### GRIFFS TO FACE ROBERT MORRIS IN HOME OPENER

The Canisius College hockey team will open Atlantic Hockey play this weekend, when they take on Robert Morris from the HARBORCENTER Friday and Saturday evening at 7:35 p.m. ET. The Griff's went 1-3-0 against the Colonials a season ago, allowing six goals in three-of-four contests. Canisius is coming off of a 1-1 weekend at the 2016 Brice Alaska Goal Rush, which saw the team get a 2-1 overtime victory over Alaska Friday night.

### SCOUTING THE GRIFFS

- ▶ Canisius is 1-3-0 to begin the season after being swept by defending national champion North Dakota two weekends ago, and splitting last weekend's games from the 2016 Brice Alaska Goal Rush Tournament.
- ▶ The Griff's have nine players tied for the team lead in points (1).
- ▶ The Griff's saw strong performances from their goaltenders this past weekend, with Senior goaltender Charles Williams making 27 saves against Alaska to gain his first career victory in a Canisius uniform. Freshman goaltender Daniel Urbani made his collegiate debut on Saturday vs. Alaska Anchorage, allowing one goal on 25 saves.

### GRIFFS COMPETE IN BRICE ALASKA GOAL RUSH

- ▶ The Golden Griffins went 1-1 last weekend from the 2016 Brice Alaska Goal Rush in Fairbanks, Alaska.
- ▶ The Blue and Gold defeated Alaska 2-1 in overtime on Friday evening, before losing to Alaska Anchorage on Saturday afternoon 1-0.
- ▶ Senior Geoff Fortman recorded the game-winning goal in a 2-1 overtime win against Alaska (his second career goal), while sophomore **Dylan McLaughlin** scored the team's first goal of the weekend to tie the game in the third.
- ▶ The Griff's nearly sent game two to overtime, when freshman **Jesse Pereira** hit the post on a shot with five seconds remaining in the game.
- ▶ Fortman and McLaughlin were named to the 2016 Brice Alaska Goal Rush All-Tournament team for their play over the weekend.

## GRIFFS PICKED NINTH IN PRESEASON RANKINGS

- ▶ Canisius was picked to place ninth in the annual Atlantic Hockey Conference preseason coaches poll.
- ▶ The Griffis earned 27 points, 16 points behind eighth-place Bentley.
- ▶ Canisius was picked to finish fourth in last year's preseason poll. The team ended in seventh place after going 10-13-5 in league play.

## ATLANTIC HOCKEY PREVIEW

- ▶ Two-time defending Atlantic Hockey champion RIT was selected as the preseason favorite in this years preseason coaches poll.
- ▶ Air Force was chosen to finish second, with Holy Cross earning third place in the poll.
- ▶ Army West Point and Mercyhurst tied for fourth in the preseason poll. Robert Morris ranks sixth, while Sacred Heart and Bentley placed seventh and eighth, respectively. Niagara and AIC round out the poll behind the Griffis.

## FORTMAN AND SCHMELZER TO WEAR LETTERS

- ▶ Senior **Geoff Fortman** will serve as team captain for the 2016-17 season, while junior **Ryan Schmelzer** will serve as alternate captain.
- ▶ Fortman, a two-time Atlantic Hockey Top Scholar Athlete, has played 98 games for the Golden Griffins over the previous three seasons. Last year, the Crystal Lake, Illinois native tallied a career best six assists from his defensive position.
- ▶ Schmelzer, the team's top returning scorer from a season ago, closed out his sophomore campaign by scoring 10 goals to go with 22 assists for 32 points in 38 games played. The Buffalo, New York native was a plus-4 in 2015-16, and he closed out his sophomore campaign with at least one point in 17 of his last 22 games, including a career-best seven-game stretch from Dec. 13 through Jan. 16.

## McLAUGHLIN NAMED CANISIUS MALE ROOKIE OF THE YEAR

- ▶ Sophomore **Dylan McLaughlin** was named the 2015-16 Canisius Male Rookie of the Year this past June.
- ▶ McLaughlin, the Canisius hockey team Rookie of the Year, was the only freshman on the hockey roster to play in all 39 games for the Golden Griffins last year.
- ▶ The Lancaster, N.Y., native ranked 22nd nationally and fourth in Atlantic Hockey among rookies with his 26 points after he scored eight goals to go along with 18 assists. He matched the program record for assists in a game when he posted four in a Canisius win over Bentley, and he closed out the year by recording 19 points in the Griffis' final 19 games.

## A LOOK AT THE GRIFFS' SCHEDULE

- ▶ The Griffis 2016-17 schedule is highlighted by its season-opening-series against the defending national champion, and No. 1 ranked, North Dakota Fighting Hawks this weekend.
- ▶ Canisius will again travel west next weekend, clashing with Alaska and Alaska Anchorage.
- ▶ The team is slated to face Penn State from State College, Pa., before facing No. 16 St. Lawrence Jan. 6-7, at the HARBORCENTER.

## GRIFFS IN THE PROS

- ▶ Cory Conacher, the program's all-time leading scorer (147 points) has played with four NHL teams (Buffalo, New York Islanders, Ottawa and Tampa Bay).
- ▶ His younger brother Shane, the second all-time scorer for Canisius, signed a contract with the Toronto Marlies of the American Hockey League on Mar. 26, 2016.

## Dave Smith

**Head Coach • 12th Season • The Ohio State University '92**

Taking the Canisius College hockey team to new heights during his career, Dave Smith is in his 12th season as head coach of the Golden Griffin program.

Smith has enjoyed a number of memorable moments during his coaching tenure and has continued to raise the bar while leading the Canisius program. Most recently, Smith has led the Griffs to three-straight trips to Atlantic Hockey Championship

weekend for the first time in school history, including consecutive appearances in the title game and the team's first crown in 2013. The program has also received national attention with its graduates having unprecedented success at the professional level.

During the 2012-13 campaign, Smith guided Canisius to the program's first conference title with a 7-2 victory in the Atlantic Hockey Championship against Mercyhurst and the team's first appearance in the NCAA Division I Tournament. The Griffs also finished the campaign ranked 19th in the final USCHO.com national poll, marking the program's highest finish in the national rankings.

Canisius nearly duplicated the remarkable feat the following two seasons, advancing to the 2014 Atlantic Hockey title game after again eliminating the top two seeds in the conference tournament before earning a second-place finish in 2015 – matching the program's best regular-season finish – and making a third-straight trip to the semifinals.

Away from campus, 2011 graduate Cory Conacher continued to make news at the highest level. Named one of the top 30 players at the Division I level in the last 10 seasons, Conacher became the first Griff to play in the National Hockey League and has enjoyed stints with the Tampa Bay Lightning, Ottawa Senators, Buffalo Sabres and New York Islanders. Conacher also became just the fourth player in AHL history to garner Most Valuable Player and Rookie of the Year accolades in the same season, helping lead the Norfolk Admirals to the 2012 Calder Cup just one year after graduating from Canisius and excelling under Smith's leadership.

The achievements under Smith are not limited to just the past four years. In his first 11 seasons leading the Golden Griffin program, he has guided numerous student-athletes to success both on and off the ice. The Griffs have collected athletic and academic honors as well as enjoying successful careers after graduation. The highlights include:

- A total of 33 Griffs have signed professional contracts after playing under Smith at Canisius, highlighted by Conacher and defender Carl Hudson inking NHL deals. Hudson became the first Griff to join an NHL franchise when he signed with the Florida Panthers after graduating in 2010.
- Smith has mentored three student-athletes who have earned individual postseason awards. Conacher highlights the honorees by being named the 2009-10 Atlantic Hockey Player of the Year, while David Kasch earned the league's Best Defensive Forward following the 2007-08 season and Dave Kostuch collected Rookie of the Year accolades in 2008-09. Conacher and Kyle Gibbons were also selected to the Senior CLASS Award All-America First Team in 2011 and 2014, respectively, while Conacher was named to the All-Atlantic Hockey 10th Anniversary First Team in 2013.
- Overall, 10 Griffs earned all-conference accolades in the past eight seasons a total of 13 times, nine more than Canisius' first 10 seasons at the Division I level combined. During the 2014-15 campaign, a school-record three Griffs earned All-Atlantic Hockey honors when Chris Rumble collected first-team accolades, while Keegan Asmundson and Ralph Cuddemi were named to the second team. Cuddemi repeated the honor during the 2015-16 season to become the third Griff to earn All-Atlantic Hockey accolades twice during his career, while Shane Conacher was named to the first team.
- Canisius student-athletes have consistently ranked among the best in the country under Smith's leadership. Goaltender Tony Capobianco led all players in Division I with 1,256 saves during the 2012-13 campaign, which also ranks as the 12th-best total in NCAA history and the most since the 1988-89 season. Conacher ranked second nationally in points per game during the 2009-10 campaign after recording a program-record 53 points.
- The Griffs have enjoyed unparalleled success against some of the nation's top competition under Smith's watch. During the 2008-09 season, Canisius swept a pair of games against eventual NCAA quarterfinalist and 15th-ranked Air Force, marking the first victories for the Griffs against a nationally-ranked opponent. Canisius has continued the trend in recent years with six wins against nationally-ranked schools, most recently against perennial-power Denver during the 2013-14 campaign.
- In his first 11 seasons, 186 Griffs have earned Atlantic Hockey All-Academic accolades, including a school-record 23 following the 2013-14 campaign. In addition, Max Buetow (2005-06), Dave Cianfrini (2009-10), Ryan Bohrer (2011-12 & 2013-14), Stephen Miller (2012-13 & 2013-14) and Geoff Fortman (2014-15 & 2015-16) were named the Atlantic Hockey Top Scholar Athlete for owning the top GPA in the league. The hockey program consistently owns the top GPA of any team at Canisius with a 3.31 cumulative mark following the 2015-16 academic year.
