BEAR NECESSITIES

• CAL PREPARED FOR NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS

With a squad comprised of 11 swimmers and one diver, Cal travels to the NCAA Championships this week in Columbus, Ohio, looking to extend its streak of top 3 national finishes to 10 years in a row.

The Golden Bears are coming off a strong showing at the Pac-12 Championships where they won four of the five relays - each in an NCAA-leading time - and junior Kathleen Baker captured both the 200-yard back and 200-yard individual medley.

Cal also earned six victories at last year's NCAA meet, including three by Baker (100 and 200 back, 200 IM), who was named the CSCAA Swimmer of the Meet. In addition, the Bears claimed wins in the 200 free relay and 200 medley relay, and the since-graduated Farida Osman won the 100 fly.

Cal, ranked second in the final CSCAA regular-season poll, enters the meet with 20 swims rated among the top 16 in the country and is atop the list in five events - 200, 400 and 800 free relay, 200 medley relay, and Baker's 1:48.27 in the 200 back.

• HOW TO FOLLOW THE NCAA MEET

ESPNU will broadcast the championship finals session Friday starting at 5 p.m. ET, and the finals session on Saturday will either be streamed live by ESPN3 or by live linear broadcast on ESPNU starting at 6 p.m. ET. All sessions not broadcast by either ESPNU or ESPN3 will be streamed at calbea.rs/2oRxCTR.

• 9 IN A ROW AMONG NCAA TOP 3

Cal has finished among the top three at the NCAA Championships nine years in a row - the longest current streak in the country. Included in the run are four national titles, coming in 2009, 2011, 2012 and 2015. The Bears were also second in 2013 and 2017, and third in 2010, 2014 and 2016.

• NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP EXPERIENCE

Of the 12 Golden Bears traveling to Columbus for the NCAA Championships, nine are making repeat appearances and six have won a national title either individually or on a relay. The most decorated is Kathleen Baker, who won the 100 and 200 back and 200 IM last year, in addition to being on the winning 200 medley relay. Amy Bilquist, Maddie Murphy and Noemie Thomas all have two relay crowns on their resumes.

• ADDING UP THE TITLES

Not only have the Golden Bears captured four team national titles in 25 seasons under head coach Teri McKeever, but Cal has also secured 55 event wins at the NCAA Championships during her tenure - 37 individual races and 18 relays. At total of 32 of those victories have come since 2011 with the Bears claiming at least five national crowns in 2011, 2012, 2015 and 2017. Last year, the Bears had six event wins - Kathleen Baker (100 back, 200 back 200 IM), Farida Osman (100 fly), the 200 free relay and the 200 medley relay.

• CAL TOPS IN RELAYS

Following its performance at the Pac-12 Championships, Cal enters the NCAA meet leading the country in four relays and ranks second nationally in the other. The Bears won the first three relays at the conference meet - 200 medley relay (1:34.13), 800 free relay (6:52.62) and 200 free relay (1:25.87). Both 200 relay times rank as the second fastest in school history, while the 800 free relay comes in at No. 4. Cal also closed out the championships with a school-record victory in the 400 free relay (3:09.04). And while the Bears were second to Stanford in the 400 medley relay, their time of 3:25.50 is the

second fastest in history and broke the school record by more than 2.5 seconds.

• WEITZEIL BREAKS CAL MARK IN 100 FREE

Sophomore Abbey Weitzeil lowered the Cal record in the 100 free when she swam the distance in 46.63 during a runner-up finish in the Pac-12 Championships final. Her time broke the mark of 46.66 set by Missy Franklin in 2015, which she set leading off the Bears' 400 free relay at the NCAA meet.

• BEARS SECOND AT PAC-12 MEET

Cal finished second in the team standings at the Pac-12 Championships in late February, posting six event wins and five runner-up performances. The Bears set three school records - Abbey Weitzeil in the 100 free (46.63), 400 free relay (3:09.04) and 400 medley relay (3:25.50) - while Kathleen Baker established a meet record with a PR 1:48.27 in the 200 back. Overall, Cal had 17 finals swims that were below the NCAA A qualifying standard.

• AN AMERICAN RECORD IN 200 FREE RELAY

When Cal captured the 200 free relay title at the Pac-12 Championships, the Bears did so with an American record that, oddly enough, was a tad slower than the school record. At the Pac-12 meet last month, Maddie Murphy, Amy Bilquist, Katie McLaughlin and Abbey Weitzeil touched in 1:25.87. The Cal record, though, is 1:25.59 from last year's NCAA meet when the team of Weitzeil, Murphy, Bilquist and Farida Osman won the national title. Because Osman is an Egyptian, the time was not an American record.

• 20 SWIMS AMONG NCAA'S TOP 16

Cal enters this week's meet with 20 swims - 15 individuals and five relays - that rank among the top 16 in the country. Kathleen Baker and Amy Bilquist appear in three different events,

while the Bears have the most swimmers in the 50 free top 16 with Abbey Weitzeil, Bilquist and Maddie Murphy.

• CSCAA SCHOLAR ALL-AMERICAN TEAM

With an impressive 3.51 GPA for the fall 2017 semester, Cal has been named a Scholar All-American team by the CSCAA. In fact, the Bears have been honored 16 semesters in a row - every time the award has been presented.

• WEITZEIL HONORED TWICE BY PAC-12

Sophomore Abbey Weitzeil has been posting top times all season and the Pac-12 has recognized her twice for her efforts. First, she was tabbed the Pac-12 Swimmer of the Month for December after attaining NCAA "A" qualifying standards with victories in both the 50 and 100 free at the Georgia Invitational. She then claimed Pac-12 Swimmer of the

Week honors Feb. 14 for her results at Stanford - a pool and Cal dual-meet record in the 50 free and a pool and Cal dual-meet record in the 200 free relay.

• THAI PAC-12 DIVER OF THE WEEK

Freshman Briana Thai has made a big impact on the boards this season, moving into Cal's all-time top 10 with her scores on 1-meter, 3-meter and platform. The Pac-12 named her its Diver of the Week Jan. 31 after she won three of four competitions in meets at USC and UCLA, helping Cal to its first sweep in Los Angeles since 2012.

• CELEBRATING 25 YEARS WITH McKEEVER

Following Cal's dual meet against North Carolina State Nov. 4, more than 200 people, including dozens of alumnae and their families, remained at Legends Aquatic Center for a special ceremony celebrating Teri McKeever's 25 years as the Bears' head coach. Chancellor Carol Christ and Director of Athletics Mike Williams were among the speakers, along with current swimmers, a former assistant coach and a pair of alums. Before the crowd heard from McKeever, Michael Go announced the formation of the Teri McKeever Swimming Scholarship, which will be awarded to a deserving student-athlete beginning next year. McKeever, now in her 26th season at the helm, has guided Cal to four NCAA team titles and served as head U.S. Olympic coach at the 2012 Games in London.

• SUPER SUMMER FOR KATHLEEN BAKER

Cal junior Kathleen Baker shined on the international stage once again during the FINA World Championships in Budapest over the summer. One year after winning two medals at the 2016 Olympics, Baker added three more medals to her collection with silver in the 100-meter back, bronze in the 200-meter back and gold on the world-record-setting 400-meter medley relay. In addition, she placed fifth in the 50-meter back final after setting an American record in the event during the semifinals.

• SUMMER SWIMS AROUND THE GLOBE

In addition to Kathleen Baker, several other Golden Bears swam on the international stage over the summer. At the World Championships, Robin Neumann competed for the Netherlands, while recent Cal grad Farida Osman (Egypt) claimed a bronze medal in the 50m fly. At the World University Games in Taipei, Katie McLaughlin (USA) earned three relay medals and reached the finals in the 50m and 100m fly, and Sarah Darcel (Canada) finaled in both the 200m IM and 400m IM. Finally, senior Maija Roses (USA) claimed gold medals in the 100m and 200m breast and on the 4x100m medley relay at the Maccabiah Games in Israel.

Kathleen Baker – Back/IM, Junior, Winston-Salem, N.C.

- Top 2017-18 Times: 100 back - 50.13; 200 back - 1:48.27; 200 IM - 1:52.70
- Captured both the 200 back and 200 IM, as well as finished second in the 100 back, at the Pac-12 Championships - all in season-best times
- The Pac-12 200 back champion for the second straight year, giving Cal a win in the event six years in a row
- Enters the NCAA meet leading the nation in the 200 back and ranks second in the 200 IM and 100 back
- Named the CSCAA National Swimmer of the Year in 2017 after winning three outright NCAA titles – 100 back, 200 back and 200 IM - and being part of the winning 200 medley relay
- Earned three medals at the 2017 FINA World Championships – silver in the 100m back, bronze in the 200m back and gold on the 400m medley relay; also set an American record in the 50m back
- Owns the Cal record in the 100 back (49.80) after breaking Natalie Coughlin's school mark at 2017 NCAA's; also the school record-holder in the 200 IM (1:51.69) and third all-time at Cal in the 200 back (1:48.27)
- Interdisciplinary Studies major with an emphasis in health and illness

Amy Bilquist – Free/Back, Junior, Carmel, Ind.

- Top 2017-18 Times: 50 free - 21.74; 100 free - 47.79; 200 free - 1:44.95; 100 back - 51.28; 200 back - 1:50.23
- Enters the NCAA meet ranked among the national leaders in the 50 free (8th), 100 back (11th) and 200 back (7th)
- At the 2018 Pac-12 meet, swam anchor on the winning 200 medley relay and 800 free relay and was a part of the winning 200 free relay and 400 free relay
- Individually, finished 3rd in the 50 free, 3rd in the 100 back and 4th in the 200 back
- The 2016 Pac-12 champion in the 200 back as a freshman
- Rates among Cal's all-time top 10 in the 50 free (4th, 21.74), 100 free (8th, 47.55), 100 back (5th, 50.50) and 200 back (5th, 1:49.90)
- Member of Cal's 2017 NCAA title team in the 200 free relay and scored individually in both the 100 back (9th) and 200 back (14th)

Keaton Blovad – Back/IM, Sophomore, Lake Oswego, Ore.

- Top 2017-18 times: 100 back - 51.83; 200 back - 1:53.31; 200 IM - 1:55.72
- All three times are PRs from the 2018 Pac-12 meet where she finished 4th in the 100 back, 7th in the 200 back and 6th in the 200 IM
- Her 200 back time puts her 10th in school history in the event, while she is eighth all-time in the 200 IM
- Competed in three events at the 2017 NCAA meet - 100 back (36th), 200 back (41st) and 200 IM (55th)
- Undeclared major

Sarah Darcel – IM, Freshman, Grande Cache, Alberta

- Top 2017-18 times: 200 IM - 1:54.50; 400 IM - 4:03.00
- Showed big improvement in both IMs at the 2018 Pac-12 Championships, finishing as a runner-up to teammate Kathleen Baker in the 200 IM and taking 4th in the 400 IM; also won the B final of the 200 fly
- Ranks sixth in school history in the 200 IM and second behind Caitlin Leverenz in the 400 IM
- Represented Canada at the 2017 World University Games in Taipei, placing fourth in the 400m IM, fifth in the 200m IM and reaching the semifinals of the 200m breast and 200m fly
- Undeclared major

Ali Harrison – Breast, Freshman, Ventura, Calif.

- Top 2017-18 times: 100 breast - 59.52; 200 breast - 2:10.56
- Leads the Bears in both breaststroke events, with her times putting her third all-time in the 100 breast and fourth in the 200 breast in school history
- At the 2018 Pac-12 meet, placed fifth in the 100 breast and sixth in the 200 breast

Katie McLaughlin – Fly/Free, Junior, Dana Point, Calif.

- Top 2017-18 times: 200 free - 1:44.42; 500 free - 4:39.45; 100 fly - 51.17; 200 fly - 1:54.97
- The 2017 NCAA runner-up in the 200 fly with her time of 1:52.37 ranking No. 2 in school history; also placed ninth in the 200 free at last year's meet
- In addition to the 200 fly, ranks ninth in school history in the 200 free (1:43.17 from 2017), third in the 500 free (4:36.04 from 2017) and seventh in the 200 fly

- A two-time finalist in the 100 fly at the NCAA Championships with a best of fifth last year; also a member of the 2015 and 2017 national champion 200 medley relays
- Won the Pac-12 title in the 200 fly as a freshman
- Ranks third in Cal history in the 100 fly (best of 50.44) and sixth all-time in the 200 fly (1:53.77)
- Competed for Canada at the 2016 Olympics in the 100m fly (18th) and on the 400m medley relay
- Psychology major

Abbey Weitzel – Free, Sophomore, Saugus, Calif.

- Top 2017-18 times: 50 free - 21.41; 100 free - 46.63; 200 free - 1:44.41; 100 breast - 1:00.98
- Named Pac-12 Swimmer of the Month for December for her performance at the Georgia Invite, and later named Pac-12 Swimmer of the Week after setting a Cal dual-meet record in the 50 free at Stanford
- Set the Cal record in the 100 free during a runner-up finish at the 2018 Pac-12 meet (46.63), breaking the mark of 46.66 by Missy Franklin in 2015
- Also finished second in the 50 free at Pac-12s, as well as seventh in the 200 free; was a member of Cal's winning 200 free relay, 400 free relay and 200 medley relay (breast leg) and anchored Cal's 400 medley relay to a school-record (3:25.50)
- Ranks second all-time at Cal in the 50 free (21.40 from 2017)
- At the 2017 NCAA meet, finished fifth in the 50 free, eighth in the 100 free and was a part of the winning 200 free relay and 200 medley relay
- A 2016 U.S. Olympian, winning medals on the 400m free relay and 400m medley relay
