BEAR NECESSITIES

• CAL TRAVELS TO PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIPS

The championship season gets underway this week with the Pac-12 Championships set for Wednesday through Saturday in Federal Way, Washington. Prelims begin at 10:30 a.m. with finals starting at 6 p.m. each day, except for Wednesday when only finals will be contested.

All sessions through Saturday afternoon will be streamed live on Pac-12.com and the Pac-12 Now app. In addition, Saturday night's finals will air live on Pac-12 Networks with Rich Burk, Amy Van Dyken and Cynthia Potter calling the action.

Cal, ranked second in the final CSCAA regular-season poll, enters the meet leading the conference in nine events - five individual and four relays. Sophomore Abbey Weitzeil tops the charts in both the 50 free (21.44) and 100 free (46.95), while Kathleen Baker is first in the 100 back (50.62) and 200 IM (1:53.24) and Amy Bilquist leads the pack in the 200 back (1:50.58). The Golden Bears also have the conference's fastest times in the 200 free relay, 400 free relay, 800 free relay and 200 medley relay.

• 18 SWIMS AMONG NCAA'S TOP 16

Cal enters this week's meet with 18 swims - 13 individual and five relays - that rank among the top 16 in the country. Amy Bilquist leads the squad with appearances in four events.

• EYES ON THE NCAA PRIZE

The Bears earned only one Pac-12 event title last February - Kathleen Baker in the 200 back - but they came back three weeks later to win six NCAA crowns, including three by Baker (100 and 200 back, 200 IM), who was named the CSCAA Swimmer of the Year. In addition, since-graduated Farida Osman finished first in the 100 fly, and Cal won the 200 free relay and 200 medley relay.

• CSCAA SCHOLAR ALL-AMERICAN TEAM

With an impressive 3.51 GPA for the fall 2017 semester, Cal has been named a Scholar All-American team by the CSCAA. In fact, the Bears have been honored 16 semesters in a row - every time the award has been offered by the coaches' association.

• WEITZEIL HONORED BY PAC-12 TWICE THIS SEASON

Sophomore Abbey Weitzeil has been posting top times all season and the Pac-12 has recognized her twice for her efforts. First, she was tabbed the Pac-12 Swimmer of the Month for December after attaining NCAA "A" qualifying standards with victories in both the 50 and 100 free at the Georgia Invitational. She then claimed Pac-12 Swimmer of the Week honors Feb. 14 for her results at Stanford - a pool and Cal dual-meet record in the 50 free and a pool and Cal dual-meet record in the 200 free relay.

• BRIANA THAI EARNS PAC-12 DIVER OF THE WEEK RECOGNITION

Freshman Briana Thai has made a big impact on the boards for the Bears this season, moving into Cal's all-time top 10 with her scores on 1-meter, 3-meter and platform. The Pac-12 named her its Diver of the Week Jan. 31 after she won three of four competitions in meets at USC and UCLA, helping Cal to its first sweep in Los Angeles since 2012.

• CAL CELEBRATES 25 YEARS WITH McKEEVER

Following Cal's dual meet against North Carolina State Nov. 4, more than 200 people, including dozens of alumnae and their families, remained at Legends Aquatic Center for a special ceremony celebrating Teri McKeever's 25 years as the Bears' head coach. Chancellor Carol Christ and Director of Athletics Mike Williams were among the speakers, along with current swimmers, a former assistant coach and a pair of alums. Before the crowd heard from McKeever, Michael Go announced the formation of the Teri McKeever Swimming Scholarship, which will be awarded to a deserving student-athlete beginning next year. McKeever, now in her 26th season at the helm, has guided Cal to four NCAA team titles and served as head U.S. Olympic coach at the 2012 Games in London.

• SUPER SUMMER FOR KATHLEEN BAKER

Cal junior Kathleen Baker shined on the international stage once again during the FINA World Championships in Budapest over the summer. One year after winning two medals at the 2016 Olympics, Baker added three more medals to her collection with silver in the 100-meter back, bronze in the 200-meter back and gold on the world-record-setting 400-meter medley relay. In addition, she placed fifth in the 50-meter back final after setting an American record in the event during the semifinals.

• SUMMER SWIMS AROUND THE GLOBE

A number of Golden Bears kept busy over the summer representing their respective national teams in competition. Kathleen Baker's results are noted above, but she wasn't the only Cal swimmer at the World Championships. Robin Neumann (Netherlands) was also in Budapest, while recent Cal grad Farida Osman (Egypt) claimed a bronze medal in the 50m fly. At the World University Games in Taipei, Katie McLaughlin (USA) earned three relay medals and reached the finals in the 50m and 100m fly, and Sarah Darcel (Canada) finaled in both the 200m IM and 400m IM. Finally, senior Maija Roses (USA) claimed gold medals in the 100m and 200m breast and on the 4x100m medley relay at the Maccabiah Games in Israel.

• BEARS HELP PAC-12 DEFEAT TEAM USA

With five Bears on the roster, the Pac-12 defeated the U.S. National team at the USA College Challenge Oct. 21-22, 326.5-286.5. Kathleen Baker captured two outright titles - the 100-yard back (50.62) and the 200-yard back (1:50.62) - and tied for first in the 200-yard IM (1:53.24), with all three times ranking as the fastest in the nation at the time. Abbey Weitzel won the 50 free in 21.63, in addition to anchoring two relays to victory. Katie McLaughlin, Maddie Murphy and Robin Neumann also represented Cal at the meet.

• BEARS SWIM FAST AT GEORGIA INVITE

The Bears came home with 10 event victories and eight swims under the NCAA "A" qualifying standard at the Georgia Fall Invitational in early December. Abbey Weitzel posted the top time in the country at the time in winning the 50 free in 21.44, while her first-place time of 46.95 in the 100 free ranks No. 2 in Cal history and the fastest ever in a 100 free race (Missy Franklin's 46.66 came leading off a relay in 2015). Other individuals to reach the top of the podium were freshman Sarah Darcel in the 400 IM (4:06.58), senior Noemie Thomas in both the 100 fly (50.77) and 200 fly (1:54.12), and junior Amy Bilquist in the 200 back (1:50.48). In addition, four Golden Bear relays touched the wall in first - 200 free relay (1:27.10), 400 medley relay (3:30.45), 200 medley relay (1:35.04) and 400 free relay (3:10.95).

• 9 IN A ROW AMONG NCAA TOP 3

Cal has finished among the top three at the NCAA Championships nine years in a row - the longest current streak in the country. Included in the run are four national titles, coming in 2009, 2011, 2012 and 2015. The Bears were also second in 2013 and 2017, and third in 2010, 2014 and 2016.

Elizabeth Bailey – Fly/IM, Freshman, Atlanta, Ga. (undeclared major)

- Has posted best times of 55.58 in the 100 fly, 2:01.12 in the 200 fly and 4:21.46 in the 400 IM as a freshman
- Competed in the 100m fly at the 2016 Olympic Trials

Kathleen Baker – Back/IM, Junior, Winston-Salem, N.C. (interdisciplinary studies major with emphasis in health and illness)

- NCAA A cut: 100 back (50.62), 200 back (1:50.62), 200 IM (1:53.24); NCAA B cut: 100 fly (54.21)
- Won the 200 back at the 2017 Pac-12 Championships in a meet-record 1:48.33, giving Cal a victory in the event for the fifth year in a row (Elizabeth Pelton 2013-14; Missy Franklin 2015; Amy Bilquist 2016)
- Named the CSCAA National Swimmer of the Year in 2017 after winning three outright NCAA titles – 100 back, 200 back and 200 IM
- Earned three medals at the 2017 FINA World Championships – silver in the 100m back, bronze in the 200m back and gold on the 400m medley relay; also set an American record in the 50m back
- Owns the Cal record in the 100 back (49.80) after breaking Natalie Coughlin's school mark at 2017 NCAA's; also the school record-holder in the 200 IM (1:51.69) and third all-time at Cal in the 200 back (1:48.33)

Amy Bilquist – Free/Back, Junior, Carmel, Ind. (media studies major)

- NCAA A cut: 200 back (1:50.48); NCAA B cut: 50 free (21.99), 100 free (47.94), 200 free (1:44.95), 100 back (51.62)
- The 2016 Pac-12 champion in the 200 back as a freshman
- Ranks among the NCAA's top 16 in four different events - 50 and 100 free, 100 and 200 back
- Rates among Cal's all-time top 10 in the 50 free (6th, 21.94, 2017), 100 free (8th, 47.55, 2017), 100 back (5th, 50.50, 2017) and 200 back (5th, 1:49.90, 2016)
- Member of Cal's 2017 NCAA title team in the 200 free relay and scored individually in both the 100 back (9th) and 200 back (14th)

Keaton Blovad – Back/IM, Sophomore, Lake Oswego, Ore. (undeclared major)

- NCAA B cut: 100 free (48.99), 200 free (1:46.87), 100 back (52.39), 200 back (1:55.31); 200 IM (1:57.08)
- Competed in three events at the 2017 NCAA meet - 100 back (36th), 200 back (41st) and 200 IM (55th)
- As a freshman last year, reached the Pac-12 final in the 100 back (6th), 200 back (8th) and 200 IM (8th)

Alexa Buckley – Breast/IM, Sophomore, Mountainside, N.J. (undeclared major)

- Owns best times this season of 1:04.47 in the 100 breast and 2:17.83 in the 200 breast
- Scored for the Bears in the 100 breast at last year's Pac-12 meet, taking 21st in the 100 breast

Alexa Cacao – Diving, Junior, Milpitas, Calif. (American studies major)

- NCAA Zone E cut: 1-meter (274.95)
- A transfer from USC before her sophomore year at Cal, she scored on all three events at the 2017 Pac-12 meet - 21st on 1-meter, 20th on 3-meter and 19th on platform

Jenna Campbell – Free/Fly, Junior, Palo Alto, Calif. (neurobiology major)

- Scored for the Bears in the 200 free at last year's Pac-12 meet (23rd), while she was 23rd in the 200 fly as a freshman
- Owns 2018 best times of 1:49.32 in the 200 free, 4:51.80 in the 500 free and 2:02.02 in the 200 fly - all from the Georgia Invite

Sarah Darcel – IM, Freshman, Grande Cache, Alberta (undeclared major)

- NCAA B cut: 200 breast (2:14.91), 200 fly (1:57.35), 200 IM (1:56.69), 400 IM 4:06.58)
- Ranks fourth in school history with her time of 4:06.58 in the 400 IM, while she is ninth all-time in the 200 IM (1:56.69)
- Represented Canada at the 2017 World University Games in Taipei, placing fourth in the 400m IM, fifth in the 200m IM and reaching the semifinals of the 200m breast and 200m fly

Chenoa Devine – Free/IM, Sophomore, Davis, Calif. (undeclared major)

- NCAA B cut: 500 free (4:42.63), 1650 free (16:25.27), 400 IM (4:15.98)
- Ranks third all-time at Cal in the 1650 free with a best of 16:04.34 from the 2017 NCAA meet (19th place)
- Also competed in the 500 free (41st) and 400 IM (37th) at last year's NCAA's
- Captured the B final of the 500 free at the 2017 Pac-12 Championships, and was 12th in the 400 IM and fifth in the 1650 free

Dannie Dilsaver – Breast/IM, Freshman, Lincoln, Neb. (undeclared major)

- NCAA B cut: 100 breast (1:01.89), 200 breast (2:14.02), 200 IM (1:58.59); 400 IM (4:12.46)
- Ranks third on the squad in both breaststroke events this season, while she is fourth in the 200 IM

Maggie Gallagher – Diving, Freshman, Coto de Caza, Calif. (undeclared major)

- A redshirt-freshman whose older sister, Sammy, is a senior diver at Stanford

Ali Harrison – Breast, Freshman, Ventura, Calif. (undeclared major)

- NCAA B cut: 100 breast (1:00.54), 200 breast (2:10.92), 100 fly (53.32), 200 IM (2:00.84)
- Leads the Bears in the breast events and her times put her seventh in the 100 breast and fifth in the 200 breast in school history

Valerie Hull – Free, Senior, San Diego, Calif. (sociology major)

- NCAA B cut: 50 free (22.51), 100 free (49.06)
- A member of Cal's NCAA championship 200 free relay and 200 medley relay last year, swimming in the prelims
- Placed 13th in the 50 free at the 2017 Pac-12 meet

Jackie Im – Diving, Freshman, San Diego, Calif. (undeclared major)

- NCAA Zone E cut: 1-meter (276.53)
- Has posted Cal's third-best score of the season on 1-meter, which puts her ninth in school history in the event

Sophie Krivokapic-Zhou – Back/Fly, Freshman, Santa Clara, Calif. (undeclared major)

- NCAA B cut: 100 back (53.84), 200 back (1:57.87), 200 fly (1:58.96)
- Ranks fourth on the squad in the 100 and 200 back and 200 fly

Phoebe LaMay – Diving, Junior, Houston, Texas (media studies major)

- NCAA Zone E cut: 1-meter (315.45), 3-meter (323.78)
- An NCAA qualifier last season who owns Cal records on 1-meter (317.63) and 3-meter (335.80)
- At the 2017 Pac-12 meet, placed fifth on 1-meter, 13th on 3-meter and sixth on platform

Aislinn Light – Free/Back, Sophomore, Irvine, Calif. (undeclared major)

- NCAA B cut: 100 back (54.25), 200 back (1:58.52)
- Scored for the Bears in the 100 back (18th) and 200 back (20th) at the 2017 Pac-12 meet

Jasmine Mau – Fly/Free/Back, Senior, Honolulu, Hawaii (sociology major)

- NCAA B cut: 50 free (22.97)
- Ranks 10th all-time at Cal in the 200 fly with a best of 1:54.85 from her freshman season
- Reached the B finals of the 100 fly (13th) and 200 fly (11th) at the 2015 NCAA meet

Katie McLaughlin – Fly/Free, Junior, Dana Point, Calif. (American studies major)

- NCAA B cut: 50 free (22.90), 100 free (49.75), 200 free (1:44.92), 500 free (4:39.45), 100 fly (51.78), 200 fly (1:55.03)
- The 2017 NCAA runner-up in the 200 fly with her time of 1:52.37 ranking No. 2 in school history; also placed ninth in the 200 free
- At the 2017 Pac-12 meet, took third in the 500 free, fourth in the 200 free and third in the 200 fly
- Competed in six events at the World University Games last summer, earning two silver medals and a bronze on relays

Maddie Murphy – Free/Fly, Sophomore, Orinda, Calif. (undeclared major)

- NCAA B cut: 50 free (22.35), 100 free (49.25), 100 fly (52.03)
- In Cal's all-time top 10, ranks fourth in the 50 free (21.76) and sixth in the 100 fly (51.15)
- Finished sixth in the 50 free and 10th in the 100 fly, while helping the 200 free relay to a national championship at 2017 NCAA's
- At the 2017 Pac-12 meet, won the B final of the 50 free and 100 free and was fifth in the 100 fly

Courtney Mykkanen – Back/IM, Sophomore, Tustin, Calif. (undeclared major)

- NCAA B cut: 200 back (1:59.06)
- Scored for the Bears at the 2017 Pac-12 meet in the 400 IM (13th), 100 back (16th) and 200 back (11th)
- Father, John, was a distance freestyler for the Bears and earned an Olympic silver medal in the 400m free in 1984

Kathleen Navas – Diving, Freshman, San Jose, Calif. (undeclared major)

- NCAA Zone E cut: Platform (239.60)
- Ranks second on the squad in the platform this season and her score puts her No. 7 on Cal's all-time list

Robin Neumann – Free, Freshman, Amsterdam, the Netherlands (undeclared major)

- NCAA B cut: 100 free (49.20), 200 free (1:45.33), 500 free (4:43.50), 200 back (1:58.86)
- A 2016 Olympian for the Netherlands, competing in the 200m free (26th) and on the 800m free relay (13th)

Maija Roses – Breast, Senior, Durham, N.C. (media studies major)

- NCAA B cut: 200 breast (2:14.02)
- Placed 10th in both breaststroke events at last year's Pac-12 meet
- Ranks eighth in Cal history in both breaststrokes, with bests of 1:00.78 in the 100 and 2:11.75 in the 200

Alexa Skorus-Neely – Breast/IM, Freshman, Canyon Country, Calif. (undeclared major)

- Has posted best times of 1:04.47 in the 100 breast and 2:18.63 in the 200 breast, both at the Georgia Invitational

Briana Thai – Diving, Freshman, Alhambra, Calif. (undeclared major)

- NCAA Zone E cut: 1-meter (296.33), 3-meter (312.50), Platform (256.60)
