NOTING THE GRIFFS

- ▶ Canisius wraps up the regular season with a match at rival Niagara on Saturday in the Gallagher Center.
- ▶ The match is part of the all-sports Battle of the Bridge competition between the schools, with the winner getting two points toward the final standings.
- ▶ Freshman **Samantha Good**, a three-time MAAC Rookie of the Week, leads Canisius, as well as all MAAC freshmen, with a .271 attack percentage and 3.45 kills per set average in conference matches.
- ▶ In conference play, Good leads Canisius and ranks seventh in the MAAC in kills per set (3.66). On the season, Good also leads the Griffis in kills per set (2.84).
- ▶ In conference play, **Janelle Davis** is posting a .385 attack percentage to go along with 1.11 kills per set, 1.91 digs per set, 9.03 assists per set, 0.59 blocks per set and 0.36 service aces per set. Davis has played in all 217 sets of her Canisius career.
- ▶ Freshman **Allyson Severyn** ranks third in the MAAC and 23rd in the country (second among freshmen) in digs per set (5.12). Severyn recorded double-digit digs in the first 23 matches of the season, the longest streak by a Canisius player in the past 10 years. Severyn's streak ended on Oct. 27, against Buffalo when Severyn moved to outside for two-plus matches.
- ▶ Junior **Renee Lettow** has a team-best nine double-doubles on the season and now has 17 in her career. The nine double-doubles (digs and kills) are the second-most by a Canisius player in the last five seasons.
- ▶ The first set has been a predictor in 26 of the 28 Canisius matches this season as the Griffis are 11-2 when winning the first set and 0-15 when dropping the opening set.

NIAGARA SCOUT

- ▶ Niagara enters the final match of the regular season with a 20-8 overall record and 13-4 record in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference standings.
- ▶ The 20 wins for the Purple Eagles set a new program record for wins.
- ▶ Niagara has also clinched the No. 2 seed in the MAAC Championship to be held next weekend.
- ▶ Hannah Hedrick leads the Purple Eagles and ranks third in the MAAC at 4.08 kills per set. Michelle James leads the MAAC at 10.73 assists per set. Sophomore Sam Morgan leads the MAAC at 5.22 digs per set, recording at least 10 digs in each match the past two seasons.
- ▶ Niagara defeated Canisius in four sets earlier this season. Hedrick led Niagara with 22 kills while James had 51 assists.

NOTES FROM LAST WEEK

- ▶ Freshman **Samantha Good** had 15 kills or more in a match for the eighth time this season.
- ▶ For the second time this season, Canisius won the opening set and lost the match. The

Griffs won the first set against Siena, but dropped the next three sets. Canisius also won the first set against Marist on Oct. 3, only to lose in four sets.

- ▶ Junior **Renee Lettow** had her eighth and ninth double-doubles of the season — the second-most by a Golden Griffin in the last five seasons.
- ▶ Good and **Michelle Godfrey** each had five blocks in the two weekend matches. Good had five blocks in consecutive matches for the second time this season while while Godfrey had two straight matches with five kills since a stretch of three straight in the middle of September.

BATTLE OF THE BRIDGE

- ▶ For the second time this season, Canisius and Niagara will participate in the Battle of the Bridge between the schools.
- ▶ Canisius and Niagara participate in an all-sports competition called the Battle of the Bridge with the winner claiming the Canal Cup.
- ▶ The name of the series is in reference to the Grand Island Bridge, which each team crosses when traveling to the other's campus. The name of the trophy is in reference to the Erie Canal, which intersects Niagara County, where Niagara is located, and Erie County, where Canisius is located.
- ▶ Each matchup between Canisius and Niagara is worth two points.
- ▶ Canisius won the Battle of the Bridge in 2007-08 and in 2008-09. Niagara won the inaugural competition in 2006-07.
- ▶ Canisius needs 16 points this year to keep the Canal Cup while Niagara needs 17 points to win the Cup.
- ▶ Niagara owns a 6-4 lead in this year's competition.



FROM THE STAT SHEET

- ▶ Sophomore **Janelle Davis** is the first Canisius player to have 900-plus assists in each of her freshman and sophomore seasons.
- ▶ Freshman **Allyson Severyn** ranks third in program history with 532 digs and 5.12 digs per set— the most ever by a Canisius freshman in either category.
- ▶ Freshman **Samantha Good** ranks second among freshmen all-time with her 285 kills.

A PRETTY GOOD FRESHMAN

- ▶ Canisius freshman **Samantha Good** has been one of the top offensive freshmen in the MAAC since the start of league play.
- ▶ In conference play, Good leads Canisius in attack percentage (.278) and kills per set (3.41). Good leads all freshmen in both categories in MAAC matches.
- ▶ Good has been named MAAC Rookie of the Week three times — Oct. 19, after averaging 3.77 kills per set in three matches, Oct. 12, after averaging

What is a Griffin?

The Griffin is a mythical creature of supposed gigantic size that has the head, forelegs and wings of an eagle and the hindquarters, tail and ears of a lion. They are well known for their speed, ability to fly and having eyes like an eagle as well as the strength and courage of a lion.



Griffins have been known for centuries as symbols of strength and vigilance, have been called "The Hounds of Zeus" in Greek mythology and are said to have mastery of both the land and sky.

They are thought to be from India, where the natives of the land made their talons and claws into drinking cups because the talon of a Griffin was said to detect poison in a liquid. Griffins would find gold in the mountains and line their nests with it and as a result, were forced to become great guardians of the nests to keep the hunters away.

3.44 kills per set in two Canisius victories, and Sept. 27, when she averaged 4.00 kills per set and 1.88 blocks per set in wins at Manhattan and Saint Peter's.

- ▶ Good also had 12 blocks (four solo blocks and eight block assists) at Manhattan on Sept. 27, tying the program record for most blocks since the rally-scoring era started.
- ▶ The Rochester, N.Y. native had 21 kills against Siena, the most kills by a Canisius freshman since Leigh Launhardt had 22 against Loyola on Nov. 17, 2002, in the MAAC Championship.
- ▶ Good had double-digit kills in nine straight matches from Sept. 26 through Oct. 18— the longest streak by a Canisius freshman in program history.
- ▶ Good had 15 kills or more in four consecutive matches from Sept. 26-Oct. 4, the first Golden Griffon to have a streak that long since Mary Boller had a four-game stretch from Oct. 8-16, 2006.

SEVERYN 23rd NATIONALLY IN DIGS (2nd AMONG FRESHMEN)

- ▶ Freshman **Allyson Severyn** ranks third in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference and ranks 23rd in the country in digs per set at 5.12 digs per set.
- ▶ Severyn is second in the country among all freshmen in digs per set.
- ▶ Severyn has been named the MAAC Defensive Player of the Week two times this season — on Aug. 31, after averaging 6.54 digs per set at the La Salle Invitational, and on Sept. 28, after averaging 6.00 digs per set in two Canisius road victories.
- ▶ The freshman had a career-high 34 digs in the win at Saint Peter's on Sept. 26, and was perfect on all 44 service reception chances on the weekend.
- ▶ Severyn recorded double-digit digs in the opening 23 matches on the season, the longest streak in the last 10 years, which was previously held Kelly Sieber who had a stretch of 16 straight from Sept. 28 to Nov. 19, 2002. Severyn's streak ended when she moved to outside hitter for two matches against Buffalo and Rider (Oct. 31).

LETTOW TAKES A DOUBLE-DOUBLE

- ▶ Junior **Renee Lettow** has improved her all-around play during the middle portion of the season, which has resulted in nine double-doubles on the season, including a stretch of four straight that ended against Saint Peter's on Oct. 18.
- ▶ Lettow had a double-double against Niagara and Manhattan, giving her a double-double in four straight matches. That streak is the longest of Lettow's career and gives her 15 double-doubles in her career.

CANISIUS BLOCK PARTY

- ▶ Under Canisius coach **Cathy Hummel**, the Griffins have developed a formidable block on the front row and have ranked in the top two of the conference each season since 2006.
- ▶ Canisius currently ranks second in the MAAC in blocks per set at 1.89
- ▶ Senior **Michelle Godfrey** has three or more blocks in 18 matches this season
- ▶ Sophomore **Layne Adams** has had three or more blocks in 30 matches during her career, including a career-high eight blocks against Manhattan on Oct. 17.
- ▶ Freshman **Samantha Good** tied the program record during the rally-scoring era with 12 blocks against Manhattan on Sept. 27. Good has at least two blocks in 23 of the 26 matches on the season.
- ▶ Since 2006, the Griffins have totaled 10 or more team blocks in 33 MAAC matches, posting a 22-11 record in those matches.

GRIFFS WRAP UP REGULAR SEASON AT RIVAL NIAGARA

FIVE FOR WINNING

- ▶ Continuing their successful play in five-set matches from last season, the Golden Griffins won their first five-set match of the 2009 season, defeating North Texas on Sept. 5.
- ▶ Dating back to midway through the 2007 season, Canisius is now 11-4 in its last 15 matches that have gone five sets, and has a 3-1 record during the 2009 season.
- ▶ Against North Texas, Canisius rallied from a 14-12 deficit in the fifth set for the 17-15 win. It was the second time since the NCAA went to the rally-scoring format that Canisius has won a match where it faced a match point.
- ▶ Canisius also trailed 14-12 against Saint Peter's in the fifth set on Sept. 28, 2008, before winning 16-14.

DOUBLE-DIGIT MAAC WINS

- ▶ The Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference switched to an 18-match conference schedule for the 2006 season. In the first three years of the new schedule, Canisius was 36-18 in the MAAC.
- ▶ The Golden Griffins were one of three programs to win at least 10 conference matches in from 2006 through 2008. Canisius went 14-4 in 2006, 10-8 in 2007 and 12-6 in 2008.
- ▶ Canisius, along with Siena and Fairfield, are the only schools in the MAAC to win double-digit MAAC matches in each of the past three seasons.

GODFREY NAMED TO ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM TWICE

- ▶ Senior **Michelle Godfrey** earned all-Tournament Team honors at the Wildcat Classic in Davidson, N.C. on Sept. 11-12, and at the Golden Grizzly Invitational on Sept. 5-6, in Rochester, Mich.
- ▶ Godfrey tied for the team lead with 26 kills in the three matches at the Golden Grizzly Invitational and led the team with a .303 attack percentage and 0.82 blocks per set.
- ▶ At Davidson, Godfrey led the team with 3.38 kills per set, including a career-high 19 kills against Radford. Godfrey also had six blocks in the win over Davidson while hitting .500 against UNC Wilmington.

HUMMEL GETS CONTRACT EXTENSION

- ▶ Ninth-year coach Cathy Hummel received a contract extension prior to the start of the season.
- ▶ The contract extension runs through the 2011 season.
- ▶ From the 2006 through 2008 seasons, Hummel posted a 50-38 record for the best three-year record in program history.

JANSMA RETURNS TO WNY, JOINS VOLLEYBALL STAFF

- ▶ **Stephanie Jansma** has joined the Canisius volleyball staff after a four-year career at the University of North Carolina.
- ▶ At Chapel Hill, N.C., Jansma was a member of two ACC championship teams, was a two-time team captain, 2006 Team MVP and a 2007 Academic All-District selection.
- ▶ Jansma played high school volleyball at Lancaster Central and was a member of the Volley FX Club Team. Jansma was also the 2004 New York State Gatorade Player of the Year.

CANISIUS HOSTING MAAC CHAMPIONSHIP

- ▶ For the first time in program history, Canisius will be hosting the MAAC Championship.
- ▶ The semifinals are scheduled for Sunday, November 22, at 1 p.m. and 4 p.m.
- ▶ The championship game is scheduled for Monday, November 23 and will be broadcast live on ESPNU. The match is scheduled to start at 7:30 p.m.

GRIFFS WRAP UP REGULAR SEASON AT RIVAL NIAGARA



Cathy Hummel Head Coach • Ninth Season 112-136 (.452)/63-53 (.543) MAAC

Cathy Hummel enters her ninth season at the helm of the Canisius College volleyball team and is the program's winningest coach with 101 career victories. During the past three seasons, Canisius has a 50-38 overall record (.568), which is the best three-year stretch in program history. The Golden Griffins have recorded 36 victories against Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference opponents as Canisius is one of three programs in the conference to post double-digit

victories in league play in each of the last three seasons.

Hummel earned the second MAAC Coach of the Year award of her career following the 2008 season when she led the Golden Griffins to a 17-11 overall record and 12-6 record in the MAAC, qualifying for a four-team MAAC Tournament for the first time since 1993. Canisius played in the semifinals of the MAAC Championship for the second time in three seasons.

In 2006, Hummel helped lead the Griffis to a school record 22 wins, with 14 of those victories coming against Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference opponents. She also guided the Blue and Gold to the team's first appearance in the MAAC Volleyball Championship semifinal round since 1993.

Hummel became the second coach in program history to be honored as the MAAC's Coach of the Year after the Blue and Gold posted a 16-13 record in 2003, the program's first winning season in 10 years. Hummel has recruited a number of players to Canisius who have been honored by the league for their play on the floor and their work in the classroom, with 10 all-league selections, two MAAC All-Tournament pick, six preseason All-MAAC honorees, as well as four Defensive Players of the Year and a total of 30 MAAC All-Academic selections.

Hummel was named the 10th head coach in program history March 29, 2001, after serving as an assistant coach at the University at Buffalo. Her coaching career began in 1995 as assistant coach at Division II Dowling College in Oakdale, N.Y. After consecutive NCAA appearances in 1995 and 1996 with the Golden Lions, she joined the Buffalo staff in 1997 and aided in the Bulls' progression into the Mid-American Conference.

A 1991 graduate of Hofstra University, Hummel was named Most Valuable Player at the ECAC Championships in 1988 and 1990. Prior to playing at Hofstra, Hummel attended James Madison University for two seasons and was named the Colonial Athletic Conference MVP in 1987. She was selected to the Wall of Fame at James Madison University in 2000.

Hummel served as a head coach for the Cheetah Volleyball program from 1995-2003. She won two gold medals at the 2003 Empire State Games in Buffalo, one as a coach and one as a participant. Hummel coached the Western scholastic team to a top finish,

then went on to help the Western open squad bring home the tournament's title as a player. She also accomplished this feat at the 2001 Empire State Games as well.

Cathy is married to Todd Hummel, the head coach of the Canisius College golf team. They reside in North Tonawanda with their son Jaxon and daughter Jordan.

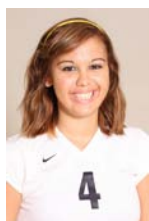

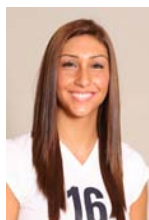
