FRESH OFF A BYE, CAL HEADS TO OREGON AND NO. 22 COLORADO THIS WEEK

California begins a three-game road trip to close out the regular season, starting with Oregon on Friday and No. 22 Colorado on Sunday.

Before last week's bye week, the Golden Bears sent their seniors out in style with a 17-8 victory over Arizona State on Senior Day on March 31, capping a week that started with a 12-11 comeback overtime win over ASU.

The last time Cal beat a ranked team was in 2008 when the Bears beat then-No. 19 Oregon, 12-8, in Eugene, Ore. This will be Cal's fourth meeting overall against a ranked foe in 2019.

Kirsten Swanson paces Cal (in scoring this year with 39 points (31 goals, eight assists). Swanson paced Cal with six points (5G, 1A) in the win over ASU on March 31. Caroline Corzel is second on the team in points (34) and goals (29). Swanson and Corzel have each scored at least one goal in all but one game this season. Swanson ranks sixth in the Pac-12 in goals, while Corzel is second in the conference in shots per game (7.07). They are two of 13 Bears to have at least one goal this season and two of six to boast at least 12 on the year.

Nikki Zaccaro paces Cal with 15 assists this season that ranks fourth in the Pac-12. After not securing a point through the first four games this season, Zaccaro got going, including a season-best six points vs. George Washington on March 1.

Eliza Christman leads the Bears in draws with 65 on the year, which ranks third in the Pac-12 individual rankings and fourth in school single-season history, 11 shy of the school single-season record. She set a career-high of eight earlier this year vs. Denver, as well as seven in the Tempe meeting vs. ASU. Her efforts helped Cal to its Pac-12 ranking of second in draws.

Also in the Pac-12 rankings, Jenny Wilkens ranks second in ground balls with 42 on the season, which ranks tied for sixth in school single-season history. Wilkens also boasts 161 ground balls for her career, which ranks second all-time at Cal, one shy of first.

BEARS OFF THE FIELD

A molecular biology major, Ella Annest worked with a genetic counseling clinic last summer that specialized with screening for hereditary cancers.

Lou Biffar has done community service for St. Vincent de Paul Community Center in Oakland and Rocket Dog Rescue also in Oakland. She also represented the German National team in 2018.

Madison Roberts Roberts worked with the nonprofit organization RISE (Ross Initiative in Sports for Equality) and specifically RISE to Vote – a nonpartisan effort of RISE that encourages student-athletes to register to vote.

Makayla Ward currently presides as Cal's GBAC president. GBAC (Golden Bear Advisory Committee) is a council made up of approximately 10 percent of Cal's student-athlete population who represent their teams in decision-making about events and activities, providing feedback to administration and input on NCAA rules and regulations.

#11 Ella Annest - Junior - Defense - Arvada, Colo.

- Second on the team with 12 caused turnovers
- Registered two ground balls and caused two turnovers against UC Davis
- Scored a goal against San Diego State
- Career totals: 47 games, 40 ground balls, 23 caused turnovers, nine draw controls

#38 Lizabanks Campagna - Sophomore - Defense - Alexandria, Va.

- Secured a career-high and season team-best 11 draws vs. Colorado, added five more vs. USC
- Earned an assist vs. Arizona State after causing a turnover and taking the ball down field
- Second on the team with 41 draws and 26 ground balls, and third with 11 caused turnovers
- Career totals: 31 games, 43 draw controls, 32 ground balls, 13 caused turnovers

#28 Eliza Christman- Senior - Midfield - Simsbury, Conn.

- Boasts 27 points this season (23 goals, four assists), tied for fourth on the team
- Scored a career-high six goals vs. Oregon, which tied for second in school single-game history
- Posted a hat trick against UC Davis
- Notched a career-high eight draw controls against Denver, seven at Arizona State, and paces Cal with 65 this season, which ranks fourth in school single-season history and third in the Pac-12 (4.64 dcp/g)
- Career totals: 53 games, 62 goals, 15 assists, 77 points

#25 Caroline Corzel- Senior - Midfield - Berwyn, Pa.

- Her 34 points this season (29 goals, five assists) rank second on the team
- Ranks second in the Pac-12 in shots per game (7.07)
- Led Cal's scoring attack vs. Colorado with five goals, which tied a career best
- Paced Cal with five points (4 goals, 1 assist) in the Bears' 16-13 win over UC Davis
- Scored four times in Cal's home win vs. Arizona State
- Career totals: 51 games, 75 goals, 12 assists, 87 points

#31 Marisa Kuberra - Sophomore - Midfield - San Diego, Calif.

- Scored four times against Fresno State and notched a hat trick vs. Stanford
- Third on the team in draws (28)
- Tallied three points (two goals, one assist) at Arizona State
- Career totals: 30 games, 29 goals, 7 assists, 36 points

#5 Susie Ropp - Junior - Attack - Darien, Conn.

- Paced Cal with four goals in the Bears' 12-11 overtime win at Arizona State

#14 Kirsten Swanson- Senior - Attack - Washington, D.C.

- Tallied six points, with four of her five goals coming in the first half in Cal's 17-8 win vs. Arizona State
- Paced the Bears in scoring at Mount St. Mary's with five points (four goals, one assist), with all four goals scored in the second half, including three in a row in a span of nine minutes.
- Also against the Aggies, secured a career-best eight draw controls
- Ranks sixth in the Pac-12 in goals per game (2.29)
- Career totals: 48 games, 94 goals, 28 assists, 122 points

#30 Jenny Wilkens - Senior - Goalkeeper - Morristown, N.J.

- Earned her 22nd career double-digit save performance at Mount St. Mary's with a season-best 13 saves, along with a team-high four ground balls
- Boasted her 21st career double-digit save performance at George Washington with 10 saves
- Has garnered at least eight saves in 44 of 65 career games
- Recorded her career best of 20 saves against San Diego State in 2016, which ranked tied for third in school single-game history
- Her 161 career ground balls rank second all-time in school history, and her 42 ground balls this season rank tied for sixth in school single-season history and rank second in the Pac-12 (3.00 gbp/g)
- She is one ground ball shy of the school career record
- Went to Ecuador for a community service trip while in high school, traveling to various different rural villages to help with service projects, helping teach English, plow fields, plant crops, raise money, etc. Wilkens wants to continue doing work like this (possibly joining the Peace Corps, Red Cross, Teach For America).
- Career totals: 65 games, 542 saves, 22 double-digit save performances
