QUICK HITTERS

- Canisius concludes its stretch of five straight games in Western New York, hosting Rider in the Koessler Athletic Center on Monday.
- Canisius has won 18 of the last 19 against Rider. The Broncs defeated the Golden Griffins 56-55 last season in the KAC, snapping a 17-game winning streak by Canisius in the series.
- Senior **Brittané Russell** needs six assists to become the first active player in the country and first player in MAAC history with 1,200 points, 500 rebounds, 400 assists and 300 steals.
- Senior **Ellie Radke** matched career highs with 21 points and 11 rebounds Saturday. Radke's next game will be the 100th of her career.
- Freshman **Whitney Ellenor** scored a career-high 10 points in 13 minutes Saturday.
- Canisius is playing its first night game in 10 games — with the last 7 p.m. start coming on Jan. 5, at Siena.
- Canisius had a season-high 38 second-half points against Loyola.
- The Griffins had a season-low with two steals on Saturday — the fewest since recording two against Loyola in the quarterfinals of the 2007 MAAC Championship.
- Canisius has allowed fewer than 30 points in the first half in 17 of 22 games this season and ranks 53rd in the country in scoring defense (57.9).
- Canisius holds the NCAA Division I record for consecutive games with a made 3-pointer, having made a 3-pointer in 476 consecutive games.

RIDER SCOUT

- ▶ Rider comes to Buffalo with a 3-19 overall record and 1-10 record in the MAAC.
- ▶ The Broncs have dropped 12 of 13, with the win coming on Jan. 31, in a 54-46 win over Manhattan.
- ▶ Rider is 1-9 on the road this season and 0-6 in MAAC road games.
- ▶ Amanda Sepulveda leads the team in scoring at 11.9 points per game and is also shooting 34.6 percent on 3-pointers. Sepulveda had a career-high 26 points at Niagara on Saturday.
- ▶ Sepulveda and Cintella Spotwood (10.3 points per game) have combined for 88 of the team's 110 3-pointers.
- ▶ Freshman Caitlin Bopp is a four-time MAAC Rookie of the Week. Bopp is averaging 9.9 rebounds per game, but has been battling a back injury and didn't play on Saturday.
- ▶ In MAAC play, Rider is 10th in field goal percentage, field goal percentage defense and 3-point field goal percentage. The Broncs are 10th in scoring margin, second in rebounding margin, 10th in turnover margin and seventh in 3-point field goals per game.
- ▶ Lynn Milligan is in her third season at her alma mater and led the Broncs to a seventh-place finish in the MAAC last season.

LAST TIME OUT: Loyola 72, Canisius 71 (OT)— Feb. 6, 2010

Kaitlin Grant's layup with 4.8 seconds proved to be the game-winning basket as the Canisius College women's basketball team fell 72-71 in overtime to Loyola in the Koessler Athletic Center on Saturday.

Loyola (10-12, 5-6 MAAC) broke the game open with 20 unanswered points in the first half, turning a 16-12 Canisius lead into a 32-16 lead for the Greyhounds. The Griffis missed 10 shots and had seven turnovers during the scoreless stretch of nearly nine minutes. Canisius scored the final six points of the half to make it 32-22 at halftime.

The Griffis opened the second half on a 9-3 run, making it 35-31 on a jumper by **Whitney Ellenor**. The Greyhounds pushed their lead back to 42-32 with a 7-1 run. Canisius would make its run with five minutes remaining. The Griffis scored eight straight points to tie the game at 54-54 on four consecutive free throws from **Ellie Radke**.

Canisius took its first lead of the second half after back-to-back layups from Ellenor, with the second basket putting Canisius up 58-56. The Greyhounds scored the next four points to take a 60-58 lead on a jumper from Miriam McKenzie. **Brittané Russell** turned the corner on a dribble-handoff with senior **Brianna Lucas**, drawing a foul on her layup attempt with 17 seconds remaining. Russell made both free throws to tie the game at 60-60. McKenzie's 3-point attempt from the wing in the final seconds of regulation hit the back of the rim.

Loyola took a 66-63 lead in overtime on a layup from Erica DiClemente, but Lucas drained a 3-pointer to tie the game at 66-66. After DiClemente split two free throws, Russell drained a deep 3-pointer to put Canisius up 69-67. McKenzie answered with her own 3-pointer to give the lead back to Loyola at 70-69. Freshman **Ashley Durham** was able to draw a foul and made both free throws to give Canisius a 71-70 lead with 30 seconds remaining.

Out of a timeout, Loyola isolated McKenzie and Grant on the right wing. With the clock winding down, Grant slipped the screen, rolling to the basket and McKenzie fed Grant with a bounce pass. Grant's layup put Loyola up 72-71 with 4.8 seconds left. Russell's running 3-pointer at the buzzer went wide right.

SCOUTING THE GRIFFS

- Senior **Brittané Russell** leads Canisius in scoring, assists, steals and minutes played. Russell also is posting career-highs in 3-point field goal percentage (37.4) and free-throw percentage (74.6).
- Russell has two or more steals in 20 of the last 25 games and in 83 games in her career.
- Russell has at least four rebounds in 17 games this season.
- In MAAC play, Russell ranks second in 3-point field goal percentage (45.0), 3-point field goals made per game (2.5) and is tied for first in steals (3.0).
- Senior **Ellie Radke** ranks second on the team in scoring (10.7 points) and first in rebounding (5.9). Radke matched career highs with 21 points and 11 rebounds against Loyola on Saturday.
- Radke has scored at least 12 points in the first half of four games this season.
- Junior **Micayla Drysdale** is the program's all-time leader in 3-point field goal percentage, ranking first at 39.7 percent. Drysdale has made two or more 3-pointers in 10 games this season and in 41 games in her career.
- Drysdale returned to the starting lineup against Manhattan on Jan. 11, and has started 76 of the last 78 games.
- In 46 career MAAC games, Drysdale has an assist-turnover ratio of 1.35.
- Senior **Brianna Lucas** moved into the starting lineup against Buffalo, making her 11th career start and first start since Feb. 17, 2008, at Iona. Lucas has played in 115 career games.
- Lucas has a career assist-turnover ratio of 1.21, including a 1.57 assist-turnover ratio this season.
- Senior **Tasia Lee** is third on the team in scoring (7.1 points per game) to go along with 3.2 rebounds per game, 1.2 steals per game and a team-best 43.8 field goal percentage.
- Lee is averaging 8.2 points in the last 11 games and has scored in double figures four times since Christmas.
- Freshman **Ashley Durham** scored a career-high 12 points in the first meeting against Loyola. Durham is first on the team in free-throw percentage (85.4 percent) and in conference play is leading the MAAC in free-throw percentage (88.0).
- Freshman **Allison Braun** moved into the starting lineup against Siena on Jan. 5, playing a team-high 35 minutes, and has started the last 10 games.
- Braun scored a career-high 14 points against Loyola. Since the start of December, Braun has five or more rebounds in 10 games and is averaging 6.3 rebounds in the last three games.
- Freshman **Whitney Ellenor** scored a career-high 10 points in 13 minutes against Loyola Saturday.
- Ellenor played a career high in minutes three times in January, and had a career-high six rebounds against Iona on Jan. 9. In the last 10 games, Ellenor is averaging 4.0 rebounds.
- Junior **Caitlin Krull** grabbed a career-high six rebounds in a career-high 21 minutes against Siena on Jan. 31. Krull is averaging 13.3 minutes in the last three games.
- Junior **Tauralee Tenn** played 11 minutes on Saturday, knocking down all four free-throw attempts.
- Canisius is 5-0 this season when shooting 40 percent or better from the field and 4-2 this season when scoring 60 or more points, with both losses coming in overtime games.

CANISIUS VS. RIDER

- Canisius owns a 22-6 lead in the all-time series with the Broncs.
- Canisius has won 11 of the 13 all-time meetings between the teams in the Koessler Athletic Center, with the last eight of those wins coming by double digits.
- Rider defeated Canisius 56-55 on Super Bowl Sunday last season, when Shaunice Parker hit a jumper from the top of the key with 3.3 seconds left.
- Canisius coach **Terry Zeh** is 10-1 against Rider in his six years at Canisius.

- ▶ Canisius improves to 5-7 in the MAAC and 3-3 in conference home games.
- ▶ Canisius defeats Rider for the 19th time in the last 20 meetings.
- ▶ Canisius sweeps the season series from Rider for the ninth time in the last 10 seasons.
- ▶ Canisius defeats Rider for the ninth time in the last 10 meetings in Buffalo.

WITH A LOSS

- ▶ Canisius falls to 4-8 in the MAAC for the first time since 2006-07.
- ▶ Canisius loses to Rider for the second consecutive season in the Koessler Athletic Center.
- ▶ Canisius and Loyola split the season series for the second consecutive season.
- ▶ Canisius falls to 2-4 in MAAC home games.

WHO'S NEXT FOR THE GRIFFS

- ▶ Canisius returns to the road, playing its first games outside of Western New York since Jan. 24, with Saturday's contest at Fairfield.
- ▶ Fairfield is the only team in the MAAC the Griff's haven't faced this season.
- ▶ Fairfield enters Tuesday's game against Marist with a 10-12 overall record and 4-7 record in the MAAC. The Stags have lost seven of their last nine MAAC games after opening the conference schedule with wins over Saint Peter's and Loyola.
- ▶ Canisius won two of the three meetings between the teams last season, including a 62-55 victory in the semifinals of the 2009 MAAC Championship.

- ▶ Canisius played its third overtime game of the season, matching its total from last season.
- ▶ The plus-10 rebounding margin was the most for Canisius this season.
- ▶ The two steals for the Griff's were a season low and the fewest since they had two against Loyola in the quarterfinals of the 2007 MAAC Championship.
- ▶ Canisius scored 38 points in the second half — the most on the season
- ▶ Canisius had 26 bench points — the most since they had 34 at Rider on Jan. 16.

INJURY UPDATE

- ▶ Sophomore **Stephanie MacDonald** had shoulder surgery on Jan. 28, and will apply for a medical redshirt following the season. MacDonald played in the first six games of the season.
- ▶ Freshman **Melissa Gardner** has been battling a foot injury throughout the past few weeks, with the foot injury now sidelining Gardner indefinitely.

- ▶ Senior **Brittané Russell** had eight points in the final three minutes of regulation against Siena and Niagara and also had three points and two assists in the overtime period against Loyola.
- ▶ Junior **Micayla Drysdale** is shooting 44 percent on 3-point field goals in the Koessler Athletic Center this season.
- ▶ Canisius has won or been tied in the rebounding battle in six of the last 10 games after winning the rebounding battle in two of the first 12 games on the season.

RUSSELL FILLS OUT THE STAT SHEET

- ▶ **Brittané Russell** has had one of the most productive careers of not only any Golden Griffin in program history but also any player in MAAC history.
- ▶ Russell is six assists away from becoming the first active player in the country (NCAA Division I) and first player in MAAC history with 1,200 points, 500 rebounds, 400 assists and 300 steals.
- ▶ In the last 20 years, four players across the country in NCAA Division I have totaled 1,200 points, 500 rebounds, 400 assists and 300 steals.
- ▶ Russell now has 1,308 points, 557 rebounds, 394 assists and 311 steals.

RADKE WANTS TO PLAY LOYOLA EVERY DAY

- ▶ Senior **Ellie Radke** has had both of her double-doubles this season against Loyola.
- ▶ Radke recorded 21 points and 11 rebounds in the 72-71 overtime loss on Feb. 6, matching career highs in both categories.
- ▶ Radke also had 18 points and 11 rebounds in the first meeting between the teams on Jan. 18.
- ▶ The two double-doubles give Radke three for her career, as the Monroe, Wisc. native also had



10 points and 10 rebounds against Siena during the 2007-08 season.

MAAC SUCCESS SINCE 2004-05

- ▶ The Golden Griffins are 61-40 in conference games since the start of the 2004-05 season, when Terry Zeh took over as coach at Canisius.
▶ Canisius compiled a school-record 14 MAAC wins in 2008-09, 2005-06 and 2004-05.

FIRING FROM BEHIND THE ARC

- ▶ Canisius is averaging 33.3 percent from behind the arc, which ranks third in the conference and 6.9 3-point field goals made per contest, which is first in the MAAC.
▶ Canisius has made eight or more 3-pointers in eight games this season. The Griffins made a season-high 13 3-pointers against Buffalo on Dec. 5.
▶ In the latest NCAA report (Feb. 7), Canisius ranks 37th in the country in 3-point field goals made per game.
▶ Last season, the Golden Griffins ranked 11th in the country in 3-point field goals made per game (7.6) and tied for 14th in the country at 36.5 percent. Canisius was the only team in the country to rank in the top 15 of both categories.

DRYSDALE TOPS THE 3-POINT CHARTS

- ▶ Junior Micayla Drysdale ranks first in program history in 3-point field goal percentage, standing at 39.7 percent.
▶ Drysdale ranks first by two percent. Amanda Cavo ranks second at 37.7 percent for her career.
▶ The Binbrook, Ontario native ranked first in the MAAC last season in 3-point field goal percentage (42.2).
▶ Drysdale has shot at least 40 percent on 3-pointers in each of her first two seasons — 40.5 percent as a freshman and 42.2 percent as a sophomore. Drysdale is the only player in program history to record two seasons of shooting 40 percent or better from behind the arc.

LOCKING DOWN ON DEFENSE

- ▶ The Canisius defense has allowed 57.9 points per game this season. The Griffins have now held their opponents to 60 points or fewer at the end of regulation in 32 of their last 41 games, holding a 22-10 record in those 32 games.
▶ The latest NCAA report (Feb. 7) has Canisius ranking 53rd in the country in scoring defense and is currently second in the MAAC in scoring defense.
▶ Canisius has held its opponents to fewer than 30 first-half points in 17 of 22 games this season.
▶ The 59.0 points allowed per game by Canisius last season was the lowest since the program went to Division I (1986-87), breaking the record of 60.8 from the 2006-07 season.
▶ Canisius opponents are shooting 37.9 percent from the field. For an entire season, Canisius opponents have never shot better than 40 percent in the Terry Zeh era. Prior to Zeh, Canisius opponents never shot lower than 40 percent for an entire season.
▶ Canisius is forcing 18.6 turnovers per contest this season. Canisius has forced 20 or more turnovers eight times on the season, holding a 5-3 record in those games.

TAKING ADVANTAGE OF THE CHARITY STRIPE

- ▶ The Golden Griffins have five players averaging 74 percent or better from the free-throw line.
▶ Canisius is shooting 73.4 percent on the season from the free-throw line and 76.6 percent from the free-throw line in the second half of games.

Griffins would find gold in the mountains and line their nests with it and as a result, were forced to become great guardians of the nests to keep the hunters away.

- ▶ The Griffins rank 59th in the country in free-throw percentage.
- ▶ Among players averaging at least one free throw made per game, freshman **Ashley Durham** is first on the team at 85.4 percent. Durham is shooting 88.9 percent from the free-throw line since Christmas.
- ▶ Senior **Brittané Russell** is having the best season of her career at the free-throw line, making 74.6 percent on the season. Since Nov. 24, Russell is 41-for-53 (77.4 percent).
- ▶ Senior **Ellie Radke** made her first 15 free-throw attempts on the season and is shooting 78 percent on the season, including 11-for-13 (84.6 percent) in the last five games.

THIEF IN THE NIGHT

- ▶ Senior **Brittané Russell** — the 2009 MAAC Defensive Player of the Year — has been one of the best in the MAAC in the steals department during her three seasons at Canisius as the 5-foot-5 guard is the current active leader in the MAAC in steals with 309 in her career.
- ▶ As of the latest NCAA report (Feb. 1), Russell is 10th in the country in steals per game and currently leads the MAAC in the category (3.2 per game).
- ▶ Russell has a steal in 20 of 21 games this season and in 106 of her 115 games as a Golden Griffin.
- ▶ Russell has at least two steals in 47 of the last 60 games, including 17 games in 2009-10.
- ▶ Russell led the MAAC at 3.1 steals per game in 2007-08 as a sophomore and at 2.1 per contest in 2006-07 as a freshman.
- ▶ Russell is one of three players in program history to lead the team in steals in her first three seasons as a Golden Griffin (Tricia Breznitsky and Mimi LaMagna).
- ▶ Russell's career-long streak of consecutive games with a steal is 24, which came during the 2007-08 season.

RADKE STARTS AS A SENIOR HOW SHE FINISHED AS A JUNIOR

- ▶ Senior **Ellie Radke** has carried over the productive end to her junior season to her senior season.
- ▶ Radke is averaging 10.7 points per game this season, which ranks second on the team and leads the team in rebounding at 5.9 rebounds per game.
- ▶ Radke led Canisius in scoring in the first four games of the season recording at least 16 points in each game — longest streak to start a season since Jénel Stevens had a five-game streak to start the 2002-03 season.
- ▶ Radke has scored at least 12 points in the first half of four games this season — including 13 against Loyola on Jan. 18, and 12 against Rider on Jan. 16.
- ▶ Radke also has made 19 3-pointers this season — one more than her total of 18 from her first three seasons combined.
- ▶ During the final four games of the 2008-09 season, Radke averaged 11.3 points and 6.0 rebounds per game, including 13.0 points per game in the MAAC Championship en route to being named to the all-Tournament Team.

RUSSELL, LUCAS HIT GAMEWINNERS IN THEIR HOMETOWNS

- ▶ Seniors **Brittané Russell** and **Brianna Lucas** have each hit game-winning shots in or near their hometowns this season.
- ▶ Russell, a Southfield, Mich. native scored the final eight points of the game for the Griffins, including the game-winning basket with 4.3 seconds remaining in a 54-52 victory against Detroit on Nov. 24.
- ▶ Lucas drained the game-winning 3-pointer from the corner with 32 seconds left in the 73-67 win at Loyola. The New Freedom, Pa. native grew up about 40 miles from Baltimore.
- ▶ Canisius has won in the final five seconds three times under sixth-year coach Terry Zeh — Nov. 24 at Detroit (54-52), Jan. 10, 2008 vs. Fairfield (58-57) and Feb. 3, 2006 vs. Manhattan (52-50).

LEE STEPS UP AS A SENIOR

- ▶ Senior **Tasia Lee** has taken advantage of more playing time this season, providing the Griffins with valuable minutes, whether it's off the Canisius bench or in the starting lineup.
- ▶ Lee is third on the team overall and first off the bench in scoring at 7.1 points per game and leads the team in field goal percentage (43.8 percent).
- ▶ Lee has set a career-high in points on three occasions on the season. The senior had a career-high 17 points in 32 minutes against Marist on Jan. 3.
- ▶ Entering the season, Lee had 24 career points in 17 MAAC games. In the first two MAAC games this season, Lee scored 25 points.
- ▶ Lee had 17 points against Marist on Jan. 3, and 14 points against New Hampshire, giving her back-to-back games in double figures for the first time in her career.
- ▶ The Coram, N.Y. native also had the game-clinching block of the potential game-winning shot at the buzzer in the 54-52 win at Detroit on Nov. 24.
- ▶ Lee has already set career highs in games played, minutes played, field goals, 3-point field goals, rebounds, assists, steals and points.



DOUBLE DOSE OF DOUBLE OVERTIME

- ▶ Canisius has played in two double overtime games on the season — a 69-65 win over Manhattan on Jan. 11, and a 72-70 loss at Duquesne on Dec. 16.
- ▶ Entering the season, Canisius had played in three double overtime games in program history.
- ▶ Junior **Micayla Drysdale** has forced a second overtime in both games. Against Manhattan, Drysdale nailed a 3-pointer from the top of the key with 19 seconds remaining. Against Duquesne, she swished a 3-pointer from NBA range with 13 seconds left in the first overtime.
- ▶ Against Duquesne **Brittané Russell** became the first player in program history to play all 50 minutes in a double OT game. Russell played every minute in a game for the 10th time in her career.
- ▶ Canisius has allowed just two fast-break points in the last four games combined, outscoring its opponents 29-2 during that stretch.

IT'S NOT OVER

- ▶ Canisius has made a number of late-game shots to either win games or extend games this season.
- ▶ Junior **Micayla Drysdale** has made three such 3-pointers:
 - Made game-winning 3-pointer with 48 seconds remaining in 59-56 win at Buffalo on Dec. 5
 - Made game-tying 3-pointer in final seconds of the first overtime at Duquesne to force double overtime
 - Made game-tying 3-pointer with 19 seconds left in the first overtime against Manhattan to force double overtime
- ▶ In the 69-65 double overtime win over Manhattan, the Griffis made three 3-pointers in the final 40 seconds (**Brianna Lucas, Brittané Russell and Drysdale**) to force double overtime.
- ▶ Senior **Brittané Russell** hit the game-winning shot with 4.3 seconds remaining in the 54-52 win at Detroit on Nov. 24.
- ▶ Lucas made the game-winning 3-pointer with 32 seconds left in the 73-67 win at Loyola on Jan. 18.

LATE RALLIES UNDER ZEH

- ▶ Canisius has rallied from a deficit of five points or more with 90 seconds or less remaining four times under **Terry Zeh** — including three straight seasons.
- ▶ Canisius trailed 57-50 with 40 seconds remaining in the first overtime against Manhattan on Jan. 11, went on a 9-2 run to force a second overtime and eventually won 69-65.
- ▶ Canisius trailed 56-48 with 1:17 remaining at Rhode Island Dec. 22, 2008 and won 68-67 in overtime.
- ▶ Canisius trailed 57-50 with 1:15 remaining against Fairfield Jan. 10, 2008. The Griffis closed the game with eight unanswered points, including a three-point play from **Ellie Radke** with 3.7 seconds remaining to win 58-57.
- ▶ Canisius trailed 67-62 to Niagara on March 5, 2005, in the semifinals of the MAAC Tournament. The Griffis rallied to win 71-68 to advance to the championship game and eventually become the first women's basketball program from Western New York area to advance to the NCAA Tournament with a 60-59 victory over Marist in the championship game.

TRENDS UNDER ZEH

- ▶ Under **Terry Zeh**, Canisius is 22-12 in overtime games or games decided by five points or fewer against MAAC schools.
- ▶ Under Zeh, Canisius has held opponents under 35 percent from the field 50 times, with the Blue and Gold boasting a 45-6 record in those contests.
- ▶ Since 2004-05, Canisius boasts a record of 29-9 in games when four or more players score in double digits.
- ▶ Canisius is 89-6 (93.6 percent) under Zeh when leading or tied with five minutes left in regulation, with three of those losses coming this season.
- ▶ Under Zeh, Canisius is 59-8 (88.1 percent) when leading by five points or more at halftime.
- ▶ Under Zeh, the Griffis have held an opponent to 50 or fewer points a total of 22 times, with the Blue and Gold holding a 21-1 record in those games.

ZEH EARNS 100th WIN

- ▶ Canisius coach **Terry Zeh** earned his 100th career victory in the 73-67 victory at Loyola on Jan. 18.
- ▶ Zeh picked up his 100th career victory in his 171st career game.
- ▶ Zeh is the second coach in program history to earn more than 100 wins, as Sister Maria Pares holds the program record with 108 victories, which came prior to the program moving to the Division I level.

HALFWAY THERE

- ▶ Canisius is 6-5 when leading at the half. The Griffins have had the lead at the half in the six of the last seven games, winning three times and losing three times — Niagara (27-20 lead), Marist (23-14 lead) and Saint Peter's (31-30 lead).
- ▶ Since 2003-04, the Blue and Gold boasts a 88-19 (82.2 percent) record when heading into the locker room at the intermission with the lead.
- ▶ Canisius trailed by five points (27-22) at Detroit on Nov. 24, and rallied for the two-point win (54-42, and trailed by four points (28-24) at Buffalo on Dec. 5, winning 59-56. Since the 2003-04 season, the Blue and Gold has posted a 22-61 (26.5 percent) record when trailing at the half.

- ▶ Canisius College women's basketball coach **Terry Zeh** has announced the signing of four student-athletes to National Letters of Intent. **Jennifer Lennox**, a 6-foot-3 forward from Kitchener, Ontario, **Jennifer Morabito**, a 5-foot-9 guard from Binghamton, N.Y., **Jamie Ruttle**, a 6-foot-3 forward from Burlington, Ontario and **Courtney VandeBovenkamp**, a 6-foot-1 forward from Amherstburg, Ontario, will join the Golden Griffin women's basketball program starting in the fall of 2010.
- ▶ "We are very, very excited to welcome such a talented, hard-working group of players to the Canisius family," Zeh said. "There are players we've been recruiting for a very long time and are very confident that they can achieve a high level of success in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference."

PRESEASON THIRD IN THE MAAC

- ▶ For the second consecutive season, Canisius was picked third in the preseason coaches poll, released at the league's annual Media Day on Oct. 27, at the ESPN Zone in New York.
- ▶ The Golden Griffins received 75 points to finish third in the projection, 15 points ahead of fourth-place Rider and 15 points behind second-place Iona.
- ▶ Defending league champion Marist was a unanimous selection by the coaches for the third consecutive season.
- ▶ The Red Foxes have won the league title five of the past six seasons, with the Golden Griffins' conference championship in 2005 interrupting the streak.

THREE GRIFFS NAMED PRESEASON ALL-MAAC

- ▶ Three Golden Griffins earned preseason all-MAAC honors at the league's annual Media Day, held Oct. 27, at the ESPN Zone in New York.
- ▶ Senior **Brittané Russell** was named to the First Team, senior **Ellie Radke** was named to the Second Team and junior **Micayla Drysdale** was named to the Third Team giving Canisius at least two preseason all-MAAC selections for the sixth consecutive season — the longest streak in the MAAC.
- ▶ Russell, the 2009 MAAC Defensive Player of the Year, 2009 MAAC all-MAAC Second Team selection, 2007 MAAC all-Rookie Team selection, was named to the preseason all-MAAC Second Team prior to her junior season and to the preseason all-MAAC Third Team prior to her sophomore season.
- ▶ Radke was named to the All-Tournament Team following the 2009 MAAC Championship.



ITALIAN GRIFF TOUR '09

- ▶ The Canisius College women's basketball team took a 10-day tour of Italy in August.
▶ The team traveled to Como, Florence, Venice, Milan, Montecatini, Rome and the Vatican City while also going white-water rafting in the Aosta region.
▶ Canisius played three games while in Italy, easily winning all three contests. The Griffis won each of the games by at least 25 points and had an average margin of victory of 43 points. Canisius allowed just over 45 points per game on the defensive end.
▶ Teams taking foreign tours are allowed to hold practices prior to leaving.
▶ The NCAA permits teams to take a foreign tour once every four years. Incoming freshmen aren't eligible to participate in the tour or in the early practices.

STEPH'S SUMMER VACATION

- ▶ For the second consecutive year, Stephanie MacDonald spent part of her summer with the Canadian Junior Women's National Team.
▶ During the end of July and beginning of August, MacDonald played with Team Canada at the 2009 FIBA U19 World Championship to be held in Thailand.
▶ MacDonald and Canada finished fourth in the U19 World Championships — the best finish by the country in the event's history. The sophomore played in all nine games, highlighted by performances against Japan (10 points) and Tunisia (nine points).
▶ In July 2008, MacDonald played with Canada's U18 team in the FIBA Americas U18 Championship in Buenos Aires, Argentina.
▶ Canada won the silver medal, qualifying for the 2009 FIBA U19 World Championship,
▶ MacDonald averaged 7.4 points per game in just over 16 minutes and was one of four Canadians who scored at least seven points in four of the games. MacDonald scored nine points in 12 minutes against the United States and had 10 points in 14 minutes against Brazil.

ZEH SIGNS CONTRACT EXTENSION

- ▶ Following the most wins by a Canisius College women's basketball team in 25 seasons, sixth-year head coach Terry Zeh was rewarded with a contract extension during the offseason.
▶ Zeh's contract extension runs through the 2012-13 season. Prior to taking over as the head coach of the women's program for the 2004-05 season, Zeh spent seven seasons as an assistant coach on the Canisius men's basketball staff.

O'BOYLE NAMED ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH

- ▶ Beth O'Boyle was named the program's associate head coach prior to the start of the regular season.
▶ O'Boyle is in her third season on the Canisius coaching staff. The 1998 graduate of Gettysburg College came to the Golden Griffin coaching staff prior to the 2007-08 season after spending three years as the head coach at Montclair State.

THIS STAFF CAN PLAY

- ▶ All four staff members under Terry Zeh played college hoops before entering the coaching ranks.
▶ Beth O'Boyle earned four letters at Gettysburg College in basketball and soccer, serving as a two-time captain in each sport.
▶ Tara Fleming played for Youngstown State from 2001-05 and appeared in 107 career games and finishing her career with 125 blocked shots, which ranked second in program history.
▶ Jen Gwin played for four seasons at Gannon University, where she was a three-time Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference selection, including two first-team selections. Gwin scored 1,000 points in her career, left as the program's all-time leader in assists and was the 2002 GLIAC Freshman of the Year.
▶ Abby Radunske played for four seasons at Canisius College, her last three seasons under Zeh. Radunske had her best season as a senior, averaging 10.8 points and 4.4 rebounds en route to earning all-MAAC Third-Team honors. Radunske was a member of the 2005 MAAC Championship team and spent the 2007-08 season playing in Germany.

SAME HIGH SCHOOL, SAME POSITION, SAME NUMBER

- ▶ Junior Micayla Drysdale hails from St. Mary's in Ontario — the same high school as Canisius guard Jessie Lamparski, who graduated in 2007.
▶ Drysdale plays in the backcourt for the Griffis with some of those minutes coming at the point guard spot, similar to Lamparski and wears the same number as Lamparski — 23.

FIRST NUMBER ONE

- ▶ Canisius freshman guard Brittané Russell made school history in her first collegiate game on Nov. 10, 2006, against Buffalo when she became the first player in school history to hit the floor wearing the jersey No. 1.
▶ Russell came to Canisius after helping her high school alma mater (Southfield-Lathrup High) win the 2005 state title in Michigan's Class A division, which finished the 2005-06 season ranked No. 14 in the USA Today Super 25 Girls' Basketball rankings.

Head Coach • Sixth Season
101-75 (.574)/61-40 (.604) MAAC

Since taking over the Canisius College women's basketball program on April 16, 2004, sixth-year head coach Terry Zeh, the 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year, has developed Canisius into one of the top programs in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference.

During his five years as head coach of the Golden Griffins, Zeh's accomplishments include:

- Canisius became the first women's basketball program from Western New York to qualify for the NCAA Tournament when the Golden Griffins won the MAAC Championship in 2005, Zeh's first season as head coach
- Zeh is the only Canisius women's basketball coach to win 20 games in two seasons at the Division I level
- Zeh has led Canisius to its only two postseason appearances at the Division I level
- Canisius has had a freshman selected to the MAAC all-Rookie Team from each of Zeh's four recruiting classes, including **Amanda Cavo**, the 2006 MAAC Rookie of the Year. Canisius is one of two schools in the MAAC to claim that distinction
- Canisius ranks second in the MAAC with 58 MAAC victories during the past five seasons. Canisius has won 14 conference games in three of his five seasons and advanced to the MAAC Championship game twice

During the 2008-09 season, the Golden Griffins had one of the best seasons in program history — winning 24 games and achieving a number of individual and team accomplishments:

- The 24 wins were the most by a Canisius team at the Division I level, the most in 25 seasons and third-most in program history
- Canisius qualified for the WNIT for the first time in program history
- Zeh became the third coach in program history to be named MAAC Coach of the Year
- **Brittane Russell** became the second player in program history to be named MAAC Defensive Player of the Year
- **Ellie Radke** became the first player in program history to be named MAAC Sixth Player of the Year
- **Marie Warner** was named an ESPN The Magazine Academic All-American, the first MAAC women's basketball player to earn that award since 1996
- Canisius improved its win total by 11 games from the 2007-08 season, the fourth-best improvement in the country
- Won a program-record 11 regular-season home games, 11 regular-season road games and had a program-record 11-game road winning streak

The Canisius women's basketball program earned a NCAA Division I Academic Performance Program public recognition award for the second consecutive season in 2007-08. The public recognition awards are presented to the best academically performing teams that rank in the top 10 percent within their sport in the NCAA Division I Academic Progress Rate (APR).

His first season as head coach had a number of first-time accomplishments, highlighted by winning the 2005 MAAC Tournament title to lead the program to the school's NCAA Tournament game against Duke in Chapel Hill, N.C. By taking to Griffis to the "Big Dance," Zeh became the first MAAC women's head coach to guide his team to the postseason in the first year as the program's head man. It also marked just the second time in program history where a coach in his or her first season won 20-plus games.

Prior to taking over the women's program at the College, Zeh spent seven seasons as an assistant on the Canisius men's basketball coaching staff, where he assisted with scheduling, opponent scouting, player skill development and on-floor coaching activities. He helped recruit Brian Dux, who was named the 2002 MAAC men's basketball Scholar-Athlete of the Year, and Toby Foster, the 2004 Scholar Athlete of the Year. Both players joined Hodari Mallory as the only class in school history to have three players score 1,000 career points. Zeh was also on the bench during the 2000-01 season, when the men's program registered a 20-11 record and a trip to the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Championship game.

A 1990 graduate of St. Bonaventure University, Zeh joined the Golden Griffins after two successful years as the head men's coach at Elmira College, a Division III program in the Southern Tier of New York State. Zeh began his coaching career during his undergraduate days in Olean, N.Y. As a junior and senior, he served as an assistant at Olean High School. After receiving his bachelor's degree in mathematics from St. Bonaventure, Zeh made his way to Elmira to serve as an assistant under Kevin Moore from 1990-93. During his three-year stay, the Soaring Eagles posted a 44-36 record and made a pair of ECAC Championship appearances. While at Elmira, Zeh completed his work for a master's degree in education.

After serving as an assistant at Elmira, he then moved to Rochester, N.Y., in August 1993, and took over as an assistant coach for the men's team at St. John Fisher College under Bob Ward. The Cardinals went 22-5 in 1994, and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Division III Tournament.

From that point, Zeh moved to metropolitan New York to work as one of Fran Fraschilla's assistants at Manhattan College. The Jaspers went 26-5 and upset fourth-seeded Oklahoma in the first round of the 1995 NCAA Tournament in Memphis, Tenn.

Zeh parlayed his series of successful seasons into the head coaching position at Elmira, beginning in the fall of 1995. His first squad went 14-13 and made it to the semifinals of the ECAC Tournament, while his second quintet went 15-13 and lost to Nazareth in the championship game in the ECAC Tournament.

Zeh and his wife, Jennifer, reside in Williamsville with their daughter, Anna, and son, Gavin.
