OFF THE TOP

- Arizona opens Pac-12 play with a trip to the San Francisco Bay Area, starting first with the California Golden Bears. UA has not opened conference play in the bay since the 2008-09 season. The Wildcats are 6-1 in conference openers under head coach Sean Miller and 2-1 on the road in Pac-12 openers.
- The Wildcats closed out non-conference play with a convincing 77-46 win over long-time rival New Mexico on Tuesday, Dec. 20 in McKale Center as Arizona's non-conference record in the Sean Miller era (2009 to present) advanced to 88-17 (.838). UA was led by sophomore Chance Comanche who had the best game of his career with 14 points, eight rebounds on a perfect six-of-six shooting night. Comanche was supported by freshman Rawle Alkins who became the first Arizona guard since Nick Johnson in 2013-14 to record a double-double as Alkins tallied 13 points and 11 rebounds versus the Lobos.
- UA head coach Sean Miller heads into the weekend in search of his 200th win as the head coach of the Wildcats. Miller enters the 2016-17 Pac-12 season with a record of 199-63 (.759) as Arizona's head coach.
- Coach Sean Miller and the Wildcats will look for a win in Haas Pavilion in what has been an even series in Berkeley after dropping a one-point decision there last season. The two teams have primarily alternated wins each trip to the Bay Area. Since 2000, six of Arizona's eight losses in Berkeley have been by single digits.
- Rawle Alkins and his unrelenting attack of the offensive glass has earned the freshman 18 offensive rebounds in his last six games. That run has propelled his yearly average to 1.8 offensive rebounds per game entering Pac-12 play. The freshman is one of only two guards in the conference to rank in the top 15 in offensive rebounding.
- The Wildcats dunked their way to their 31-point victory over the New Mexico Lobos in their non-conference finale on Dec. 20. Arizona tallied seven dunks (five from Comanche alone) in that game after recording 33 total dunks in the 12 games prior (2.8 per game).

MILLER LOOKING TO JOIN THE 200 IN 300 CLUB

Head coach Sean Miller has forged his path to 200 wins at Arizona at a blistering pace of 75.9 percent. Here's a closer look at Miller's approach of 200 wins compares to the other notable coaches with 200 wins at their current school who achieved the feat in fewer than 300 games.

THE LAST TIME THESE TWO MET: "THE GABE YORK GAME"

The last time these two teams met was yet another ESPN Classic worthy game. Arizona earned a 64-61 victory following a trio of three-pointers from Gabe York in the final two and a half minutes, including a pair in the last 60 seconds of the game.

DEFENSE ON THE RISE

The foundations of the Arizona program have centered around defense under Sean Miller. Since the team's second loss of the season, a 62-69 loss to Gonzaga in Los Angeles on Dec. 3, the team's rankings in a trio of defensive categories have been on a gradual rise during a five-game winning streak.

ROAD WARRIORS

In addition to holding one of the highest home court winning percentages in the nation, Arizona has shown a knack for continuing its winning ways outside of Tucson. Since Sean Miller's arrival prior to the 2009-10 season, the Wildcats have posted a record of 84-51 (.622) away from McKale Center.

DRAWING A CROWD WHEREVER THEY PLAY

UA's unrelenting support inside McKale Center, as the Pac-12 leader in attendance in 32 consecutive seasons, has also extended outside of Tucson. In each of the last two seasons, attendance at Arizona's away games in Pac-12 play increased at least 48.0 percent over season averages prior to playing the Wildcats.

ONE OF THE WINNINGEST PROGRAMS IN THE LAST THREE YEARS

Entering the 2016-17 season, Arizona has become one of the winningest programs in the nation in the past three seasons. Arizona, Villanova and Kentucky have jockeyed for the title of winningest program in the nation during this three-year span.

It's just part of the winning culture instilled on the Arizona Basketball program since the arrival of head coach Sean Miller. In Miller's seven seasons in Tucson, UA has averaged 26.8 wins per season. Since the start of the 2010-11 season, the Wildcats have a 183-48 (.792) record, both the most wins and best winning percentage in the Pac-12 in that span.

NOT JUST PLAYING SHORTHANDED, WINNING SHORTHANDED

Since Parker Jackson-Cartwright suffered a high ankle sprain in the first half versus Texas Southern on Nov. 30, the Wildcats have played with seven available scholarship players for six and a half games. Arizona has played 272:27 of real game action since Jackson-Cartwright's injury, and it has led for 225:40, trailed for 41:49 and been tied for 4:58 of that time with seven players.

MARKKANEN IN THE PAC-12 STATISTICS

As the Wildcats enter Pac-12 play in the 2016-17 season, freshman Lauri Markkanen continues to standout in the Pac-12 statistical rankings. Markkanen ranks ninth in scoring (16.1 ppg), 13th in rebounding (7.3 rpg), tied for sixth free throw percentage (83.3 percent) and eighth in three-point field goal percentage (43.5 percent). He is the only player in the conference to rank in the top 15 in all four of those statistical categories.

IN ELITE CONFERENCE OF CHAMPIONS COMPANY

Through his first seven seasons as the head coach at the University of Arizona, Sean Miller has amassed a record of 91-35 (.722) in Pac-12 games. That conference winning percentage ranks fourth in the history of the Pac-12 for coaches with six or more seasons in the league.

WILDCATS CONTINUE TO BUILD ON RANKINGS STREAK

The Wildcats have been ranked in 86-consecutive AP polls and 89-straight coaches polls. The 86-consecutive weeks in the AP poll is currently the second-longest streak in the nation behind Kansas. Since the start of the 2012-13 season, Arizona has spent 60 weeks ranked in the top 10 of the AP poll during that span. UA took over the No. 1 ranking in the AP poll on Dec. 9, 2013, marking its first top ranking since 2003 and the first time a Pac-12 team had garnered the top spot since 2006. The Wildcats held the top spot for a program-record eight straight weeks. Arizona was one of just 11 programs in the nation to appear in all 20 Associated Press polls in 2012-13, and one of just eight programs nationally to do so in 2013-14. UA was the only program in the nation to be ranked in the top 10 in every AP poll in the 2013-14 and the 2014-15 seasons.

CONTINUED OFFENSIVE COHESION IN MILLER ERA

KenPom's adjusted offensive efficiency metric measures points scored per 100 possessions with adjustments for the quality of opposing defenses, the site of each game, and when each game was played (recent games get more weight). Arizona ended the season ranked 20th in the nation in KenPom's adjusted offensive efficiency at 114.7. FRESHMEN PRODUCTION

UA is led in scoring this season by the freshmen trio of Lauri Markkanen (16.1 ppg), Rawle Alkins (12.4 ppg) and Kobi Simmons (12.2 ppg). Those three freshmen make Arizona one of only two programs in the nation to have its top three scorers all be freshmen averaging at least ten points per game. MILLER AND COMPANY INK FOUR DECORATED FUTURE WILDCATS

Head coach Sean Miller and the Arizona Basketball program have announced the addition of four future Wildcats for the 2017 recruiting class. Deandre Ayton (Phoenix, Ariz.), Alex Barcello (Phoenix, Ariz.), Ira Lee (Los Angeles, Calif.) and Brandon Randolph (Yonkers, N.Y.) give Arizona another top recruiting class in the nation.

Deandre Ayton – 7'0" 250 lbs. Center – Phoenix, Ariz.

Coach Sean Miller on Ayton: "I'm not going to sugarcoat it, Deandre is one of these once in a generation types of players. He's big, seven feet (tall). The fact that he hasn't lifted weights is astonishing to me because when you shake his hand, he has a physical presence as a young person that you don't often times see. One thing I'm really excited for sure is to plug him into our strength and conditioning program, which is a real part of our program. The thing that impresses me about Deandre as a player is that he is really smart. He has the know-how to play with four other players that not a lot of big guys have. He can pass, he can step away from the basket and dribble the ball, and he's a really skilled player."

Alex Barcello – 6'2" 180 lbs. Guard – Phoenix, Ariz.

Coach Miller on Barcello: "Alex is a point guard from Phoenix and an incredible student. He has the makings to be an incredible leader, and has some characteristics of T.J. McConnell that we've grown to love. I think that he has a fire inside of him, a toughness, and a love of the game that at that position you love to have. We are really elated to have him. Alex is not small, he's 6-1, 6-2 and has a good build to him. Another thing we love about Alex, in addition to his playmaking skills, is that he can really shoot the three... Being from Phoenix is nice for his family. He has already won several state championships, and winning is a real part of his background."

Ira Lee – 6'8" 220 lbs. Forward – Los Angeles, Calif.

Coach Miller on Lee: "Ira Lee is the one we've probably been with the longest in terms of our recruiting efforts. We identified Ira a long time ago and offered him a scholarship early on in his high school career. He's a guy with a high motor, plays the game with tremendous energy, and he's involved in so many different plays on both offense and defense. From a defensive perspective he has a chance to be great. Ira has the type of size and athleticism, but mostly the mindset of toughness that we really love. He's also a versatile player where he can play more than one position. He gives us versatility in that regard because you can play him in many different combinations, he's not a one position type player."

Brandon Randolph – 6'6" 185 lbs. Guard – Yonkers, N.Y.

Coach Miller on Randolph: "Brandon, like Alex (Barcello), is an exceptional shooter. Not a small two guard, he's around 6'5", 6'6". When you have that type of frame, strength and conditioning can give you additional skills that you may not have right now. He's got a great frame, but where his body will go over the next couple of years, it's exciting to think about. He's more than just a shooter, he's a basketball player, really knows how to pass the ball. He plays on one of the best high school teams in the country, and that winning environment on both the travel circuit as well as a highly competitive high school. He's a high-character kid, tremendous student and comes from a great family."

RAY SMITH INJURY UPDATE

University of Arizona forward Ray Smith has suffered a knee injury and will miss the 2016-17 season. Smith injured the ACL in his right knee as well as other ligament and meniscal damage in Tuesday's exhibition. He will have surgery in the upcoming month and begin the rehabilitation process. Smith later announced he would step away from the game after three ACL injuries in less than three years.

Below is Head Coach Sean Miller's official statement.

"About a year ago I began my statement regarding Ray Smith's season-ending injury by saying, "Ray Smith is one of the most talented young players that has ever entered our program." Unfortunately, I begin this year's statement by reiterating the special talent that Ray has on the basketball court and once again addressing a season-ending knee injury.

In the 25 years I have been a college basketball coach, I have never felt as helpless as I did when I saw him go down on Tuesday night. No 19-year-old kid should have to experience three season-ending injuries in a 30-month period of time. I have watched Ray work with our strength and conditioning coach tirelessly for two years. I have seen him in our training room around the clock, doing everything he can to play the game he loves. To witness his extraordinary efforts and see this happen to him once again is beyond disheartening.

Ray is surrounded by a community that loves Arizona Basketball, current and former teammates that look at him as a brother, and a coaching staff and family that is beyond supportive and forever with him. Although the mountain that Ray is climbing continues to change, my belief in him to be a resounding success in life has never been stronger. His intelligence, charisma and sheer will position him to be special in all that he does. I certainly look forward to helping him, as part of our basketball family, reach all of the goals that he sets out to achieve."

1.25 BILLION AND COUNTING IN NBA CONTRACTS

Former Wildcats continue their storied NBA careers after eclipsing the \$1 billion mark in NBA contracts signed prior to the 2013-14 season. Sean Miller era Cats have now inked \$129 million in NBA contracts since his arrival in Tucson prior to the 2009-10 season. Arizona also boasts six former players who have each earned in excess of \$100 million in NBA deals, including Gilbert Arenas, Mike Bibby, Andre Iguodala, Richard Jefferson, Damon Stoudamire and Jason Terry. Arizona products have signed for over \$58 million in NBA contracts for the 2016-17 season alone.

ANOTHER JERSEY GOES INTO THE MCKALE RAFTERS

Miles Simon, one of the most decorated players in Arizona's rich basketball history, will have his number 34 uniform recognized at the 2016 McDonald's Red-Blue Game on Friday, Oct. 14. Simon was the Most Outstanding Player of the 1997 NCAA Tournament that saw UA claim a national championship. He was the leading scorer for the entire tournament, including 30 points in the overtime win over Kentucky in the championship game.

The Southern California native ended his career in the top 10 in program history in scoring, assists, made free throws and made three-point field goals. He tallied 20 points or more in a game an impressive 34 times in his sophomore, junior and senior seasons. Simon is still one of just 13 Wildcats to score over 1,600 points in a career while currently still ranking in the top 10 in assists, free throws made and made three-point field goals.

The Arizona guard was a first-team All-American as a senior in 1997-98 after earning All-Pac-10 honors in each of his final three seasons with the Wildcats. Simon is Arizona's all-time career leading scorer in NCAA Tournament history and is one of four Wildcats to score 1,600 points and dish out 400 assists in a career, joining Sean Elliott, Damon Stoudamire and Jason Gardner.

MCKALE FINGERPRINTS ON THE NBA FINALS

It was former members of the Arizona Basketball program that made headlines in June. Seven former Wildcat players were part of the 2016 NBA Finals between the Golden State Warriors and the Cleveland Cavaliers, which is the most UA alums in a NBA Finals in program history, topping five one year ago.

A HISTORY OF GOLD MEDALS WITH TEAM USA AS A PLAYER AND A COACH

Sean Miller led Team USA to a gold medal to the 2015 FIBA U-19 World Championships as head coach with a roster that included Arizona Wildcat Allonzo Trier. This came one summer after he helped guide the U.S. U-18 National Team to a gold medal at the FIBA Americas Championship as an assistant coach.

The pair of gold medals he has earned as a coach are team with a third that he won one as a player at the 1991 World University Games in England.

MILLER AMONG NATION'S ELITE AT ADVANCING IN NCAA TOURNAMENT

Head coach Sean Miller has directed Arizona to its 17th Sweet 16 appearance in 2015, marking the program's third in a row and fourth in five years. He led Xavier to Sweet 16 appearances in 2008 and 2009, giving him six for his career.

Since 2008, Miller is one of four coaches nationally to lead a team to six or more Sweet 16 berths. He also has a 13-2 (.867) career record in the NCAA Tournament against lower-seeded teams.

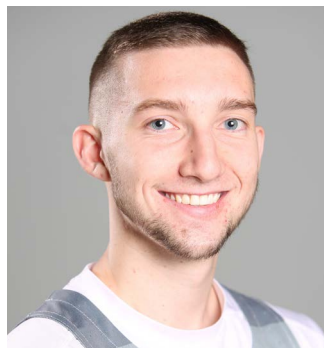
