CANISIUS TRAVELS TO NATIONALLY-RANKED SYRACUSE

- ▶ The Canisius College men's basketball team will close out its five-game road stretch tonight when the team plays at No. 4/4 Syracuse in the Carrier Dome.
- ▶ The Golden Griffins are 6-1 overall and 2-0 in Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference play after the Blue and Gold went on the road and defeated Marist 94-82 Dec. 9.
- ▶ Canisius is off to its best start (6-1) since 1973-74, and the program's 2-0 start in conference play is the best beginning to a league season for the team since the 1997-98 campaign.

FAST BREAK POINTS

- ▶ This game tonight is Canisius' first game in the inaugural Chevrolet Gotham Classic.
- ▶ The Griffins come into this game on a three-game road winning streak, the program's longest road winning streak since the 2006-07 season.
- ▶ The 94 points scored by Canisius in the win at Marist are the most for the team in a game since Feb. 16, 2005, when the Blue and Gold scored 103 points in a 113-103 loss at Niagara.
- ▶ The 94-point effort stands as the program's best scoring output in a regulation game since Jan. 10, 2001 when the team beat Siena 95-77 at home.
- ▶ Canisius earned two votes this week in the Colleg Insider.com Men's Mid-Major Top-25 Poll. This is the first time in the poll's 14 years that Canisius has received any recognition.
- ▶ Junior guard **Billy Baron** was named the MAAC's Player of the Week and the Colleg Insider.com "Lou Henson Award" Player of the Week after he averaged 17.0 points, 6.5 rebounds and 6.0 assists per game last week at Fairfield and Marist.
- ▶ Baron became the first Canisius player in two-plus seasons to record a double-double in points and assists after he scored 16 points and dished out a career-high 11 assists at Marist.
- ▶ Senior guard **Harold Washington** comes into tonight's game averaging 18.6 points per game this season, which leads the team, ranks fourth in the MAAC and ranks 59th nationally.
- ▶ Washington had a team-high 25 points in the win at Marist, his 12th career game of 20 or more points. He also hit a career-high six 3-point field goals in that victory.

Head coach Jim Baron and requested student-athletes will be available to the media after the NCAA's 10-minute cooling off period. All press conference at Canisius will be held in the Griffin Team Room, located on the second floor of the Koessler Athletic Center.

ABOUT THE ORANGE

- ▶ Syracuse is 8-0 this season and comes into tonight's game ranked fourth in the nation in both the Associated Press Top-25 poll and the *USA Today*/ESPN Coaches Poll.
- ▶ The Orange are averaging 84.6 points per game and are coming off a 108-56 win over Monmouth Dec. 8, at home. The team ranks third nationally in scoring offense.
- ▶ Syracuse starts tonight's game boasting a plus 28.5 scoring margin, which ranks second in the country. The Orange scored a season-low 62 points in the 2012-13 opener against San Diego State in the Battle On The Midway game Nov. 11.
- ▶ Senior guard **Brandon Triche**, who is childhood friends with Canisius senior **Alshwan Hymes**, leads Syracuse with his 14.9 points per game scoring average.
- ▶ Senior forward **James Southerland** is posting 14.5 points per game, while shooting 53.8 percent from the field and 41.9 percent from 3-point land.
- ▶ Sophomore guard **Michael Carter-Williams** is averaging 12.4 points, a nation-leading 10.4 assists and 6.5 rebounds per game. He also has a total of 30 steals through eight games this year.
- ▶ Freshman **DaJuan Coleman** leads the Syracuse team with his 6.9 rebounds per game. A native of Jamesville, N.Y., Coleman played at the same high school (Jamesville-DeWitt) as Triche and Hymes.

CANISIUS - SYRACUSE SERIES

- ▶ This will mark the 70th all-time meeting between Canisius and Syracuse, in a series that began Feb. 10, 1945, in Buffalo.
- ▶ The Orange have won 20 straight over the Griffs and come into tonight's game holding a 45-24 lead in the series.
- ▶ Canisius' last win in this series came Feb. 15, 1975, when the Griffs defeated the Orange 80-76 in Buffalo's Memorial Auditorium.
- ▶ Syracuse head coach **Jim Boeheim** is 19-0 all-time against Canisius. The Griffs' last win at Syracuse came Jan. 9, 1968 when the Blue and Gold posted a 66-65 victory in the Manley Fieldhouse.

CANISIUS AGAINST RANKED TEAMS

- ▶ This will be the 99th time in Canisius' history where the Golden Griffins have played a ranked team in the Associated Press Top-25 poll, with the team holding a 13-85 record in the previous 98 contests.
- ▶ Canisius' last win over a ranked school came Dec. 9, 1994, when the Griffs defeated No. 13 Cincinnati on the road by a score of 72-69.
- ▶ The Griffs have played more games against Syracuse when the Orange have been ranked than any other opponent. Including tonight's game, the Canisius has played a ranked Syracuse team a total of 17 times.
- ▶ Tonight's contest against No. 4 Syracuse will be the program's ninth meeting against the No. 4 team in the country. The last time Canisius played the No. 4 team in the country was Dec. 10, 1997, when the Griffs lost to No. 4 Kentucky at home by a score of 81-54.

GRIFFS TAKING PART IN CHEVROLET GOTHAM CLASSIC

- ▶ Tonight's game against Syracuse will be Canisius' first game in the inaugural Chevrolet Gotham Classic.
- ▶ This is Canisius' first exempt in-season event since 2009-10, when the Blue and Gold took part in the Southern Miss Christmas Classic in Gulfport, Miss.
- ▶ The Griffs are also scheduled to play at Temple (Dec. 19), at home against Alcorn State (Dec. 27) and at Detroit (Dec. 30) as a part of this new event, which is has been put together by the Gazelle Group out of Princeton, N.J.

GRIFFS OFF TO A BANNER START

- ▶ Canisius' win at Marist allowed the team to start 6-1 overall and 2-0 in MAAC play. The 6-1 start is the program's best since 1973-74, when the team also opened the year with a 6-1 record.
- ▶ The Blue and Gold's road wins at Fairfield (Dec. 7) and Marist (Dec. 9) gives the team its first 2-0 start in league play since 1997-98. This is just the third time the Griffs have opened conference play with a 2-0 start since Canisius joined the MAAC prior to the 1989-90 campaign.
- ▶ The win at Marist not only moved the team to 6-1 overall and 2-0 in league play, but it also allowed the Griffs to better their overall record (five wins) and the league record (one win) from the 2011-12 season.

HIGH SCORING GRIFFS

- ▶ Canisius' 94 points in the team's 94-82 victory at Marist Dec. 9 are the most points for the program since Canisius scored 103 points in a 113-103 overtime loss at Niagara Feb. 16, 2005.
- ▶ To find the last time Canisius scored 94 or more points in a regulation game, you have to go back to Jan. 10, 2001, when the Blue and Gold posted 95 points on the scoreboard in a 95-77 victory at home over conference rival Siena.
- ▶ Canisius comes into tonight's game averaging 77.9 points per game this season, which ranks second in the MAAC and 36th in the nation.

BOMBS AWAY

- ▶ Canisius drained a school-record 17 3-point field goals in the team's win at Marist Dec. 9.
- ▶ The 17 makes from long range bested the previous school single-game record of 16, which was set Jan. 10, 2001 in the Griffs' 95-77 win at home over Siena.
- ▶ Canisius took 36 3-pointers in that game at Marist, which was one shot shy of tying the school's single-game record for 3-point field goal attempts. That record was set Dec. 5, 2010, also in a game that was played at Marist.
- ▶ The Griffs are currently tied for the league's lead in 3-pointers made per game with 8.3 per outing, which ranks 29th in the nation.

FREE-THROW ADVANTAGE

- ▶ Through the Griff's first seven games this season, Canisius is shooting 73.1 percent from the free-throw line, as the team has connected on 125-of-171 tosses from the charity stripe.
- ▶ Canisius is averaging 17.9 made free-throws per game this season, and the 125 makes from the line are 38 more than the team's opponents through seven games. In fact, Canisius is averaging seven more free-throw attempts per game than its opponents this year.
- ▶ The Griff's come into tonight's game ranked second in the MAAC and 72nd in the country with its 73.1 percent effort from the free-throw line.

A NOVEMBER TO REMEMBER

- ▶ For the first time in the program's 109-year history, the Canisius men's basketball team won four games in the month of November, capped by the team's road win at UMBC Nov. 29.
- ▶ The Griff's played their first game in the month of November on Nov. 30, 1973 when the team started the season with a 99-72 win over Niagara.
- ▶ Prior to this year, the most wins for the team in November came during the 2000-01 campaign when the team went 3-0.

GRIFFS END ROAD WOES

- ▶ Canisius' 83-65 win at UMBC Nov. 29, snapped the team's 11-game road losing streak, which dated back to Dec. 18, 2011, when the Griff's defeated South Dakota in overtime.
- ▶ The Griff's victory over UMBC not only ended the team's long road losing skid, but it also served as the program's largest margin of victory on the road since Jan. 15, 2011 when the Blue and Gold beat Manhattan 72-51 in Riverdale, N.Y.
- ▶ Canisius' road wins at UMBC, at Fairfield (Dec. 7) and at Marist (Dec. 9) serve as the program's first three-game road winning streak since Jan. 3-7, 2007.

THE JIM BARON ERA STARTS AT CANISIUS

- ▶ Canisius hired **Jim Baron**, a 25-year head coaching veteran and winner of 395 career games, to take over the men's basketball program April 2, 2012.
- ▶ Baron spent the previous 11 seasons as the head coach at Rhode Island where he helped guide the Rams to eight 20-win seasons.
- ▶ The long-time head coach is no stranger to Western New York - he played for four seasons at St. Bonaventure and then served as an assistant coach for his alma mater during the 1980-81 campaign. He later returned as the Bonnies' head coach, a stay that lasted from 1992-01.
- ▶ In his 25 previous years as a head basketball coach at the Division I level, Baron has helped lead his teams to the postseason 11 times, including taking St. Francis (Pa.) to the 1991 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Tournament - the only national postseason appearance for the Red Flash in program history.
- ▶ A four-time Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year honoree, Baron's players have experienced the same level of success in the classroom as they have on the court. Nearly every player who has played for Baron for four seasons has gone on to earn his undergraduate degree.

WASHINGTON DOING WORK

- ▶ Canisius senior **Harold Washington** enters tonight's game averaging 18.6 points per game, which leads the team, ranks fourth in the MAAC and places his 59th in the nation.
- ▶ Washington scored a season-high 25 points in Canisius' road win at Marist Dec. 9, the third time this season and the 12th time in his career where he's scored 20 or more points in a game.
- ▶ Washington has double figures in the scoring column in 32 of his 37 career games at Canisius.
- ▶ Washington's back-to-back 20-plus point efforts to start the year (he had 22 points against Boston University and 23 points against St. Bonaventure), combined with his two-straight 20-plus points games to end 2011-12, made him the first Canisius player since **Darrell Barley** to score 20-plus in four-straight games. Barley scored 20-plus points in games from Dec. 2-9, 1995.

BILLY BARON EARNS PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS

- ▶ Canisius junior **Billy Baron** was named the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Player of the Week on Monday after he averaged 17.0 points, 6.5 rebounds and 6.0 assists last week in two games at Fairfield and Marist.
- ▶ Baron was also named the CollegelInsider.com "Lou Henson Award" Player of the Week on Monday, making him the first Canisius player to ever receive that honor.
- ▶ Baron is the first Griff to earn MAAC Player of the Week honors since Nov. 30, 2009 when former Griff **Julius Coles** was honored by the conference office for his play against Buffalo and Howard.

BILLY BARON GOT OFF TO A FAST START

- ▶ Junior guard **Billy Baron** wasted little time making an impact on the Canisius offense, as he scored 21 points to go with eight assists in the Blue and Gold's 83-75 victory over Boston University Nov. 12.
- ▶ Baron's 21 points stand as the best scoring performance for a Canisius player in his first career game as a Griff since **Larry Fogle** poured in 35 points in the team's 89-74 season-opening win over Gannon Dec. 1, 1973.
- ▶ Through his first seven games as a Griff, Baron ranks second on the team with his 17.7 points per game and his 6.0 assists per game leads the MAAC.
- ▶ The East Greenwich, R.I., native at Rhode Island last season, but was given clearance for a free transfer by the NCAA after his father **Jim Baron** left Rhode Island and became Canisius' head coach.

HYMES DIALS IN FROM LONG DISTANCE

- ▶ Senior guard **Alshwan Hymes** became the 11th player in school history to hit 100-career 3-point field goals Nov. 17, 2011, when he hit four shots from long range in the team's loss at UNLV.
- ▶ One of the MAAC's best long-range shooters, Hymes starts tonight's game with 184 career makes from behind the arc, which ranks third in school history.
- ▶ The DeWitt, N.Y., native has made at least one triple in 70 of his 91 career games played and he had at least one 3-pointer in 33 of the team's last 37 games, dating back to last season.

- ▶ Junior center **Jordan Heath** comes into tonight's game averaging 9.9 points per game, highlighted by the fact that he's scored in double-figures in four of the team's previous five contests.
- ▶ Heath had a career-high 15 points at Stony Brook Nov. 24, and followed that effort with 12 points on 5-of-6 shooting from the field in the Griffs' win at UMBC Nov. 29.
- ▶ Heath, who is the older brother of teammate **Josiah Heath**, leads Canisius with 11 slam dunk field goals this season. Of his five makes from the field at UMBC Nov. 29, four of those were dunks.
- ▶ He has also been a force on defense as well, and he was credited with a career-high four blocked shots at Fairfield Dec. 7. He currently leads the MAAC with his 1.9 blocks per game.

BROTHERLY ROSTER

- ▶ Canisius junior **Jordan Heath** joins his younger brother **Josiah Heath** on this year's active roster.
- ▶ Jordan Heath sat out 2011-12 after transferring from Roberts Wesleyan (NAIA). Josiah Heath played in all 30 games as a freshman last year and closed out the season as the top-ranking rookie rebounder in the conference.

- ▶ Canisius junior forward **Chris Manhertz** pulled down a career-high 18 rebounds in the team's win at Marist Dec. 9.
- ▶ The Bronx, N.Y., native had 12 rebounds in the first half, and he starts tonight's game averaging 13.7 rebounds per game in the team's last three contests.
- ▶ A team captain, Manhertz is currently averaging 8.0 rebounds per game, which ranks first on the Canisius roster, second in the MAAC and 96th nationally.

ASPRILLA MAKES HIS RETURN

- ▶ Canisius senior **Freddy Asprilla** played in his first game as a Golden Griffin Nov. 24, at Stony Brook after serving a three-game suspension for violation of team rules.
- ▶ The first Colombian-born player in program history, Asprilla's violation occurred during the 2011-12 season, but because he was sitting out due to NCAA transfer rules, his suspension was carried over to the start of this season.
- ▶ In his first three college basketball game since Jan. 12, 2011, when he was a member of the Kansas State program, Asprilla is averaging 3.5 points and 2.8 rebounds per game while averaging 16.5 minutes per game off the bench.

SOSA THE SHOOTER

- ▶ After sitting out the 2011-12 season following his transfer from Central Florida, senior guard **Isaac Sosa** is on this year's active roster and he's been in the starting line-up in each of the team's first five games this year.
- ▶ Sosa, who played in his 100th career college game at Stony Brook Nov. 24, left the Central Florida program ranked fourth all-time in career makes from behind the 3-point line with 189 and he is still ranked fourth in career 3-point field goal percentage at UCF after he shot 42 percent from long range.
- ▶ The Guaynabo, Puerto Rico native scored 11 points in the team's win over Marist Dec. 9 and enters today's game averaging 7.3 points and 1.9 rebounds this season.

CHARGE IT

- ▶ Canisius sophomore forward **Josiah Heath** and junior forward **Chris Manhertz** have combined to take 10 of the team's 13 offensive charges through the first seven games this season.
- ▶ Heath leads the team with five offensive charges taken this season, highlighted by the three charges he drew in the Griffis' win over Buffalo Nov. 20. Manhertz has drawn a charge in four of the team's last five games.
- ▶ Last season through 30 contests, the Griffis collected a total of 18 offensive charges, with Heath leading the way with his team-high six.

TWO-STRAIGHT SELLOUTS

- ▶ For the second-straight game, and for the 13th time since the building was renovated prior to the 2002-03 season, the Koessler Athletic Center was sold out Nov. 20, when the Golden Griffins played host to cross-town rival Buffalo.
- ▶ The Koessler Athletic Center was also sold out Nov. 17 when the Blue and Gold hosted St. Bonaventure.
- ▶ The first sellout of 2,176 in the renovated building came Dec. 19, 2003 when the Bonnies and Griffis battled in St. Bonaventure's second visit to Canisius' on-campus facility. Since that time, Canisius has added 20 courtside seats, pushing the seat capacity to 2,196.

PROTECT THIS HOUSE

- ▶ The Griffis own an all-time record of 180-108 (62.5 win percentage) in the Koessler Athletic Center, but are 59-76 (43.7 win percentage) since 2001.
- ▶ The Feb. 18, 2012, game against UMBC was the program's 285th all-time contest in the Koessler Athletic Center, which opened before the 1968-69 academic year.
- ▶ Canisius did not use the Koessler Athletic Center as its main home venue until 1999-00.

A STRONG NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULE FOR 2012-13

- ▶ This year's Canisius men's basketball schedule features a total of 12 games against schools that played in the postseason a year ago.
- ▶ The Griffis are the only team in the MAAC scheduled to play two teams in the Associated Press Top-25 Preseason Poll, as the Blue and Gold will play at No. 4/4 Syracuse tonight and at No. 20/17 UNLV (Dec. 22).
- ▶ For the first time since the 2009-10 season, Canisius is scheduled to play in an exempt in-season event, as the team takes part in the inaugural Gotham Classic. In that event, Canisius will play at Syracuse, at Temple (Dec. 19) home against Alcorn State (Dec. 27) and at Detroit (Dec. 30).
- ▶ The team's first three home games of the season were played on the Koessler Athletic Center floor - the first time in program history the Griffis have opened the year with three-in-a-row in their on-campus facility.

BILLY THE KID

- ▶ Canisius junior **Billy Baron** left Rhode Island after the 2011-12 season and chose to join his father **Jim Baron** on the Canisius men's basketball roster for 2012-13.
- ▶ Baron, who officially started his college career at Virginia before transferring to Rhode Island, averaged 13.0 points and 4.4 rebounds per game last year in 20 contests for the Rams.
- ▶ There are five father-son tandems in Division I college basketball this season. The Barons are just the fifth father-son combination in recorded Division I college basketball history to coach/play at two different Division I schools, joining basketball families like the **Suttons** (father Eddie and son Sean) and the **Williards** (father Ralph and son Kevin).

FIVE NAMED CAPTAIN FOR THIS SEASON

- ▶ Canisius head coach **Jim Baron** has announced that seniors **Alshwan Hymes, Isaac Sosa** and **Harold Washington** and juniors **Billy Baron** and **Chris Manhertz**.
- ▶ Hymes and Manhertz served as team captains last season as well.

THREE SIGN NLI TO JOIN THE CANISIUS PROGRAM

- ▶ Canisius head coach **Jim Baron** has announced that **Jermaine Crumpton (Niagara Falls/Niagara Falls, N.Y.)**, **Zach Lewis (Fishburne Military Academy/Windsor, Conn.)** and **Adam Weir (Canisius High School/Tonawanda, N.Y.)** have signed their National Letters of Intent during the NCAA's early signing period and will join the program for the 2013-14 season.
- ▶ Crumpton is a 6-foot-6, 220-pound forward who averaged 17.0 points and 9.0 rebounds per game for the Niagara Falls High School Wolverines in 2011-12, a season that saw NFHS go 17-5 overall and 11-1 in league play.
- ▶ Lewis, a 6-foot-3, 175-pound guard, is a two-time all-state selection from his time at Northwest Catholic in Connecticut. He averaged 22.2 points per game as a senior at Northwest Catholic and is currently spending a prep year at Fishburne.
- ▶ Weir is a 6-foot-4, 185-pound shooting guard who averaged 18.0 points and 7.0 rebounds per game in his junior season for the Crusaders. He was named the team's MVP as a junior and helped lead Canisius High to its second-straight Manhattan Cup as the champions of the Monsignor Martin Association.
- ▶ Weir is the first Canisius High School player to sign an NLI to join the Canisius College men's basketball team since former Griff **Darren Fenn** signed his NLI as a senior in 1996.

FRED DUPREE BACK AT CANISIUS

- ▶ New head coach **Jim Baron** brought back a former Griff to be a part of his new coaching staff this season when he hired former forward **Fred Dupree**.
- ▶ After his playing days, the Brooklyn, N.Y., native went on to coaching stints at Rider, where he helped the Broncs to back-to-back regular-season MAAC crowns in 2002 and 2003 before heading south to work at the College of Charleston for six seasons.
- ▶ Dupree helped recruit and develop NBA Draft picks Jason Thompson (12th overall by Sacramento in 2008) and Andrew Goudelock (second round pick of the Los Angeles Lakers in 2011).
- ▶ Dupree played in 98 career games for Canisius from 1994-98 and was a member of the 1996 MAAC Championship squad, the last team to earn a berth into the Division I Men's Basketball Tournament.

MEET THE NEW STAFF

- ▶ Head coach **Jim Baron** has built an impressive coaching staff in his first year at Canisius - a staff that features more than 35 years of combined coaching experience.
- ▶ Joining Baron on the Griff's bench this season is **Pat Clarke**, a long-time Baron assistant who worked with him at St. Bonaventure and Rhode Island. Clarke is a 1992 graduate of St. Bonaventure.
- ▶ Along with former Canisius player **Fred Dupree**, who came back to Main Street after working at the College of Charleston for six season, is **Mike Mennenga**, who most recently served as an assistant at Illinois-Chicago.
- ▶ Mennenga served as a color commentator for Time Warner Sports in Buffalo last season, and has also coached as an assistant at Providence, Iowa State and cross-town rival Buffalo.

IUZZOLINO REJOINS BARON

- ▶ In June, head coach **Jim Baron** announced that **Mike Iuzzolino** had joined the Golden Griffins program as the team's director of basketball operations. Iuzzolino spent the previous three seasons as the associate head coach at Saint Vincent College in Latrobe, Pa.
- ▶ Iuzzolino played for Baron at St. Francis (Pa.) and helped lead the Red Flash to the program's only NCAA Tournament berth in 1991. The 1991 Northeast Conference Player of the Year, Iuzzolino was also honored for his work in the classroom as he was named the 1991 CoSIDA Academic All-American Player of the Year.
- ▶ The Altoona, Pa., native went on to play 10 years of professional basketball, including two seasons for the Dallas Mavericks, who drafted him in the second round (35th overall) in the 1991 NBA Draft. During the 1991-92, he ranked fourth in the NBA in 3-point field goal percentage after he shot 43.4 percent from long-range.
- ▶ Iuzzolino went on to play in the CBA and overseas in Italy, Greece and Spain. He began his college coaching career at Duquesne in 2005 when he worked with the Dukes' women's basketball program.

- ▶ Canisius will return home for the first time since Nov. 20, when the Griff's play host to Longwood in the Koessler Athletic Center on Monday, Dec. 17. The game will tipoff at 7 p.m., and will be broadcast live on Time Warner Cable SportsChannel.

Griffs Return to the BracketBuster

The Canisius College men's basketball team will once again take part in the annual ESPN BracketBuster series, which is set to run Feb. 22-23, 2013. Canisius will be a road team this year after hosting UMBC in the event during the 2011-12 campaign.



Canisius has appeared in the BracketBuster event seven previous times, with the Golden Griffins boasting a 5-2 record in those seven contests. After beating UMBC at home last year, the team moved to 4-0 in the BracketBuster in home games.

The 11th annual BracketBusters, a two-day men's college basketball event pitting potential NCAA Championship hopefuls against each other, will feature 13 nationally televised games - across ESPN2, ESPNU and ESPN3. The NCAA hopefuls will be selected from a pool of 122 teams from 15 conferences, including Ohio University, which made a run into the Sweet Sixteen. The Griff's opponent and game date will be announced in early February.

Canisius Co-Hosts 2014 NCAA Tournament in Buffalo

On Nov. 12, the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Committee announced that the second and third rounds of the 2014 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Tournament would return to First Niagara Center in downtown Buffalo. Canisius, along with the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference and Niagara University will co-host the event, which will run March 20 & 22, 2014.



The 2104 tournament will mark the fifth time Canisius, the MAAC and Niagara have co-hosted the event in Buffalo. All four previous occasions have been sold out. A total of 53 cities put in bids to host rounds of the 2014 and 2015 tournaments, with 25 towns being selected by the NCAA.

Ticket information through Canisius will be online at GoGriffs.com when it becomes available.

TV Time

The Canisius men's basketball team will make nine appearances on TV and ESPN3 this season, starting with the team's game at Syracuse Dec. 15, which will be shown live on Time Warner Cable Sports Channel throughout New York State. The Griff's will have both of their home games in the month of December on Time Warner Cable SportsChannel (Dec. 17 against Longwood and Dec. 27 against Alcorn State) and will also play televised road games at Siena and Niagara.



As part of the MAAC's broadcast package, the Blue and Gold will also play three games on ESPN3, starting Jan. 27, when the Griff's host long-time rival Niagara at 4 p.m., in the Koessler Athletic Center. Canisius is also scheduled to be on ESPN3 Feb. 7 at Manhattan and Feb. 28, when the team hosts Saint Peter's.

Canisius Men's Basketball Game Notes



Jim Baron

Head Coach • First Season at Canisius • St. Bonaventure '77

Jim Baron, a winner of 395 career games that includes eight 20-win seasons, two NCAA Tournament berths and 11 postseason appearances, was named the 23rd head coach in Canisius College men's basketball history, Canisius College Director of Athletics Bill Maher announced on April 2.

"I am extremely pleased to introduce Jim Baron as our men's basketball coach," Maher said at the time of Baron's hiring. "In naming Jim to this position, we have hired a man who has a proven track record of building successful basketball programs and developing young men. He is excited to return to Western New York to lead the Canisius College basketball program.

"Jim comes to us as a highly respected coach, having led three different institutions to postseason success. Our goal is to win the MAAC Championship, and I look forward to working with Jim to accomplish this goal at Canisius College."

A head coach at the Division I level for the past 25 seasons and a four-time Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year (1995 at St. Bonaventure, 2003, 2007 and 2009 at Rhode Island), Baron returns to Western New York after spending the previous 11 years at the University of Rhode Island where he won 184 games, made six postseason appearances (all 20-win seasons) and enjoyed a four-week appearance in the national rankings during the 2007-08 season. He improved the Rams' win total in six-straight seasons, from six wins in 2004-05 to 26 victories in 2009-10, and he helped guide the Rhode Island program to the 2010 NIT Final Four in Madison Square Garden, the team's first appearance in the NIT semifinal round since 1946.

"This is a great day for Canisius College basketball," Canisius College president John J. Hurley said when Baron was hired. "Jim Baron has demonstrated throughout his career that it is possible to match success on the court with success in the classroom. He has been a positive influence in the lives of hundreds of young men, and I'm tremendously excited about the prospect of working with Jim to restore Golden Griffin basketball to glory."

A 1977 graduate of St. Bonaventure University and 2009 inductee into the St. Bonaventure Athletics Hall of Fame, Baron spent nine seasons as head coach at his alma mater (1992-2001). Prior to his return to Olean, N.Y., the Bonnies had won 22 combined games during the previous three seasons. In his third year at the helm, he guided the team to an 18-13 record and a trip to the 1995 NIT. In his final two seasons, Baron led the Bonnies to a 39-22 mark, including the program's first trip to the NCAA Tournament in 22 years, where St. Bonaventure fell to heavily favored Kentucky by a score of 85-80 in double overtime in the first round of the 2000 NCAA Tournament.

Baron's first head coaching experience came at St. Francis University (Pa.) in Loretto, Pa., where he led the Red Flash to the 1991 NCAA Tournament. That year, the team posted a 24-8 overall record and a 13-3 mark in the Northeast Conference, which resulted in the program's only NEC Tournament title and appearance in the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Tournament.

Before becoming a head coach, Baron, 58, was an assistant coach at four institutions - the University of Notre Dame (1981-87), St. Bonaventure (1980-81), Loyola University (Md.) (1979-80) and the University of Rochester (1978-79). He got his start in coaching at Aquinas High School in Rochester, N.Y. During his four years as a student-athlete at St. Bonaventure, the Bonnies were 72-38 and as a senior, Baron served as a co-captain when the Bonnies went 24-6 and won the 1977 NIT Championship.

Baron and his wife Cindy have two sons, Jimmy - a former standout guard for Rhode Island who graduated from the school in 2009 - and Billy, who is currently enrolled at Canisius and is a junior guard on the men's basketball team.
