#### **CAMPBELL NOTES**

Campbell has won three in a row after its most recent defeat of College of Charleston on Wednesday, 53-45.

Three Camels scored in double figures for the Camels, led by Caroline Bowns' 14 points, including 4-of-5 from downtown. Summer Price (12 points) and MaKala Rouse (10 points) also scored in double digits for the visiting Camels.

Taya Bolden posted her third straight game with double digit rebounds, snagging a game-high 13. Rouse also neared the double digit rebound mark, grabbing nine, one shy of a double-double.

Price leads Campbell with 13.8 points per game, with Bowns adding 10.5 per game for CU. Bolden leads CU on the glass with 10.3 boards per game, Rouse follows with 5.3.

Campbell hasn't had much success against UNCG, having won just one game in their 11 meetings. The last meeting was an 84-68 loss for CU at home.

#### **UNCG NOTES**

UNCG enters Saturday's game with just one loss in 2017, boasting a 4-1 overall mark. The lone blemish is a 70-59 at Eastern Kentucky on Nov. 18.

The Spartans most recently defeated VCU at home on Nov. 21, 74-61 for its third double-digit win of the season.

Nadine Soliman leads the UNCG offense with a 17.2 points per game, with Te'ja Twitty contributing 11 per outing. Twitty also has 7.2 rebounds, second to lie Ajemba's 11.8 per game mark. Brandi Fier leads the team in assists, holding a team-high 25 helpers, a 5.0 per game mark.

The Spartans went 14-4 at home last season and is currently undefeated in Fleming Gym in 2017-18 at 3-0.

UNCG opened with wins over Southern Wesleyan (96-35) and Greensboro College (82-34) at home, followed by a 60-54 win at Coastal Carolina.

#### **Strong Offensive Starts At Home**

>> The Camels have outscored opponents by an average of 45 points in the last six home openers (5-1).

>>The largest margin of victory in the last five home-openers was 69 points (102-33) against Barber-Scotia (11/10/12).

>>Most recently, Campbell won by 52 over William Peace last Friday night.

# Loss In Season-Opener

>> In 2015-16, Campbell's last seasonopening loss, CU bounced back by winning five of its next six contests.

>> Campbell is currently 2-0 after its season-opening loss at Kansas on Nov. 12.

#### Freshmen Impact

>> Through the first four games, all six freshmen have appeared for the Camels. >> Five recorded at least 10 minutes of game time at Kansas, led by Tatyana Carver's 22 minutes.

>> Against William Peace, Julia Crocker made her collegiate debut, knocking down a 3-pointer on her first shot of the game. >> Lauren McNamara-Clement earned her first career start at College of Charleston (11/22), joining Kyra Davis as the only two freshmen to earn a start this season.

#### **Big South Weekly Awards**

>> McNamara-Clement picked up the first weekly award of the season for the Orange and Black, earning Freshman of the Week honors on Monday, Nov. 20.

>> She poured in 21 points on 69.2 percent shooting and snagged nine rebounds during the two games to earn the weekly honor

#### Let Me Help

>> The Camels have combined to assist on 57 of the last 80 shots in the last three contests, a 71-percent mark.

#### Follow Us, We'll Lead The Way

>> Campbell has lead for 114:27 during its three-game winning streak.

>> The Camels have trailed for only 1:57 in that span.

#### **Big South Preseason**

>> The Camels were tabbed third in the Big South preseason poll, earning 77 points in the voting.

>> Campbell finished four points ahead of fourth place High Point and four points behind second place Liberty.

>> Summer Price and MaKala Rouse were named to the preseason second team all-conference.

#### Campbell signs two for 2018

>> Head coach Ronny Fisher announced the signing of Shyanne "Shy" Tuelle and Lauren Carter to the 2018 incoming class. >> Tuelle, a 5-10 guard, comes to Campbell from Hampton, Tenn., and Hampton High

#### School.

>> Carter, a 6-0 forward, joins the Camels from High Point, N.C., and Southwest Guilford High School.

#### **Postseason Play**

>> Campbell made its first postseason appearance in 17 years,in 2017, as it earned a spot in the Women's Basketball Invitational

>> CU fell to St. Francis (Pa.), 79-68, on March 16 in tournament play.

#### **Top Scoring Defense**

>> Campbell finished the 2016-17 season with the top scoring defense in NCAA Division I, allowing just 49.6 points per game.

>> The Camels held teams to just 47.8 points per game inside Gore Arena.

>> CU tallied nine double-digit victories, holding opponents to under 40 points in five of those contests.

#### Big South 2016-17 Honors

>> MaKala Rouse was named the 2016-17 Big South Defensive Player of the Year.

>> Rouse also earned honorable mention all-conference honors.

>> Summer Price earned second team honors and former Camel, Brianna Cribb, picked up All-Academic honors.

#### 1,000-Point Watch

>> Senior guard Summer Price is nearing the 1,000-point plateau, only needing 28 points to reach that mark.

>> Price tallied 416 points last season, 45 percent of her three-year career total.

#### 2017-18 Camels

>> CU returns nine from 2016-17, including its top four scorers.

>> Price, Rouse, Caroline Bowns and Hannah Long pace the top four returning scorers for the Camels.
