NEED TO KNOW

California men's basketball looks to stretch its road record to a perfect 4-0 when the Golden Bears take on the Washington Huskies on Thursday evening at Alaska Airlines Arena in Seattle, Wash. Tipoff is set for 8 p.m., with the game airing live on Pac-12 Networks and KGO 810 AM.

The Huskies are 2-1 in Pac-12 play and hosting the Bears in their first conference home game of the year. Washington won on the road at USC (88-81) and at Washington State (74-53), but fell to UCLA 74-53 to start conference action. The Bears aim to snap a two-game losing streak after dropping a pair of home games to the LA schools for the first time since 2007.

Cal is a perfect 3-0 in true road games this season. The streak started on Dec. 9 with a 63-62 victory at San Diego State, followed by a decisive 81-59 victory at Seattle on Dec. 19. The 77-74 win on the Farm came as a come-from-behind victory in which the Bears battled back from a 17-point deficit late in the second half.

Justice Sueing and Marcus Lee have emerged as leaders for the Bears through the first three games of conference play, with Sueing averaging 18.3 points per game and Lee shooting 66.7 percent (22-33) over their last three appearances. Don Coleman (11.7 ppg) and Darius McNeill (10.3) are also scoring in double figures in Pac-12 play, while Juhwan Harris-Dyson has turned in back-to-back career-high 10-point games in his last two outings.

BY THE NUMBERS

39 Marcus Lee ranks 39th in the country in field goal percentage after shooting 59.0 percent (82-139) from the floor. He is 22-33 (66.7 percent) in Pac-12 play.

2015 The Golden Bears are 3-0 in true road games this season. Cal's three-game road win streak is its best since 2015, when the Bears won at Washington State, Washington and Colorado between Jan. 29 and Feb. 12.

14.0 Justice Sueing is averaging 14.0 points in the second half of the last three games. In the last three second halves, he scored 14 of 18 total against Stanford, 13 of 15 against USC and 15 of 22 against UCLA.

10.0 Juhwan Harris-Dyson is averaging 10.0 points in his last two outings. The freshman guard has scored a career-high 10 points on four occasions this year, including back-to-back 10-point totals against USC and UCLA.

9 Darius McNeill is 9 three-pointers away from Cal's top-five totals among freshmen. Charlie Moore (2017) is fifth with 45 treys. McNeill currently has 36 triples and has turned in 11 games this season with multiple three-point makes.

LAST TIME OUT

The Golden Bears fell to UCLA, 107-84, in Haas Pavilion

- Marcus Lee posted his fifth double-double of the year, finishing with 19 points and a career-high 15 rebounds. He had a double-double by halftime with 11 points and 11 boards.
- Justice Sueing finished with 22 points, 15 of which came in the second half. The total marked his third game of at least 20 points and one point shy of his career high.
- Along with Lee and Sueing, Don Coleman (16 points), Darius McNeill (12) and Juhwan Harris-Dyson (10) scored in double figures.
- Sueing's four three-pointers marked a career-best total.
- McNeill added three of his own treys on the evening.
- After shooting just 25.6% from the floor in the first half, Cal shot 63.3% after intermission.
- Cal out-rebounded UCLA, 40-35, including 21 offensive boards that led to 22 second-chance points. Lee led the Bears with 11 offensive rebounds.

ROAD WARRIORS

With the Dec. 30 win at Stanford, the Golden Bears are riding a three-game win streak in games away from Haas Pavilion, and are 3-0 in true road games this season. The streak started on Dec. 9 with a 63-62 victory at San Diego State, followed by a decisive 81-59 victory at Seattle on Dec. 19. The 77-74 win on the Farm came as a come-from-behind victory in which the Bears battled back from a 17-point deficit late in the second half.

Cal's three-game road win streak is its best since 2015, when the Bears won at Washington State, Washington and Colorado between Jan. 29 and Feb. 12. The streak ended on Feb. 15, 2015, when Cal fell at No. 11 Utah, 68-61. The Bears have not recorded a four-game winning streak in true road games since the 2002-03 season, when Cal took wins at New Mexico, Cleveland State, Washington and Washington State.

SECOND-HALF SUEING

California freshman Justice Sueing has been superior down the stretch for Cal. In three games of Pac-12 play, the rookie is averaging 14.0 points in the second half of action. In back-to-back games against Stanford and USC, Sueing tallied a combined 13 points in the final minutes. Against the Trojans, he scored five points in the final minute, plus 13 of 15 in the second half. Previously, he turned in eight points in the final three minutes at Stanford, and 14 of his 18 in the game in the second half. In Cal's outing against UCLA, he scored 15 of 22 in the second half.

ROOKIES RISING TO THE CHALLENGE

With one of the youngest squads in the nation, California's newcomers have been pushed to step up and contribute major minutes to the lineup.

Two freshmen are averaging double figures for the Bears, with Darius McNeill (12.9 points per game) and Justice Sueing (12.8 ppg) averaging above 11.0 points.

McNeill, a Houston, Texas product poured in back-to-back career-high point totals, starting with 18 points against Chaminade and improving to 22 points against CSUN, then topped it four games later with a 30-point outing against CSU Fullerton. McNeill became the 40th player in Cal basketball history to score 30 points in a game. Against the Titans, he also recorded career-high totals for assists (6), steals (5) and rebounds (6). Following his 30-point outing against the Titans, McNeill added 20 points – all in the second half – at Seattle. The rookie carried a 12-game

three-pointer streak before it was snapped in Cal's nonconference finale against Portland State. He has 12 games of multiple three-pointers this season.

Sueing was pivotal in Cal's come-from-behind win at Stanford, scoring 14 of his 18 points in the second half with the Bears down 17 points. Over the final three minutes, he scored eight points. Earlier this season, he scored a career-high 23 points against Chaminade, including 19 in the second half, and has scored in double figures in nine games this season while starting all but one game. His output comes after missing most of the preseason due to a stress fracture.

Juhwan Harris-Dyson has also stepped up with solid minutes for the Bears, averaging 5.0 points and 3.0 rebounds. He came up clutch in Cal's 63-62 win at San Diego State, icing a pair of free throws with less than 8 seconds in the game to lift Cal to the win. Harris-Dyson has scored his career-high 10 points four times this season. Like Sueing, Harris-Dyson's output comes despite a weight loss of 20 lbs. early in the season after a bout with the flu.

Rookie Grant Anticevich helped fuel Cal's comeback win at Stanford with a key three-pointer at 1:19 in the second half to help erase the deficit. Anticevich was 1-10 on the season in three-pointers before making the three that brought the game within one point. Anticevich has appeared in every game for the Bears, providing valuable rest for Cal's big men.

BIG KIDS ON THE BLOCK

California's senior big men are among the country's best players on the block, with Kingsley Okoroh and Marcus Lee combining for 73 blocks so far this season. The Bears rank among the Top 20 nationally for total blocks (17th, 91) and blocked shots per game (17th, 5.7).

Individually, Okoroh is 26th in the nation with 38 total blocks, and 27th with 2.38 blocked shots per game. Lee is 35th for his 35 total blocks and 42nd at 2.19 blocks per game.

The 7-1 Okoroh has tied the Cal single-game record for blocked shots twice this season, recording 7 blocks against UC Riverside and against Portland State. He ties the number set by Michael Stewart (1994-97), which Stewart recorded thrice in his Golden Bear career. Okoroh has 173 career blocks, currently ranked third among Cal's career leaders. Stewart ranks second with 207 blocks, and David Kravish (2012-15) leads with 226 career blocked shots.

The Cal team record for blocked shots in a season is 161 blocks through 33 games in 2013, an average of 4.9 per game. The Bears are currently swatting shots at a pace of 5.7 blocks per game, with 91 total blocks.

MARCUS LEE NAMED SENIOR CLASS AWARD CANDIDATE

Marcus Lee is one of 30 student-athletes from men's basketball programs around the country recognized as a candidate for one of the most prestigious awards in college athletics – the Senior CLASS Award. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School®, the Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities.

Lee, a social welfare major, is no stranger to acts of community service, earning All-NCAA Community Service, SEC Community Service and Allstate Good Works Team recognition while he was at Kentucky. At Cal, he is a member of the Student Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC) and Cal's Pac-12 SAAC representative, partnering with 23 Pac-12 student-athletes to change the views on equality empowerment. He has attended numerous community service events in the Bay Area and in Lexington, including serving a pancake breakfast to seniors, spreading holiday cheer at the Children's Hospital Oakland, organizing a blanket drive and visiting children affected by pediatric hospitalization.

From the list of 30 candidates, a committee will select 10 finalists for the Senior CLASS Award in February. Those 10 names will then be placed on the official ballot for a nationwide vote open to media, coaches and fans. The Senior CLASS Award winners will be announced during the 2018 NCAA Men's Final Four.

FAST BREAK

Five Fast Facts on: Juhwan Harris-Dyson

SPIDERFLY

In high school, Harris-Dyson's father, Jeff, coined the nickname Spiderfly after watching his son play.

"My Dad came up with it one night after watching me play," Harris-Dyson explained. "The spider is kind of like my defense trapping, like a fly in its web. The fly part is like the elusiveness of me going on offense, between slashing and attacking the basket."

THINK OF THE HAASIBILITIES

Amid his freshman year at Cal, Harris-Dyson has the Haas School of Business on his radar, and sees the inherent value of a degree in Business.

"I'm still kind of just figuring it out, but Haas is really interesting – just having a business major, especially if you want to play professional basketball," Harris-Dyson shared. "You want to have something like that, so you can be able to negotiate your own contracts and stuff like that."

THE SCENIC ROUTE

Although he's had trouble adjusting to cooler temperatures than near his home in Southern California, Harris-Dyson is enthralled with his new home's scenery and enjoys walking through campus and around Berkeley.

"I just love the feeling, and especially the scenery. The area is really nice. You just walk down the street and you're like, 'Dang!'," he said.

"When you're walking around campus, it's a nice mixture of old buildings and new buildings – and kind of like how the Campanile is set up, if it falls, it will fall down the street – all those cool little fun facts that you find out when you just talk to people around campus," Harris-Dyson added.

KAWHI IS HIS GUY

One of Harris-Dyson's favorite players is San Antonio Spurs star Kawhi Leonard, who he views as a testament to how hard work and dedication pay off.

"I watch a lot of Kawhi Leonard because I like playing defense, and he's a great defensive player," he said. "I like watching his work ethic and how he's developed, and is starting to become an all-around player. He's knocking down shots and becoming a leader, so that's someone I'm setting a goal for myself to become like."

REUNITED

This year, Harris-Dyson was reunited with Deschon Winston, a fellow freshman on the Cal Men's Basketball team, whom he's known for many years and competed against during his senior year of high school.

The pair met during their freshman year of high school, attending the same school for both freshman and sophomore years before each transferred elsewhere. A tournament during their senior year brought the duo back together on the court.

"We were friends until tipoff of that game in high school, and then we were friends once the buzzer sounded," Harris-Dyson said. "We took a picture after we finally got to play against each other after both transferring schools."

CAL IN THE PAC-12 PRESEASON POLL

The Golden Bears were projected to finish 11th in the Pac-12 in 2017-18, according to a preseason vote by media who regularly cover the conference.

Arizona is the favorite to win the conference, followed by USC and UCLA in the top 3. Washington State is predicted to finish behind the Bears at 12th.

Cal's worst finish in the last decade came in 2007-08, when the Bears went 17-16 overall and 6-12 in the Pac-10 to earn 9th place.

OKOROH ON KAREEM ABDUL JABBAR AWARD WATCH LIST

Kingsley Okoroh is on the shortlist of the best collegiate centers in the nation. The Cal big man was named one of 20 players on the 2018 Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Award.

Okoroh enters his senior season following Pac-12 All-Defensive Honorable Mention laurels last year. He logged 74 blocks to become Cal's single-season blocked shots leader. The Derby, England native started 24 contests in 2016-17 – appearing in all 34 games – en route to averaging a career-best in points (4.6) and rebounds (5.5). During his junior season, Okoroh also averaged 2.2 blocks per a game and recorded four or more blocks in six outings, while also setting single-game career-highs with five blocks against Wyoming and 13 rebounds against No. 4 UCLA.

The list will be narrowed down to 10 candidates by mid-February, with five finalists announced in March and the winner crowned in April.

BEARS SIGN TOP 25 CLASS

Head coach Wyking Jones first recruiting class is off to a strong start, signing a consensus Top 30 class, with three outlets listing Cal's 2018 signees as a Top 25 group. Top 100 recruits Jacobi Gordon (Houston, Texas) and Matt Bradley (San Bernardino, Calif.) and three-star California standout Andre Kelly have signed with the program. 247Sports and Scout gave the Bears the 18th-best class in the country. ESPN ranks the class 22nd. More notes on the class:

- Matt Bradley – 97th in the ESPN 100, four-star shooting guard
- Jacobi Gordon – 89th in the ESPN 100, No. 22 small forward in the country
- Andre Kelly – Stockton Record's reigning All-Area Player of the Year who averaged 24.1 points, 15.2 rpg, 2.7 assists and 1.9 blocks as a junior.

CAL TO OPEN NEXT SEASON IN CHINA

California men's basketball will open the 2017-18 season against Yale in China in the fourth edition of the Pac-12 China Game presented by Alibaba Group. The flagship event of Pac-12 Global is designed to grow the global popularity of Pac-12 athletic programs and universities, fostering cultural exchange through sport, and creating unique educational experiences for Pac-12 student-athletes. In addition to the game, the trip will include educational and cultural experiences for student-athletes and university delegations. Specific date and location information will be announced at a later date.

HAMILTON NAMED TO NABC HONORS COURT

Senior guard Nick Hamilton was recognized for his exemplary work in the classroom this summer, earning NABC Honors Court laurels. The Honors Court recognizes student-athletes who excelled in academics during the 2016-17 season, carrying a 3.2 GPA or higher.

Hamilton boasts a 3.74 cumulative GPA as a double major in legal studies and media studies. The Inglewood, Calif. product saw action in 12 games during the Bears' 2016-17 campaign after recovering from a knee injury during the 2015-16 season.

OKOROH'S OFFSEASON

In preparation for Wyking Jones' style of press, Kingsley Okoroh spent his summer becoming a leaner, more mobile and more conditioned athlete. From June 19 to Aug. 28, Okoroh dropped 14 lbs. of weight, improving his lean body mass from 245.8 to 252 – a gain of 7 lbs. of muscle. His fat measured at 8.4, down from 18.7 in June, including a nearly four percent drop in body fat from 9 percent to 5.1 percent.

Okoroh worked with men's basketball strength and conditioning coach Jordan Jackson, with a primary area of focus in his mobility – including the ability to stay into basketball stances and positions for longer periods of times, and opening up his hips to move better. Ankle strength for the 7-footer was also a focus. Okoroh's conditioning to lean out included utilizing the underwater

treadmill at Cal's Simpson High Performance Center to put less pressure on his joints, and participating in low-impact cardio such as intervals on the elliptical. Okoroh, Jackson and team nutritionist Elizabeth McNear also met several times throughout the summer to tighten up Okoroh's diet and nutrition plan.

WORKOUT WAYS

In order to prepare for a new style of offense this year, the Golden Bears were hard at work this offseason adapting to Strength & Conditioning Coach Jordan Jackson's workouts. Along with Olympic style weightlifting and conditioning, the Bears also participated in unique sessions such as hot yoga, conditioning on the campus beach volleyball courts and running the California Memorial Stadium steps.

HEAD COACH WYKING JONES

With more than 15 years of collegiate coaching experience, Wyking Jones was introduced as California's head coach on March 24, 2017.

Prior to his tenure as head coach, Jones served as an assistant coach at Cal for two seasons under Cuonzo Martin in 2015-16 and 2016-17.

Charged with coaching Cal's big men, Jones helped forward Ivan Rabb become a two-time All-Pac-12 performer and Jaylen Brown earn All-Pac-12 and Pac-12 Freshman of the Year honors in 2015-16. In addition, center Kingsley Okoroh set a school record with 74 blocks in 2016-17.

In his first season with the Golden Bears, Jones helped steer Cal to the program's first NCAA Tournament bid since 2013 and the program's highest tournament seeding, a No. 4 seed. Cal's defense earned top marks, leading the Pac-12 with just 67.3 points allowed per game and finishing in the top three for rebounding. The Bears went 23-11 and extended their home winning streak to 19 games, dating back to the 2014-2015 season.

The Bears continued their success in 2016-17 by pushing their home winning streak to a program-record 27 games and once again led the league in defense, limiting opponents to 63.4 ppg and 40.0 percent shooting. Cal finished the season with a 21-13 record and earned the top seed in the National Invitation Tournament.

Throughout his career, Jones has also been instrumental in the development of 11 current and former NBA players, including standout Golden Bear Jaylen Brown, plus Terry Rozier, Gorgui Dieng, Montrezl Harrell, Tony Snell, Russ Smith and Peyton Siva.

Jones, a native of Inglewood, Calif., returned to his home state with 12 years of experience as a coach at the collegiate level and was introduced as Martin's assistant on April 23, 2015. He joined the Golden Bears' staff after serving as an assistant coach at Louisville for four seasons. During his time on the Cardinals' coaching staff, UofL's combined record was 123-30. Louisville captured the 2013 NCAA Championship and reached two Final Fours over the past four seasons. The Cardinals completed the 2014-15 season with a 27-9 record, reaching the NCAA Tournament regional final.

Prior to Louisville, Jones served two seasons on the coaching staff at New Mexico where the Lobos won 52 games in two seasons, including a school-record 30-win campaign in 2010. New Mexico finished the 2010 season ranked eighth in the Associated Press national poll.

Jones served as an assistant coach for five seasons from 2002-06 at Pepperdine, where he was the Waves' recruiting coordinator. He got his start in coaching at his alma mater, Loyola Marymount, during the 1996-97 season.

As an assistant coach, Jones boasts one national championship, two Final Four runs, seven NCAA Tournament appearances, an Elite Eight and Sweet 16 run and 10 NBA Draft selections.

He was a standout at LMU from 1991-95 under head coach John Olive, where his 1,076 career points rank 24th all-time in the program's history. Jones also collected 493 career rebounds during his career with the Lions. He was a two-time All-West Coast Conference selection, highlighted by a 19.7 ppg average as a junior. He earned his bachelor's degree in business administration from Loyola Marymount in 1995.

Jones played professional basketball from 1995-2001 in Italy, France, Japan, Lebanon and South Korea. He also served on the staff at Nike Elite Youth Basketball for three years, where he was the Travel Team Manager for more than 45 programs.

Jones and his wife, Estrella, have a son, Jameel and a daughter, Zoe.
