The Matchup...Buffalo State is looking to snap a two-game skid, entering with a 5-3 overall record and a 3-3 mark in Empire 8 play. Hartwick has lost four in a row and is 2-6 overall and 1-5 in league play. The Bengals have never lost to the Hawks in three previous meetings, including a 59-41 win at Hartwick last season.

Last Game...Buffalo State (5-3/3-3) could not overcome 583 yards of total offense by host St. John Fisher (7-1/5-1) and the nationally-No. 15 ranked Cardinals dealt the Bengals a 35-25 defeat in an Empire 8 game at Growney Stadium.

Buffalo State junior quarterback Dan Serignese finished 10 of 28 for 246 yards and a touchdown and also had a rushing score in his first collegiate start. Ryan Carney had four catches for 133 yards and a touchdown, and Mike Doherty had four grabs for 87 yards. John Alessandra led the Bengals' defense with a career-high 17 tackles, and Marquis Artis had 11 tackles, including a sack and a fumble recovery.

Fisher quarterback Tyler Fenti finished 21 of 30 for 318 yards with two touchdowns and one interception, and also had 52 rushing yards and two scores on the ground. Tony Fusco ran for 158 yards on 29 carries and had a touchdown, while Mike Collichio had eight catches for 174 yards and two scores.

The Cardinals outrushed the Bengals 265-87, and outgained Buffalo State by 250 total yards.

Buffalo State took the early 7-0 lead on a 6-yard scoring run on the option by Rich Pete. The Bengals defense forced a turnover on downs and a 46-yard flea flicker from Serignese to Carney set up the shot score.

The Cardinals would answer with an 11-play, 71-yard, penalty-filled drive and knotted the score at 7-7 with a 5-yard keeper by Fenti.

After a 45-yard field goal by Marc Montana reclaimed the lead for the Bengals, each team traded big plays to leave the score 17-14 in Buffalo State's favor to end the first quarter. After a 54-yard scoring run by Fusco for the Cardinals, Buffalo State answered just two plays later with a 73-yard scoring strike from Serignese to Carney.

Fisher found the end zone again, taking a lead it would not relinquish. Collichio reeled in a 33-yard touchdown toss from Fenti, to put the Cardinals ahead, 21-17. Fisher would assemble a 90-yard drive late in the half, but Buffalo State stuffed a fourth-and-goal attempt from the 1-yard line, keeping the deficit at four at halftime.

The Cardinals put together another long drive on its first possession of the second half, and this time capped the 11-play, 86-yard march with a 3-yard scoring run by Fenti.

After Rob Riggio blocked a Bengals' punt on the ensuing possession, Fisher took full momentum of the game, but an Ish Height interception in the end zone on the very next play gave Buffalo State a new life.

Two possessions later, Buffalo State cut the deficit to 28-25 just 12 seconds into the fourth quarter. After Serignese scored on a 5-yard bootleg, Pete converted on the two-point conversion, scooping an errant option pitch off the turf and running it into the end zone.

James Chambers answered the Bengals' score with a 43-yard kick return, and the Cardinals needed just four plays to go the remaining 48 yards, pushing the advantage to 35-25 with another 33-yard pass from Fenti to Collichio.

Buffalo State would threaten once more, but could not score on a first and goal and turned the ball over on downs after two cracks from the 1-yard line, before the Cardinals were able to run off the final four minutes and 35 seconds.

About the Bengals' Coach...

Jerry Boyes enters his sixth season of his second stint as the head football coach at Buffalo State in 2014 (21st overall), while maintaining his role as athletics director, a position he has held since 1999.

The Bengals went 5-5 in 2013 and earned a winning record in 2012 under Boyes and upset the No. 1 team in the nation Wisconsin-Whitewater, snapping the three-time defending NCAA Champion's 46-game winning streak.

Upon coming to Buffalo State in 1986, Boyes inherited a football program that was entering just its sixth season of varsity competition but transformed the Bengals into one of the premier Division III football programs in the Northeast. In 19 seasons at the helm of the program, he has compiled an 116-93 overall record and qualified for the NCAA postseason seven seasons. In addition to being a three-time Eastern Collegiate Athletic Conference Upstate Coach of the Year, Boyes claimed CNN Division III Coach of the Year honors in 1995. He also recruited and mentored 12 All-Americans and four Academic All-Americans during his illustrious coaching career.

Boyes was a stellar player in his own right during his collegiate days at Ithaca. A two-time All-American quarterback, his success earned him a free agent tryout with the Cleveland Browns. He also played basketball and baseball for the Bombers before graduating in 1976 with a bachelor's degree in physical education. He earned his master's degree in physical education from Ithaca in 1981.

Before coming to Buffalo State, Boyes was the offensive coordinator at Ithaca. The Bombers were 72-18 during his tenure with three appearances in the Amos Alonzo Stagg Bowl, winning the NCAA Division III Championship in 1979.

Oh captain, my captains...Sophomore quarterback Kyle Hoppy and junior defensive end Dez Howard will serve as the Bengals 2014 captains.

With honors...Buffalo State returns seven players that earned All-Empire 8 honors last season. Seniors Rich Pete (running back), Mike Doherty (wide receiver) and Tawone Williams (defensive line) all earned first team honors last season. Juniors Brandon Lathrop (offensive line), Anthony Sanders (defensive line), Shaq Frederick (linebacker) and senior Joe Going (punter) were all named honorable mention.

We've got our eye on you...Wide receiver Mike Doherty was named to the North Offense second team on the preseason D3 Senior Classic Preseason Super Senior Watchlist. Defensive lineman Tawone Williams was named to the North Defense honorable mention.

Run and jump...In addition to being a first team All-Empire 8 running back, senior Rich Pete is three-time All-American triple jumper, including finishing fifth at last year's NCAA Indoor Championships.

In the swing of things...Sophomore quarterback Kyle Hoppy was drafted in the 28th round of the 2009 MLB entry draft by the Baltimore Orioles and played four seasons in the Orioles organization from 2009-12.

The "Glory Days"...Buffalo State has made seven NCAA playoff appearance and won three ECAC Bowl Championships, all from 1991-2000. The Bengals advanced to the NCAA playoffs in 1992, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1996, 1998 and 1999, and won ECAC Bowl games in 1991, 1997 and 2000. During that 10-year span, the Bengals went a combined 78-28 (.736).

In the End Zone...Senior running back **Rich Pete** is closing in on the Buffalo State record for career touchdowns of 40 held by Perez Dinkins. Pete has scored 10 times this season, and now has 39 for his career. He has 35 rushing touchdowns and four receiving scores.

Big Boot...Junior transfer kicker **Marc Montana** set a school record and the third longest in Division III this season in his Bengals' debut against Cortland, nailing a 49-yard field goal as time expired to force overtime. He also hit his third field goal of the game to win it in overtime, which also set a school record. Montana leads the Empire 8 with eight field goals this season.

Takeaways...Buffalo State ranks 28th in the nation, having forced 21 turnovers in its first eight games this season, including 11 interceptions. **Mitch Thomas** and **Sherman Nelson** lead the Bengals with four picks each.

Racking Up the Yardage...Senior wide receiver **Mike Doherty** piled up 419 all-purpose yards (the most in a game in Division III this season), including nine receptions for 229 yards and two touchdowns in the season-opening win over Cortland. Doherty already holds the school's all-time record for career kick return yards with 2,186, and leads the Bengals this season with 814 receiving yards.

Big Plays...Buffalo State ranks sixth in the nation averaging 18.5 passing yards-per-completion. **Ryan Carney** averages 26.5 yards-per-reception, and **Mike Doherty** is averaging 20.9.
