## BEARS SURGE INTO SALT LAKE TO FACE UTES

With a pair of strong back-to-back offensive efforts under their belts, a surging California men's basketball squad heads to Salt Lake City to face Utah in a battle for upward mobility in the Pac-12 standings. The Golden Bears look to upend the Utes on Saturday at 5 p.m. PT/6 p.m. MT from the Jon M. Huntsman Center and live on Pac-12 Networks.

Cal fell at No. 24 Colorado Thursday night, but the Bears took the Buffs to the wire by shooting 55.6 percent (25-45) from the floor – their best clip in Pac-12 play and top shooting effort on the road all season. It marked the second consecutive game in which the Bears shot above 50 percent after recording 50.0 percent shooting (26-52) in the win over Oregon State last Saturday.

The Bears are shooting 51.4 percent (74-144) and averaging nearly 69 points in its last three outings, up from just 36.3 percent (124-342) and 55 points in the first six games of league action. Each of Cal's last four games has been decided by six points or fewer.

With just one 3-pointer in the game at Colorado, Matt Bradley hit a 3-pointer with 0:51 seconds remaining in the second half to extend his streak to eight consecutive games with multiple 3-pointers, a career-long.

Cal's last win at Utah came on Jan. 24, 2013. The Bears topped the Utes, 62-57, behind Allen Crabbe's 23 points and 5 rebounds.

Andre Kelly is averaging 13.0 points in his last two games, with 22 of his 26 points in that span coming in the second half of games. He is now 13-15 (86.7 percent) from the floor in the last half of the previous two outings.

## MORE NUMBERS TO KNOW

• Matt Bradley has reached double figures in all but one game this season (vs. Duke). He ranks 81st nationally with his 17.8 points per game and 97th with 392 total points.

• Bradley ranks among the top 100 players in the nation for his free throw shooting, including: free throw percentage (68th, 84.8) and free throws made (75th, 95).

• Bradley has hit multiple 3-pointers in eight consecutive games, a career-long streak. In that span, he is shooting 19-48 (39.6 percent) beyond the arc. Bradley has also connected on at least one 3-pointer in every Pac-12 game this season.

• Against Oregon State (14 points) and at Colorado (12 points), Andre Kelly recorded double-figures in back-to-back games for the second time this season. Kelly also recorded back-to-back double-figure outings against Fresno State and Saint Mary's, with 10 and 26, respectively.

• Paris Austin has scored in double figures in four consecutive outings, his longest span of the season. He is averaging 13.3 points in that span. Austin has scored in double figures in six of nine Pac-12 games after reaching double-digit totals just three times in non-conference action.

• Four Golden Bears have combined for a total of 11 20-point games this season: Matt Bradley (8 games), Grant Anticevich (1), Andre Kelly (1) and Kareem South (1). Bradley and Kelly's 26 points are team-highs this season.

## SCOUTING THE UTES

• **Series Record:** The series is tied, 16-16  
 • **Last Meeting:** Utah overpowered Cal, 82-64, when the teams last met more than a year ago on Jan. 26, 2019 at Haas Pavilion. Matt Bradley had 11 points in that

effort, while Both Gach scored 18 for Utah and Timmy Allen added 17.

- **Utah's 2019-20 Record:** 13-9, 4-6 Pac-12
- **Utah's Last Game:** Stanford took the Utes to overtime, but Utah outscored the Cardinal 14-6 in OT to win, 64-56, in Salt Lake City on Thursday. Allen and Branden Carlson turned in a pair of 15-point performances to lead all scorers.
- Allen is averaging 18.3 points and 7.5 rebounds to lead Utah in both categories.
- Rylan Jones is averaging 10.9 points and 4.8 assists. He is 89th nationally with 100 total assists.
- Both Gach is third on the team with 10.6 ppg but has missed the last three games with a knee injury.
- Jones and Gach are two of 18 players in the nation to have recorded a triple-double this season.
- The Utes are the Pac-12 free throw leader, shooting 74.2 percent at the stripe. Allen leads the Utes with 119 free throws made, which ranks 11th nationally.
- Utah is 4-1 at home against its Pac-12 opponents, falling only to Oregon, 69-64, on Jan. 4.

### LAST TIME OUT

**The Result:** Cal outshot Colorado, but the Buffaloes escaped with a 71-65 victory in Boulder on Thursday night.

- Three Bears scored in double figures – Matt Bradley (17 points), Paris Austin (15) and Andre Kelly (12).

- The Bears shot 63.2 percent (12-19) in the first half, their highest first-half percentage Pac-12 play this season. Cal shot 65.2 percent (15-23) in the first half against UC Davis on Nov. 26.

- Kelly scored 8 of his 12 points in the second half, going 4-for-5 in the final 20 minutes.

- Kareem South started the game 3-for-3, scoring 7 points before missing a 3-pointer at 10:45.

- Cal shot 6-for-6 to open the game, with three of Cal's first 6 shots coming as 3-pointers.

### NEXT UP

The Bears head back to Berkeley for their only regular-season action against the Arizona schools this season. The weekend series opens against Arizona on Thursday at 7:30 p.m. for Cal's annual Gold Out game, airing live on FS1. The Bears host Arizona State on Sunday, Feb. 16 to close the series. Tipoff is set for 3 p.m., broadcasting on ESPNU.

**ALSO NOTABLE...**
**BRADLEY WINS PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

Matt Bradley led the way in Cal's weekend sweep over the Washington programs to be voted the program's first conference player of the week since Ivan Rabb on Jan. 9, 2017. The San Bernardino, Calif. product set a new career-high by pouring in 26 points on 10-14 shooting and logged his second career double-double with 10 rebounds against Washington State, and with 28 seconds remaining, Bradley connected on a 3-point jumper to push the Golden Bear lead to 72-66 and seal the victory. He added another gamewinner against the Huskies. With the game locked up, 58-58, in overtime, Bradley shot a 3-pointer with 7 seconds left on the clock, propelling the Bears to a 61-58 triumph. For the weekend, he averaged 21.5 points, 7.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists.

**ABDUR-RAHIM HONORED WITH PETE NEWELL AWARD**

Earlier this season, Cal announced 1996 Pac-12 Player of the Year and current NBA G League President Shareef Abdur-Rahim as this year's Pete Newell Career Achievement Award recipient. The annual contest honors the legacy of Cal's Hall of Fame basketball coach and is presented to a Cal men's basketball alumnus who has distinguished himself in his career accomplishments.

Abdur-Rahim will be recognized during Cal's game against Colorado on Thursday, Feb. 27 at Haas Pavilion in the 10th Pete Newell Classic.

**BEARS INK DUO IN EARLY SIGNING PERIOD**

Mark Fox's first full recruiting class is starting to take shape after the signing of two wing players in November's early signing period. The Bears added Monty Bowser and Jalen Celestine to their roster.

- Oakland's own Bowser is a product of Bishop O'Dowd High School, where current Bear Paris Austin and former standout Ivan Rabb also attended. He was an honorable mention selection for both the SF Chronicle All-Metro and All-Bay Area News Group squads.
- Celestine averaged 16 points, 6 rebounds and 3 assists playing on the 2019 Nike EYBL circuit. He attends Long Island Lutheran.

**CAL IN THE PAC-12 PRESEASON POLL**

- The Golden Bears are projected to finish 12th in the Pac-12, according to a preseason vote by media who regularly cover the conference.
- Oregon is the favorite to win the conference.
- Cal has finished 12th in the league in each of the last two seasons.

**BEARS IN THE NBA**

Three Golden Bears are listed on NBA rosters: Jaylen Brown (Boston Celtics), Allen Crabbe (Minnesota Timberwolves) and Ivan Rabb (New York Knicks, 2-way). Numerous former members of the Golden Bear roster own front-office roles, including G League President Shareef Abdur-Rahim, Lakers assistant coach Jason Kidd, Nets General Manager Sean Marks and Warriors coach Theo Robertson, as well as several Bears in scouting and development roles or in the G League, including Marcus Lee (Sioux Falls Skyforce), Roger Moute a Bidias (Santa Cruz Warriors) and Stephen Domingo (Lakeland Magic).

**OFFSEASON OVERHAUL**

Cal's offseason roster overhaul started at the top, with head coach Mark Fox's changes among his coaching staff. He retained assistant coach Marty Wilson and brought on talented recruiters and veteran coaches in Andrew Francis and Chris Harriman. Francis joined the Bears after serving as an assistant under Fran McCaffery at Iowa for nine seasons, while Harriman headed to Berkeley with experience under Rick Majerus (Saint Louis), Tim Miles (Nebraska) and Paul Weir (New Mexico). Fox also brought on longtime colleague, mentor and friend Trent Johnson as Cal's Deputy Analyst & Director of Player Development. He previously helmed the men's basketball programs at Nevada (1999-2004), where he was inducted into the Hall of Fame in 2013, as well as at Stanford (2004-08), LSU (2008-2012) and TCU (2012-16).

Mark Fox, a veteran coach who guided teams at Nevada and Georgia to multiple postseason berths during the course of his career, was named head men's basketball coach at Cal on March 29, 2019.

Fox compiled a 123-43 record in five seasons leading Nevada from 2005-09, a run that included four conference championships, three invitations to the NCAA Tournament and two trips to the CBI Tournament. He later served as head coach at Georgia for nine seasons from 2010-18 and amassed a 163-133 mark, leading the Bulldogs to a pair of NCAA Tournaments and three National Invitation Tournaments. With a career record of 286-176, he has averaged more than 20 wins per season over 14 years.

Fox brings strong West Coast roots to Cal, as he began his collegiate coaching career as an assistant at Washington from 1991-93 before spending the next six seasons on staff at Kansas State. Fox then served as associate head coach at Nevada before taking over the lead role prior to the 2004-05 campaign.

Outside of coaching, Fox is a former chair of the NCAA Men's Basketball Rules Committee and member of the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Ethics Coalition. He has also raised nearly \$1 million for Coaches vs. Cancer.

After leaving Georgia, Fox spent the fall of 2018 serving with USA Basketball as an assistant coach to Jeff Van Gundy for the World Cup Qualifying team. He also assisted the Milwaukee Bucks in the NBA Summer League and spent professional development times with coaches Brad Stevens, Gregg Popovich and Geno Auriemma, among others.

Fox's tenure at Georgia included four 20-win seasons, which ties for the most by a head coach in school history, and guided the team to the SEC Tournament semifinals three different times. The Bulldogs produced three consecutive 20-victory campaigns from 2014-16, making Fox the only coach at Georgia to win at least 20 games three years in a row. He led Georgia to the NCAA Tournament in 2011 and 2015 and to the NIT in 2014, '16 and '17.

In Fox's first season with the Bulldogs, Georgia defeated three top-25 teams and paced the SEC in field goal shooting, free throw shooting and assists. A year later, Georgia had its first 20-win season and

earned an NCAA Tournament berth for the first time in nine seasons. Fox's 2013-14 squad tied for second in the SEC, a milestone achieved by just three other Georgia teams in the previous 82 years.

From 2014-17, Georgia won a total of 80 games – the second-winningest four-year stretch in program history – and the Bulldogs' 42 SEC wins and 54 home wins over the span are the most ever at the school.

Individually under Fox, Yante Maten was named the Associated Press SEC Player of the Year after averaging a conference-best 19.3 ppg and 8.6 rpg, while Juwan Parker was named the SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year in 2017-18. Overall, every senior who played for Fox during his tenure at Georgia graduated. In addition, more than 15 student-athletes went on to play professionally, including Kentavious Caldwell-Pope, who was the No. 8 pick of the 2013 NBA Draft by the Detroit Pistons. Caldwell-Pope, the first McDonald's All-American in nearly 20 years to choose Georgia, was named the 2013 SEC Player of the Year.

While at Nevada, Fox enjoyed one of the most successful starts to a coaching career in Division I history, establishing what was then a record for highest winning percentage in a coach's first three seasons (.818, 81-18). He guided Nevada to four conference titles (one shared), three NCAA Tournament berths and two more trips to the CBI Tournament, as the Wolf Pack won at least 21 games each season. Fox was named WAC Coach of the Year three times – in 2005, '06 and '07 – and he coached four WAC Players of the Year.

Prior to accepting the head coaching role, Fox served as an assistant under Trent Johnson at Nevada, and together they helped the Wolf Pack to its first NCAA Sweet 16 appearance in 2004. Fox was an assistant to Tom Asbury at Kansas State from 1994-2000 and served as an assistant with Lynn Nance at Washington from 1991-93.

Fox played collegiately at Garden City Community College in Kansas and then lettered two seasons at Eastern New Mexico, where he was a first-team academic all-conference selection in 1991. He earned his bachelor's degree in physical education from Eastern New Mexico in 1991 and a master's degree in sport administration/sports psychology from Kansas in 1996.

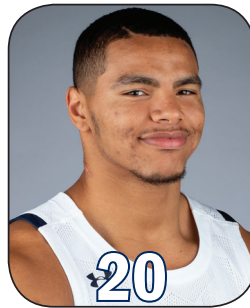
