HISTORY OF THE BIG MEET

1893 – The first Big Meet was held at the Olympic Club Grounds in San Francisco.

1931 – Kenneth Churchill (Cal) set a meet record of 221-7 in the javelin.

1939 – Clyde Jeffrey (Stanford), a world record holder, set a meet record of 20.8 in the 220y.

1940 – The Stanford world record mile relay team of Charles Shaw, Ernie Clark, Craig Williamson and Clyde Jeffrey set a meet record of 3:12.9.

1941 – Grover Klemmer (Cal), a world record holder, set a meet record of 47.6 in the 440y.

1950 – Otis Chandler (Stanford), the publisher of the LA Times from 1960-80, set a meet record of 55-3 in the shot put.

1960 – Ernie Cunliffe (Stanford), an Olympian, set a meet record of 1:47.7 in the 800m.

1970 – The Cal 4x100m team of Dan Couser, Isaac Curtis, Dave Masters and Olympic gold-medalist Eddie Hart set a meet record of 39.7.

1983 – Regina Jacobs (Stanford), a four-time Olympian, set a meet record of 4:19.4 in the 1,500m.

1984 – Louise Romo (Cal), the first woman to win a national championship at Cal, set a meet record of 2:04.10 in the 800m.

1991 – Chris Huffins (Cal), an Olympic decathlon bronze medalist, set a meet record of 26-1.50 in the long jump. Brent Burns (Cal) set a meet record of 17-8.50 in the pole vault.

2002 – Jennifer Joyce (Cal), a Canadian Olympian, set a meet and Canadian record of 214-0 in the hammer throw. Bubba McLean (Cal) set a meet record of 18-0.50. Kathleen Donoghue (Stanford) set a meet record of 13-5.50 in the pole vault. Grant Robison (Stanford) set a meet record of 3:42.14 in the 1,500m. Laura Turner (Stanford) set a meet record of 10:13.47 in the 3,000m steeplechase.

2006 – Five women's Big Meet records were broken: 100m – Chauntae Bayne-Hackett (Stanford, 11.32), 200m – Bayne Hackett (23.01); 400m – Alysia Johnson (Cal, 53.01); 4x100m relay – Stanford (44.32); and triple jump – Erica McLain (Stanford, 44-0.75).

2007 – Alysia Johnson (Cal) clocked a meet record of 2:03.43 in the 800m.

2008 – Katie Morgan (Cal) and Thomas Mack (Cal) each set Big Meet records, Morgan in the pole vault (13-5.75) and Mack in the 110m hurdles (13.74).

2009 – Four Big Meet records fell: Kimyon Broom (Cal) in the 100m hurdles (13.26), Myles Bradley (Stanford) in the 110m hurdles (13.61), Ryan Young (Cal) in the javelin (224-10) and Katie Morgan (Cal) in the pole vault 13-6.50.

2010 – Cal's women won the Big Meet for the first time since 2000, while Cal's Steve Sodaro broke a 25-year-old meet record in the 3000m steeplechase (8:48.32).

2014 – The Cal men and women swept the Big Meet for the first time since 2000, and the women's team claimed their first win since 2010.

2018 – Stanford's women's 4x400m team (3:36.95), Mackenzie Little (javelin; 192-4), Vanessa Fraser (3000m; 9:07.19) and Isaiah Brandt-Sims (100m; 10.41) all broke meet records.

2019 – Five Big Meet records were broken for the second consecutive year - three for Stanford (Steven Fahy, 3000m steeplechase; 8:45.59) (Liam Cristensen, javelin; 245-5) (Mackenzie Little, javelin; 195-1) and two for Cal (Tuomas Kaukolahti, triple jump; 54-1.75) (Camryn Rogers, hammer; 221-1); Cal won the men's meet on the deciding 4x400m relay.

2021 – Canadian Olympian Camryn Rogers broke the meet record in the hammer with her heave of 234-2; Cal won the women's meet.

2022 – Cal swept the Big Meet for the first time since 2014 and the first time ever at Cobb Track and Angell Field; the last time they swept at Stanford was in 1995. Four Big Meet records were broken, topped by Cal's Mykolas Alekna's NCAA-record 222-0 in the mens' discus;

other record-setters included Cal's Camryn Rogers (hammer, 237-2), Stanford's Udodi Onwuzurike (100m, 10.20) and Stanford's men's 4x100m relay team (39.75).

2023 - Cal swept the Big Meet for the second straight year, its first multi-year sweep since 1995-96. The Bears' Mykolas Alekna broke his own collegiate discus record again, throwing 232-11; Cal's Claire Yerby (1500m - 4:16.41) and the women's 4x100m relay squad (44.23) added two more meet records, while Stanford's Maya Valmon broke the women's 400m meet record at 52.07.

2024 - Cal's men posted their largest margin of victory since 1992, while the Bears broke meet records in the men's hammer (Rowan Hamilton, 244-3), men's 4x100m relay (39.46) and women's pole vault (Amari Turner, 14-3.25).
