CANISIUS RESUMES MAAC PLAY AGAINST MARIST AND SIENA

The Canisius men's soccer team returns to conference play with a pair of home games against Marist and Siena. The final home weekend of the season for the Griffis, Canisius will host the Red Foxes on Friday at 7 p.m., while playing the Saints in a Senior Day contest on Sunday at noon.

SENIOR CELEBRATION

- ▶ Sunday's senior day contest will mark the final home game for one of the most successful classes in school history.
- ▶ The eight Canisius seniors have totaled 24 victories during their careers, tying them for the most successful class in school history. Last year's seniors also won 24 career games.
- ▶ **Mike Globits, Victor Gonzalez, Peter Leoni, Alan McGreal, Matt Sprague, Adam Studniarek, Sean Vella** and **Kyle Westerholt** represent the eight seniors of the highly-successful class.
- ▶ Between the eight players, the class has played in 403 career games with 289 starting assignments, while totaling 52 goals and 37 assists.

FAST STARTERS

- ▶ After a slow start to the season, Canisius is 2-2-1 in its last five games and has its strong first half of play to thank for that.
- ▶ The Griffis have scored a first-half goal in its last four games after netting a goal in just two of the team's first 11 contests.
- ▶ It was an uphill battle for Canisius to start the season as the team found itself being outscored 13-6 during the first half in its opening 11 games. The Griffis have now outscored teams in the opening period, 4-2, during their last four contests.
- ▶ Canisius has been known to be a tough team to beat when having the halftime advantage. The Griffis are 17-2-3 in their last 22 games when leading at the intermission.

McGREAL AMONG THE MAAC BEST

- ▶ Senior **Alan McGreal** finds himself in a familiar position in 2009 – among the MAAC's best.
- ▶ McGreal leads the Griffis with 19 points, eight goals and three assists this season.
- ▶ The senior currently ranks fourth in the conference with 1.27 points per game and third with 0.57 goals per game.
- ▶ McGreal also ranks fourth in MAAC games with 1.80 points per game and fifth with 0.80 goals per game.
- ▶ The Dublin, Ireland has ranked at least fifth in each of the last two seasons in points per game, including leading the MAAC during the 2007 season.
- ▶ Since McGreal first stepped foot on the Canisius campus in 2006, he has dominated the MAAC rankings.
- ▶ In the last three-plus seasons, McGreal is the MAAC leader in assists in addition to ranking second in points and goals. He has recorded two more assists than the next-highest player and is just two points and two goals shy of the leader.

ANNE EQUALS MAAC VICTORIES

- ▶ Junior **Greg Anne** picked a good time to contribute to the Griffis offense.
- ▶ Anne has scored his first two collegiate goals in MAAC victories over Manhattan and Rider. Both goals were part of Canisius wins.
- ▶ Without Anne's offensive powers, the Griffis are 0-3-0 during the MAAC season when the junior is held off the scoresheet.
- ▶ Anne is one of six Griffis to net his first collegiate goal this season, joining sophomores **J.J. Hughes** and **Jason Marks** plus freshmen **Ian Buzzio, Regan Steele** and **Sam Zarka**.

CANISIUS - MARIST SERIES HISTORY

- ▶ In 13 previous meetings between the two schools, Marist holds a 10-3-0 advantage in a series that dates back to the 1996 season.
- ▶ Canisius has won the last two meetings, 3-0, after losing nine-straight contests to the Red Foxes.
- ▶ **Alan McGreal** has recorded seven points in the last two victories for the Griffs, posting three goals and an assist.
- ▶ **Adam Miller** recorded six saves, including one on a penalty kick, in last year's meeting to record his first collegiate shutout.

ABOUT THE RED FOXES

- ▶ Marist enters the weekend tied for third in the MAAC standings with a 3-2-1 record. The Red Foxes are 7-6-2 overall during the 2009 campaign.
- ▶ The Red Foxes are unbeaten in their last four games (3-0-1) after winning just once in their previous seven contests.
- ▶ Stephan Brossard leads the team this season with 13 points and six goals.
- ▶ Joe Touloumis (5g, 1a) and Lucas Szabo (3g, 5a) rank second on the team with 11 points.
- ▶ Joe Pilla has seen a majority of time in goal, posting a save percentage of .795 and a goals against average of 1.12

CANISIUS - SIENA SERIES HISTORY

- ▶ In a series that dates back to the 1987 season, Siena holds a 12-8-1 edge against the Griffs.
- ▶ Canisius has won five of the last seven meetings in the series.
- ▶ The Griffs have not lost at home to the Saints since the 1997 season, a span of four games.
- ▶ Siena defeated the Griffs last season, 2-0. In the teams' last meeting at the Demske Sports Complex, Canisius defeated Siena, 3-2, behind an **Alan McGreal** penalty kick goal in the 84th minute of play.

ABOUT THE SAINTS

- ▶ Siena lost to Loyola in its last game, 3-1, ending a three-game winning streak for the Saints.
- ▶ Siena is 3-2-1 in the MAAC this season and is tied for third with 10 points. Overall, the Saints are 8-6-2.
- ▶ Emery Welshman leads the Saints with 15 points in 2009, recording six goals and three assists.
- ▶ Matthew Kadoch (5g, 1a) and Joe Tavernese (3g, 5a) rank second on the team with 11 points.
- ▶ Phil Chabot has started 13 games in net for the Saints, posting a goals against average of 1.59 and a save percentage of .734.

What is a Griffin?

The Griffin is a mythical creature of supposed gigantic size that has the head, forelegs and wings of an eagle and the hindquarters, tail and ears of a lion. They are well known for their speed, ability to fly and having eyes like an eagle as well as the strength and courage of a lion.



Griffins have been known for centuries as symbols of strength and vigilance, have been called "The Hounds of Zeus" in Greek mythology and are said to have mastery of both the land and sky.

They are thought to be from India, where the natives of the land made their talons and claws into drinking cups because the talon of a Griffin was said to detect poison in a liquid. Griffins would find gold in the mountains and line their nests with it and as a result, were forced to become great guardians of the nests to keep the hunters away.

McGREAL TIES SCHOOL'S ASSISTS RECORD

- ▶ After setting the school's career scoring record, senior **Alan McGreal** has no plans of stopping.
- ▶ McGreal, the school's all-time leading scorer, has posted a team-best 18 points, eight goals and three assists during the 2009 season.
- ▶ McGreal owns the school record with 94 career points. He set the program's record on Sept. 11 against Cornell. He now has 19 more points than Gianfranco Gallo's 75 points.
- ▶ In his latest game, McGreal tied the program's all-time assists record with his 28th career helper.
- ▶ The senior also ranks second in school history with 33 career goals, just one shy of the record.
- ▶ McGreal currently ranks fourth in the MAAC in points per game and third in goals per game.

ON THE MARK

- ▶ Sophomore **Jason Marks** has raised his level of play recently and it is providing much-needed offense.
- ▶ Marks has totaled eight points in his last 10 games (3g, 2a) after recording just one point in his first 23 collegiate games
- ▶ His goal against Robert Morris was the first of his career
- ▶ Marks ranks second on the team in both points (eight) and goals (three) in 2009.

INTERNATIONAL FLAVOR

- ▶ When glancing over the Griff's roster this season, fans will notice the international feel to the team in 2009.
- ▶ Canisius has nine international players from seven different countries on the 2009 roster. The seven countries represented by the Griff's this season are:
 - ▶ Canada (Casper Rej-Kleczek)
 - ▶ England (Adam Kingston)
 - ▶ France (Sam Zarka)
 - ▶ Ireland (Jason Marks, Alan McGreal)
 - ▶ New Zealand (Sam Margetts, Regan Steele)
 - ▶ Poland (Adam Studniarek)
 - ▶ Venezuela (Victor Gonzalez)
- ▶ International players have accounted for 77.8 percent of the team's goals (14-of-18) and all 10 of the team's assists.
- ▶ All nine international players have started at least one game for the Griff's this season.
- ▶ In addition, Canisius assistant coach and former Griff's standout, **Adam Reekie**, is a native of England.

SENIOR DEFENSE

- ▶ The Griff's defensive unit is hoping that experience matters in 2009.
- ▶ The Canisius defensive unit returns three senior starters in **Mike Globits**, **Adam Studniarek** and **Sean Vella** in addition to **Kyle Westerholt**, who is a senior academically and was named to the MAAC All-Rookie Team last year. Vella was a second-team All-MAAC selection in 2007.
- ▶ The four returning players have appeared in a total of 216 games, including 178 starting assignments.

McGREAL EARNS PRESEASON ALL-MAAC HONORS

- ▶ Senior **Alan McGreal** earned All-MAAC Preseason Team honors, voted on by the league's coaches.
- ▶ McGreal totaled 26 points on seven goals and 12 assists in 2008, earning All-MAAC accolades for the third time in his career.
- ▶ The Dublin, Ireland native ranked first in the conference and sixth nationally with 0.60 assists per game in 2008.
- ▶ As a team, the Griff's were selected to finish seventh in the preseason coaches poll.

McGREAL AND VELLA NAMED TEAM CAPTAINS

- ▶ Seniors **Alan McGreal** and **Sean Vella** will serve as team captains during the 2009 season.
- ▶ McGreal ranks first in school history with 94 career points and 28 career assists in addition to ranking second with 33 career goals.
- ▶ Vella has appeared in 60 games on defense, totaling five goals.
- ▶ McGreal and Vella have earned All-MAAC honors a total of four times in their careers. Both players were also named to the All-MAAC Rookie Team in 2006, while McGreal was named the conference's Rookie of the Year.

Jim Hesch Head Coach • Ninth Season 46-99-16/29-43-5 MAAC

The winningest coach in school history, Jim Hesch is in his ninth season at the helm of the Canisius College men's soccer team.

During his tenure, the Golden Griffin soccer program has seen steady signs of improvement, capped by eight overall wins and five conference victories in 2007, the most in the program's Division I history. Canisius has won 15 games in the last two seasons, the most in any two-year span during the school's history.

The third-longest tenured head coach in the MAAC, Hesch became the program's winningest coach when the Golden Griffins defeated Marist by a score of 3-2 at home Oct. 12, 2007. The 2007 season also saw Canisius win the second MAAC Tournament game in school history as the Blue and Gold advanced to the conference tournament's semifinal round for the second time in school history.

Individual accolades have become common under Hesch during the past eight seasons. He has guided eight players to be named to the All-MAAC Team. In addition, Fabien Lewis was named the league's Co-Defensive Player of the Year in 2003, while Alan McGreal earned the conference's Rookie of the Year award in 2006 and has earned all-conference honors in each of his three seasons. In addition, two MAAC New York Lottery Men's Soccer Scholar Athletes of the Year came from Canisius as Anthony Palmiero earned the honor in 2003 and Brian Brehm won the award in 2004.

The Syracuse, N.Y., native played in the National Professional Indoor Soccer League from 1995-2002, which included a stint with the Buffalo Blizzard from 1999-2000. In 2000, Hesch played in 38 games and tallied 21 goals and 14 assists. He played with the Harrisburg Heat from 1996-99 and was named an NPSL All-Star in the 1997-98 season after posting 119 points, the eighth-best single-season total in Heat history. In 2002, Hesch captured a

Major Indoor Soccer League Championship as a member of the Philadelphia Kixx, tallying 36 points in 28 games.

As a collegiate player, Hesch won a national championship with Southern Connecticut University in 1990 before transferring to Cortland State, where he played from 1991-93 and was named a first-team All-American. He earned his bachelor's degree in physical education in 1994.

He owns a USSF A coaching license and is the president of the newly-formed Black Watch - New York West Premiere Soccer Club.

Hesch and his wife, Linda, reside in Amherst with their daughter, Ryan, and son, Connor. Jim's brother, Dave Hesch, is the associate head coach at cross-town rival the University at Buffalo.
