77 | GEORGE MOORE
Jr. » 6-6 » 320

- » Saw first career action in opener while also playing vs. PSU.
- » Missed San Jose State game after leaving PSU game late.

68 | SHANE LEMIEUX
Jr. » 6-4 » 317

- » Has started 29 straight games at left guard.
- » Named to PFF National Team after the season opener.
- » Named to PFF All-Pac-12 Team each of first 2 weeks.
- » Academic All-Pac-12 honorable mention as both a freshman and sophomore.

72 | SAM POUTASI
So. » 6-4 » 276

- » Played in 4 career games including 3 this season.

- » Has a catch in nine straight games.
- » Has 3 career 100-yard games.

81 | DAEWOOD DAVIS
Fr. » 6-2 » 178

- » Made 1st career catch (13 yards) against San Jose State.
- » Played in all 4 games.
- » Redshirted in 2017.

80 | BRYAN ADDISON
Fr. » 6-5 » 180

- » Made first career catch (12 yards) in 40 vs. Portland State.
- » True freshman who played in each of the first three games.
- » Rated the No. 51 overall recruit, No. 2 athlete and No. 8 player in the state of California by Rivals.

- » 9th in Pac-12 in YPC with 16.88 average.

- » Has TD catches in 3 of last 5 games.
- » Caught 3 passes for 18 yards against STAN.

17 | TABARI HINES
Sr. » 5-10 » 175

- » 3 receptions for 32 yards and a TD against PSU.
- » Career: 126 receptions, 1,528 yards and 14 TDs (all most on the team).
- » Graduate transfer from Wake Forest.
- » 4 career 100-yard receiving games.
- » DNP vs. STAN

WIDE RECEIVER (X)

3 | JOHNNY JOHNSON III
So. » 6-0 » 197

- » 7th in the Pac-12 in YPC with 18.67 average.
- » Had TD catches in each of 1st 3 games, including two vs. San Jose State.
- » Tied for second in the Pac-12 with four TD receptions.
- » 22 of his 30 career catches have resulted in a first down or TD, including all 8 of 9 this season.

9 | BRENDEN SCHOOLER
Jr. » 6-2 » 193

- » Led team with 4 catches against PSU.
- » First-team All-Pac-12 in 2018 (Special Teams)
- » Finished fourth on the team in receptions (20) in 2017 and fifth in receiving yards (274) while catching 3 TD passes.
- » Starting safety as a freshman.

TIGHT END

27 | JACOB BREELAND
Jr. » 6-5 » 248

- » 3 catches for team-high 92 yards and a TD in win over San Jose State.
- » John Mackey Award Watch List 2018.
- » Honorable mention All-Pac-12 in 2017.
- » Led team with 5 TD catches in 2017.
- » Led Oregon with seven 20-yard catches in 2017 & has 11 for his career.
- » Career bests in receptions (4) and yards receiving (95) at Arizona State.

85 | KANO DILLON
Sr. » 6-5 » 265

- » 3 of 4 catches in 2018 have resulted in 1st down or TD.
- » 3 catches and first TD as a Duck vs. PSU.
- » Graduate transfer from South Florida.
- » Started 8 games and made 27 catches during 3 seasons at USF.
- » 1 career 100-yard receiving game (126 yards on 4 catches vs. FAMU in 2015).

OR

87 | RYAN BAY
Jr. » 6-3 » 240

- » Caught one pass (career-long 20 yards) vs. San Jose State.
- » Has played in 16 career games including all 3 this season.
- » 3 career catches for 40 yards, with 1st two in a win over California in 2017.

QUARTERBACK

10 | JUSTIN HERBERT
Jr. » 6-6 » 237

- » Has thrown for 300-yards in back-to-back games for the first time in his career.
- » Sixth in the nation with 13 TD passes, while ranking 13th in QB rating (179.41).
- » His streak of 19 consecutive games with a TD pass ranks second nationally.
- » Has thrown a TD pass to seven different receivers, while completing passes to 15 different players.
- » Completed 12-of-13 passes in the first half and 25-of-27 in regulation against Stanford.
- » Named CoSIDA Academic All-American in 2017 with a 4.08 GPA in biology.
- » Chose Oregon over Montana State, Nevada, Northern Arizona and Portland State.

12 | TYLER SHOUGH
Fr. » 6-5 » 204

- » Made career debut vs. Portland State, leading team on a TD drive without attempting a pass.
- » True freshman who enrolled in January and took part in Spring drills.
- » Rated the No. 1 player out of the state of Arizona in his recruiting class by Rivals and 247Sports.
- » Threw 30 TD passes with just five INT as senior, finishing w/ 3,071 passing yards and 64.2 completion %.

RUNNING BACK

20 | TONY BROOKS-JAMES
Sr. » 5-9 » 190

- » Tied for sixth in the Pac-12 with 408 all-purpose yards.
- » Seventh career 100-yard rushing game came against Portland State (21 carries, 107 yards, 2 TD).
- » Career long 53-yard reception vs. Bowling Green.
- » Named to the watch lists for the Doak Walker Award and the Paul Hornung Award.
- » Named second-team All-Pac-12 Conference in 2016 after rushing for 771 yards on 101 carries.
- » Three of seven career 100-yard rushing games have come on single-digit carries.
- » Has scored 20 career touchdowns (17 rush/2 receiving/1 return).
- » One of 15 returning players in FBS with 1,000 all-purpose yards in each of the last two seasons.

34 | C.J. VERDELL
R-Fr. » 5-9 » 201

- » Ranks fifth among freshmen nationally and fourth overall in the Pac-12 in rushing yards (314).
- » Tied for sixth in the Pac-12 with 408 all-purpose yards.
- » Fourth in the Pac-12 with 22 first downs (18 rushing, 4 receiving) on 65 touches.
- » Two career 100-yard games: 115 yards on 20 carries vs. Stanford and 106 yards on 11 carries vs. PSU.

OR

26 | TRAVIS DYE
Fr. » 5-8 » 197

- » True freshman (enrolled in January) who is tied for team lead in yards per carry (5.3).
- » Scored first career TD (49-yard run) against Portland State.
- » Has 189 all-purpose yards.
- » Brother (Troy) is a three-year starter at linebacker for the Ducks.

- » Played in 23 career games starting 5. (2018 season opener/4 in 2016).

So. » 6-1 » 329

- » Set career highs in tackles (7) and TFL (1.5) vs. Bowling Green.
- » Named to the watch lists for the Bronko Nagurski Trophy and the Outland Trophy.
- » Named freshman All-American by the FWA and 247Sports.
- » Played in 17 career games, starting the last 15.

50 POPO AUMAVAE
Fr. » 6-3 » 303

- » 2 tackles and 1st career TFL vs. PSU.

Jr. » 6-5 » 282

- » 3 tackles vs. BGSU and STAN, 1 shy of career best.
- » Played in 21 career games, starting one (at Nebraska -- 2016).

OUTSIDE BACKER

Sr. » 6-5 » 242

- » Only FBS players with a full sack in all four games this season.
- » Tied for national lead with 3 FF.
- » Tied for 8th in nation in TFL (7.5) and 10th in sacks (4.0).
- » Leads team in sacks & TFL, while ranking 3rd in tackles.
- » Named to PFF Pac-12 team of the week after week 3.
- » Has five sacks in his last five games after 4.5 in his first 38 games.

24 KEITH SIMMS
So. » 6-3 » 227

- » Matched a career-high with 5 tackles against Bowling Green.
- » Added 4 tackles vs. PSU.
- » Played in 12 career games making 19 tackles.
- » Redshirted in 2017 after playing in eight games as a true freshman in 2016.

- » Has made one tackle playing special teams and backup ILB in the first 4 games.
- » Played in 6 games as a true freshman finishing with eight tackles and a TFL.
- » Had a career-high 3 tackles and a TFL in Las Vegas Bowl vs. Boise State.

- » Second on team in tackles w/ 24.

So. » 5-11 » 191

- » Played in all 17 career games, starting the last 16.
- » Made 5 tackles and had a career-high 3 PBU vs. San Jose State.
- » Leads team with 5 PBU.
- » Third on the team in tackles (62) and tied for the team lead w/ 3 INT in 2017.
- » Had 2 picks in his first career start, a 42-35 win over Nebraska.

23 VERONE MCKINLEY III
Fr. » 5-10 » 183

- » Made collegiate debut and 1st career tackle against Bowling Green.
- » Added a tackle against both PSU and SJSU.

- » Finished w/ 3 tackles vs. BGSU.

25 BRADY BREEZE
So. » 6-0 » 195

- » Academic All-Pac-12 Conference honorable mention in 2017.
- » Finished redshirt freshman year with 23 tackles and an interception.
- » First career interception came at Washington.

21 MATRELL MCGRAW

- » Had 2 tackles against Bowling Green.

- » Six career interceptions and 21 career PBU are the most on the team.

- » Named to PFF Pac-12 team of the week after week 3.
- » Intercepted 1st career pass against San Jose State while finishing with 3 tackles.
- » Finished with 4 solo tackles and a PBU against Bowling Green.
- » Added tackle vs. Portland State.
- » Made 2 tackles vs. Stanford.
- » True freshman.

CORNERBACK

- » First 4 career starts have come this year.
- » Played in all 13 games as a true freshman in 2017.

- » Picked off a pass at Stanford in 2017.
