FASTBREAK POINTS

- ▶ The Canisius men's basketball team closes its first weekend of MAAC play tonight when the team travels to play at Siena in Times Union Center.
- ▶ The Golden Griffins are 4-8 overall and 1-0 in MAAC play after the team defeated Marist 75-72 Thursday night in Poughkeepsie, N.Y.
- ▶ The win over Marist Thursday extended Canisius' MAAC-opening win streak to seven straight, which dates back to the 2012-13 season.
- ▶ The Griffis grabbed 39 rebounds in the win at Marist, with 16 coming off the offensive glass. Canisius is averaging 12.4 offensive rebounds per game in the team's last five contests.
- ▶ Sophomore **Takal Molson** enters tonight's game ranked fourth in the MAAC in scoring average at 16.6 points per game. He has scored in double-figures in 16-straight games, dating back to last season.
- ▶ Senior **Jibreel Faulkner** scored a career-high 18 points off the bench in the win at Marist. In that game, he hit a career-high four 3-point field goals.
- ▶ Junior **Isaiah Reese** dished out eight assists at Marist, the most assists in a game for a Griff since **Malik Johnson** had nine at Pacific Nov. 26, 2017.

WITHERSPOON AVAILABILITY

All interview requests for head coach Reggie Witherspoon should be directed to Matt Reitnour in the Canisius Athletic Communications office. Coach Witherspoon will be available to the media every Wednesday prior to the start of practice. Postgame media availability will be held after each game, home and away.

PLAYER INTERVIEWS

All player interview must be arranged through Matt Reitnour in the Canisius Athletic Communications office at least two days in advance. Along with coach Witherspoon, players will be available to the media every Wednesday prior to the start of practice. There is NO player availability on game day prior to tipoff. The Canisius locker room is closed.

CREDENTIALS

Single-game press credentials are issued to accredited members of the working media. Requests for credentials should be submitted to Matt Reitnour at least five days in advance. Credentials can be picked up 90 minutes ahead of tipoff on game days. Parking is provided as available (see PARKING NOTE, please).

MEDIA WORK ROOM

The Canisius media work room is located on the second floor of the Koessler Athletic Center, across from the weight room. The work room opens 90 minutes before tip and is open for two hours after the game.

PRESS ROW SEATING

CANISIUS - SIENA SERIES

- ▶ This will be the 101st all-time meeting between these two schools, with Siena holding a 54-46 lead in the series.
- ▶ Canisius and Siena split the season series in 2017-18, with the Saints scoring a 65-62 win at the Times Union Center on Jan. 7, 2018. That three-point victory improved Siena to 13-10 all-time in series history when games were decided by five points or less.
- ▶ Canisius is 6-20 all-time against Siena in the Times Union Center, including MAAC Tournament games. The Griffs' 92-88 triple overtime win over the Saints in the 2013-14 season ended the program's nine-game losing streak to Siena in their downtown home building.

ABOUT THE SAINTS

- ▶ Siena enters tonight's game with an overall record of 5-9 and an 0-1 mark in MAAC action after falling on the road to Saint Peter's 65-60 Thursday afternoon.
- ▶ The Saints are in their first season under the direction of head coach **Jamion Christian**, who was named the 17th head coach in program history last May after spending the six previous seasons as the head man at Mount St. Mary's.
- ▶ As a team, Siena is averaging 64.8 points per game, which ranks ninth in the conference. The team's 9.1 3-point makes per game ranks third in the conference and 49th in the country.
- ▶ Siena is allowing opposing teams to shoot 51.6 percent from the field this season, which ranks last in the MAAC and second-to-last in the nation.
- ▶ The Saints are averaging just 9.1 turnovers per game, which ranks ninth in the country, and the team is whistled for an average of just 13.7 fouls per game, which is fifth-best in the nation.
- ▶ Senior forward **Evan Fisher** leads the Saints with his 16.3 points per game scoring average. Freshman **Jalen Pickett** adds 15.1 points and a league-best 7.1 assists per game.

LAST TIME vs. THE SAINTS

BUFFALO, N.Y. (Feb. 8, 2018) - Former Canisius forward **Jermaine Crumpton** scored a game-high 24 points and the Golden Griffins shot 59.4 percent from the field in the game's second half en route to an 89-65 win over Siena in the Koessler Athletic Center. The 24-point win for the Griffs was the team's largest at that point in the season. Guard **Isaiah Reese** added 15 points, seven rebounds, five assists and two steals to the winning effort for the Blue and Gold, while fellow guard **Jonathan Sanks** came off the bench to add 14 points, which matched his career high. That win for Canisius was the Griffs' fifth in its last six home dates against Siena, with those five victories coming by an average of 19.6 points per game.

NEXT UP

- ▶ Canisius will officially close out the non-league portion of its 2018-19 schedule at home Jan. 8, when the team plays host to Brown. Tipoff on ESPN+ is set for 7 p.m.
- ▶ The game against Brown will start a three-game homestand for Canisius, the team's longest of the season.
- ▶ Canisius will return to MAAC action next weekend with home dates vs. Rider (Jan. 11) and Iona (Jan. 13).

- ▶ Scored a career-high 18 points off the bench in the Griffs' win over Marist.
- ▶ Averaging 11.2 points and 4.6 rebounds per game in the team's last five.
- ▶ Made a career-high four 3-pointers in the win at Marist. Has 10 3-point makes in the last five games.

NEWS AND NOTES

CANISIUS IN MAAC OPENERS

- ▶ Canisius opened its 30th season in MAAC at Marist on Thursday with a 75-72 victory.
- ▶ The win over the Red Foxes moved the Griffs to 16-14 all-time in MAAC openers and it also extended the team's MAAC-opening win streak to seven straight, dating back to the 2012-13 campaign.
- ▶ The Griffs have won the first MAAC game of the season under third-year head coach **Reggie Witherspoon** by a total of five points, with the three-point win at Marist being the largest victory. In the two previous seasons, the Blue and Gold beat Rider (2017-18) and Manhattan (2016-17) by the score of 77-76.

2018-19 SCHEDULE FEATURES PLENTY OF MADNESS

- ▶ Canisius' 2018-19 schedule features five non-conference opponents that played in the 2018 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Tournament last March.
- ▶ The Griffs are one of seven teams in the country to play five or more non-league games against NCAA Tournament teams from a season ago.
- ▶ One of Canisius' five non-league games against NCAA Tournament teams from last year came Nov. 22 when the Griffs played Villanova in the AdvoCare Invitational. This season marks the first time the Blue and Gold have played the defending national champion since the team met Syracuse in 2003-04.

GRIFFS AGAINST THE RANKED

- ▶ As of Dec. 31, Canisius' schedule features two teams ranked in the Associated Press Top-25 Poll.
- ▶ The Griffs lost to then-No. 14 Florida State 93-61 Nov. 19, and fell to No. 21 Buffalo 87-72 at home Dec. 29.
- ▶ Canisius is the only MAAC school to play two ranked teams this season. This marks the first time since 2003-04 where the Blue and Gold have played multiple ranked opponents in the same season.

CANISIUS' NON-LEAGUE SCHEDULE IS STRONG

- ▶ As of Jan. 4, the combined record of the 11 non-conference teams on Canisius' 2018-19 schedule is 99-68. Two of those teams, Florida State and Buffalo, are currently ranked in the AP poll with 12-1 overall records.
- ▶ Eight of the Griffs' 11 non-league opponents this season are .500 or better on the year, as of Jan. 1.
- ▶ Canisius faced three teams at the 2018 AdvoCare Invitational that currently have a winning record. The Griffs went 0-3 against those three schools (Villanova, Memphis and UAB).

WITHERSPOON COACHES CAREER GAME NO. 500

- ▶ Canisius head coach **Reggie Witherspoon** coached his 500th career game at the Division I level when the Griffs play at St. Bonaventure Nov. 28.
- ▶ Witherspoon is the only current active coach in the MAAC to reach the 500-career game milestone.

DECEMBERS TO REMEMBER

- ▶ Since 2012-13, Canisius is 32-14 in games played in the month of December. The Griffs finished December 2018 with a 2-2 record after the team lost to No. 21/22 Buffalo 87-72 Dec. 29..
- ▶ In the three Decembers under head coach **Reggie Witherspoon**, the Blue and Gold is 13-6, with 11 of those wins coming in non-league play.
- ▶ Prior to the 2012-13 season, Canisius only had 11 wins in the month of December from 2008-09 through the 2011-12 campaigns.

GRIFFS OFFENSE LOOKING TO GET GOING

- ▶ Canisius enters tonight's game at Siena averaging 67.6 points per game, which ranks sixth in the MAAC and 307th in the nation.
- ▶ The Griffs scored a season-high 92 points in the win over Elon Dec. 16. Prior to that offensive outburst, the Blue and Gold had scored more than 80 points just once this year - an 82-73 win at Bucknell Nov. 13.
- ▶ The Griffs are 39-14 under third-year head coach **Reggie Witherspoon** when posting 70-or more points on the scoreboard in a game after the team beat Marist 75-72 Thursday night.

GETTING OFFENSIVE (REBOUNDS)

- ▶ In each of the team's last four games, Canisius has recorded double-digit offensive rebounds, highlighted by the Griffs' season-high 17 offensive rebounds in the loss to Buffalo Dec. 29.
- ▶ In the win at Marist on Thursday, the Griffs grabbed 10 offensive rebounds in the second half. In the team's last three contests (at Holy Cross, vs. Buffalo, at Marist), the Blue and Gold is averaging 10.6 offensive rebounds after intermission.

TROUBLE ON THE GLASS

- ▶ Despite the recent surge on the glass, Canisius comes into tonight's game averaging 32.8 rebounds per game, which ranks seventh in the MAAC and 318th in the country.
- ▶ The Griffs rank 10th in the league and 328th in the nation with a -5.3 rebounding margin.
- ▶ Canisius has allowed its opponents to grab an offensive rebound on 33.4 percent of all possessions, which ranks 318th nationally, according to kenpom.com.
- ▶ Canisius has out rebounded its opponent four times this season, and the team is 3-1 in those three contests. The Griffs' +10 rebounding margin in the win over Marist on Thursday is the team's largest of the season.
- ▶ In the 79 games under Witherspoon, the Griffs have out rebounded their opponent 32 times. The team is 24-8 in those 32 contests.

A GAME OF RUNS

- ▶ In 11 of the Griffs' 12 games this season, Canisius has allowed its opponents at least one scoring run of nine points or more during the course of the contest.
- ▶ In the Griffs' loss to Buffalo Dec. 29, the Bulls used a 21-2 run over the span of 5:09 midway through the first half to turn a 10-point deficit into a 34-25 lead in the opening frame.
- ▶ The largest scoring run against Canisius this season came in the game against UAB Nov. 25. In that game, the Blazers used a 22-7 run midway through the first half to erase a 24-9 lead midway through the opening 20 minutes of play.

CHARGE IT!

- ▶ Canisius comes into tonight's game having drawn multiple offensive charges in five of the team's last eight games after taking two charge calls win the loss at Holy Cross Dec. 20.
- ▶ Sophomore **Takal Molson** leads the Griffs with six offensive charges taken in nine games this season. He's also the program's active leader in that category with 12 drawn charges in his first 45 career games as a Griff.

BUFFALO STEALERS

- ▶ Canisius was credited with six steals in the win over Marist Thursday night, the 10th time this season the team has recorded five or more steals in a game.
- ▶ The Griffs enter tonight's game averaging 7.1 steals per game, which ranks fourth in the MAAC and 121st in the nation.

- ▶ Canisius is 16-12 all-time when playing on Jan. 5.
- ▶ This marks the fourth time in program history where Canisius has played Siena on Jan. 5. The Griffs and the Saints have met on Jan. 5, 1952, Jan. 5, 1985 and Jan. 5, 1994. Canisius is 1-2 against Siena on this date.
- ▶ The game on Jan. 5, 1952 marked the first time in the series history between these two schools where Siena won a road game in Buffalo. On this date in 1952, the Saints dropped the Griffs 56-45 in The Aud in downtown Buffalo.

NEWS AND NOTES

LOOKING FOR THAT SHOOTING SUCCESS

- ▶ Through 12 games this season, Canisius is shooting 40.5 percent from the field, highlighted by its season-best 50.8 percent success rate from the floor in the win at Elon Dec. 16.
- ▶ The Griff's come into tonight's game ranked seventh in the MAAC and 323rd nationally in team field goal percentage.
- ▶ The Griff's ended the 2017-18 campaign by shooting 46.4 percent from the field, with the team connecting on 901-of-1,942 shots from the field.
- ▶ Canisius, which ranked second in the MAAC and ranks 82nd nationally in field goal shooting percentage last year, shot better than 45 percent from the field in 18 games in 2017-18.

THE GRIFFS NOT AFRAID TO SHOOT FROM DEEP

- ▶ Canisius starts tonight's game having attempted 301 shots from 3-point range, which breaks down to 43.5 percent of the team's total shots this season.
- ▶ The 2017-18 edition of the Griff's made 304 3-pointers, which ranks as the third-most in program history. This year's team has made just 87 treys in 12 games, connecting on a 28.9 percent clip.
- ▶ Canisius starts this game tonight averaging 7.3 3-point makes per game, which ranks eighth in the MAAC and 221st in the country.
- ▶ The Griff's hit 10 3-point field goals in the win over Marist on Thursday. The program has made 10-or more treys 68 times since the start of the 2012-13 season.

DROPPING DIMES

- ▶ Through 12 games this season, the Griff's are averaging 12.8 assists per game. That ranks fourth in the 11-team conference.
- ▶ Canisius recorded 18 assists on 25 made field goals in the win over Marist on Thursday. Those 18 assists tied the team's season high, as the unit also had 18 assists in the win at Elon Dec. 16.

WE'LL TAKE THAT

- ▶ Canisius comes into tonight's game ranked second in the MAAC in turnover margin at +2.0. That ranks the Griff's 95th nationally.
- ▶ The Griff's are forcing opponents to turn the ball over an average of 15.5 times per game, which is third in the league behind Rider (17.2) and Manhattan (16.5).

TAKING CARE OF THE ROCK

- ▶ Through the first 12 games of the 2018-19 campaign, Canisius is averaging 13.5 turnovers per game, which is tied for fifth in the MAAC and 184th in the nation. The team turned the ball over a season-low eight times in the home loss to Albany Nov. 17.
- ▶ The Griff's were charged with a season-high 20 turnovers in the loss to UAB on Nov. 25, the most for the team in a game this season, and the most since the Blue and Gold gave the ball away 21 times in a win over Arkansas Pine-Bluff on Nov. 25, 2017.
- ▶ Canisius closed out the win at Marist with five second-half turnovers, and the Blue and Gold did not turn it over for the final 9:12 of contest.

THAT 70s SHOW

- ▶ In three seasons under head coach **Reggie Witherspoon**, the Griff's are 39-14 when posting 70 points or more on the scoreboard after the Blue and Gold 75 points in their win over Marist Jan. 3.
- ▶ Canisius, which went 18-5 when scoring 70-or more points in a game last season, is 3-1 this year when lighting up the scoreboard with 70-plus points in a game this season.

GRIFFS GO SHARPIE

- ▶ The Griff's are 78-2 since the start of 2013-14 when leading at the 2:00 mark of the second half of a game.
- ▶ The Griff's are 72-7 since 2013-14 when leading at the 5:00 mark in the second half. One of those seven losses came Dec. 20, as Canisius led Holy Cross 63-53 at the 5:00 mark before the host Crusaders stormed back to record an 65-63 victory in Worcester, Mass.

PROTECT THIS HOUSE

- ▶ The Griff's own an all-time record of 234-139 (.627 win percentage) in the Koessler Athletic Center. The team is 113-107 (.514 win percentage) since 2001.
- ▶ Canisius did not use the Koessler Center as its main home venue until 1999-00.

DEFENDING MAIN STREET

- ▶ Canisius went 11-3 at home last season. The Griff's won their 11 home games by an average margin of 14.4 points per game.
- ▶ The 2017-18 season marks the sixth-straight year where Canisius finished .500 or better over the length of the home schedule.

NEWS AND NOTES

REESE CLOSING IN ON 1,000

- ▶ Canisius junior **Isaiah Reese** enters tonight's game as the program's active leader in career points scored with 930, good for a career average of 11.8 points per game.
- ▶ Reese scored a team-high 16 points in the loss at Holy Cross Dec. 20 to move past the 900-career point milestone. He needs 70 more points to become the 38th player in program history to join the famed 1,000-point club.

REESE THE REBOUNDER

- ▶ Canisius junior **Isaiah Reese** enters tonight's game as the Griffs' leading rebounder with his 5.9 rebounds per game average. That ranks the 6-foot-5 guard tied for seventh in the MAAC in rebounding average through 12 games.
- ▶ Of Reese's 71 total rebounds, 62 have come off the defensive glass, which breaks down to 5.2 defensive boards per game. That ranks him fourth in the MAAC and 172nd in the country.
- ▶ Reese has been the team's leading rebounder in six games this year and 22 times in his career. His game-high 12 rebounds in the win over Robert Morris Dec. 5 tied his career-high, previously set Feb. 18, 2018 at Rider.

REESE CLIMBING THE CAREER STEALS LIST

- ▶ Junior **Isaiah Reese** is the program's active leader with 136 steals in 79 career games. That ranks him 11th in program history.
- ▶ The Miami, Fla., native did not have a steal in the team's loss to Buffalo Dec. 29, the first time he did not record at least one steal in a game since Nov. 19 at Florida State. He responded with two steals in the win at Marist on Thursday, his fourth multi-steal game of the season.
- ▶ Reese starts tonight's game ranked second on the team and 10th in the MAAC with 1.4 steals per contest this year.

DYNAMIC DUO

- ▶ Canisius junior **Isaiah Reese** and sophomore **Takal Molson** combine to make a powerful 1-2 punch for the Griffs' offense.
- ▶ Through the team's first 12 games this year, the backcourt tandem have combined to score 40.9 percent of Canisius' total points. Molson leads the way with his 16.6 points per game scoring average, while Reese is good for 11.1 points per contest this season.
- ▶ Entering tonight's contest, the two guards have combined to take 43.8 percent of the team's field goal attempts this season. Of the combined 303 shots by Molson and Reese, 150 have come from behind the 3-point arc (49.5 percent).
- ▶ Reese and Molson, who were both Preseason All-MAAC selections, started the 2018-19 season as the highest returning scoring tandem in the MAAC.

THE MOLSON 500

- ▶ Canisius guard **Takal Molson** comes into tonight's game averaging a team-high 16.6 points per game, which ranks fourth-best in the MAAC.
- ▶ The Buffalo, N.Y., starts this game this evening with 616 total points in his career through 45 career games, good for an average of 13.7 points per outing.
- ▶ Molson moved past the 500-career point mark in 37 career games, making him the fastest Canisius sophomore to reach the 500-career point milestone since **'Sugar' Ray Hall** passed the 500-point plateau in 31 games as a Griff during the 1982-83 season.

MOLSON GOOD FOR 10-PLUS

- ▶ Canisius guard **Takal Molson** leads Canisius and ranks fourth in the MAAC with his 16.6 points per game scoring average.
- ▶ The Buffalo, N.Y., has scored in double-figures in all 12 games to date this season. Dating back to last year, Molson has scored 10-plus points in 16 consecutive games.
- ▶ Molson matched a career-high with 25 points in the team's season-opening win at Bucknell Nov. 13, the second-straight season where he scored 25 points in the team's season opener.
- ▶ In his first college game on Nov. 11, 2017, Molson scored 25 points in the Griffs' road loss at Buffalo. Those 25 points set the program record for points scored in a Canisius debut by a true freshman.

MOLSON TO THE LINE

- ▶ Sophomore **Takal Molson** leads Canisius and ranks second in the MAAC with his 82 trips to the free-throw line this season.
- ▶ The Buffalo, N.Y., ranks fourth in the MAAC in free-throw percentage at 78.0 percent. His 82 trips to the line ranks 73rd nationally, and his 64 makes at the charity stripe places him 64th in the country.

NEWS AND NOTES

HAPPY TO HELP

- ▶ Junior guard **Malik Johnson** comes into this game with 335 career assists, which ranks him 12th in program history.
- ▶ Through 12 games this season, he is averaging 2.9 assists per game, which ranks him second on the team and ninth in the MAAC.
- ▶ In the team's last five games, Johnson is averaging 3.8 assists per outing.
- ▶ Last season, Johnson ranked seventh in the MAAC with his 4.6 assists per game average, which placed him 105th nationally. He was credited with career-high nine assists at Pacific on Nov. 26, 2017.
- ▶ The Richmond, Va., native is the first Canisius sophomore to dish out more than 145 assists in each of his first two seasons in Blue and Gold.

TO GIVE AND TO TAKE

- ▶ Junior **Malik Johnson** is one of the team's leaders in assists per game, and he also leads this year's unit in steals per game, entering tonight's game with 1.7 takeaways per contest.
- ▶ He has recorded multiple steals in seven games this season after earning two swipes Thursday at Marist.
- ▶ Johnson, who is tied for sixth in the MAAC with 1.7 steals per game this season, became just the 19th player in school history to record 100 career steals when he was credited with two in the road loss at Holy Cross Dec. 20.

SANKS LOVES LEAGUE PLAY

- ▶ Senior **Jonathan Sanks** came off the bench and scored a 10 points in 22 minutes off the bench at Marist Thursday night. In the team's last five contests, he's averaging 7.4 points per contest.
- ▶ In that win at Marist, Sanks drilled two 3-point field goals, his fifth game this season with multiple makes from 3-point range. In his 43 career games as a Griff, Sanks has hit multiple treys in 17 contests.
- ▶ The Warner Robins, Ga., native has heated up when league play comes around. In 19 MAAC games, Sanks is averaging 7.8 points per game, with 34 of his 53 3-point makes coming against league rivals.
- ▶ Sanks ended the 2017-18 conference schedule by averaging 7.7 points per game, which ranked fourth-best on the Griff's roster. In those 18 league games a season ago, he shot 47.8 percent (32-for-67) from 3-point range. That ranked third-best among all MAAC players in conference action.

FAULKNER FUEL

- ▶ Senior **Jibreel Faulkner** came off the bench and scored a career-high 18 points in the team's road win at Marist on Thursday. In the team's last five games, he ranks second on the team with his 11.2 points per game scoring average.
- ▶ The Washington, D.C., native is shooting 50 percent from the field and 50 percent (10-for-20) from 3-point land in the team's last five games, where the Griff's are 3-2. In the win at Marist on Thursday, he hit a career-high four 3-point field goals.

HITCHON HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Sophomore **Scott Hitchon** scored a career-high 16 points in the team's win over Elon Dec. 16. He comes into tonight's game ranked fifth on the team in scoring at 6.9 points per game.

What is a Griffin?

The Griffin is a mythical creature of supposed gigantic size that has the head, forelegs and wings of an eagle and the hindquarters, tail and ears of a lion. They are well known for their speed, ability to fly and having eyes like an eagle as well as the strength and courage of a lion.



Griffins have been known for centuries as symbols of strength and vigilance, have been called "The Hounds of Zeus" in Greek mythology and are said to have mastery of both the land and sky.

They are thought to be from India, where the natives of the land made their talons and claws into drinking cups because the talon of a Griffin was said to detect poison in a liquid. Griffins would find gold in the mountains and line their nests with it and as a result, were forced to become great guardians of the nests to keep the hunters away.

NEWS AND NOTES

GRIFFS COMING OFF A BANNER SEASON

- ▶ Canisius finished the 2017-18 regular season with a 15-3 record in conference play, which earned the Griffis a share of the MAAC regular-season championship.
- ▶ The 15 conference victories last season set a new program record for the Blue and Gold, and the regular-season title was the first for Canisius since 1993-94.
- ▶ The previous record for MAAC wins in a single-season was 14 games, set by the 2013-14 team.

2017-18 GRIFFS TIE PROGRAM WINS RECORD

- ▶ Canisius ended the 2017-18 season with an overall record of 21-12, the ninth 20-win campaign in school history, and the first since 2013-14.
- ▶ The team's 98-74 win over Marist Feb. 25, 2018 allowed last year's team to tie the school record for wins in a regular season. The 1993-94 edition of the Griffis also won 21 regular-season games.
- ▶ The Canisius program record for wins in a season is 22, set by the 1993-94 team. That team won a game in the 1994 MAAC Basketball Championship before eventually losing to Villanova in the first round of the 1994 NIT.

CANISIUS PICKED SECOND IN MAAC POLL

- ▶ Canisius was picked to finish second in the annual MAAC Preseason Coaches Poll. The second-place projection for this year's team is the highest for the Griffis in the history of the preseason poll.
- ▶ The Griffis received 105 votes in the poll, leaving the Blue and Gold 16 points behind the league's preseason favorite, Rider. Canisius and Rider both went 15-3 in league play last season, and the two schools shared the MAAC's regular-season championship title.

REESE NAMED PRESEASON MAAC PLAYER OF THE YEAR

- ▶ On Oct. 23, Canisius junior **Isaiah Reese** was officially named the 2018-19 MAAC Preseason Player of the Year, as voted on by the league's 11 head coaches.
- ▶ Reese, who was one of two unanimous Preseason All-MAAC First Team honorees as well, is just the second player in school history to be named the MAAC's Preseason Player of the Year. Former Griff **Billy Baron** also received the award prior to the start of the 2013-14 season.
- ▶ The Miami, Fla., native ended his sophomore season as an All-MAAC First-Team choice, making him the first Canisius sophomore since **Michael Meeks** in 1994 to be honored to the league's top postseason all-star unit.

MOLSON EARNS MAAC HONORS AS WELL

- ▶ Canisius sophomore guard **Takal Molson** was named to the 2018-19 Preseason All-MAAC Second Team Oct. 23, when the conference officially released its preseason awards live on ESPN3.
- ▶ Molson, the reigning MAAC Rookie of the Year, was one of two Canisius guards honored in the preseason, joining teammate **Isaiah Reese**.
- ▶ The Buffalo, N.Y., native ranked third on last year's team and second among

all MAAC freshmen with his 12.6 points per game scoring average. He is the fourth player in school history to be named the MAAC's Rookie of the Year, and the first since **Frank Turner** in 2006-07.

MANHERTZ ... TOUCHDOWN!

- ▶ On Dec. 17, former Griffis forward and current Carolina Panthers tight end **Chris Manhertz** scored his first career touchdown on a 50-yard pass from teammate Christian McCaffery on Monday Night Football.
- ▶ That play against the New Orleans Saints makes Manhertz the first former Griff to score a touchdown in a professional football game since **Tom Colella** scored for the Cleveland Browns in a game in 1947.
- ▶ A former three-time team captain, Manhertz played 116 career games as a Griff during his career on Main Street from 2010-14. His 789 career rebounds ranks fourth all-time in program history.

BINKY GETS THE CALL TO THE HALL

- ▶ Former Canisius guard **Dana 'Binky' Johnson** (Class of 1994) was recently named as one of six new inductees into the Canisius Sports Hall of Fame.
- ▶ Johnson played in 99 career games for the Griffis from 1990-94, where he averaged 6.7 points, 2.9 rebounds and 4.4 assists per contest.
- ▶ He graduated from Canisius as just the sixth player in school history to distribute more than 300 assists in his time in Blue and Gold. He currently ranks 15th in program history on the school's all-time assist list.
- ▶ The Norristown, Pa., native ranks fifth in school history with his 183 career steals, and he still holds the program record for steals in a single season with 79 swipes in 1992-93.
- ▶ Johnson, who was a two-time team captain for the Griffis, is the 54th former men's basketball player to be inducted into the school's Hall of Fame.

115TH SEASON OF CANISIUS HOOPS

- ▶ Canisius embarks on the 115th season of basketball this year. Canisius has sponsored varsity basketball longer than any other team in the MAAC.
- ▶ The 2018-19 campaign also marks the 30th season of MAAC membership for the program.
- ▶ The Griffis played their first basketball game Dec. 7, 1903, a 14-6 win over Gordon's of Buffalo.
- ▶ The program has made a total of 14 postseason appearances (5 NCAA, 4 NIT, 4 CIT, 1 CBI). Canisius' appearance in the 2018 CBI marked the fifth time in the last six years where the Blue and Gold have earned a postseason berth.

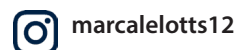

- ▶ His 2017-18 team tied the school record for wins in the regular season with 21, and the Griffs' 15 MAAC victories last year set a new program standard for league wins in a single season.
- ▶ Those 15 MAAC wins allowed Canisius to earn a share of the 2017-18 MAAC regular-season championship, the program's first since 1993-94.
- ▶ Witherspoon joins with former Canisius head coach **Jim Baron** as the only two coaches in program history to lead Canisius to back-to-back national tournaments in their first two years on Main Street.
- ▶ A Buffalo native, Witherspoon returned to his hometown to take over the Golden Griffin program after spending the 2015-16 season on the bench at Chattanooga.
- ▶ Witherspoon led the University at Buffalo program for 14 seasons from 1999-13, where he earned 198 career wins against 228 career losses.
- ▶ A two-time Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year (2004, 2012), he boasted a record of 174-143 in his last 10 years with the Buffalo program.
- ▶ Witherspoon has a MAC regular-season crown, two trips to the MAC Tournament title game, an NIT berth, two bids to the College Basketball Invitational (CBI) and a pair of trips to the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT) on his head coaching resume.
- ▶ Witherspoon has also coached at the international level, as he has assisted with USA Basketball and the national under-18 team program two times. In 2006, he worked with the USA U-18 tryout team that featured **Blake Griffin**, **Michael Beasley**, **Jared Bayless** and **Kyle Singler**. In 2010, he was an assistant coach under **Jeff Capel** and worked with **Kyrie Irving**, **Austin Rivers** and **Patric Young**.
- ▶ Witherspoon began his coaching career at his high school alma mater - Sweet Home High School in the north suburbs of Buffalo.
- ▶ As a player, Witherspoon played for two seasons at Erie Community College, where his head coach was **John Beilein**. Beilein later went on to be the Canisius head coach from 1992-97, and he now leads the Michigan basketball program.

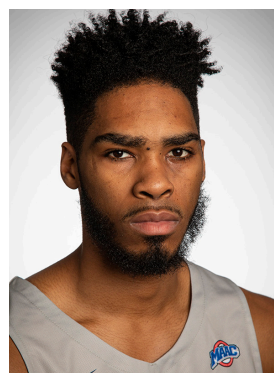
