NEED TO KNOW

California heads south looking to snap a two-game losing skid in its first true non-conference road game since 2015. The Golden Bears enter Aztec territory on Saturday, battling it out against San Diego State in Viejas Arena beginning at 2 p.m. The action airs live on CBS Sports Network and on KGO 810 AM.

The Bears dropped their last two home games to Saint Mary's and Central Arkansas and look to get back on track with their first win over the Aztecs in five meetings between the two programs. Cal is winless against San Diego State since a 2007-08 squad featuring starters Ryan Anderson, Patrick Christopher and Jerome Randle defeated the Aztecs 77-69 on Nov. 24. Cal's last win against San Diego State on the road came as a 60-57 victory in the 2004-05 season.

While the Bears have yet to play a true road game this season, Cal has three players averaging in double figures away from Haas Pavilion, led by Don Coleman's 22.3 point average. Justice Sueing averaged 18.0 points and Dairus McNeill averaged 14.7 points in three games at the neutral-site Maui Invitational. The trio are among the four Bears scoring in double figures in all nine games this season, along with 12.3 points from Marcus Lee. The senior forward is one half of Cal's frontcourt duo that ranks among the nation's best shot blockers, as California is the only program in the country with two players ranked inside the top 25 in total blocks. Lee has 23 blocks, and fellow big man Kingsley Okoroh has 25, with Cal ranking in the nation's top 10 in both total blocks (5th, 60) and blocks per game (7th, 6.7) as a team.

BY THE NUMBERS

2015 Saturday's game is California's first true non-conference road game since December 2015. The Aztecs and Bears met last year in a neutral-site contest at Sacramento's Golden 1 Center.

9 Juhwan Harris-Dyson finished just one rebound shy of his first career double-double with a career-best 10-point, 9-rebound performance against Central Arkansas. The frosh is averaging 7.3 points and 5.3 rebounds in three consecutive starts.

48 California is the only program in the country with two players ranked in the Division I Top 25 for blocked shots. Kingsley Okoroh is 16th with 25 blocks and Marcus Lee is 22nd with 23 blocks for a combined total of 48 blocked shots.

6 With two three-pointers against Central Arkansas, Darius McNeill extended his three-point streak to all nine games this season. He has six games with multiple three-point makes.

SCOUTING THE AZTECS

Last Meeting: The Bears fell to the Aztecs, 77-65, on Nov. 21, 2016 at the Golden 1 Center in Sacramento, Calif.

Series Record: San Diego State leads, 7-4

San Diego State's 2017-18 Record: 7-2

San Diego State's Last Game: The Aztecs topped Bradley, 75-52, at home.

- Four Aztecs are scoring in the double figures – Devin Watson (14.7), Trey Kell (13.6), Malik Pope (11.8) and Matt Mitchell (10.7).
- Pope leads with 62 rebounds, averaging 6.9 per game.
- Former Golden Bear Kameron Rooks has started all nine games at center for the Aztecs and is averaging 4.0 points and 5.2 rebounds while shooting 53.3 percent from the field.
- The Aztecs currently own a four-game winning streak over the Bears.
- San Diego State is outscoring opponents 80.8-64.3 through nine games this season.
- The Aztecs are 0-2 against Pac-12 schools this season, falling to Arizona State 90-68 and Washington State 93-86.

LAST TIME OUT

The Bears dropped a second consecutive home game, falling to Central Arkansas 96-69

- Four Bears scored in double figures – Don Coleman (20 points), Marcus Lee (11), Darius McNeill (10) and Juhwan Harris-Dyson (10).
- Harris-Dyson fell one board shy of his first career double-double, matching a career-high 10 points and setting a personal best 9 rebounds.
- Lee matched his season-high four-block total.
- McNeill extended his three-pointer streak to nine games this season, and logged his fifth game with multiple triples after going 2-for-5 from downtown.
- As a team, Cal logged eight blocks for the Bears' sixth-straight game with at least five blocks.
- Central Arkansas scored 35 points off Cal's 21 turnovers.
- Cal shot 82.8 percent (24-29) from the free throw line, with Coleman going 12-13.

BIG KIDS ON THE BLOCK

California's senior big men are among the country's best players on the block, with Kingsley Okoroh and Marcus Lee combining for 48 blocks so far this season.

The Bears rank among the Top 10 nationally for total blocks (5th, 60) and blocked shots per game (7th, 6.7 per game). Okoroh and Lee are both in the top 30 individually for total blocks and blocked shots per game. Okoroh checks in at 16th with 25 total blocks, and 19th with 2.78 per game. Lee is 22nd with 23 total blocks and 26th with an average of 2.56 per game.

ROOKIES RISING TO THE CHALLENGE

With one of the youngest squads in the national, California's newcomers have been pushed to step up and contribute major minutes to the lineup. Two freshmen are averaging double figures for the Bears, with Justice Sueing and Darius McNeill averaging 11.6 points apiece.

McNeill, a Houston, Texas product poured in back-to-back career-high point totals, starting with 18 points against Chaminade and improving to 22 points against CSUN. He's also hit a three-pointer in every game of the season for a nine-game streak, including six games with multiple three-point makes.

Sueing scored a career-high 23 points against Chaminade, including 19 in the second half, and has scored in double figures in five games this season. His output comes after missing most of the preseason due to a stress fracture.

Juhwan Harris-Dyson missed the first two games due to illness, but has seen time in seven games, including starts in the last three. Harris-Dyson is averaging 7.3 points and 5.3 rebounds in his trio of starts. The rookie nearly logged his first career double-double against Central Arkansas, matching a career-high 10 points and setting a personal best 9 rebounds.

BEARS AMONG YOUNGEST IN NATION

After a busy offseason, the Golden Bears boast among one of the youngest squads in the country, ranking among the Top 10 fewest returning starts from 2016-17 (7th, 45), fewest returning letterwinners (1st, 2), fewest minutes played by returnees in 2016-17 (3rd, 1,167) and most scholarship freshmen (5th, 6).

CAL IN THE PAC-12 PRESEASON POLL

The Golden Bears were projected to finish 11th in the Pac-12 in 2017-18, according to a preseason vote by media who regularly cover the conference.

Arizona is the favorite to win the conference, followed by USC and UCLA in the top 3. Washington State is predicted to finish behind the Bears at 12th.

Cal's worst finish in the last decade came in 2007-08, when the Bears went 17-16 overall and 6-12 in the Pac-10 to earn 9th place.

OKOROH ON KAREEM ABDUL JABBAR AWARD WATCH LIST

Kingsley Okoroh is on the shortlist of the best collegiate centers in the nation. The Cal big man was named one of 20 players on the 2018 Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Award.

Okoroh enters his senior season following Pac-12 All-Defensive Honorable Mention laurels last year. He logged 74 blocks to become Cal's single-season blocked shots leader. The Derby, England native started 24 contests in 2016-17 – appearing in all 34 games – en route to averaging a career-best in points (4.6) and rebounds (5.5). During his junior season, Okoroh also averaged 2.2 blocks per a game and recorded four or more blocks in six outings, while also setting single-game career-highs with five blocks against Wyoming and 13 rebounds against No. 4 UCLA.

The list will be narrowed down to 10 candidates by mid-February, with five finalists announced in March and the winner crowned in April.

BEARS SIGN TOP 25 CLASS

Head coach Wyking Jones first recruiting class is off to a strong start, signing a consensus Top 30 class, with three outlets listing Cal's 2018 signees as a Top 25 group. Top 100 recruits Jacobi Gordon (Houston, Texas) and Matt Bradley (San Bernardino, Calif.) and three-star California standout Andre Kelly have signed with the program. 247Sports and Scout gave the Bears the 18th-best class in the country. ESPN ranks the class 22nd. More notes on the class:

- Matt Bradley – 97th in the ESPN 100, four-star shooting guard
- Jacobi Gordon – 89th in the ESPN 100, No. 22 small forward in the country
- Andre Kelly – Stockton Record's reigning All-Area Player of the Year who averaged 24.1 points, 15.2

CAL TO OPEN NEXT SEASON IN CHINA

California men's basketball will open the 2017-18 season against Yale in China in the fourth edition of the Pac-12 China Game presented by Alibaba Group. The flagship event of Pac-12 Global is designed to grow the global popularity of Pac-12 athletic programs and universities, fostering cultural exchange through sport, and creating unique educational experiences for Pac-12 student-athletes. In addition to the game, the trip will include educational and cultural experiences for student-athletes and university delegations. Specific date and location information will be announced at a later date.

HAMILTON NAMED TO NABC HONORS COURT

Senior guard Nick Hamilton was recognized for his exemplary work in the classroom this summer, earning NABC Honors Court laurels. The Honors Court recognizes student-athletes who excelled in academics during the 2016-17 season, carrying a 3.2 GPA or higher.

Hamilton boasts a 3.74 cumulative GPA as a double major in legal studies and media studies. The Inglewood, Calif. product saw action in 12 games during the Bears' 2016-17 campaign after recovering from a knee injury during the 2015-16 season.

OKOROH'S OFFSEASON

In preparation for Wyking Jones' style of press, Kingsley Okoroh spent his summer becoming a leaner, more mobile and more conditioned athlete. From June 19 to Aug. 28, Okoroh dropped 14 lbs. of weight, improving his lean body mass from 245.8 to 252 – a gain of 7 lbs. of muscle. His fat measured at 8.4, down from 18.7 in June, including a nearly four percent drop in body fat from 9 percent to 5.1 percent.

Okoroh worked with men's basketball strength and conditioning coach Jordan Jackson, with a primary area of focus in his mobility – including the ability to stay into basketball stances and positions for longer periods of times, and opening up his hips to move better. Ankle strength for the 7-footer was also a focus. Okoroh's conditioning to lean out included utilizing the underwater treadmill at Cal's Simpson High Performance Center to put less pressure on his joints, and participating in low-impact cardio such as intervals on the elliptical. Okoroh, Jackson and team nutritionist Elizabeth McNear also met several times throughout the summer to tighten up Okoroh's diet and nutrition plan.

BEARS HOST "FAMILY DAY OLYMPICS"

With a family atmosphere as an integral part of the foundation for head coach Wyking Jones' team culture, the Bears held a Family Day Olympics to kick off their preseason. Student-athletes, support staff and their families came together at Thousand Oaks Park in Berkeley for a picnic followed by a competitive slate of games, including a three-legged race, motivational quote unscramble, obstacle course, limbo and more.

NEWELLY-SURFACED

As part of Cal’s transition to Under Armour, the Golden Bears received updated facilities paid for with a bonus from the apparel giant. Along with new signage and decor throughout Haas Pavilion, Pete Newell Court now displays the traditional Cal script logo at center court on the first-grade maple. The old maple wood surface was used for 17 seasons, reaching the end of its functional lifespan. The Sather Stripe makes an appearance on both baselines, as does the new font, again spelling out California and Golden Bears.

The Golden Bears return to Berkeley for their penultimate non-conference home game, set for Saturday, Dec. 16 against Cal State Fullerton. HEAD COACH WYKING JONES

With more than 15 years of collegiate coaching experience, Wyking Jones was introduced as California's head coach on March 24, 2017.

Prior to his tenure as head coach, Jones served as an assistant coach at Cal for two seasons under Cuonzo Martin in 2015-16 and 2016-17.

Charged with coaching Cal's big men, Jones helped forward Ivan Rabb become a two-time All-Pac-12 performer and Jaylen Brown earn All-Pac-12 and Pac-12 Freshman of the Year honors in 2015-16. In addition, center Kingsley Okoroh set a school record with 74 blocks in 2016-17.

In his first season with the Golden Bears, Jones helped steer Cal to the program's first NCAA Tournament bid since 2013 and the program's highest tournament seeding, a No. 4 seed. Cal's defense earned top marks, leading the Pac-12 with just 67.3 points allowed per game and finishing in the top three for rebounding. The Bears went 23-11 and extended their home winning streak to 19 games, dating back to the 2014-2015 season.

The Bears continued their success in 2016-17 by pushing their home winning streak to a program-record 27 games and once again led the league in defense, limiting opponents to 63.4 ppg and 40.0 percent shooting. Cal finished the season with a 21-13 record and earned the top seed in the National Invitation Tournament.

Throughout his career, Jones has also been instrumental in the development of 11 current and former NBA players, including standout Golden Bear Jaylen Brown, plus Terry Rozier, Gorgui Dieng, Montrezl Harrell, Tony Snell, Russ Smith and Peyton Siva.

Jones, a native of Inglewood, Calif., returned to his home state with 12 years of experience as a coach at the collegiate level and was introduced as Martin's assistant on April 23, 2015. He joined the Golden Bears' staff after serving as an assistant coach at Louisville for four seasons. During his time on the Cardinals' coaching staff, UofL's combined record was 123-30. Louisville captured the 2013 NCAA Championship and reached two Final Fours over the past four seasons. The Cardinals completed the 2014-15 season with a 27-9 record, reaching the NCAA Tournament regional final.

Prior to Louisville, Jones served two seasons on the coaching staff at New Mexico where the Lobos won 52 games in two seasons, including a school-record 30-win campaign in 2010. New Mexico finished the 2010 season ranked eighth in the Associated Press national poll.

Jones served as an assistant coach for five seasons from 2002-06 at Pepperdine, where he was the Waves' recruiting coordinator. He got his start in coaching at his alma mater, Loyola Marymount, during the 1996-97 season.

As an assistant coach, Jones boasts one national championship, two Final Four runs, seven NCAA Tournament appearances, an Elite Eight and Sweet 16 run and 10 NBA Draft selections.

He was a standout at LMU from 1991-95 under head coach John Olive, where his 1,076 career points rank 24th all-time in the program's history. Jones also collected 493 career rebounds during his career with the Lions. He was a two-time All-West Coast Conference selection, highlighted by a 19.7 ppg average as a junior. He earned his bachelor's degree in business administration from Loyola Marymount in 1995.

Jones played professional basketball from 1995-2001 in Italy, France, Japan, Lebanon and South Korea. He also served on the staff at Nike Elite Youth Basketball for three years, where he was the Travel Team Manager for more than 45 programs.

Jones and his wife, Estrella, have a son, Jameel and a daughter, Zoe.
