CANISIUS OPENS MAAC PLAY AT SIENA

- ▶ The Canisius men's basketball team will officially open MAAC play tonight as the team plays Siena at Times Union Center in Albany, N.Y.
- ▶ The Griffins are 5-5 on the year after falling to cross-town rival Buffalo 82-73 Dec. 18 in Alumni Arena. The Griffins are .500 overall through 10 games for the first time since 2016-17, and this marks the sixth since 1999-00 where the Blue and Gold have been .500 or better through the first 10 contests of the year.
- ▶ Canisius will be starting its MAAC schedule against Siena for the fourth time since 1989-90, and for the first time since the 1997-98 campaign.
- ▶ This marks the first time Canisius has played a MAAC game in the month of December since Dec 31, 2018, when the team beat Iona 85-78 at home.

FASTBREAK POINTS

- ▶ As of Dec. 21, Canisius is one of five teams in the MAAC to have an overall record of .500 or better.
- ▶ This is the Griffins' second game in a three-game road swing to close out the 2019 calendar year. Tonight's game also marks the second time this year Canisius has played in Albany, N.Y., having already lost to Albany 83-57 back on Nov. 13.
- ▶ Senior **Malik Johnson** became just the fourth player in school history to distribute 500-or-more career assists after he dished out a season-high 10 assists in the loss to Buffalo Dec. 18.
- ▶ Johnson, who ranks second among active MAAC players in career assists (Rider's **Stevie Jordan** has 519 career assists), leads the league with his 5.3 assists per contest this year.
- ▶ Junior forward **Scott Hitchon** scored a career-high 29 points in the loss to Buffalo, making him just the sixth player (and first since **Jermaine Crumpton** in 2017-18) to score 29-or-more points in a game against Buffalo, Niagara or St. Bonaventure.
- ▶ Junior guard **Majesty Brandon** came off the bench and scored 14 points against Buffalo, the ninth time in 10 games this season where he's recorded 10-plus points in the scoring column for the Blue and Gold.

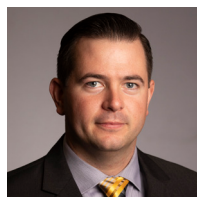

ON THIS DATE

DECEMBER 23

- ▶ This marks the 12th time in program history where the Griff's have played on Dec. 23. The team is 7-4 in the previous 11 games played on this date.
- ▶ Canisius is 3-0 in its last three games played on this date, going back to 2006-07. The Griff's' first game on Dec. 23 came during the 1911-12 season - a 19-17 overtime road win at the Moose of Salamanca.

LAST TIME OUT

BUFFALO 82, CANISIUS 73 • Dec. 18 | Alumni Arena | Buffalo, N.Y.

- ▶ Canisius opened its three-game road swing at cross-town rival Buffalo Dec. 18 with an 82-73 loss to the Bulls.
- ▶ The Griff's trailed by as many as 16 points with 13:55 left on the clock, but the Blue and Gold fought back, and trimmed the Buffalo lead to just two before being outscored 8-0 in the game's closing 1:45.
- ▶ Junior **Scott Hitchon** scored a career-high 29 points in the loss, making him just the sixth player in Canisius history to score 29-or-more points in a game against Buffalo, Niagara or St. Bonaventure.
- ▶ Senior **Malik Johnson** recorded his third career double-double with 11 points and 10 assists. Those 10 assists allowed him to become just the fourth player in school history to reach the 500-career assist milestone.
- ▶ Prior to the UB game, Johnson's last double-double effort came against Siena on March 1, 2019 after he posted 10 points and a career-high 12 assists in the Griff's' home win over the Saints in the Koessler Athletic Center.

CANISIUS - SIENA HISTORY

- ▶ This will be the 103rd all-time meeting between these two schools, with Siena holding a 54-48 lead in the series.
- ▶ Canisius has won three straight and five of the last six meetings with Siena, dating back to the 2016-17 season. Last January, Canisius trailed by 10 points at halftime before racing back for a 70-66 victory at Times Union Center, the Griff's' seventh win all-time over the Saints in their downtown Albany home.
- ▶ Canisius is 8-21 all-time against Siena in the Times Union Center, including MAAC Tournament games. The Griff's' 92-88 triple overtime win over the Saints in the 2013-14 season ended the program's nine-game losing streak to Siena in their downtown home building.

ABOUT THE SAINTS

- ▶ Siena comes into tonight's MAAC opener with an overall 3-5 record after the Saints snapped a four-game slide on Saturday with an 81-71 home win over Bucknell.
- ▶ The Saints are 3-0 at home this season, making Siena one of four teams, including Canisius, to be undefeated at home this year.
- ▶ As a team, Siena is averaging 73.9 points per game, which ranks second in the MAAC and 165th in the country. The Saints have recorded 75-or-more points in all three home dates to this point this season.
- ▶ Graduate student **Elijah Burns** leads Siena offensively with his 16.0 points per game. In the win over Bucknell on Saturday, he posted a game-high 28 points.
- ▶ Burns is one of four Siena players averaging double-figures in scoring column this year. The Saints are the only team to have four players ranked among the top-15 in the MAAC in scoring average so far this season.

CANISIUS IN MAAC OPENERS

- ▶ Canisius opens its 31st season in MAAC tonight when the team plays at Siena.
- ▶ Last year, the Griff's opened league play with a 75-72 road win over Marist to start conference action. That win over the Red Foxes improved Canisius to 16-14 all-time in the first MAAC game of the season.
- ▶ The win over Marist last year in the conference opener extended the Griff's' MAAC-opening win streak to seven straight, dating back to the 2012-13 campaign.
- ▶ This game tonight will mark the fourth time in program history where Canisius has started league play against Siena, with the last occasion coming during the 1997-98 campaign. The Griff's are 1-2 in those three previous MAAC openers versus the Saints.
- ▶ Canisius' first MAAC game was against Siena, a game that was played on Dec. 11, 1989 at Siena. The Saints won that contest by the score of 87-76.

MAAC MASTERS

- ▶ Since the start of the 2012-13 season, Canisius ranks third among the current MAAC schools with its 80 regular-season league wins.
- ▶ Only Iona (96 wins) and Rider (81 wins) have more victories during regular-season play in league than the Blue and Gold in that time.
- ▶ In the seven years prior to the 2012-13 season, Canisius won a total of 36 MAAC regular-season contests.

UP NEXT FOR THE GRIFFS

- ▶ Canisius will close out its three-game road swing on Monday, Dec. 30, when the team travels to play at Pittsburgh.

CANISIUS BASKETBALL

DECEMBERS TO REMEMBER

- ▶ Since 2012-13, Canisius is 34-17 in games played in the month of December. The Griffis are 2-3 this month after falling to Buffalo Dec. 18.
- ▶ In the four Decembers under head coach **Reggie Witherspoon**, the Blue and Gold is 15-8, with 12 of those victories coming in non-league play.
- ▶ Prior to the 2012-13 season, Canisius only had 11 wins total in the month of December from 2008-09 through the 2011-12 campaigns.

OLD-SCHOOL SUCCESS

- ▶ In Canisius' loss at Buffalo Dec. 18, 30 of the Griffis' 73 total points came from 2-point field goals.
- ▶ Coming into tonight's game, 54.8 percent of Canisius' total points this season have come from the traditional 2-point area, which ranks 68th in the nation, according to kenpom.com.
- ▶ As a team, Canisius is averaging 70.8 points per game, which ranks fourth in the MAAC and 211th in the nation despite ranking 3190th nationally with 57 total makes from 3-point land.

HIT OR MISS

- ▶ Canisius comes into tonight's game ranked second in the MAAC in team field goal percentage with the team shooting 44.6 percent for the season through 10 games.
- ▶ It has been either feast or famine for the Griffis this season in regards to field goal percentage for a game. In 10 games, Canisius has shot 50.0 percent or better four times, while shooting under 40.0 percent in the other six contests.

THE GRIFFS NOT AFRAID TO SHOOT FROM DEEP

- ▶ Despite ranking 299th in the nation with 5.7 makes per game from 3-point land this season, the Griffis have proven they can get hot from behind the arc.
- ▶ With the season-high 15 makes from 3-point range at UIC Nov. 26, Canisius has made 10-or more treys 79 times since the start of the 2012-13 season.
- ▶ Canisius ended the 2018-19 season play by hitting 8.0 3-point makes per game, which ranked sixth in the MAAC and 145th in the country.

DROPPING DIMES

- ▶ The Griffis average 14.0 assists per game this season after the team had 16 assists in the loss at Buffalo Dec. 18. The Blue and Gold starts tonight's game ranked second in the MAAC in assists per game average.
- ▶ In the three previous seasons under head coach **Reggie Witherspoon**, Canisius has ranked in the top-100 nationally in assists per game three times, highlighted by the team's sixth-place finish following the 2016-17 campaign.

BUFFALO STEALERS

- ▶ As a team, Canisius has recorded five-or-more steals in all 10 games to date. The team's 8.4 steals per game average ranks third in the MAAC and 63rd in the nation.
- ▶ As a team, Canisius was credited with 11 steals in the loss to FAU Dec. 4, the most steals in a game for the Blue and Gold since March 14, 2018, when the team had 14 swipes in a CBI game loss to Jacksonville State at home.

TO GIVE AND TO TAKE

- ▶ As a team, Canisius is averaging 16.0 turnovers per game, which ranks ninth in the MAAC and 313th in the nation.
- ▶ However, thanks to forcing 17.4 opponent turnovers per game, the Griffis' rank third in the league and 133rd in the nation with a +1.4 turnover margin.

THAT 70s SHOW

- ▶ Under head coach **Reggie Witherspoon**, the Griffis are 49-22 when posting 70 points or more on the scoreboard.

GRIFFS GO SHARPIE

- ▶ The Griffis are 92-3 since the start of 2013-14 when leading at the 2:00 mark of the second half of a game.
- ▶ The Griffis are 85-9 since 2013-14 when leading at the 5:00 mark in the second half.

PROTECT THIS HOUSE

- ▶ The Griffis own an all-time record of 240-145 (.623 win percentage) in the Koessler Athletic Center. The team is 119-113 (.513 win percentage) since 2001.
- ▶ Canisius did not use the Koessler Center as its main home venue until 1999-00.

- ▶ Senior guard **Malik Johnson** was good for a season-high 10 assists in the Griffs' loss at Buffalo Dec. 18, the 55th time in his career he's been good for five-or-more assists in a game.
- ▶ Those 10 assists allowed the Richmond, Va., native to become just the fourth player in school history to reach the 500-career assist milestone. He starts tonight's game tied for third all-time in the school's record book with 508 assists to his credit.
- ▶ Johnson enters this game averaging 5.3 assists per game this season, which leads the MAAC and ranks 49th in the nation.

- ▶ His career-high seven steals vs. Holy Cross at home Dec. 14 stand the most for a Canisius player since **Craig Wise** had seven swipes against St. Bonaventure in The Aud on Jan. 25, 1994, and it also serves as the most steals for a player at the Koessler Athletic Center since former Griff **Harry Seymour** set the building record with nine steals in a game against Vermont on Jan. 28, 1991.
- ▶ Johnson enters tonight's game leading the MAAC and ranking ninth in the nation with his 2.9 steals per outing this season.

- ▶ With his efforts this season, senior **Malik Johnson** recently became just the second player in school history to dish out 500-plus career assists to go with 160-or-more career steals.
- ▶ Johnson joins former Griff guard **Frank Turner** (2006-10) as the only players in school history to accomplish that feat.

RANKING AMONG THE NATION'S BEST

- ▶ **Malik Johnson** starts tonight's game ranked among the top-20 nationally among all Division I players with his 508 career assists and 167 career steals.
- ▶ As of Dec. 21, Johnson ranks ninth among all Division I players with his 508 career assists. Rider guard **Stevie Jordan** ranks eighth on that list with his 519 career assists.
- ▶ Johnson is the MAAC's active leader in career steals, as his 167 career swipes is one better than Jordan's 166.

JOHNSON ADDS SCORING PUNCH TO HIS GAME

- ▶ **Malik Johnson** is well known around the MAAC for his ability to distribute the ball when the Griffs are on offense, but this season, he's adding a scoring touch to the team's offensive attack.
- ▶ Through the first 10 games of the season, the senior guard has scored 10-or-more points eight times, including a stretch of the team's last five games, where he's averaging 13.8 points per game.
- ▶ Johnson starts tonight's action averaging a team-best 14.4 points per game, which ranks 12th in the MAAC. His 12 points in the loss at FAU Dec. 4, allowed him to pass the 800-point mark for his career.

CANISIUS BASKETBALL

HITCHON HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Canisius junior **Scott Hitchon** scored a career-high 29 points in the team's loss at Buffalo, Dec. 18. That stands as a school record for points scored in a game by a Canisius player in UB's Alumni Arena.
- ▶ Hitchon is just the sixth player in program history to score 29-or-more points in a road game against Buffalo, Niagara and St. Bonaventure.
- ▶ The Whitby, Ontario native made a career-high 10 field goals against the Bulls, and he also added four rebounds, two steals, two blocks to his final stat line. He also drew two offensive charges in the game, which also makes a career best.

THREE TIMES A CHARM

- ▶ On Dec. 2, Canisius freshman **Jacco Fritz** was named the MAAC's Rookie of the Week, which marked the third-straight week the Tiel, Netherlands native earned the award.
- ▶ By earning that honor Dec. 2, Fritz became the first player in program history to earn a MAAC weekly honor in three consecutive weeks, and he became the second MAAC freshman to win the award in three-straight weeks in the last two seasons, joining Siena's **Jalen Pickett**, who garnered the league's top-rookie award on multiple occasions last season.

MAJESTY THE MICROWAVE

- ▶ Junior guard **Majesty Brandon** has proven he doesn't need much time to get hot when coming off the bench for the Griffis.
- ▶ In his first 10 career games with the program, Brandon is averaging 10.9 points per game, highlighted by his career-high 21-point effort in the win at UIC Nov. 26.
- ▶ The Bronx, N.Y., native has come off the bench and scored five-or-more points in nine of the team's 10 games to date. He is a driving force behind Canisius' bench-scoring effort, as the Griffis' reserves come into tonight's game averaging 31.3 points per contest.

BACK-TO-BACK 10-PLUS FOR WHITE

- ▶ Canisius junior **Jalanni White** scored 16 points off the bench in the Griffis' win over Holy Cross Dec. 14. That effort marked the second consecutive game of 10-or-more points for the New Haven, Conn., native after he scored 12 points at FAU Dec. 4.
- ▶ He scored his 16 points against Holy Cross after going 8-for-10 from the field. White starts tonight's game ranked fourth in the MAAC with his 55.0 percent (33-for-60) effort from the field this season.

FIRST TIME IN A LONG TIME

- ▶ Canisius junior **Jalanni White** closed out the 2018-19 season in strong fashion, capped by an appointment to the 2019 MAAC All-Tournament Team.
- ▶ White was good for double-digit points in four-straight games, highlighted by a season-high 16 points in the team's MAAC Championship quarterfinal round win over Manhattan.
- ▶ In that game, the New Haven, Conn., native went a perfect 7-for-7 from the floor, making him just the third player in MAAC Basketball Championship history to make seven-or-more field goals in a game without a miss.
- ▶ He is the ninth Canisius player in program history to be named to the MAAC All-Tournament Team, and he is the first front-court player to earn the honor since former Griffis **Ryan Collins** and **Micheal Meeks** were recognized in 1996.
- ▶ White used that strong finish to the season to push himself in the offseason. He starts this year having added 25 pounds to his 6-foot-8 frame.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR THE GRIFFS?

- ▶ Canisius welcomes senior **Corey Brown** to the 2019-20 roster as a graduate transfer from Northern Arizona. In his first game in a Canisius uniform at Brown Nov. 9, the Griffis' new big man scored 10 points and grabbed four rebounds in 21 minutes off the bench.
- ▶ Brown sat out the 2018-19 season, what was to be his senior year at Northern Arizona, with an injury. By joining the Canisius program, he becomes just the third grad transfer in program history and the first under head coach **Reggie Witherspoon**.
- ▶ The Hollywood, Fla., native played 82 games and made 23 starts at Northern Arizona in his time with that program. He joins with former Griffis **Chris Perez** (2013-14) and **Malcolm McMillan** (2015-16) as the only three graduate transfer in school history.

HARRIED GETTING INTO THE FLOW

- ▶ Canisius freshman **Armon Harried** has started all 10 games for the Griffis this season.
- ▶ Harried joined the Golden Griffin program after leading Lake Clifton High School to back-to-back Maryland Class 1A state championships. Last season, he averaged 29.4 points per game with three double-double efforts in Lake Clifton's title run. To cap his scholastic career, he scored 35 points in the title game.
- ▶ The son of former Syracuse big man **Herman "Tree" Harried**, Armon is averaging 6.4 points per game this season, and in the team's last five games, he's been good for 7.8 points per contest.

GAME NOTES

A FIRST FOR ZERO

- ▶ Canisius freshman **Akrum Ahemed** is wearing jersey No. 0, making him the first player in program history to wear just a single zero on his jersey.
- ▶ Six players in program history have worn "00", with the most recent double-zero on the Canisius roster being former Griff **Ronnie Gombe**, who played for the team from 2015-17.

JOHNSON EARNS PRESEASON ALL-MAAC HONORS

- ▶ Canisius senior guard **Malik Johnson** was named to the 2019-20 Preseason All-MAAC Second Team, as the league office announced its annual preseason awards live on ESPN3 Oct. 22.
- ▶ Johnson, who closed out the 2018-19 season as an All-MAAC Third Team honoree, was the only Canisius player selected among the league's top-15 players.

CANISIUS ADDS A TRANSFER

- ▶ In August, Canisius added transfer **Malek Green** to its roster. He is eligible to participate in practice on the Griffs' scout team, but will not be eligible to compete in games until the start of the 2020-21 campaign.
- ▶ A 6-foot-7, 215 pound forward, Green comes to Canisius after playing the two previous seasons at Morehead State. There, the Cincinnati, Ohio native played in 61 career games where he averaged 7.3 points and 5.2 boards per game for the Eagles.

CANISIUS IN KEYBANK CENTER

- ▶ Canisius' 61-57 win over St. Bonaventure at KeyBank Center Nov. 23 improved the Griffs to 29-19 all-time in the downtown Buffalo arena.
- ▶ The Griffs are now 4-2 all-time against St. Bonaventure at KeyBank Center, with wins coming in each of the last two meetings (including a 68-66 win on Nov. 29, 2009).

GRIFFS MAKE WAVES IN THE WINDY CITY

- ▶ Canisius' 94-64 win at UIC Nov. 26 stands as the program's largest margin of victory under fourth-year head coach **Reggie Witherspoon**.
- ▶ The 94 points for the Blue and Gold at UIC are the most for the program in a regulation road game since Dec. 9, 2012 when the team beat Marist 94-82 in Poughkeepsie, N.Y.
- ▶ The Griffs' victory over UIC stands as the program's largest margin of victory on the road in a non-league game since Dec. 1, 1976 when the Blue and Gold beat St. Michael's 100-70 in Colchester, Vt.
- ▶ The win at UIC also marked the program's first in the city of Chicago since Dec. 15, 1959, when the Griffs defeated Loyola University Chicago 73-68.

DUKE GETS THE CALL TO THE HALL

- ▶ On Dec. 5, Canisius College officially introduced its 2019 Sports Hall of Fame Class, and former Griffs guard **Duane "Duke" Richardson '82** is part of the induction class.
- ▶ Richardson played two seasons at Canisius (1978-79 and 1979-80) after transferring from Niagara County Community College. In his two years on Main Street, Richardson played 53 games and set program records for assists in a single-season (215 in 1978-79), assists per game average (8.3 in 1978-79) and career assists per game average (7.0).
- ▶ Richardson will be formally inducted in the Canisius Sports Hall of Fame on Saturday, Feb. 29, when the Griffs play host to Saint Peter's at the Koessler Athletic Center.

ALL-SESQUICENTENNIAL TEAM

- ▶ In honor of Canisius' 150th anniversary, the athletic department formally introduced the men's basketball program's "All-Sesquicentennial Team" on Nov. 23, when the Griffs played host to St. Bonaventure at KeyBank Center.
- ▶ The team, which was voted on by Canisius fans through an online poll at GoGriffs.com, represent some of the greatest players to ever wear the Blue and Gold.

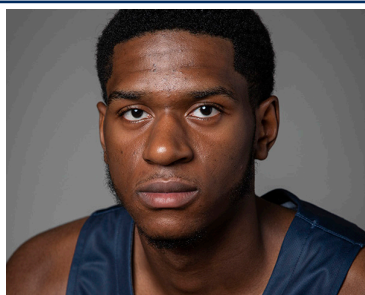

- Witherspoon has a MAC regular-season crown, two trips to the MAC Tournament title game, an NIT berth, two bids to the College Basketball Invitational (CBI) and a pair of trips to the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT) on his head coaching resume.
- Witherspoon has also coached at the international level, as he has assisted with USA Basketball and the national under-18 team program two times. In 2006, he worked with the USA U-18 tryout team that featured **Blake Griffin**, **Michael Beasley**, **Jared Bayless** and **Kyle Singler**. In 2010, he was an assistant coach under **Jeff Capel** and worked with **Kyrie Irving**, **Austin Rivers** and **Patric Young**.
- Witherspoon began his coaching career at his high school alma mater - Sweet Home High School in the north suburbs of Buffalo.
- As a player, Witherspoon played for two seasons at Erie Community College, where his head coach was **John Beilein**. Beilein later went on to be the Canisius head coach from 1992-97, and he now he serves as the head coach of the Cleveland Cavaliers.
