35-14. The remaining 13 minutes went scoreless with both defensive units standing tall through the end.

The Bison receiving group was led by Sam Milligan, who finished with 70 yards and a touchdown. Bucknell's running backs were led by Michael Cadden, who rushed for 24 yards and found 57 yards and a touchdown through the air. Chris Dietrich went 16-for-30 for 155 yards and two touchdowns.

On the defensive side of the ball, Ayden Murray led the crew with six total tackles with five solo tackles and one tackle for loss in a pivotal part of the game for the Bison. Takai Whitmore also stood out with four solo tackles, three of which were for loss. Deuce Geter recorded Bucknell's lone forced fumble of the night with Jack Inserra securing the fumble recovery. Freshman Lucas Rost recorded his first collegiate start, tackle and pass breakup in the game.

The Spiders out-paced the Bison in total net yards 393 to 187 as both its rushing and receiving found success throughout the full game. Bryce Allen and Aziz Foster-Powell both surpassed 100 yards, Allen receiving and Foster-Powell rushing. Richmond quarterback Ashton Snelsire went 17-for-28 for 199 yards and three touchdowns. Foster-Powell and Allen also led the Spider scoring with two touchdowns apiece in the contest.
