NEED TO KNOW

California men's basketball wraps up its non-conference slate Thursday when the Golden Bears host the Portland State Vikings, with a chance to finish the preseason slate with a winning record for the 14th consecutive season. The action begins at 8 p.m. from Haas Pavilion, airing live on the Pac-12 Network and on KGO 810 AM.

Cal has finished above .500 through the non-conference slate every season since 2003-04, when the Bears went 4-5. Through their toughest stretch of the preseason, the young Bears fell as low as 2-4 with three consecutive losses at the Maui Invitational, but the squad has bounced back with four wins in their last six outings. Cal is currently on a three-game win streak and stands at 6-6 with an even .500 record.

A pair of Bears in Don Coleman and Marcus Lee have been pivotal in Cal's winning stretch, with the duo averaging above 20.0 points across the three games. McNeill enters Thursday's contest averaging 25.0 points in his last two appearances after pouring in a career-high 30 points against CSU Fullerton and adding 20 in Cal's win at Seattle. He's averaging 20.0 points in the three-game stretch. Meanwhile, Coleman is averaging 20.3 points and 5.3 rebounds, plus a team-high 13 assists, including a career-high six in his latest outing at Seattle. Justice Sueing has also been strong for the Bears as the other rookie in Cal's starting lineup, averaging 12.3 points during the streak.

As a team, Cal is outscoring opponents 79.7-70 in the last three games, with a +5.7 rebound margin.

HOW TO FOLLOW THE ACTION: Thursday's contest airs live on Pac-12 Networks, with the commentary and call from Jim Watson and Ben Braun. The California Golden Bears Sports Network will offer play by play and analysis, as well as post-game interviews, from Todd McKim and Jay John live on KGO 810 AM. Live stats, full broadcast details and more can be accessed via the Cal men's basketball schedule page on CalBears.com, and fans can follow the Bears on social media via @CalMBball on Twitter and Instagram, and at Facebook.com/CalMBball.

BY THE NUMBERS

10.0 California is averaging 10.0 steals per game in the last three outings. The Bears turned in 11 steals at San Diego State, 10 steals vs. CSU Fullerton and 9 at Seattle.

6.1 Cal is averaging 6.1 blocked shots per game with 73 total blocks. The Golden Bear record is 161 blocks, which Cal set in 2013 at a pace of 4.88 swats per game in 33 total contests.

25.0 Darius McNeill is averaging 25.0 points in his last two appearances. The frosh poured in a career-high 30 against CSU Fullerton, then added 20 points -- all in the second half -- at Seattle.

5 The Golden Bears have scored 80 or more points in five games this season, including in back-to-back wins against CSU Fullerton and Seattle. Cal is 4-1 when scoring 80+.

2003-04 With a win over the Vikings, California would avoid a losing record in non-conference play. The Bears' last losing record in non-con action was in 2003-04, when Cal went 4-5.

SCOUTING THE VIKINGS

 • Traylin Farris, who was averaging 8.5 points in the first six appearances for the Vikings, has missed six games.
 • The Viks lead the nation at 10.0 steals per game, logging 18 or more steals in five contests this season.
 • Portland State's three losses have come against No. 1 Duke (99-81), Butler (71-69) and Oregon (95-84).
 • The Vikings are 1-1 against the Pac-12, defeating Stanford 87-78 and losing to the Ducks.

LAST TIME OUT

The Bears raced past the Redhawks, 81-59, at Seattle's KeyArena
 • The Golden Bears posted their largest margin of victory this season, and fifth 80+ point game.
 • Three Bears scored in double figures, led by 20 points from Darius McNeill, plus 17 from Justice Sueing and 16 from Don Coleman.
 • McNeill scored all 20 of his points in the second half against the Redhawks, extending his three-pointer streak to 12 consecutive games.
 • Coleman logged a new personal best for assists with 6.
 • Cal tallied 9 steals.
 • Cal was 1-7 from beyond the arc in the first half, but improved to 4-7 (57.1 percent) in the second half.
 • The Bears' 47 points in the second half were the most in any second half by the Bears this season.

BEARS GIVE BACK

California men's basketball helped spread some holiday spirit this week when the Golden Bears banded together with Cal women's basketball at the UCSF Benioff Oakland Children's Hospital holiday party. Both Bear squads interacted with the oncology department, signing autographs, taking photos with patients and Santa and even participated in some dancing and photobooth fun.

ROOKIES RISING TO THE CHALLENGE

With one of the youngest squads in the national, California's newcomers have been pushed to step up and contribute major minutes to the lineup. Two freshmen are averaging double figures for the Bears, with Darius McNeill (13.7 points per game) and Justice Sueing (11.8 ppg) averaging above 11.0 points.

McNeill, a Houston, Texas product poured in back-to-back career-high point totals, starting with 18 points against Chaminade and improving to 22 points against CSUN, then topped it four games later with a 30-point outing against CSU Fullerton. McNeill became the 40th player in Cal basketball history to score 30 points in a game. Against the Titans, he also recorded career-high totals for assists (6), steals (5) and rebounds (6). Following his 30-point outing against the Titans, McNeill

added 20 points -- all in the second half -- at Seattle. He's also hit a three-pointer in every game of the season for a 12-game streak, including nine games with multiple three-point makes.

Sueing scored a career-high 23 points against Chaminade, including 19 in the second half, and has scored in double figures in seven games this season. His output comes after missing most of the preseason due to a stress fracture.

Juhwan Harris-Dyson has also stepped up with solid minutes off the bench for the Bears, averaging 4.2 points and 3.4 rebounds. He came up clutch in Cal's 63-62 win at San Diego State, icing a pair of free throws with less than 8 seconds in the game to lift Cal to the win.

BIG KIDS ON THE BLOCK

California's senior big men are among the country's best players on the block, with Kingsley Okoroh and Marcus Lee combining for 59 blocks so far this season. The Bears rank among the Top 20 nationally for total blocks (9th, 73) and blocked shots per game (16th, 6.1 per game).

Okoroh and Lee are both in the top 30 individually for total blocks and blocked shots per game. Lee is averaging 2.50 blocked shots per game, ranked 25th nationally, and is 19th nationally with 30 total blocks. Okoroh has 29 blocks, good for 22nd in the country, and is 28th with 2.42 blocks per game.

The Cal team record for blocked shots in a season is 161 blocks through 33 games in 2013, an average of 4.88 per game. The Bears are currently swatting shots at a pace of 6.1 blocks per game, with 73 total blocks.

CAL IN THE PAC-12 PRESEASON POLL

The Golden Bears were projected to finish 11th in the Pac-12 in 2017-18, according to a preseason vote by media who regularly cover the conference.

Arizona is the favorite to win the conference, followed by USC and UCLA in the top 3. Washington State is predicted to finish behind the Bears at 12th.

Cal's worst finish in the last decade came in 2007-08, when the Bears went 17-16 overall and 6-12 in the Pac-10 to earn 9th place.

OKOROH ON KAREEM ABDUL JABBAR AWARD WATCH LIST

Kingsley Okoroh is on the shortlist of the best collegiate centers in the nation. The Cal big man was named one of 20 players on the 2018 Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Award.

Okoroh enters his senior season following Pac-12 All-Defensive Honorable Mention laurels last year. He logged 74 blocks to become Cal's single-season blocked shots leader. The Derby, England native started 24 contests in 2016-17 – appearing in all 34 games – en route to averaging a career-best in points (4.6) and rebounds (5.5). During his junior season, Okoroh also averaged 2.2 blocks per a game and recorded four or more blocks in six outings, while also setting single-game career-highs with five blocks against Wyoming and 13 rebounds against No. 4 UCLA.

The list will be narrowed down to 10 candidates by mid-February, with five finalists announced in March and the winner crowned in April.

BEARS SIGN TOP 25 CLASS

Head coach Wyking Jones first recruiting class is off to a strong start, signing a consensus Top 30 class, with three outlets listing Cal's 2018 signees as a Top 25 group. Top 100 recruits Jacobi Gordon (Houston, Texas) and Matt Bradley (San Bernardino, Calif.) and three-star California standout Andre Kelly have signed with the

program. 247Sports and Scout gave the Bears the 18th-best class in the country. ESPN ranks the class 22nd. More notes on the class:

- Matt Bradley – 97th in the ESPN 100, four-star shooting guard
- Jacobi Gordon – 89th in the ESPN 100, No. 22 small forward in the country
- Andre Kelly – Stockton Record's reigning All-Area Player of the Year who averaged 24.1 points, 15.2 rpg, 2.7 assists and 1.9 blocks as a junior.

CAL TO OPEN NEXT SEASON IN CHINA

California men's basketball will open the 2017-18 season against Yale in China in the fourth edition of the Pac-12 China Game presented by Alibaba Group. The flagship event of Pac-12 Global is designed to grow the global popularity of Pac-12 athletic programs and universities, fostering cultural exchange through sport, and creating unique educational experiences for Pac-12 student-athletes. In addition to the game, the trip will include educational and cultural experiences for student-athletes and university delegations. Specific date and location information will be announced at a later date.

HAMILTON NAMED TO NABC HONORS COURT

Senior guard Nick Hamilton was recognized for his exemplary work in the classroom this summer, earning NABC Honors Court laurels. The Honors Court recognizes student-athletes who excelled in academics during the 2016-17 season, carrying a 3.2 GPA or higher.

Hamilton boasts a 3.74 cumulative GPA as a double major in legal studies and media studies. The Inglewood, Calif. product saw action in 12 games during the Bears' 2016-17 campaign after recovering from a knee injury during the 2015-16 season.

OKOROH'S OFFSEASON

In preparation for Wyking Jones' style of press, Kingsley Okoroh spent his summer becoming a leaner, more mobile and more conditioned athlete. From June 19 to Aug. 28, Okoroh dropped 14 lbs. of weight, improving his lean body mass from 245.8 to 252 – a gain of 7 lbs. of muscle. His fat measured at 8.4, down from 18.7 in June, including a nearly four percent drop in body fat from 9 percent to 5.1 percent.

Okoroh worked with men's basketball strength and conditioning coach Jordan Jackson, with a primary area of focus in his mobility – including the ability to stay into basketball stances and positions for longer periods of times, and opening up his hips to move better. Ankle strength for the 7-footer was also a focus. Okoroh's conditioning to lean out included utilizing the underwater treadmill at Cal's Simpson High Performance Center to put less pressure on his joints, and participating in low-impact cardio such as intervals on the elliptical. Okoroh, Jackson and team nutritionist Elizabeth McNear also met several times throughout the summer to tighten up Okoroh's diet and nutrition plan.

BEARS HOST "FAMILY DAY OLYMPICS"

With a family atmosphere as an integral part of the foundation for head coach Wyking Jones' team culture, the Bears held a Family Day Olympics to kick off their preseason. Student-athletes, support staff and their families came together at Thousand Oaks Park in Berkeley for a picnic followed by a competitive slate of games, including a three-

NEWELLY-SURFACED

As part of Cal’s transition to Under Armour, the Golden Bears received updated facilities paid for with a bonus from the apparel giant. Along with new signage and decor throughout Haas Pavilion, Pete Newell Court now displays the traditional Cal script logo at center court on the first-grade maple. The old maple wood surface was used for 17 seasons, reaching the end of its functional lifespan. The Sather Stripe makes an appearance on both baselines, as does the new font, again spelling out California and Golden Bears.

NEXT UP

The Pac-12 slate officially begins on Saturday, Dec. 30, when the Golden Bears head to Bay Area rival Stanford for a faceoff at the Farm. Action begins at 7 p.m. from Maples Pavilion and airing live on FS1.

HEAD COACH WYKING JONES

With more than 15 years of collegiate coaching experience, Wyking Jones was introduced as California's head coach on March 24, 2017.

Prior to his tenure as head coach, Jones served as an assistant coach at Cal for two seasons under Cuonzo Martin in 2015-16 and 2016-17.

Charged with coaching Cal's big men, Jones helped forward Ivan Rabb become a two-time All-Pac-12 performer and Jaylen Brown earn All-Pac-12 and Pac-12 Freshman of the Year honors in 2015-16. In addition, center Kingsley Okoroh set a school record with 74 blocks in 2016-17.

In his first season with the Golden Bears, Jones helped steer Cal to the program's first NCAA Tournament bid since 2013 and the program's highest tournament seeding, a No. 4 seed. Cal's defense earned top marks, leading the Pac-12 with just 67.3 points allowed per game and finishing in the top three for rebounding. The Bears went 23-11 and extended their home winning streak to 19 games, dating back to the 2014-2015 season.

The Bears continued their success in 2016-17 by pushing their home winning streak to a program-record 27 games and once again led the league in defense, limiting opponents to 63.4 ppg and 40.0 percent shooting. Cal finished the season with a 21-13 record and earned the top seed in the National Invitation Tournament.

Throughout his career, Jones has also been instrumental in the development of 11 current and former NBA players, including standout Golden Bear Jaylen Brown, plus Terry Rozier, Gorgui Dieng, Montrezl Harrell, Tony Snell, Russ Smith and Peyton Siva.

Jones, a native of Inglewood, Calif., returned to his home state with 12 years of experience as a coach at the collegiate level and was introduced as Martin's assistant on April 23, 2015. He joined the Golden Bears' staff after serving as an assistant coach at Louisville for four seasons. During his time on the Cardinals' coaching staff, UofL's combined record was 123-30. Louisville captured the 2013 NCAA Championship and reached two Final Fours over the past four seasons. The Cardinals completed the 2014-15 season with a 27-9 record, reaching the NCAA Tournament regional final.

Prior to Louisville, Jones served two seasons on the coaching staff at New Mexico where the Lobos won 52 games in two seasons, including a school-record 30-win campaign in 2010. New Mexico finished the 2010 season ranked eighth in the Associated Press national poll.

Jones served as an assistant coach for five seasons from 2002-06 at Pepperdine, where he was the Waves' recruiting coordinator. He got his start in coaching at his alma mater, Loyola Marymount, during the 1996-97 season.

As an assistant coach, Jones boasts one national championship, two Final Four runs, seven NCAA Tournament appearances, an Elite Eight and Sweet 16 run and 10 NBA Draft selections.

He was a standout at LMU from 1991-95 under head coach John Olive, where his 1,076 career points rank 24th all-time in the program's history. Jones also collected 493 career rebounds during his career with the Lions. He was a two-time All-West Coast Conference selection, highlighted by a 19.7 ppg average as a junior. He earned his bachelor's degree in business administration from Loyola Marymount in 1995.

Jones played professional basketball from 1995-2001 in Italy, France, Japan, Lebanon and South Korea. He also served on the staff at Nike Elite Youth Basketball for three years, where he was the Travel Team Manager for more than 45 programs.

Jones and his wife, Estrella, have a son, Jameel and a daughter, Zoe.
