Lion Close Out Trip at California

Southeastern Louisiana closes out a three-game western road trip when it visits California for a 7 p.m. tip-off in Haas Pavilion on Sunday.

The Lions (4-2) have split their previous two games on the trip, defeating UTEP 72-56 on Wednesday before losing at Colorado State 67-59 on Friday.

Sophomore guard Marlain Veal finished with 20 points while junior guard Eddy Polanco had a career-high 15 for Southeastern against Colorado State. The Lions rallied from a 17-point deficit in the second half to get as close as eight in having a three-game win streak snapped.

Veal is averaging 19.3 points to go with 27 assists and 11 steals. Sophomore forward Moses Greenwood is averaging 12.8 points

and 6.7 rebounds while junior guard Davon Hayes is scoring 12.8 points a game. Senior Dominic Nelson (5.8 ppg, 8.3 rpg) is the team's leader in blocks (14) after getting four in each of the past two games. The Lions are averaging 77.5 points per game on 49.5 percent shooting and are plus-7.8 in rebounding margin.

Defensively, Southeastern is allowing opponents 66.3 points a contest on 39.9 percent shooting and have forced 90 turnovers, 44 coming on steals.

Veal, Nelson, Greenwood, Hayes and junior guard Jabbar Singleton (4.5 ppg, 20 assists) will be the Lions' starters on Friday. Coming off the bench will be Polanco (7.0 ppg), junior guard George Brock (1.7 ppg), sophomore guard Dimi Cook (2.0 ppg) and freshmen guards Chris Mejia (4.2 ppg) and Michael Corchiani (1.8 ppg).

Scouting the Bears

California is bringing back seven letterwinners and two starters from the 2015-16 squad that went 23-11 overall. The Bears tied for third in the Pac-12 with a 12-6 mark and advanced to the semifinals of the conference tournament. Cal advanced to the NCAA Tournament before losing in the first round to Hawaii.

Cuonzo Martin is in his third season as head coach at Cal and his 10th overall.

Sophomore forward Ivan Rabb, an AP Preseason All-American, saw his first action of the season in a 77-65 loss to San Diego State on Monday. He is averaging 15.5 points and 10.5 points through his first two games.

Freshman guard Charlie Moore, who was named the Pac-12 Player of the Week on Monday, leads the Bears with 19.8 points per game and six steals and is tied for the team lead with 10 assists.

Guard Grant Mullins (11.0 ppg, 4.3 rpg), junior center Kameron Rooks (6.5 ppg, 6.8 rpg, 9 blocks) and senior guard Stephen Domingo (4.8 ppg, 5.0 rpg) round out the projected starting five for the Bears.

California is averaging 73.2 points on 40.7 percent shooting. The Bears have allowed 64.0 points on 36.7 shooting and have out-rebounded opponents by a 15.0 margin (45.5-30.5).

California bounced back from the loss to San Diego State to defeat Wyoming 71-61 on Friday. Moore had 18 points and six assists and Rabb a double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds. Mullins added 14 points while senior forward Roger Moute a Bidas came off the bench to score 12. Junior center Kingsley Okorah blocked five shots, giving him 12 on the season.

SLU-California Series

Friday's game will be the first meeting between Southeastern and California.

It will be the Lions' first visit to the state of California since they lost to St. Mary's and UC Davis at the Shamrock Office Solutions Classic in Moraga, Calif., Dec. 17-18, 2005.

The last time Southeastern played a team

from California was a 76-69 win over Cal Poly in the 2006-07 season opener in the Oregon Rain Invitational in Corvallis, Ore.

The Lions are 4-7 against teams from California, going 2-0 against U.S. International, 1-0 against Cal Poly, 1-1 against San Diego, 0-1 versus Cal St. Bakersfield and 0-2 against both San Francisco and St. Mary's.

Southeastern is also 1-1 against current members of the Pac-12. The Lions defeated Oregon State in 2006 and lost to Washington in 1986.

Last Time Out

Southeastern sophomore guard Marlain Veal and junior guard Eddy Polanco scored in double figures, but the Lions could not overcome a pair of first-half scoreless spells in a 67-59 loss at Colorado State Friday afternoon in Moby Arena.

Veal finished with 20 points while Polanco had a career-high 15. The Lions rallied from a 17-point deficit in the second half to get as close as eight in having a three-game win streak snapped.

Southeastern shot 33.9 percent (20-of-59) from the field, the first time this season the Lions shot less than 47 percent. Southeastern committed a season-low 11 turnovers and were 10-of-12 at the line but were out-rebounded 42-33. Senior center Dominic Nelson led the way with eight rebounds.

Colorado State (4-1) shot 37.3 percent (19-of-51) from the field and 72.7 percent (24-of-33) at the line. Emmanuel Omogbo had a double-double with 18 points and 16 rebounds. Devocio Butler tossed in 12 points.

Both teams struggled from the field in the first half as Colorado State took a 29-19 lead. Southeastern shot 22.2 percent while the Rams were at 26.7.

11 to Go

With Southeastern finally playing a team from Colorado on Friday, that leaves the Lions with 11 states they have either not played a team from nor visited.

The remaining states are Alaska, Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Jersey, North Dakota, Rhode Island, South Dakota, Utah, Vermont and Wyoming.

Southeastern has not played a program from West Virginia but played in the Marshall Memorial Classic in Huntington, West Virginia in 1987-88.

Southeastern also played Mexico University from Mexico City in 1965-66 and Waterloo University from Waterloo, Ontario, Canada in 1971-72.

Strong Start

Southeastern's 4-1 start was its best since the 2010-11 season. The Lions started the 2009-10 season 6-1 and were 5-1 in both 2005-06 and 2007-08, but had to vacate those wins due

to NCAA sanctions. The last time Southeastern officially started 5-1 was in 1982-83 when it won six of its first seven games.

Breaking Through on the Road

Southeastern snapped a 19-game non-conference road losing streak with a 72-56 victory at UTEP Wednesday night.

It was the Lions' first win at a non-conference opponent's place since an 80-76 win at UT Martin on Jan. 9, 2013.

The Lions also broke a two-game road losing streak overall while defeating UTEP for the first time in four tries.

Familiar Face

UTEP head coach Tim Floyd and Southeastern head coach Jay Ladner were both from Hattiesburg, Miss. and both attended Oak Grove High School.

Floyd was also a well-known name among Louisiana basketball fans.

Floyd played for Louisiana Tech and graduated from the university in 1977. He was an assistant coach at Tech in 1977. Floyd went on to be the head coach at the University of New Orleans from 1988-94, guiding the Privateers to five postseason appearances.

Floyd was also the head coach of the New Orleans Hornets in 2003-04 and was a Hornets assistant in 2009-10. He was inducted into the Louisiana Basketball Hall of Fame in 2004.

Home Sweet Home

Southeastern extended its home winning streak to 10 with its 89-72 win over Xavier-Louisiana on Monday.

It is the longest home winning streak for the Lions since a 23-game streak from Feb. 22, 2003 to Feb. 5, 2005 (SLU had a 13-game streak from Jan. 27, 2010 to Feb. 9, 2011 but had to vacate the first six wins due to NCAA sanctions).

The Lions' streak is currently tied with Cincinnati for the 20th longest in the country.

The Lions won their final seven homes of 2015-16 and entered the 2016-17 campaign with the second-longest streak in the Southland Conference behind Stephen F. Austin's 28. Southeastern has not lost in the University Center since a 75-71 setback against Incarnate Word on Jan. 16. The Lions finished the season 9-3 at home.

Southeastern will play 14 home games in 2016-17, the most games in the University Center since the 2011-12 season.

The Lions will host three non-conference games against Division I programs (Jackson State, Maryland-Eastern Shore, Florida A&M) and will also welcome in four-time reigning Southland regular season champion Stephen F. Austin.

Veal Named Southland POW

Sophomore guard Marlain Veal became the first Lion in more than five years to be named Southland Conference Player of the Week, the league announced on Monday. He averaged 25 points as Southeastern split a pair with Tulane and Jackson State.

Guard Brandon Fortenberry was the last Lion to receive the honor on Feb. 14, 2011.

Playing in his hometown of New Orleans, Veal set career highs in points (game-high 28), field goals attempted (16), 3-pointers attempted (6), free throws made (9) and free throws attempted (15) in the Lions' 93-76 loss at Tulane. The Helen Cox High School alum also tied personal bests in field goals made (8) and 3-pointers made (3) while collecting a team-high four steals and adding two assists.

Veal again led all scorers with 22 points in an 84-71 win over Jackson State. He was 8-of-12 from the field and 5-of-5 from the line while also dishing out six assists and grabbing two steals.

Lions Vs. the NAIA and GCAC

Southeastern's 89-72 win over Xavier of Louisiana Monday pushed the Lions' all-time regular season record to 8-0 against current members of the Gulf Coast Athletic Conference.

Southeastern is now 4-0 against Dillard, 2-0 against SUNO and 2-0 against Xavier.

Jay Ladner is 3-0 in the regular season against NAIA schools as head coach of the Lions. Southeastern also defeated Langston 92-80 during his first season in 2014-15 and Loyola-New Orleans, 101-65, in 2015-16.

Xavier was the second member of the Gulf Coast Athletic Conference and the third NAIA program Southeastern has faced this season. The Lions defeated Southern-New Orleans of the GCAC, 81-53, and Louisiana-Alexandria, 59-53, in exhibition games.

Breaking the SWAC Streak

Southeastern's 84-71 victory over Jackson State on Nov. 16 was the Lions' first over a Southwestern Athletic Conference opponent since a 65-61 overtime win over Southern on Dec. 12, 2011.

The Lions had dropped three straight to the SWAC, including losses to Southern and Jackson State in 2015-16.

Lions Double Up On Tigers

Southeastern had five players in double figures in an 84-71 win over Jackson State on Nov. 16.

Sophomore guard Marlain Veal led the way with 22 points while sophomore guard Moses

Greenwood added 16, junior guard Jabbar Singleton and senior center Dominic Nelson and junior guard Eddy Polanco 12 apiece.

It was Southeastern's first game with five players in double figures since an 84-74 win at New Orleans on March 9, 2016 - Zay Jackson (17), Joshua Filmore (13), Veal (11), Jordan Capps (10) and James Currington (10).

Nelson Has Career Night Vs. JSU

Senior center Dominic Nelson had his best night as a Lion in a 84-71 win over Jackson State on Nov. 16.

The Harlem, N.Y. native finished with career highs of 12 points and 13 rebounds for his first career double-double. He went 4-for-5 from the field, setting a personal best for field goals while tying his career best for attempts.

Nelson was also 4-for-6 from the line, tying his career best for free throws made. He also pulled down nine offensive rebounds, blocked a game-high two shots and had two assists, the latter tying another career high.

Newcomers Make Their Mark

A pair junior guards playing in their first season at Southeastern played a key role in the Lions' 84-71 win over Jackson State on Nov. 16.

Jabbar Singleton, who sat out the 2015-16 season after transferring from Oral Roberts, scored a career-high 15 points, knocking down 5-of-6 3-pointers. He also tied a career high with four assists and had a steal.

Eddy Polanco, a transfer from College of Central Florida, tossed down a career-best 12 points, going 4-for-8 from the field, including 2-for-4 on 3s. He also had three rebounds.

Veal Scores Big in Return Home

Sophomore guard Marlain Veal had a career night in the Lions' 93-76 loss at Tulane on Nov. 14.

The New Orleans native set career highs in points (28), field goals attempted (16), 3-pointers attempted (6), free throws made (9) and free throws attempted (15) while tying personal bests in field goals made (8) and 3-pointers made (3).

Going to the Line

Southeastern and Tulane attempted a combined 73 free throws in the Green Wave's 93-76 victory on Nov. 14. The combined attempts were the most in a Southeastern game since the Lions and Stephen F. Austin combined for 76 on Jan. 5, 2015.

The Lions were 25-of-38 (65.8%) from the line. The 25 free throws were the most by Southeastern since the 40 made against Nicholls on Feb. 15, 2014. The 38 attempts were the most since the Lions took 40 against Nicholls on Feb. 13, 2016.

Tulane was 30-of-35 (85.7%) on their attempts with the free throws made and attempted the most by a Southeastern oppo-

nent since TCU went 36-of-47 in the 2015-16 season opener on Nov. 13, 2015.

Getting Defensive

The 39 points scored by Millsaps in Southeastern's 85-39 season-opening win over the Majors were the fewest points the Lions have allowed since a 54-33 win over Stephen F. Austin on Feb. 5, 2004. They also tied for the fifth fewest points allowed by Southeastern in its history and was only the sixth time the Lions have allowed fewer than 40 points in a game.

It was also the first time Southeastern has held an opponent to under 50 points since a 45-40 loss at North Texas on Dec. 16, 2012.

by the coaches with 66 points and eighth by the SIDs with 65. Southeastern finished sixth in the conference with a 9-9 mark and were 12-21 overall in 2015-16. The Lions defeated New Orleans in the opening round of the conference tournament for their first tournament win since 2013 before losing to Houston Baptist.

Sam Houston State was selected as the favorite over four-time defending league champion Stephen F. Austin. Sam Houston State received six first-place votes and 138 total points in the coaches' poll, edging Stephen F. Austin, also with six first-place votes and 137 points. Texas A&M-Corpus Christi received one first-place vote and 123 points for a third-placed prediction by the coaches.

Northwestern State was fourth with 93 points and was followed by Houston Baptist (91), Abilene Christian (75) and Southeastern. McNeese was picked eighth with 64 points with New Orleans (63), Incarnate Word (58), Central Arkansas (49), Lamar (33) and Nicholls (24) rounding out the poll.

In the SID's preseason poll, SHSU received seven first-place votes and 137 points to SFA's five first-place votes and 135 points. The sports information directors also rated Texas A&M-Corpus Christi as the preseason third-place team with a single first-place tally and 123 points.

Houston Baptist was the pick for fourth with 92 points and was followed by Northwestern State (77), Abilene Christian (75), McNeese (68) and Southeastern. Central Arkansas was ninth with 64 points and was followed by New Orleans (62), UIW (54), Lamar (34) and Nicholls (28).

Bringing Them Back

Southeastern is returning seven letterwinners, including four starters, from 2015-16, the most returnees Jay Ladner has had in his three years as head coach of the Lions.

Leading the way will be senior forward Jordan Capps who earned All-Southland Conference Tournament honors at the end of last season. He is the Lions' leading returner in scoring (10.0 ppg.), rebounding (6.3 rpg.) and blocked shots (26).

Also returning in the post are sophomore Moses Greenwood (7.6 ppg., 4.3 rpg.), redshirt junior James Currington (5.7 ppg., 5.0 rpg.); and senior Dominic Nelson (2.6 ppg., 4.0 rpg.).

Back on the perimeter are sophomores Dimi Cook (7.5 ppg., 34 assists, 22 steals) and Marlain Veal (7.3 ppg., 98 assists, 40 steals).

Welcome Aboard

The Lions are bringing in a strong group of newcomers that consists of three freshmen and four transfers.

Junior Davon Hayes, who played for Ladner at St. Stanislaus before playing at Southern Mississippi and Northeast Mississippi Community College, will get a shot at small forward.

Southeastern has a deep group of newcomers at guard, including junior Jabbar Singleton, who redshirted last season after transferring from Oral Roberts; junior George Brock, a transfer from Dodge City Community College; junior Eddy Polanco, a transfer from the College of Central Florida; and true freshmen Michael Corchiani (Metairie, La./Country Day); and Chris Mejia (Hialeah Gardens, Fla./Mater Academy).

Freshman Brandon Gonzalez (Punta Gorda, Fla./Charlotte High School) is a new face in the post.

Basketball in His Blood

Freshman guard Michael Corchiani has a deep basketball bloodline.

His dad, Gabe, played at the University of New Orleans from 1984-88 and helped lead the Privateers to the NCAA Tournament in 1987 and the American South Conference regular season co-championship and the NIT in 1988. He is UNO's all-time assist leader and ranks 20th on the program's scoring list.

Michael's uncle, Chris, was an All-American in 1990 and '91 at North Carolina State. He retired as the NCAA all-time assist leader and was the first player to pass the 1,000-assist plateau. He is N.C. State's all-time leader in both assists and steals and went on to play in the NBA for the Boston Celtics and Orlando Magic.

Michael's grandfather, Gabe Sr., was also a renowned basketball coach in Florida

Changes on the Sidelines

With the naming of assistant coach Errol Gauff as Southeastern's women's basketball head coach and the departure of Kyle Roane to become the director of basketball operations at Southern Mississippi, Lions head coach Jay Ladner was forced to make a few changes in his coaching staff.

David Kiefer, starting his second season with the Lions, was elevated to associate head coach. Joey Stiebing, also entering his second year at Southeastern, was promoted to assistant coach after serving as a special assistant to Ladner in 2015-16.

Odell Witherspoon III was hired in the off-season as an assistant coach. Garland Wilson, was named the Lions' director of basketball operations after holding the same position at Jacksonville State from 2012-16.

Aaron Ardis, who served the past two seasons as Southeastern's head manager and assistant video coordinator, is moving into a graduate assistant role and will be the Lions' video and camp coordinator.

Catch 'Em on the Tube (or the Net)

Also on the schedule are the Southland Conference games at Lamar at 4:30 p.m. on Saturday, Jan. 7 and at home against New Orleans at 5:30 p.m. on Saturday, Feb. 11.

The American Sports Network will telecast the Southland game at Northwestern State at 8 p.m. on Thursday, Feb. 16. The game will also be streamed on the Southland Conference Digital Network.

The Lions' non-conference game at Colorado State will be on the Mountain West Network at 3 p.m. on Nov. 25 with the Pac-12 Network picking up the Lions' following game at California on Sunday, Nov. 27 at 7 p.m.

Ex-Assistant Cordaro Returns to UC

There was a familiar face on the LSUA bench for Southeastern fans when the Lions hosted the Generals in an exhibition game on Nov. 2.

Generals head coach Larry Cordaro was an assistant coach with the Lions from 2002-12 and an associate head coach from 2012-14. He was named the head coach of the startup men's basketball program at LSUA prior to the 2013-14 season and has led the Generals to a 52-8 record in his two seasons. LSUA has captured a pair of Red River Athletic Conference regular season titles and one conference tournament championship and made two trips to the NAIA Tournament.

During Cordaro's tenure in Hammond, the Lions had nine All-Southland Conference players, six All-Louisiana players, four National Association of Basketball Coaches All-District players and made six trips to the conference tournament.

Cordaro played a key role in the recruitment and development of Brandon Fortenberry and Roosevelt Johnson, both recently finishing their careers as two of the top players in Lions history.

Lions Great Core Selected to La. Hall

Recognized as the most decorated player in Southeastern Louisiana men's basketball history, Lion legend C.A. Core was selected to the Louisiana Sports Hall of Fame's Class of 2017, the Hall of Fame in September.

Core, who starred on the hard court for the Lions from 1964-68, will be a part of a class that includes jockey Calvin Borel, gymnastics coach D-D Breaux, baseball coach Raymond Didier, football player Eddie Kennison, baseball player Juan Pierre, football player Ed Reed and golfer David Toms.

The class will be enshrined on June 24, 2017 in Natchitoches to culminate the 2017 Louisiana Sports Hall of Fame Induction Celebration. The 2017 class will be showcased in the Louisiana Sports Hall of Fame Museum, situated adjacent to Cane River Lake in the National Historic Landmark District of Natchitoches.

Core's career has been recognized in many ways since he finished his Southeastern career.

The only men's basketball player in school history to have his jersey retired, Core's No. 34 hangs in the rafters of the University Center. In 1974, he was named to the Southeastern Athletics Hall of Fame and earned a spot in the Louisiana Association of Basketball Coaches Hall of Fame in 1979-80.

A native of Noblesville, Indiana, Core was recognized for his high school exploits by being named to the Hamilton County Basketball Hall of Fame in 2008. Core passed away at the age of 41.

During his time with the Lions, Core set standards that still stand nearly 50 years later. The only All-American selection in program history, Core was a NAIA All-American as both a junior and senior, while also earning Associated Press All-American accolades as a junior. He was also a four-time All-Gulf States Conference selection.

During his time at Southeastern, Core set career records for points (2,046), scoring average (21.3 ppg), rebounds (1,475), rebounding average (15.4 rpg), field goals made (759) and free throws made (524). His 22.3 points per game in 1964-65 remains the highest single-season scoring average in school history. In his four years in Hammond, Core never posted a season scoring average of less than 20 points per contest and owns four of the top six single-season performances.

His rebounding averages were even more staggering. He averaged a double-double every season, highlighted by a single-season school record of 18.5 rebounds per contest as a senior. Core owns three of the top four averages in school history and never averaged less than 12.3 rebounds per game in any season.

Core is the eighth Southeastern Louisiana selection to the Louisiana Sports Hall of Fame. Former women's basketball legend Queen Brumfield Nard and legendary football coach Stan Galloway preceded Core, while Southeastern graduate Jim Corbett was also inducted.

Two Southeastern graduates – longtime sports information director Larry Hymel and Bud Johnson – have received the Hall's Distinguished Service Award in Sports Journalism, while SLU alums Emmanuel Bourgeois and Elmo Aldoph were both recipients of the Dave Dixon Louisiana Sports Leadership Award.

Kennedy Named Alumnus of the Year

Southeastern honored one of its own this fall as former Lion head coach Billy Kennedy was honored as the university's 2016 Alumnus of the Year.

Kennedy, a 1986 graduate of Southeastern, returned to his alma mater in 1999 to coach the Lions for six seasons. Under his direction, Southeastern had its best two-year record from 2003-05, winning a combined 44 games. The 2004-05 team captured the Southland Conference championship and made the pro-

gram's first trip to the NCAA Division I Tournament.

Kennedy went on to coach at Murray State for five seasons, leading the Racers to two Ohio Valley Conference championships and the 2009-10 NCAA Tournament. He has been the head coach at Texas A&M for the past five seasons, leading the Aggies to a share of the Southeastern Conference title and the NCAA Tournament in 2015-16.

Kennedy returned to the campus during Homecoming week in mid-October and spoke to the 2016-17 squad and members of the Lion Athletics Association Hardwood Club.

Lending A Hand

The Lions were a familiar sight in the community during the offseason.

The Lions, as well as members from the entire Southeastern athletic program, spent hours helping move furniture from flooded homes, tearing out sheetrock and delivering supplies to those in need following the historical flooding in southeast Louisiana in August.

In July, the Southeastern men's and women's basketball teams interacted with a group of area young men and women at the annual Camp Kateri held at the Rosaryville Spirit Life Center.

The Lions and Lady Lions not only played basketball with the campers but also went canoeing and bicycle riding with them as well as competing in kickball and volleyball matches.

And in March, the basketball squad were among the student-athletes from throughout the program who were on hand at Tucker Elementary's annual Field Day in Ponchatoula.

The Lions also helped serve meals at Holy Ghost School in conjunction with Cafeteria Workers Appreciation Week in October.

Honorary Lion

Southeastern head coach Jay Ladner and the Lions sent Houston native Joseph Fleming a video in late August, inviting him to be the team's honorary coach for the Oct. 26 exhibition game against Southern-New Orleans.

Sadly, Fleming, who had been diagnosed with liver cancer, passed away the week of the game at the age of 10.

The plan for the video started when Ladner received a call from NFL Hall of Fame quarterback Brett Favre, a mutual friend of his and of Tony Creel, Fleming's youth baseball coach in Houston.

"Brett Favre is one of his favorite football players and he sent Joseph a video and called me and asked what about inviting him over to be an honorary head coach," Ladner said. "I said certainly we would do it. There is a mutual relationship between the young man's coach who let us know what was going on and he heard Brett talk about me being here at Southeastern Louisiana and (Joseph) has kind of adopted us as his team from what I understand."
