BEARS FACE THIRD STRAIGHT RANKED OPPONENT IN USC THIS WEEK

California hits the road to play its third straight ranked opponent when the Golden Bears face No. 20 USC on Saturday, March 23, at noon before heading to Tempe to face Arizona State on Monday, March 25 at 4 p.m. The game at ASU will be broadcast on the Pac-12 Networks.

Last Saturday vs. then-No. 18 Stanford, Marisa Kuberra paced Cal in scoring with a hat trick, while three other Bears scored twice. Cal hung in tough against the ranked Cardinal in the 13-11 loss, never trailing by more than three goals at any point in the contest.

The last time Cal beat a ranked team was in 2008 when the Bears beat then-No. 19 Oregon, 12-8, in Eugene, Ore. This will be Cal's fourth meeting overall against a ranked foe in 2019.

Kirsten Swanson paces Cal in scoring this year with 27 points (20 goals, seven assists). She and Eliza Christman each boast 20 goals on the year. Swanson notched three points (two goals, one assist) vs. Stanford last Saturday. Christman scored a personal-best six goals - tied for second in school single-game history - against Oregon on March 8.

Cal ranks second in the Pac-12 in draw controls (14.30 dcpg). Christman leads the Bears in that category with 50 on the year, which ranks second in the Pac-12 individual rankings and fifth in school single-season history. She set a career-high of eight earlier this year vs. Denver, as well as six last Saturday vs. Stanford. Against Colorado on March 10, Lizabanks Campagna set a career high and team season high total of 11 draws against the Buffaloes.

Also in the Pac-12 rankings, Jenny Wilkens ranks second in ground balls with 33 on the season, while Kendall Swenson ranks second in the conference in caused turnovers with 16 after notching three vs. Stanford last Saturday.

Jenny Wilkens boasts 152 ground balls for her career, which ranks second all-time at Cal. She is 10 shy of the school record of 162 set by Hilary Lynch (2004-07).

BEARS OFF THE FIELD

A molecular biology major, Ella Annet worked with a genetic counseling clinic last summer that specialized with screening for hereditary cancers.

Lou Biffar has done community service for St. Vincent de Paul Community Center in Oakland and Rocket Dog Rescue also in Oakland. She also represented the German National team in 2018.

#11 Ella Annest - Junior - Defense - Arvada, Colo.

- Has garnered 10 caused turnovers and nine ground balls this season
- Registered two ground balls and caused two turnovers against UC Davis
- Scored a goal against San Diego State
- Career totals: 43 games, 35 ground balls, 22 caused turnovers, eight draw controls

#38 Lizabanks Campagna - Sophomore - Defense - Alexandria, Va.

- Secured a career-high and season team-best 11 draws vs. Colorado
- Second on the team with 24 draws, 19 ground balls
- Career totals: 27 games, 26 draw controls, 25 ground balls, 9 caused turnovers

#28 Eliza Christman- Senior - Midfield - Simsbury, Conn.

- Boasts 23 points this season (20 goals, three assists), tied for second on the team
- Scored a career-high six goals vs. Oregon, which tied for second in school single-game history
- Posted a hat trick against UC Davis
- Notched a career-high eight draw controls against Denver, six vs. Oregon and Stanford, and paces Cal with 50 this season, which ranks fifth in school single-season history and second in the Pac-12 rankings (5.00 dcpg)

- Her 23 points this season (19 goals, four assists) are tied for second on the team
- Led Cal's scoring attack vs. Colorado with five goals, which tied a career best
- Paced Cal with five points (4 goals, 1 assist) in the Bears' 16-13 win over UC Davis
- Secured her first hat trick of the season vs. Michigan
- Career totals: 48 games, 63 goals, 11 assists, 75 points

#31 Marisa Kuberra - Sophomore - Midfield - San Diego, Calif.

- Scored four times against Fresno State and notched a hat trick vs. Stanford
- Third on the team in draws (21)
- Tallied 17 points thus far in 2019 (15 goals, two assists)
- Career totals: 26 games, 27 goals, 4 assists, 31 points

#5 Susie Ropp - Junior - Attack - Darien, Conn.

#30 Jenny Wilkens - Senior - Goalkeeper - Morristown, N.J.

- Earned her 22nd career double-digit save performance at Mount St. Mary's with a season-best 13 saves, along with a team-high four ground balls
- Boasted her 21st career double-digit save performance at George Washington with 10 saves
- Has garnered at least eight saves in 43 of 61 career games
- Recorded her career best of 20 saves against San Diego State in 2016, which ranked tied for third in school single-game history
- Her 152 career ground balls rank second all-time in school history, and her 33 ground balls this season lead the team and rank second in the Pac-12 (3.30 gbpg)
- She is 10 ground balls shy of the school career record
- Went to Ecuador for a community service trip while in high school, traveling to various different rural villages to help with service projects, helping teach English, plow fields, plant crops, raise money, etc. Wilkens wants to continue doing work like this (possibly joining the Peace Corps, Red Cross, Teach For America).
- Career totals: 61 games, 519 saves, 22 double-digit save performances
