## **QUICK HITTERS**

- ▶ The Canisius College women's basketball team opens the 2011-12 season against rival St. Bonaventure University in the Koessler Athletic Center on Monday night.
- ▶ The 2011-12 season is the 37th in program history overall (1975-76) and 26th in program history at the Division I level (1986-87)
- ▶ Canisius holds a 22-21 lead in the all-time series, with St. Bonaventure having won the last five meetings overall between the teams and the last three between the teams in the KAC.
- ▶ The last Canisius win in the series came in a 77-67 victory in Olean on Dec. 17, 2005. The last Canisius win over the Bonnies in the KAC came on Nov. 20, 1999, a 92-73 win.
- ▶ Monday's game is the first of 14 home games for Canisius this season.
- Six of those home games are doubleheaders with the Canisius men's basketball team.
- ▶ Canisius sophomore **Jamie Ruttle** was named to the preseason All-MAAC Second Team at the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Preseason awards banquet on Oct. 25, at the National Basketball Hall of Fame and Museum in Springfield, Mass.
- ➤ Starting in 2012, the MAAC Championship will be held at the neutral-site MassMutual Center in Springfield, Mass. for three years.
- ▶ **Terry Zeh** is entering his eighth year as head coach of the Golden Griffins. Zeh has a 115-101 record in his career, leading Canisius to the 2005 MAAC Championship, including the program's first appearance NCAA Tournament, and to the 2009 WNIT.
- ▶ Zeh is a 1990 graduate of St. Bonaventure University.
- ▶ Junior **Allison Braun** will serve as the team's captain for the 2011-12 season.
- ▶ The 2011-12 Golden Griffin roster features zero seniors for the first time since the 2004-05 team. Every other roster in the MAAC features at least two seniors.

# ST. BONAVENTURE SCOUT

- ➤ St. Bonaventure posted a 21-12 overall record during the 2010-11 season.
- ▶ The Bonnies appeared in the WNIT for the third consecutive season.
- ► The Bonnies tied for third in the Atlantic 10 standings the best-ever finish in program history.
- ► St. Bonaventure has won 20-plus games in each of the last three seasons.
- ▶ St. Bonaventure returns all five starters from last year's team and 92 percent of its scoring.
- ➤ Senior Megan Van Tatenhove is a preseason Atlantic 10 First-Team selection. Van Tatenhove averaged 14.5 points per game last season.
- ▶ Jessica Jenkins made 100 3-pointers last season, shooting 40.2 percent from behind the arc.

## LAST TIME OUT: Loyola 68, Canisius 53 (OT) — March 4, 2011

BRIDGEPORT, Conn. - Loyola's Miriam McKenzie made a 3-pointer at the end of regulation to tie the game and the Greyhounds carried that momentum into overtime to defeat the Canisius College women's basketball team 68-53 in the quarterfinals of the 2011 Spark Energy MAAC Championship.

Canisius started the second half by scoring on four of its first six possessions, building a 38-30 lead on a layup from **Micayla Drysdale**. The Greyhounds responded by scoring nine straight points to take a 39-38 lead after **Katie Sheahin** split two free throws. Loyola took a 43-40 lead after a layup from McKenzie, and the Griffs answered with a free throw from Gardner and a jumper from **Jamie Ruttle** to tie the game at 43-43.

Canisius held Loyola without a field goal for the next seven minutes and tied the game at 45-45 after a layup from **Jen Lennox** with 3:55 left. McKenzie split two free throws to give Loyola a 46-45 lead with 2:19 left. Neither team would score on its next two possessions, giving Canisius the ball, down one point with the shot clock off.

Drysdale drove down the left-side of the lane and was fouled. The senior made both of her free throws to give Canisius the one-point

lead with 13.7 seconds remaining. After Sheahin missed the go-ahead basket, Drysdale corralled the rebound and was fouled. The senior made both free throws again, to put Canisius up 49-46 with 3.7 seconds remaining.

Loyola, who had to go the length of the court, threw the ball into McKenzie, who caught the ball just before the halfcourt circle. McKenzie split the Canisius defense and took three dribbles into the frontcourt. The All-MAAC First-Team selection gathered the ball, set her feet and swished the 3-pointer as the buzzer sounded to tie the game at 49-49.

In overtime, Loyola made four free throws in the first minute and Alyssa Sutherland nailed a 3-pointer to put Loyola up 56-49 just 90 seconds into the extra session. Trying to score quickly, Canisius missed all seven of its 3-point attempts in overtime as Loyola made 16 free throws to put the game away.

## **SCOUTING THE GRIFFS**

- ▶ Sophomore Jamie Ruttle, the 2011 MAAC Rookie of the Year, is the team's leading returning scorer (8.9) and has scored eight or more points in 16 of the last 21 games.
- ▶ Sophomore Jen Morabito, a MAAC All-Rookie Team selection, ranked fifth in the MAAC in 3-point field goal percentage (35.4) last season and fourth in 3-point field goals made per
- Junior Allison Braun, the team's captain for the 2011-12 season, has appeared in 59 games in her career, making 23 career starts. Braun led the team in FG percentage (40.4) as a freshman.
- Junior **Ashley Durham** ranked third on the team in scoring (8.7) last season. She ranked 10th in the MAAC in assists per game (2.5) and free-throw percentage (72.2).
- Junior Melissa Gardner recorded a career-high 11 rebounds in a career-high 36 minutes in the MAAC quarterfinals. She averaged 10.0 rebounds per 40 minutes as a sophomore.
- ▶ Sophomore Jen Lennox set the program's Division I blocks record for freshmen with 28 blocks last season. She ranked 10th in the MAAC in blocks per game. Lennox has scored six or more points in seven of the last 10 games.
- ▶ Sophomore Courtney VandeBovenkamp had five or more rebounds in 15 games as a freshman and shot 45.7 percent in the last seven games of the 2010-11 season.

- ▶ Canisius and St. Bonaventure are meeting for the 44th time, with Canisius holding a 22-21 lead in the all-time series.
- St. Bonaventure has won the last five meetings between the teams.

- Canisius held a 17-16 lead after a Ruttle jump shot with 10:20 remaining, but the Bonnies held Canisius to two field goals the rest of the half in building a 39-24 halftime lead.

## YOUNG BUT EXPERIENCED

- ▶ The Canisius College roster is composed of 12 players zero seniors, four juniors, four sophomores and four freshmen.
- ▶ Canisius is the only team in the MAAC that doesn't have at least two seniors on the roster.
- ▶ Canisius doesn't have a senior on the team for the first time since the 2004-05 season.
- ▶ All four sophomores played at least 26 games last season, making a combined 118 appearances that included 65 starts.

## **LATE RALLIES UNDER ZEH**

- Canisius has rallied from a deficit of five points or more with 90 seconds or less remaining four times under Terry Zeh.
- ➤ Canisius trailed 57-50 with 40 seconds remaining in the first overtime against Manhattan on Jan. 11, went on a 9-2 run to force a second overtime and eventually won 69-65.
- ► Canisius trailed 56-48 with 1:17 remaining at Rhode Island Dec. 22, 2008 and won 68-67 in –overtime.
- ➤ Canisius trailed 57-50 with 1:15 remaining against Fairfield Jan. 10, 2008. The Griffs closed the game

with eight unanswered points, including a three-point play from **Ellie Radke** with 3.7 seconds remaining to win 58-57.

▶ Canisius trailed 67-62 to Niagara on March 5, 2005, in the semifinals of the MAAC Tournament. The Griffs rallied to win 71-68 to advance to the championship game and eventually become the first women's basketball program from Western New York area to advance to the NCAA Tournament with a 60-59 victory over Marist in the championship game.

- ► Canisius went 9-2 on the season when leading or tied at intermission, losing against Iona (32-31 lead) on Feb. 18, and against Loyola in the MAAC Championship (30-28 halftime lead).

- ▶ Also in 2010-11, Canisius freshmen won seven MAAC Rookie of the Week awards. It was the first time in league history one school has had four freshmen named MAAC Rookie of the Week in
- ▶ Prior to last season, Canisius never had more than two freshmen named MAAC Rookie of the Week in the same season.

### **MAAC SUCCESS SINCE 2004-05**

- ▶ The Golden Griffins are 69-57 in conference games since the start of the 2004-05 season, when Terry Zeh took over as coach at Canisius.
- ▶ Canisius compiled a school-record 14 MAAC wins in 2008-09. 2005-06 and 2004-05.
- ▶ The Golden Griffins are tied for fourth in the conference for wins since the start of the 2004-05 campaign, when Terry **Zeh** took over as coach.
- ▶ Canisius has won 14 games in three of Zeh's seven seasons, as Canisius is one of only three schools (along with Marist and Loyola) to win 14 regular-season MAAC games since the 2004-05 season. **ZEH HAS MOST CANISIUS WINS EVER** 

- ▶ Zeh passed Sister Maria Pares (1981-86), who recorded 108 victories during her tenure at Canisius.
- ▶ Zeh picked up his 100th career victory in his 171st career game, a 73-67 victory at Loyola on Jan. 18.
- > Zeh is the second coach in program history to earn more than 100 wins, as Sister Maria Pares holds the program record with 108 victories, which came prior to the program moving to the Division I level.
- ▶ Zeh set the program's Division I record with his 94th victory, which came on Nov. 24, 2009, in a 54-52 win at Detroit.

## **STAFF CHANGES**

- ▶ With the departure of Beth O'Boyle to take over as the head coach at Stony Brook University, the Golden Griffins did some shulffing of their coaching staff in the offseason. O'Boyle is the second assistant under Zeh to become a head coach (Kendra Faustin at Niagara).
- ▶ Tara Fleming enters her sixth year on the Golden Griffin bench and is the fifth-longest tenured assistant coach in the conference. Fleming played for Youngstown State from 2001-05 and appeared in 107 career games and finishing her career with 125 blocked shots, which ranked second in program history.
- > Jacey Brooks enters her second year with the Golden Griffins. She, a two-time all-SUNYAC performer, played for four years at Buffalo State, leaving as the program's fourth all-time leading scorer (1,219 points) and ninth in rebounding (554).
- ▶ Nick Moore moves up to an assistant coach position after serving as the program's graduate student manager during the 2010-11 season. Moore graduated from SUNY Fredonia in 2010, after spending two years as a student assistant coach with the women's basketball program.
- After a four-year playing career with the Golden Griffins, Micayla Drysdale takes over as the program's graduate student manager. Drysdale tied a program record by appearing in 125 games, ranking second in program history in 3-point field goal percentage (37.2) and fifth in 3-point field goals made (189).

# Terry Zeh Head Coach • Eighth Season 115-101 (.532)/69-57 (.548) MAAC

Since taking over the Canisius College women's basketball program on April 16, 2004, eighth-year head coach Terry Zeh has developed Canisius into one of the top programs in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year, Zeh enters the season with a 115-101 record, ranking first all-time in program history for victories and first among Division I coaches in winning percentage (.532). Zeh became the program's all-time winningest coach on Jan. 4, 2011, in a win over Saint Peter's College at the Koessler Athletic Center.

During his seven years as head coach of the Golden Griffins, Zeh's accomplishments include:

- Canisius became the first women's basketball program from Western New York to qualify for the NCAA Tournament when the Golden Griffins won the MAAC Championship in 2005, Zeh's first season as head coach
- Zeh is the only Canisius women's basketball coach to win 20 games in two seasons at the Division I level
- Zeh has led Canisius to its only two postseason appearances at the Division I level
- Canisius has led the Golden Griffins to three 14-win seasons in MAAC play, one of two teams in the conference to have multiple 14-win MAAC campaigns during the past seven years
- Canisius has had a freshman selected to the MAAC all-Rookie Team from five out of Zeh's six recruiting classes, the only MAAC program to claim that distincation
- · Canisius has earned two MAAC Rookie of the Year awards (Jamie Ruttle in 2011 and Amanda Cavo in 2006)
- Canisius had four freshmen win MAAC Rookie of the Week honors during 2010-11 the first time in league history that's been accomplished

Zeh has led Canisius to the postseason two times (2005 and 2009) during his time as head coach of the Golden Griffins. In his first season as head coach (2004-05), Zeh had a number of first-time accomplishments, highlighted by winning the 2005 MAAC Tournament title to lead the program to the school's NCAA Tournament game against Duke in Chapel Hill, N.C. By taking to Griffs to the "Big Dance," Zeh became the first MAAC women's head coach to guide his team to the postseason in the first year as the program's head man. It also marked just the second time in program history where a coach in his or her first season won 20-plus games.

During the 2008-09 season, the Golden Griffins had one of the best seasons in program history — winning 24 games and achieving a number of individual and team accomplishments:

- The 24 wins were the most by a Canisius team at the Division I level, the most in 25 seasons and third-most in program history
  - · Canisius qualified for the WNIT for the first time in program history
  - Zeh became the third coach in program history to be named MAAC Coach of the Year
  - Brittane Russell became the second player in program history to be named MAAC Defensive Player of the Year
  - Ellie Radke became the first player in program history to be named MAAC Sixth Player of the Year
- Marie Warner was named an ESPN The Magazine Academic All-American, the first MAAC women's basketball player to earn that award since 1996
  - $\bullet \textit{Canisius improved its win total by 11 games from the 2007-08 season \\ -- fourth-best improvement in the \ country \\$
- Won a program-record 11 regular-season home games, 11 regular-season road games and had a program-record 11-game road winning streak

Canisius has also succeeded academically under Zeh. The Golden Griffins ranked 10th among Division I women's basketball programs during the 2010-11 academic year with a team cumulative GPA of 3.441 for the season. Canisius has earned two NCAA Division I Academic Performance Program public recognition awards (2007-08 and 2006-07). The public recognition awards are presented to the best academically performing teams that rank in the top 10 percent within their sport in the NCAA Division I Academic Progress Rate (APR).

Prior to taking over the women's program at the College, Zeh spent seven seasons as an assistant on the Canisius men's basketball coaching staff, where he assisted with scheduling, opponent scouting, player skill development and on-floor coaching activities. He helped recruit Brian Dux, who was named the 2002 MAAC men's basketball Scholar-Athlete of the Year, and Toby Foster, the 2004 Scholar Athlete of the Year. Both players joined Hodari Mallory as the only class in school history to have three players score 1,000 career points. Zeh was also on the bench during the 2000-01 season, when the men's program registered a 20-11 record and a trip to the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Championship game.

A 1990 graduate of St. Bonaventure University, Zeh joined the Golden Griffins after two successful years as the head men's coach at Elmira College, a Division III program in the Southern Tier of New York State. Zeh

began his coaching career during his undergraduate days in Olean, N.Y. As a junior and senior, he served as an assistant at Olean High School. After receiving his bachelor's degree in mathematics from St. Bonaventure, Zeh made his way to Elmira to serve as an assistant under Kevin Moore from 1990-93. During his three-year stay, the Soaring Eagles posted a 44-36 record and made a pair of ECAC Championship appearances. While at Elmira, Zeh completed his work for a master's degree in education.

After serving as an assistant at Elmira, he then moved to Rochester, N.Y., in August 1993, and took over as an assistant coach for the men's team at St. John Fisher College under Bob Ward. The Cardinals went 22-5 in 1994, and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Division III Tournament.

From that point, Zeh moved to metropolitan New York to work as one of Fran Fraschilla's assistants at Manhattan College. The Jaspers went 26-5 and upset fourth-seeded Oklahoma in the first round of the 1995 NCAA Tournament in Memphis, Tenn.

Zeh parlayed his series of successful seasons into the head coaching position at Elmira, beginning in the fall of 1995. His first squad went 14-13 and made it to the semifinals of the ECAC Tournament, while his second quintet went 15-13 and lost to Nazareth in the championship game in the ECAC Tournament. Zeh and his wife, Jennifer, reside in Williamsville with their daughter, Anna, and son, Gavin.
