GRIFF-INFO

► Canisius makes its first trip to Monmouth's campus this afternoon as the Golden Griffins meet the Hawks for the second time in the last seven days.

► The Griffins are coming off an 85-83 win over Iona on Friday night in New Rochelle, N.Y. In a wild game that saw Canisius lead by as many as 20 in the second half, Iona fought back and eventually took the lead late, but the Blue and Gold held the Gaels to two points over the game's final 4:52 to secure the win.

► The Griffins come into this game with an 12-6 overall record and a 6-1 mark in MAAC play. This marks the second time since 1989-90 where the Griffins are 6-1 in league play after seven games. The only other 6-1 start in MAAC play came in the 1996-97 season.

FAST BREAK POINTS

► The Griffins are averaging 81.4 points per game in MAAC action this season.

► Canisius senior **Billy Baron** became the school's 34th 1,000-point scorer on Friday when he hit two free-throws with 3:51 left in the game. He scored his 1,000th point at Canisius in his 52nd career game in a Griff uniform, making him the fifth fastest player in school history to reach the famed scoring milestone.

► Canisius senior **Chris Perez** was good for 17 points in the win over Iona Friday. The Griffins are 7-2 this season when he scored in double-figures.

► Senior center **Jordan Heath** registered a season-high 12 rebounds at Iona, one shy of matching his career high, set last year. Of his game-high 12 boards Friday, nine came off the defensive glass.



ABOUT THE HAWKS

- Monmouth comes into this afternoon's game with an 8-10 overall record and a 2-5 mark in MAAC action. The Hawks have dropped two straight after falling at Quinnipiac Thursday night.
- Monmouth is 5-4 at home this season overall, but 1-2 in MAAC home dates.
- Junior **Dion Jones** leads Monmouth with his 15.3 points and 6.5 rebounds per game. Jones ranks 12th in the MAAC in scoring and eighth in the conference in rebounding average.
- Freshman guard **Justin Robinson** has started all 18 games for Monmouth and comes into the game averaging 3.8 assists per game, which ranks sixth in the league.
- Monmouth ranks seventh in the MAAC in scoring average and average points allowed. The Hawks are scoring 71.0 points per game, while giving up 73.4 points per contest.

CANISIUS - MONMOUTH SERIES

- This will mark the second all-time meeting between these two schools, with the first contest coming just seven days ago in Buffalo.
- Last week, the Griffins defeated Monmouth 87-67 in the Koessler Athletic Center. In that game, Canisius senior **Billy Baron** scored a game-high 26 points while freshman guard **Zach Lewis** added a career-high 25 points on the power of seven made 3-pointers.
- Monmouth is in its first year as a MAAC member. Previously, the Hawks played in the NEC. Canisius head coach **Jim Baron** is 7-6 all-time against Monmouth, with five of those wins coming when he served as the head coach of St. Francis (Pa.).

2013-14 GAME DAY INFORMATION

A DEEPER LOOK AT THE GRIFFS

- Canisius comes into this game having won three straight, four of their last five and nine of their last 11 since losing to Metro State Nov. 26 in the final game of the NIT Season Tip Off.
- The Griffins knocked down a season-high 32 field goals in the win over Iona on Friday night. Canisius shot 51.6 percent from the field as a team in the win over the Gaels, the fourth time this season the team has been 50 percent or better from the floor in a game.
- Canisius is 17-8 in MAAC games under second-year head coach **Jim Baron**. Seven of those victories have come on the road.
- The Griffins come into today's game at Monmouth with four players shooting better than 40 percent from 3-point land. Senior center **Jordan Heath** is shooting a team-best 47.5 percent (29-for-61) from long range, while fellow senior **Billy Baron** is shooting 44.2 percent (57-for-129) from behind the arc.
- Through seven MAAC games, the Blue and Gold is averaging 81.4 points per game. The Griffins have scored 80-plus points in three-straight league games and in five conference contests overall.

ANNIVERSARIES THIS SEASON

- The 2013-14 season marks the 110th year of Canisius College men's basketball. The Golden Griffins played their first varsity game Dec. 7, 1903 - a 14-6 win over Gordon's of Buffalo.
- All-time, Canisius is 1,212-1,181 (.506 win percentage). The Griffins have been to four NCAA Tournaments, five NIT events and they have played in one CIT. Canisius has won 20 games in a season a total of seven times, most recently last year.
- This year will also mark the 25th season that Canisius has played in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference. All-time, the Blue and Gold is 169-241 in MAAC regular season contests. Canisius has claimed one MAAC Tournament title, which came in 1996.
- This season also marks the 20th anniversary of Canisius' 1994 NIT team, which was coached by current Michigan head coach **John Beilein**. The Griffins went 22-7 that season and lost in the first round of the NIT to Villanova in Philadelphia, Pa.

GRIFFS LIGHTING UP THE SCOREBOARD

- Canisius comes into today's game averaging 75.6 points per game through 18 contests, and the team is averaging 81.4 points per game in seven MAAC contests this season.
- In the team's double overtime win over Rider Jan. 10, Canisius scored a season-high 94 points, the second time this season the team has scored more than 90 points in a game. The last four times Canisius has posted 90-plus in a game, that contest has been a MAAC game, and three of those four occasions have come in the Koessler Athletic Center.
- The Blue and Gold's 85 points at Iona gives the team 80-plus points scored in three-straight games. The Griffins have scored 80-plus points in two separate stretches of three-straight games this season. Prior to this season, Canisius has not scored 80-plus in three-straight ball games since Feb. 23-March 2, 2002.

BOMBS AWAY

- The Griffins knocked down a season-high 15 3-point field goals and shot 57.7 percent (15-for-26) from 3-point range in the team's win over Siena Dec. 8, in the Koessler Athletic Center.
- Dating back to last season, the Blue and Gold have hit 10-or more 3-pointers in 23 of the team's last 52 contests.
- Canisius comes into today's game shooting 41.0 percent from 3-point land. That ranks third in the MAAC and 15th in the nation.
- The Griffins rank second in the MAAC and 26th in the nation in 3-pointers made per game with 8.4 per contest. Last year, the Griffins led the MAAC and ranked third in the nation with 9.2 3-point field goals per game last season.

CANISIUS COMEBACKS

- So far this season, Canisius has won two games when trailing by 11 points in the game's second half, most recently overcoming an 11-point second-half deficit to beat Buffalo Dec. 11.
- Canisius trailed Elon by 11 points with 9:31 left to play when the teams met in the NIT Season Tip Off Nov. 19. The Blue and Gold scored the game's final nine points to secure the 86-85 victory.
- On Dec. 11 at Buffalo, the Griffins used a 24-6 run in the last 10-plus minutes to beat their cross-town rivals by the final score of 69-55.
- Canisius trailed Rider by nine points with 10:40 left in regulation time when the two teams met in Buffalo Jan. 10. The Griffins fought back to send the game into overtime and eventually won the contest in double-overtime on the power of **Billy Baron** and his career-high 38 points.

TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

- Canisius comes into today's game with 199 total turnovers through 18 games, an average of 11.1 per contest.
- Canisius matched a season-low with six turnovers in the team's win over Buffalo Dec. 11. In their three contests from Dec. 6-11, the Griffins were charged with 21 total turnovers. In the team's last three outings, Canisius has committed 32 total turnovers (14 against Rider, seven against Monmouth and 11 at Iona).
- In the MAAC, Canisius ranks second in the league in turnover margin (plus 2.35). Nationally, Canisius ranks 57th in turnover margin and 61st in turnovers per game.

THE GLASS NEEDS WORK

- Canisius has struggled in the rebounding battles this season, as the Griffins come into this game tonight having only out rebounded six opponents in 18 games.
- Canisius ranks 10th in the MAAC with its 32.7 rebounds per game. The team has been out rebounded in five of its last 11 outings. In the loss at Marist Jan. 6, each team had 34 rebounds, the only time this season where the Griffins matched their opponents' final rebounding number.
- The Griffins are 6-0 this year when the Blue and Gold wins the rebounding battle, which last happened Jan. 17 at Iona. The team's rebounding margin of minus 3.3 ranks ninth in the MAAC and 298th in the country.

WORKING OVERTIME

- Canisius has played in two overtime games this season, with the Griffins holding a 1-1 mark in those two contests. The Griffins are now 3-1 under head coach **Jim Baron** when playing extra periods.
- Canisius' overtime victory this season came Jan. 10, at home when the Blue and Gold defeated Rider 94-91 in double-overtime. That marked Canisius' first double-overtime victory since Feb. 14, 1987, when the team went on the road and beat Niagara in two OTs by the score of 78-76.
- All-time, Canisius has played a total of 124 overtime games in program history, with the team boasting an all-time record of 81-43. The double-overtime win over Rider Jan. 10, moved the team to 9-9 all-time in games that featured multiple overtimes to decide the final outcome.
- Canisius lost to Notre Dame in overtime Dec. 29, by the score of 87-81. That loss was Canisius' first overtime loss since Feb. 15, 2012, when the Griffins lost at Niagara in OT. Canisius has played more overtime games against Niagara (18) than any other opponent.

BARON FILLING IT UP FOR CANISIUS

- Senior guard **Billy Baron** leads the Griffins and ranks fifth in the nation with his 23.2 points per game this season. In his first 52 games as a Griff, he has scored 1,002 total points (an average of 19.3 points per game).

Baron scored a career-high 38 points in the team's double-overtime win over Rider Jan. 10. That stands as the most points for a Canisius player in the Koessler Athletic Center since former Griff **Craig Prosser** scored a school-record 39 points in the KAC Feb. 3, 1976 against Siena.

- The East Greenwich, R.I., native scored 33 points in the team's overtime loss to Notre Dame Dec. 29. That 30-plus point effort against the Fighting Irish makes him just the sixth player in Canisius history to have 30-or more points in multiple road games during his career.
- Baron's current Canisius career scoring average of 19.3 points per game ranks fifth all-time in school history among players with at least 40 career games played as a Griff. The last Canisius player to end their career with a scoring average better than 18 points per game was **Ray Hall**, who averaged 19.4 points per game in 115 career contests from 1981-85.

BARON REACHES 1,000-POINT MARK AT CANISIUS

- Senior guard **Billy Baron** became the 34th player in Canisius history to score 1,000 career points on Jan. 17 at Iona, when he drained a pair of free-throws with 3:51 left in the team's win over the Gaels.

Baron reached the famed 1,000-career point milestone in his 52nd career game as a Griff. That makes him the the fifth fastest player in school history to score 1,000 points during his time in Blue and Gold.

- Baron scored a team-high 584 points last season, the most points in a single-season for a Griff in 28 years. He has scored 20-plus points in 28 career games (23 at Canisius) and 30 or more points in a game six times (all at Canisius).

BARON GOES FOR 25 IN SIX STRAIGHT

- **Billy Baron** scored a game-high 29 points in the team's win at Iona Friday night. That marked the sixth-straight game and the seventh time in the team's last eight games where the senior guard has been good for 25 or more points in a game.
- Baron is the first Griff since **Larry Fogle** in 1973-74 to score 25 or more points in five consecutive games. Fogle had two streaks of 25 or more in five-straight games in that season, highlighted by his school-record 11-straight contests with 25 or more points in the final box score.

IT HAS BEEN A WHILE...

- Canisius senior **Billy Baron** became the first player since former Griff **Jon Popofski** to win a game for the Golden Griffins with a buzzer-beater when the team defeated Elon 86-85 Nov. 19, in the NIT Season Tip Off in Piscataway, N.J.
- Baron's 3-pointer at the final horn capped a Canisius comeback which saw the Griffins outscore the Phoenix 13-6 in the game's last 4:42.
- The East Greenwich, R.I., native knocked down his second buzzer-beater of the 2013-14 season Jan. 10, when he drained a deep 3-pointer at the final horn in the second overtime to lift Canisius past Rider by a final score of 94-91.
- There were a total of 223 Canisius games between Baron's game-winner against Elon and Popofski's game-winner against Loyola (Md.) in the 2006 MAAC Tournament. This year, Baron has hit two game-winning shots in a span of 12 games.

BARON JOINS AN ELITE LIST IN SOUTH BEND

- Canisius senior guard **Billy Baron** not only matched a then career-high with his 33 points in the team's overtime loss at Notre Dame Dec. 29, he also joined an elite list of visiting players to score 33 or more points against Notre Dame in Purcell Pavilion.
- Baron is the first visiting player since **Will Walker** from DePaul to score 33-plus in a game against the Irish on their home court. Walker had 35 points for DePaul Jan. 23, 2010.
- Baron's 33 points not only ties him for the sixth-best single-game scoring effort by a Notre Dame opponent in Purcell Pavilion, but it also ties him for 10th on Canisius' single-game road scoring record list. He scored 33 points in a Canisius win at Niagara Feb. 10, 2012.

WELCOME TO CANISIUS

- Canisius senior **Chris Perez** made his Griff debut Nov. 11 against South Dakota. He is one of 10 players on the Canisius roster that did not register a minute for the Blue and Gold in the 2012-13 season.
- Perez transferred to Canisius after spending the three previous years at Stetson. At Stetson, he was named All-Atlantic Sun Second Team in 2012-13 after he averaged 15.1 points and 4.1 rebounds per game for the Hatters.
- The Santiago, Dominican Republic native earned his undergraduate degree from Stetson in May 2013, and he is currently working on his master's degree in sport administration at the College.
- Perez ranks third on the team with his 10.4 points per game. He has posted double figures in the scoring column nine times this season and 56 times in his 109 career games. Canisius is 7-2 in those nine contests this season.

MANHERTZ JOINS THE 600 BOARD CLUB

- Canisius senior forward **Chris Manhertz** became the 16th player in school history to record 600-plus career rebounds after he was credited with six boards in the team's loss to Metro State Nov. 26.
- Manhertz, who started the season as the MAAC's top returning rebounder after he pulled 8.7 rebounds per game in 2012-13, comes into today's game ranked 12th in school history with his 682 boards.
- In the team's last five outings, he is averaging 5.4 rebounds per game. He starts this game against Monmouth averaging 5.6 rebounds per game in seven league contests.
- Manhertz had a season-high 11 rebounds at Notre Dame Dec. 29. In his career, he's been good for double-digit rebounds in 22 of his 102 games in a Canisius uniform.

A CAREER NIGHT FOR JORDAN HEATH

- Canisius senior **Jordan Heath** had a career-night Dec. 6 as the Griffins defeated Saint Peter's at home in the MAAC opener for both squads. Heath had a career-high 28 points to go with 10 rebounds for his third career double-double.
- Heath went 11-for-17 from the field and 4-for-6 from 3-point land in the win, setting new career highs for field goals made (11), field goals attempted in a game (17) and 3-pointers made in a contest (4). He also added two blocked shots.
- Three of Heath's four career double-doubles have come in MAAC play, with his previous double-double efforts coming Jan. 31, 2013 when he had 21 points and 11 boards in a home win over Loyola (Md.). He registered his fourth career double-double Dec. 29 at Notre Dame when he posted 13 points and 11 rebounds in 36 minutes of action.

THE BIG BLOCKER

- Canisius senior **Jordan Heath** set a school record with nine blocked shots in the Griffins' win over Rider Jan. 10, at home.
- Heath comes into today's game ranked second in the MAAC with his 2.4 blocks per game, which also ranks him 41st in the nation in blocked shots per game.
- The Rochester, N.Y., native now has 96 career blocked shots in 49 career games as a Griff, which breaks down to 2.0 blocks per contest. He currently ranks 10th all-time in school history with his 96 blocks, and his 2.0 blocks per game average ranks third in program history among players with 40 or more career games played in a Canisius uniform.

HEATH HAS A SHOOTER'S TOUCH TOO

- Canisius senior **Jordan Heath** is not only one of the league's top shot blockers, but he also has an offensive game as well. The 6-foot-10 center starts today's game ranked second in the MAAC in field goal percentage at 54.5 percent.
- Entering today's game, Heath is shooting 51.3 percent from the field (20-for-39) in the Griffins' last five games, and he also has the ability to step out and knock down a 3-point field goal as well. Heath is shooting 47.5 percent (29-for-61) from behind the arc this season, which ranks third in the MAAC.
- The Rochester, N.Y., native had a slam dunk basket in the win at Iona Friday to give him a team-high 12 dunks this season. Over the last two years, he has a total of 46 dunks, which means 35.7 percent (46-of-129) of his two-point field goals in 49 career games have been dunks.

LEWIS GETS INTO THE ACTION

- Canisius freshman **Zach Lewis** made his first career start for the Griffins Jan. 10, against Rider, where he scored 12 points to go with five rebounds and three assists in 46 minutes of action. He is the first true freshman to play for head coach **Jim Baron** in his first two years at the helm of the Canisius program.
- Lewis missed two games (Nov. 25-26) with a quad injury, but has since returned and is averaging 10.4 points per game in 11 games since Dec. 6 vs. Saint Peter's.

LEWIS SCORES 25 AGAINST MONMOUTH

- Canisius freshman **Zach Lewis** scored a career-high 25 points in the team's win over Monmouth Jan. 12. That stands as the most points in a game for a Canisius freshman since **Micheal Meeks** has 25 points in a win over Saint Peter's Feb. 11, 1993.
- Of Lewis' 25 points, 21 came on the power of seven makes from 3-point land. His seven makes from behind the arc set a new Canisius freshman record for 3-point field goals in a game.

VALENTI PROVIDES ENERGY OFF THE BENCH

- Canisius redshirt freshman **Phil Valenti** came off the bench and scored a career-high 12 points (eight in the second half and overtime periods) in the Griffins' 94-91 double-overtime win over Rider Jan. 10.
- Valenti led all players with 10 rebounds in the Griffins' 71-66 win over South Dakota Nov. 11.
- The Victor, N.Y., native is just the second Griff in the last 30 years to record double-digit rebounds in his first career game. Former Griff **Rigoberto Sargent** had 11 rebounds in his first career game, the 2004-05 opener against Howard.
- Valenti sat out the entire 2012-13 season, but did practice and travel with the team. He came to Canisius after averaging 25 points and 12 rebounds per game in his senior year at Aquinas High School in Rochester, N.Y.

CANISIUS' LOCAL CONNECTION

- Two of Canisius' six newcomers this season are familiar to Western New York, as they both grew up within a 30 minute drive of the school's Main Street campus.
- Freshman **Adam Weir** (Tonawanda, N.Y.) went to Canisius High School and he is the first Canisius High grad to sign an NLI to join the Griffins since Hall of Famer **Darren Fenn** signed his NLI out of high school in 1997.
- Fellow freshman **Jermaine Crumpton** (Niagara Falls, N.Y.) graduated from Niagara Falls High School, a local high school powerhouse that has recently produced players like **Paul Harris** and **Johnny Flynn**, who both played at Syracuse.
- Both players were named to the 2013 *Buffalo News* All-Western New York First Team, with Weir earning the 2012 Allen Wilson Player of the Year Award following his senior season at Canisius High.

ROCHESTER CONNECTIONS, TOO

- This year's Canisius roster features three players from Rochester, N.Y., including redshirt freshman **Phil Valenti**.
- Valenti comes to Canisius after playing at Aquinas in Rochester, N.Y. The Victor, N.Y., native was honored as the Greater Rochester Player of the Year by the *Rochester Democrat and Chronicle* in 2011 after he averaged 25 points and 12 rebounds while helping the Little Irish to the New York State Class AA championship game.
- Senior center **Jordan Heath** and his brother, junior **Josiah Heath** also call Rochester home. Josiah Heath was named the 2010-11 Greater Rochester Player of the Year by the *Rochester Democrat and Chronicle* after he helped guide Irondequoit High School to the program's first Section V championship in 66 years.

PROTECT THIS HOUSE

- The Griffins own an all-time record of 195-112 (.635 win percentage) in the Koessler Athletic Center, but are 74-80 (.481 win percentage) since 2001.
- Canisius did not use the Koessler Athletic Center as its main home venue until 1999-00.

TAKING CARE OF BUSINESS AT HOME

- Canisius set a new program record with 12 wins in the Koessler Athletic Center last season.
- The previous KAC single-season win record was held by the 1983-84 and the 2010-11 teams, which each collected 10 wins in the school's on-campus facility.
- Under second-year head coach **Jim Baron**, the Griffins are 18-4 at home, with the team posting a 6-0 record at home this season in six home dates.

CANISIUS IN THE CLOSE ONES

- Canisius is 14-19 in games decided by two points or less since 2001-02 and 23-36 in games decided by four points or less, dating back to 2004-05.
- The Griffins are 49-81 in games decided by six points or less, dating back to the 2002-03 season.

GRIFFS GET TO 20 IN 2012-13

- The 2012-13 Canisius men's basketball team reached the 20-win mark, the first time the team has won 20 games in a season since 2000-01.

What is a Griffin?

The Griffin is a mythical creature of supposed gigantic size that has the head, forelegs and wings of an eagle and the hindquarters, tail and ears of a lion. They are well known for their speed, ability to fly and having eyes like an eagle as well as the strength and courage of a lion.



Griffins have been known for centuries as symbols of strength and vigilance, have been called "The Hounds of Zeus" in Greek mythology and are said to have mastery of both the land and sky.

They are thought to be from India, where the natives of the land made their talons and claws into drinking cups because the talon of a Griffin was said to detect poison in a liquid. Griffins would find gold in the mountains and line their nests with it and as a result, were forced to become great guardians of the nests to keep the hunters away.

For the fifth time since 2000, the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Committee has announced that the second and third rounds of the 2014 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Tournament will return to First Niagara Center in downtown Buffalo. Canisius, along with the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference and Niagara University will co-host the event, which will run March 20 & 22, 2014.



The 2014 tournament will mark the fifth time Canisius, the MAAC and Niagara have co-hosted the event in Buffalo. All four previous occasions have been sold out. A total of 53 cities put in bids to host rounds of the 2014 and 2015 tournaments, with 25 towns being selected by the NCAA.

 ► The Griffins return their top scorer (**Billy Baron**), top rebounder (**Chris Manhertz**), leader in assists and steals (Baron) and shot blocker (**Jordan Heath**).
 ► Baron led the team with 17.2 points per game, which ranked third in the MAAC last year, and his 5.0 assists per game ranked tops in the MAAC. Manhertz's 8.7 rebounds per game ranked second in the league and 50th nationally.

WHAT THEY LOST

► Canisius is looking for find ways to replace two of the team's top-five scorers from a season ago, as former guards **Isaac Sosa** and **Harold Washington** graduated last May.
 ► Washington averaged 13.8 points per game last year and earned All-MAAC Third-Team honors, while Sosa chipped in 11.6 points per game. Sosa also set the school's single-season record with 95 3-point field goals.
 ► Washington closed out his college career averaging better than 15 points per game in his 64 games as a Griff.
 ► Two other Canisius guards also graduated last May, as seniors **Alshwan Hymes** and **Reggie Groves** ended their time in a Canisius uniform. In all, Canisius lost a total of 400-career games played with last year's graduating class.

MEET THE CANISIUS STAFF

► Head coach **Jim Baron** has built an impressive coaching staff at Canisius - a staff that features more than 38 years of combined coaching experience.
 ► Joining Baron on the Griffins' bench again this season is **Pat Clarke**, a long-time Baron assistant who worked with him at St. Bonaventure and Rhode Island. Clarke is a 1992 graduate of St. Bonaventure.
 ► Along with former Canisius player **Fred Dupree**, who came back to Main Street after working at the College of Charleston from 2006-12, is **Mike Mennenga**, who previously served as an assistant at Illinois-Chicago.

CHUCK HARRIS BACK AT CANISIUS

► Head coach **Jim Baron** announced that **Chuck Harris** has joined the Golden Griffins program as the team's director of basketball operations.
 ► Harris played 115 games at Canisius from 2003-07, where he scored 1,090 points to go with 555 rebounds and 312 assists.
 ► The Detroit, Mich., native was named Third-Team All-MAAC after his senior year in 2006-07, and he left the Canisius program as one of three players in school history to score more than 1,000 career points while recording 500-plus rebounds and 300-plus career assists.

BRIAN DUX TO BE INDUCTED INTO CANISIUS SPORTS HALL OF FAME

► Former Canisius guard **Brian Dux** (1999-03) will be inducted into the Canisius Sports Hall of Fame Feb. 9, 2014, when the Griffins play host to Iona in the Koessler Athletic Center on Hall of Fame Day.
 ► Dux, who is one of nine Griffins to earn All-MAAC postseason honors in two different seasons, scored 1,239 career points and dished out 508 assists in his 119 career games.
 ► The Orchard Park, N.Y., native is still the school's career free-throw percentage leader at 82.9 percent.

NEXT UP FOR THE GRIFFS

► Canisius will return home for the final time in January with a pair of MAAC home games, starting Jan. 22, when the team hosts long-time rival Niagara in the Koessler Athletic Center.
 ► The Griffins and Purple Eagles will meet for the first time this season and for the 173rd time in series history. Last year, each team won a regular-season game on the road.

- Canisius named **Jim Baron** the program's 23rd head coach in program history April 2, 2012.
- In his 27-year head coaching career, Baron has won 421 career games, has posted eight 20-win seasons and he's taken nine team at four different Division I schools to the postseason.
- In his first year at the helm of the Canisius College men's basketball program, Baron helped guide the Golden Griffins to a 20-14 overall record, the program's first 20-win season since 2000-01.
- Baron's first team on Main Street in Buffalo earned a berth into the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT), the school's first postseason berth since 1996.
- Prior to coming to Canisius, Baron served as the head coach at Rhode Island for 11 seasons, where he posted 184 total wins with six postseason appearances (all 20-win campaigns) and led the team to a four-week stint in the Associated Press Top-25 poll during the 2007-08 season.
- Baron was the head coach at his alma mater, St. Bonaventure, from 1992-01, and he led the Bonnies to their first NCAA appearance in 39 years when the team played Kentucky in the 2000 NCAA Tournament First Round.
- In all, Baron has been named the Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year four times. Only former Temple head coach and Basketball Hall of Famer **John Cheney** has won that award more than Baron.
- He got his first head coaching job at St. Francis (PA) in Loretto, Pa. He coached the team to the 1991 NEC championship and 1991 NCAA Tournament, the Red Flash's only NEC crown and NCAA Tournament berth.
- Baron served as an assistant coach for nine seasons at four different schools, including his alma mater, St. Bonaventure. He was a member of **Digger Phelps'** staff at Notre Dame for 1981-87.
- The Brooklyn, N.Y., native got his coaching career started at Aquinas High School in Rochester, N.Y.
- Baron won four varsity letters at St. Bonaventure as a player, where the team went 72-38 in four years.
- As a senior captain in 1977, Baron helped lead the Bonnies to a 24-6 record and the 1977 NIT Championship.
- Baron and his wife, Cindy, have two children - sons Jimmy and Billy. Both of his sons have played for him at the collegiate level.
- Baron's older son Jimmy, who played for him at Rhode Island, currently plays overseas in Italy.
- Billy is in his senior year on the Canisius roster and is the first player in school history to be named the MAAC's Preseason Player of the Year.
- Baron is active in numerous charitable groups, including the American Cancer Society Coaches vs. Cancer program and Camp Good Days and Special Times.
- He is a member of the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) International Coaches Group as well.
- He has been inducted into the St. Bonaventure Hall of Fame and the New England Basketball Hall of Fame as well.
- Since coming to Canisius, Baron has inserted himself in the Buffalo community, stressing to local youth groups and boy's clubs the importance of "Books and Basketball".
- His stance on strong academics is not just for the local youth in the Buffalo area - he also stresses school work with his players as well. In his head coaching career, all but two of his former players that played for him for four seasons have earned their undergraduate degrees.




