BEARS CONCLUDE HOMESTAND VS. NO. 18 STANFORD

California concludes its three-game homestand this week with a renewal of its rivalry with No. 18 Stanford on Saturday, March 16, at 5 p.m. from California Memorial Stadium. The game will be broadcast live on the Pac-12 Networks.

The last time Cal beat a ranked team was in 2008 when the Bears beat then-No. 19 Oregon, 12-8, in Eugene, Ore. This will be Cal's third meeting against a ranked foe in 2019.

Kirsten Swanson paces Cal in scoring this year with 24 points (18 goals, six assists). She is one of three Bears to have 18 goals this season (Eliza Christman, Caroline Corzel). Christman scored a personal-best six goals - tied for second in school single-game history - against Oregon last Friday in the Bears' 12-7 win over the Ducks.

Cal ranks third in the Pac-12 in draw controls (14.22 dcp). Christman leads the Bears in that category with 44 on the year, which ranks third in the Pac-12 individual rankings. She secured six against Oregon last Friday after setting a career-high of eight vs. Denver.

Also in the Pac-12 rankings, Nikki Zaccaro ranks third in assists with 11 on the season after recording six in Cal's two games last weekend, including four vs. Oregon.

Lizabanks Campagna has been stellar on the defensive end, particularly last weekend when she recorded a career-high 11 draw controls against No. 23 Colorado. Two days earlier against Oregon, she helped the Cal defense hold the Ducks off the scoreboard from the 23:31 mark in the first half until the 10:01 mark in the second half.

Jenny Wilkens earned her 21st and 22nd career double-digit save performances during Cal's east coast road trip two weeks ago, including a season-best 13 saves vs. Mount St. Mary's. She also leads the Bears in ground balls with 29 on the year and 148 for her career, which ranks second all-time at Cal. Her season total ranks fourth in the Pac-12 season rankings.

BEARS IN ACTION OFF THE FIELD

A molecular biology major, Ella Annest worked with a genetic counseling clinic last summer that specialized with screening for hereditary cancers.

Lou Biffar has volunteered with St. Vincent de Paul Community Center and Rocket Dog Rescue, both in Oakland. With Rocket Dog, she assisted with bringing dogs from the North Bay to the East Bay and San Francisco during the 2017 Marin County fires.

Susie Ropp and Caroline Corzel are organizing a Headstrong game this season, as they did last year, as well. Headstrong is an organization that helps raise money for families affected by cancer. For more information, visit <https://headstrong.org/>

Makayla Ward currently presides as Cal's GBAC president. GBAC (Golden Bear Advisory Committee) is a council made up of approximately 10 percent of Cal's student-athlete population who represent their teams in decision-making about events and activities, providing feedback to administration and input on NCAA rules and regulations.

#11 Ella Annest - Junior - Defense - Arvada, Colo.

- Has garnered nine caused turnovers and eight ground balls this season
- Registered two ground balls and caused two turnovers against UC Davis
- Scored a goal against San Diego State
- Second Team Pac-12 All-Academic last season
- Career totals: 42 games, 34 ground balls, 21 caused turnovers, eight draw controls

#38 Lizabanks Campagna - Sophomore - Defense - Alexandria, Va.

- Secured a career-high and season team-best 11 draws vs. Colorado
- Second on the team with 16 ground balls, and tied for third on the team with 20 draws
- Career totals: 26 games, 22 ground balls, 22 draw controls, 9 caused turnovers

#28 Eliza Christman- Senior - Midfield - Simsbury, Conn.

- Boasts 21 points this season (18 goals, three assists)
- Scored a career-high six goals vs. Oregon, which tied for second in school single-game history

#31 Marisa Kuberra - Sophomore - Midfield - San Diego, Calif.

- Scored four times against Fresno State and notched three points at Mount St. Mary's

- Boasted her 21st career double-digit save performance at George Washington with 10 saves
- Has garnered at least eight saves in 42 of 60 career games
- Recorded her career best of 20 saves against San Diego State in 2016, which ranked tied for third in school single-game history
- Her 148 career ground balls rank second all-time in school history, and her 29 ground balls this season lead the team and ranks fourth in the Pac-12 (3.22 gbpg)
- Went to Ecuador for a community service trip while in high school, traveling to various different rural villages to help with service projects, helping teach English, plow fields, plant crops, raise money, etc. Wilkens wants to continue doing work like this (possibly joining the Peace Corps, Red Cross, Teach For America).
- Career totals: 60 games, 510 saves, 22 double-digit save performances
