CAL POLY VISITS CAL, WASHINGTON IN PAC-12 NETWORK TELEVISED MATCHUPS

The Cal Poly men's basketball program continues its six-game road trip with a pair of nationally televised, Pac-12 Network matchups at California on Saturday, Dec. 17 at 5 p.m. and Washington on Tuesday, Dec. 20 at 8 p.m. Facing California (8-2) for just the fifth time in program history and Washington (4-5) for just the second time, Cal Poly (5-5) enters Saturday's matchup with the Golden Bears leading the Big West Conference with a 38.9 (96-for-247) percent three-point mark and ranked 32nd among 347 Division I programs in three-pointers per game (9.6) and 39th in total three-pointers. Cal Poly's five non-conference wins match UC Davis (5-4) for the most of any Big West program. Cal, which received seven votes in the Dec. 12 edition of the USA Today Coaches Poll, is one of three opponents on Cal Poly's 2016-17 schedule that qualified for last year's NCAA Tournament. Washington hosts Western Michigan on Sunday, Dec. 18 before facing Cal Poly.

CAL POLY VERSUS WASHINGTON: The Mustangs and Huskies have met just once prior with Washington claiming a 75-62 victory in Seattle on Dec. 20, 2012.

THE COMPANY YOU KEEP: Cal Poly is in the midst of a five-game stretch where each of its opponents – Fresno State (Dec. 10), California (Dec. 17), Washington (Dec. 20), Grand Canyon (Dec. 28) and Princeton (Dec. 31) – all qualified for postseason play a year ago. Fresno State and California made the NCAA Tournament while Washington and Princeton each qualified for the 2016 NIT. Grand Canyon, meanwhile, reached last season's CollegeInsider.com Tournament quarterfinals.

ARC DE TRIOMPHE: The Big West's top three-point shooting program at 38.9 (96-for-247) percent, Cal Poly has knocked down double-digit three-pointers in a game five times this season and shot better than 50 percent from the three-point line twice. Among 347 Division I programs, Cal Poly ranks 32nd in three-pointers per game (9.6) and 39th in total three-pointers (96). Under eighth-year head coach **Joe Callero**, Cal Poly's previous best for three-point shooting was a 37.5 (227-for-606) percent mark during the 2012-13 season.

MUSTANG OFFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: Among Cal Poly's five victories this season, the Mustangs have won games when scoring in the 80s (Texas A&M-Corpus Christi), the 70s (Cal State Dominguez Hills), twice in the 60s (Northern Illinois, Bethesda) and once in the 50s (UTSA).

TOTH BACK AS CAL POLY'S SENIOR SHARPSHOOTER: A year after redshirting and two years after making just 11 appearances, senior guard **Kyle Toth** enters Cal Poly's Saturday game ranked eighth among NCAA Division I players with a 54.5 (30-for-55) percent three-point mark. Also 10h in the Big West with a 51.4 (38-for-74) percent field goal mark and Cal Poly's second leading scorer at 11.6 points per game, Toth has scored in double digits six times and knocked down multiple three-pointers in eight of 10 games. Of Toth's 38 field goals this season, 79.0 percent have come from beyond the arc. Toth is a 49.5 (45-for-91) percent three-point shooter at Cal Poly.

SHREAD'S DISTRIBUTION SERVICE: The Big West's leader and ranked 57th among NCAA Division I players with 5.2 assists per game, sophomore guard **Jaylen Shread** has kicked down at least five assists during seven of his nine appearances this year. Offensively, Shread has produced three double-digit scoring games this season and – helped by a career high 20-point effort versus Illinois-Chicago – is fifth in Cal Poly's lineup with 8.0 points per game. Shread is also Cal Poly's leading rebounder at 4.4 boards per game.

JOSEPH ENJOYING BREAKOUT ROLE AS CAL POLY'S SIXTH MAN: Despite not starting a Division I game in his career, sophomore guard **Victor Joseph** enters Saturday's game at California as Cal Poly's leading scorer at 11.7 points per game. Averaging 15.8 points per Cal Poly's last six games, Joseph's career high 23-point effort versus Elon (Nov. 26) marks the top single game scoring performance by a Mustang this season. with six double-digit scoring games, Joseph ranks sixth among Big West players with a 44.7 (21-for-47) percent three-point mark and 12th with a 50.0 (41-for-82) percent field goal mark.

SHIPLEY'S SUPERB SENIOR SEASON: Ranked second among Big West players and 61st among Division I performers with a 2.7-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio, senior guard **Ridge Shipley** – owner of 213 career assists – requires just two more to move into the No. 10 spot in Cal Poly's record book. Also seventh among Big West players at 3.2 assists per game, Shipley is averaging 7.1 points per outing.

CAL POLY'S QUALITY CONTROL: No Division I program has committed fewer turnovers per game since the beginning of the 2012-13 season than Cal Poly, which has averaged just 9.48 turnovers per 135 matchups (1,280 turnovers total). Having led the Big West in fewest turnovers per game in each of the last five seasons, Cal Poly once more owns the top spot with just 11.3 turnovers per matchup this year while ranking 33rd among 347 Division I programs. The Mustangs have finished with a single-digit turnover total four times this season.

MUSTANGS FACE ANOTHER TESTING SCHEDULE DURING 2016-17 SEASON: Once again contesting one of the Big West Conference's more demanding schedules, Cal Poly will play a program record 16 games this season against opponents that qualified for postseason play a year ago.

ETC: Cal Poly fell to 2-6 in season openers under eighth-year head coach Joe Callero, 9-14 in season openers at the Division I level and 2-12 in Division I road season openers with a 77-68 loss at Pepperdine (Nov. 11) ... Josh Martin's 21-rebound effort at Pepperdine marked the highest single game total in Cal Poly's 23-season Division I era and the total was four shy of the Mustang program record ... Cal Poly won its fourth home-opening matchup inside Mott Athletics Center in the last five attempts with a 75-64 victory against Cal State Dominguez Hills (Nov. 17) ... since transitioning to the Division I level prior to the 1994-95 season, Cal Poly improved to 36-1 against non-Division I programs and 11-1 in similar games under eighth-year head coach Joe Callero with victories against Division II Cal State Dominguez Hills (Nov. 17) and NCCAA Bethesda (Nov. 19) ... JOE CALLERO

Head Coach • Eighth Season • Central Washington, 1986

Having established the Cal Poly men's basketball team as the Big West Conference's elite defensive program and with the Mustangs enjoying their most successful period in the Division I era, Joe Callero is in his eighth season as head coach.

Under Callero, Cal Poly's 53 Big West victories rank as the highest total over a seven-year period in program history while the team's 100 total wins rank as the highest seven-year total in 24 seasons.

The Big West's dominant defensive program, Cal Poly led the conference in fewest points allowed per game for five seasons (2010-15) while ranking as one of the nation's top 40 defensive programs in four of the last six years.

Also one of the nation's most efficient squads, Cal Poly has averaged just 9.34 turnovers per game during the past four seasons – the lowest total among 345 Division I programs. Additionally, Cal Poly has led the Big West during the previous five years with a combined 1.30-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio.

Cal Poly's notable achievements continued last season under Callero. Averaging 72.4 points per game – the program's highest scoring average in 14 years – the 2015-16 Mustangs finished 16th among NCAA Division I programs with 10.3 turnovers per game, won the 2015 Maui Invitational Regional Round championship and defeated two programs that reached the NCAA Tournament (Fresno State, Austin Peay).

Through Callero's direction, Cal Poly's finish to the 2013-14 season ranked as one of the most notable

athletics achievements in university history. The first and only No. 7 seed in the 40-year history of the Big West Conference Tournament to claim the crown, Cal Poly swept aside second-seeded UC Santa Barbara, No. 1 UC Irvine and fifth-seeded CSUN to earn the program's first Big West championship and first NCAA Division I Tournament berth. At the NCAA Tournament First Four, the Mustangs topped fellow No. 16 seed Texas Southern to record the program's first postseason win in 32 years and one of only two NCAA Tournament victories by a Big West program in the last 11 seasons. Despite failing to top-seeded Wichita State in the second round, Cal Poly finished the year ranked fifth nationally in fewest turnovers per game (8.9) and 37th in points allowed per game (63.6).

Individually, Cal Poly has produced 10 All-Big West selections under Callero while, in 2014, Chris Eversley became the first Big West Tournament Most Valuable Player selection in program history. With a reputation for refining talent, Callero – who coached NBA champion Brian Scalabrine at USC (1998-99) – has helped produce 12 professional players from Cal Poly. Most recently, forward Brian Bennett (2012-16) signed with Slovakian club BK Banik Handlova while forward Joel Awich (2011-16) joined French side Basket Club Montbrison. Among Cal Poly's recent professional successes, guard Kyle Odister (2009-14) helped Sheffield Sharks to the 2016 British Basketball League title, guard Drake U'u (2009-13) lifted Perth Wildcats to the 2014 Australia National Basketball League championship and guard Amaunys Fernin (2009-12) was named 2013 Rookie of the Year in the Dominican Republic national league.

Under Callero, Cal Poly regularly plays the nation's elite teams in elite venues and features on national television. In seven previous seasons under Joe Callero, Cal Poly has played in 19 different states, competed in 13 arenas that have hosted NCAA Tournament games and visited nationally ranked opponents such as Arizona, UCLA, Gonzaga, Texas

A&M, San Diego State, Pitt and Wisconsin. During the past three seasons, Cal Poly has made 33 television appearances – including two as part of the 2014 NCAA Tournament.

In the classroom, the Mustangs have performed exceptionally under Callero's guidance with all 20 senior players during the previous five seasons earning degrees. For the 2014-15 academic year, Cal Poly received a perfect 1,000 Academic Progress Rate scores from the NCAA.

In support of Cal Poly's talent, winning ways and nationally recognized style of play, the Mustang program has experienced a 31.9 percent increase in attendance between the 2008-09 campaign (the final season prior to Callero's arrival) and last season's average of 2,310 fans per home game. Cal Poly's peak attendance figure of 2,411 fans under Callero during the 2014-15 season marked the program's highest total in 12 years.

Under Callero, Cal Poly is 54-36 inside Mott Athletics Center. Between the 2011-12 and 2013-14 seasons, Cal Poly won 16 straight Big West Conference home games.

Setting the stage for Cal Poly's 2013-14 championship season was a 2012-13 Mustang squad that set program records for Big West victories (12) and Big West winning percentage (.667) en route to a second successive Big West Tournament semifinal appearance. An overall 18-win total helped Cal Poly match or exceed its victory total from the previous year for the fourth successive season (a feat not accomplished for 41 years). The 2012-13 Mustangs also finished 13-1 inside the Mott Athletics Center to set Division I program records for home victories, fewest home losses and home winning percentage (.929). In topping No. 11 UCLA at Pauley Pavilion, the Mustangs chalked up their first victory against a ranked opponent and, as part of the CollegeInsider.com Tournament, Cal Poly played the program's first postseason game in 27 years. Cal Poly also finished second nationally in fewest turnovers per game (9.4) and fourth in assist-to-

turnover ratio (1.46-to-1).

Cal Poly finished the 2011-12 season ranked among Division I basketball's top-25 defensive programs for a second successive year. Along the way, Cal Poly produced an 18-win season, reached the Big West Tournament semifinals for the first time in five years and, during a 100-54 victory against Cal State Northridge, the Mustangs sank their first 11 three-point attempts to match a 25-year-old NCAA record.

Selected to finish fifth in the Big West standings during the 2010-11 season, Cal Poly instead matched single-season program records for highest showing in the Big West (second) and highest seeding for the conference tournament (second). The Mustangs also cemented their status as a defensive powerhouse by finishing third among NCAA Division I programs in opponent three-point percentage and sixth in opponent points per game. Callero's initial 2009-10 season at Cal Poly yielded one of the top single-year turnarounds in program history. In orchestrating a five-win improvement from the previous year, Callero also directed the Mustangs to their best start to any Big West season (5-2). Predicted to finish last in the standings, Cal Poly clinched the No. 6 seed for the Big West Tournament and capped the year by winning the program's first conference tournament game in three seasons.

Named head coach of Cal Poly on April 3, 2009, Callero has developed a reputation for revitalizing programs. As head coach at Seattle (2001-09), Callero directed the Redhawks to 75 victories during his final four seasons and successfully led the program through its Division I transition. Callero's final 2008-09 season with the Redhawks produced a 21-8 campaign and the program's highest winning percentage in 45 seasons. Additionally, the 2008-09 Seattle squad – as an independent program – finished No. 131 out of 347 Division I programs in the final Sagarin Ratings.

Under Callero, Seattle finished the 2006-07 season with a 20-9 record, a Great Northwest Athletic Conference

title and the program's first berth in the NCAA Division II Tournament in 38 years. During just his second season at Seattle (2002-03), Callero directed the Redhawks to a 16-11 finish that was the program's first winning campaign in nine seasons and a 10-victory improvement upon the previous year.

Prior to success at Seattle, Callero guided Division III University of Puget Sound to a combined 22-25 record during the 1999-00 and 2000-01 seasons. The Loggers finished 14-10 during his final season to secure the program's first winning campaign in nine years. Before pointing Puget Sound in a winning direction, Callero served the 1998-99 season as an assistant coach at USC. During his one season in Los Angeles, Callero assisted the Trojans to the NIT.

A prominent figure on the northwest basketball scene for more than two decades, Callero compiled a 130-49 mark during two three-season stints at Highline Community College (1989-92, 1995-98) and, before departing for USC, helped guide the Thunderbirds to successive Northwest Athletic Association of Community Colleges championships.

Callero twice earned conference Coach of the Year praise after Highline posted a combined 63-2 mark during the 1996-97 and 1997-98 campaigns.

Between successful stints at Highline Community College, Callero served as the head coach and as a guidance counselor at Sumner HS (1992-95). Under Callero, Sumner also posted its first winning campaign in six years.

A 1986 graduate of Central Washington with a bachelor's degree in psychology, Callero helped guide the Wildcats to consecutive NAIA National Championship appearances. The point guard and captain of Central Washington's 1985-86 squad received his master's degree in education from Seattle in 1991. One of 16 children, Callero is a graduate of Enumclaw HS.

Callero, his wife, Erika, and daughter, Malia, reside in nearby Arroyo Grande.
