- ▶ The Griffs, winners of five of their last six, enter tonight's game with a record of 6-4. All 10 of the team's games have been against MAAC opponents.
- ▶ Prior to last Thursday, the Blue and Gold were scheduled to finish the season with eight-straight road games. However, that stretch was cut to six straight away from Buffalo after the series at Niagara was called off due to a positive COVID-19 test result among a Tier 1 member of the Purple Eagles program.
- ▶ Canisius is closing out the regular season on the road for the first time since the 2015-16 season.

CH-CH-CH CHANGES

- ▶ After numerous postponements to this series, Canisius and Siena will finally meet for two games, starting tonight in Loundonville, N.Y.
- ▶ The Golden Griffins were scheduled to end the 2020-21 season on an eight-game road stretch, which would have been the longest in program history. However, last weekend's series at Niagara was cancelled due to a postive COVID-19 test result within the Purple Eagle program.
- ▶ In the five years under head coach **Reggie Witherspoon**, Canisius is 34-36 in road games, with a 25-19 mark in MAAC road contests. Witherspoon is the only coach in program history to have at least one win in every opposing MAAC building. This however, will be his first game against Siena in the UHY Center.

FIRST TIME IN A LONG TIME

- ▶ The Canisius Niagara men's basketball rivalry is one of the best in the MAAC, with the two teams having met on the hardwood 187 times since the 1903-04 season.
- ▶ But this year will be different. With the cancellation of last weekend's series at Niagara, the 2020-21 campaign will mark the first time since 1965-66 season where the two Western New York schools have not played.
- ▶ In all, Canisius will close out the 2020-21 regular season having not played Iona, Manhattan Niagara and Rider.

DON'T COUNT THEM OUT

- In each of its last two series, Canisius has overcome a double-digit first half deficit to come back and score a win after the Griffs trailed by 11
- At Quinnipiac on Feb. 12, Canisius trailed the Bobcats by as many as 15 points in the first half before scoring a 74-67 road win. Including the comeback win at Fairfield Feb. 19, this season marks the first time under head coach **Reggie**Witherspoon where the Griffs trailed by 10-or more points in multiple games and came back to score victories.

After winning just once time last season when trailing at the halftime break, Canisius has now won two such contests this season (Feb. 12 at Quinnipiac and Feb. 19 at Fairfield).

YEAR FIVE UNDER WITHERSPOON

- ▶ The 2020-21 season marks the fifth year Canisius head coach **Reggie Witherspoon**. In terms of service at his current school, Witherspoon ranks fourth in the MAAC behind **Steve Masiello** (Manhattan 10th season); **King Rice** (Monmouth 10th season); and **Kevin Baggett** (Rider eighth season).
- ▶ Since Witherspoon took over the program prior to the 2016-17 campaign, the Griffs have posted 72 total wins. Those 72 victories since 2016-17 rank four-best among the 11 teams in the MAAC.
- ▶ Prior to the start of this season, Witherspoon had 66 career wins at Canisius to his credit. Only three previous Canisius head coaches Joseph Curran, John Beilein and Jim Baron have won more games as the Griffs' bench boss in their first four years than Witherspoon's 66 victories.
- Additionally, Canisius is 49-37 in MAAC regular-season games under Witherspoon. The team's .570 league win percentage since the start of the 2016-17 season is the best for the program in more than 20 years.
- ▶ The team's win at Fairfield Feb. 19 moved Witherspoon into a tie for eighth place on the school's career coaching wins list. He starts tonight's game tied with former head coach and Canisius Hall of Famer Joe Niland, who won 72 games from 1948-53.

MOVING UP THE MAAC CHART

- Now 10 games into this fifth season as the Griffs' head coach, Reggie Witherspoon ranks second among Canisius coaches with his 49 career MAAC regular-season victories.

- ▶ Witherspoon is the sixth Canisius head coach to lead the Blue and Gold since the program joined the MAAC prior to the start of the 1989-90 campaign. The Griffs' 70-58 win over Saint Peter's Jan. 1 allowed him to move into sole possession of second place on the program's career MAAC wins list.

LUCKY NUMBER 70

- ▶ Under head coach **Reggie Witherspoon**, the Griffs are 58-26 (5-0 this year) when scoring 70-or more points on the scoreboard after posting an 80-69 win over Fairfield Feb. 19.
- ▶ The 53 points scored by Canisius in the road loss at Fairfield Feb. 20 marked the 57th time since 2016-17 where the Griffs failed to reach 70 on the scoreboard. Canisius is 14-43 in those 57 contests (1-4 this season).

FINALLY BACK TO ACTION

- ▶ Canisius' game at Quinnipiac on Feb. 12 marked the first time the Golden Griffins had played game since Jan. 2, a span of 41 days.
- ▶ The Griffs are one of five active Division I men's basketball teams to have a mid-year Covid-19 related "pause" of 40-or more days.
- ▶ The two games played in the month of January by the Griffs are the fewest for the program since that 1933-34 season when Canisius also played two contests. Like this year, the 1933-34 edition of the Griffs won both of their January games as well.

THE BENCH BOOST

- ▶ Through the first 10 games of the season, Canisius' bench is averaging 35.9 points per game, which leads the MAAC and ranks second in the nation.
- ▶ The Griffs have scored 20-plus points off the bench in all 10 games, and in five contests, the team received 40-plus points from its reserve players.

MAKING THE FREE ONES

- ▶ In the sweep over Quinnipiac Feb. 12-13, Canisius made 40 free-throws on 50 chances from the stripe, a success rate of 80.0 percent.
- ▶ The Golden Griffins made 22 free-throws on 28 chances from the line in the team's come-from-behind win over the Bobcats on Feb. 12. That stands as the most makes from the charity stripe in a game for the Blue and Gold since March 14, 2018, when the team knocked down 25 free-throws chances against Jacksonville State in a first-round CBI game.
- After making just eight free-throws in the season-opening win over Marist Dec. 11, the Griffs have been much more efficient at the line, making an average of 15.7 charity tosses in the other eight contests this season.
- ▶ Sophomore Jacco Fritz made a career-high 10 free-throws in the win at Quinnipiac Feb. 12. That stands as the most free-throw makes in a game for a Griff since Takal Molson made 11 charity tosses against the Bobcats on Feb. 1, 2019.

TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

- ▶ The Griffs come into this weekend at Siena averaging 12.4 turnovers per game, which ranks as the fewest of any active team at the Division I level .
- ▶ In the win over Fairfield Feb. 19, Canisius turned the ball over a season-low seven times. Five of those seven turnovers came after halftime.
- As a team, Canisius is 6-1 this year when turning the ball over 15 times or less, with the lone loss coming at Fairfield Feb. 20.

GETTING OFFENSIVE (REBOUNDS)

- Entering tonight's game at Siena, Canisius is averaging 10.5 offensive rebounds per game as a team, which ranks third-best in the MAAC and 144th in the nation.
- ▶ The Griffs are one of three teams in the MAAC to have two players (Jacco Fritz and Malek Green) ranked among the top-10 in the league in offensive rebounds per game. Fritz is good for 2.0 offensive rebounds per game, which ranks third in the MAAC (114th nationally) and Green ranks ninth in the league (224th in the nation) with his 2.1 offensive boards per contest.

MORE POINTS, YOUR MAJESTY

- ▶ Senior guard Majesty Brandon has picked up right where he left off at the end of the 2019-20 campaign. In the Griffs' first 10 games this season, the Bronx, N.Y., native is averaging 12.1 points per contest, which ranks second on the roster.
- ▶ Brandon has scored 10-plus points in six of the Griffs' 10 games to date. Through his first 42 career games at Canisius, he's scored in double-figures 28 times, which is the most for any active player on the roster.
- ▶ With his 10 points at Monmouth Dec. 28, Brandon passed the 500-point milestone for his career. Only teammate Scott Hitchon (568 points) has more career points on the Griffs' current roster than Brandon (565).
- ▶ Brandon scored a game-high 21 points for the Blue and Gold in the Griffs' 56-52 loss to Marist Dec. 12. That marked the seventh time in his Canisius career where he's posted 20-or more points in a game.
- ▶ Brandon continues to prove he can play and contribute at both ends of the floor. The Griffs' leader with 11 steals this season, he is tied for second on the team with six blocked shots after being credited with two blocks in the win over Fairfield Feb. 19.

ABOUT THE SAINTS

- ▶ Siena enters tonight's game with a record of 11-3 on the year. Like Canisius, all of the Saints' games have been played against MAAC opponents.
- ▶ The Saints are coming off a home sweep of Manhattan last weekend. The Saints start this series with the Griffs having won three straight and four of their last five, dating back to Jan. 31.
- ▶ Senior Manny Camper is the only player in the MAAC averaging a double-double on the year. He is good for 14.2 points per game, which ranks him fifth in the conference, and his 10.1 rebounds per contest is the best number in the league.
- ▶ The Saints have four players averaging 10.2 points per game or better, as the team ranks fifth in the MAAC in scoring average at 67.8 points per contest. The Saints' defense has been formidable this season as well, with Siena allowing just 62.4 points per game to its opponents, which is second-best in the conference.

CANISIUS - SIENA SERIES HISTORY

- ▶ This will be the 105th all-time meeting between these two schools, with Siena holding a 55-49 lead in the series.
- ▶ Four of the last six games between the Griffs and Saints have been decided by six points-or fewer. Last year at the Times Union Center, Siena scored a 73-72 win over Canisius in the MAAC opener for both squads.
- ▶ This weekend marks the first time Canisius has played a regular season game at the UHY Center since Jan. 5, 1994. The Griffs are 1-13 all-time at UHY Center on Siena's campus, with the lone victory coming Jan. 8, 1986 a 74-52 victory for the Blue and Gold.

GREEN MEANS GO

- ▶ Junior forward Malek Green was named the MAAC Player of the Week Feb. 22 after he averaged 21.5 points and 7.0 rebounds per game in a split at Fairfield.
- In the team's comeback win over the Stags Feb. 19, Green came off the bench and scored a career-high 29 points after he made a career-best 10 field goals, including a career-high four 3-pointers.
- ▶ Green, who joined the Canisius program after playing two seasons at Morehead State, is averaging a team-high 12.6 points and a team best 7.3 rebounds per game in his first 10 career games on Main Street.
- After sitting out the 2019-20 due to NCAA transfer rules, Green returned to the floor Dec. 11 against Marist, marking his first live game action since March 7, 2019 a span of 645 days. He ended that game with 18 points and seven boards.

GREEN GOES AND GETS IT

- ▶ With his six rebounds at Fairfield Feb. 20, junior Malek Green extended his streak of pulling down fiveor more boards in a game to 10 straight, which makes him the first Canisius player to record five-plus rebounds in his first 10 games with the program in the last 25 seasons.
- ▶ Green leads the Griffs and ranks third in the MAAC in rebounds per game at 7.3 per outing.

ALL-AROUND AHAMADOU

- ▶ Junior Ahamadou Fofana has been a stat sheet filler over the last few games for the Griffs, as he posted 11 points, four rebounds, two assists and two steals in the win over Fairfield Feb. 19.
- ▶ His six assists in the win over Quinnipiac Feb. 13 stand as a season-high for the Bronx, N.Y., native, and his five rebounds in that game are also a season high.
- ▶ In the team's last five games, he is averaging 10.4 points, 3.6 assists and 2.8 rebounds per game. He also owns an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.0 in those five contests.

FOFANA HITS THE FREE ONES

- ▶ Junior guard Ahamadou Fofana posted a career-high 17 points in the team's win over Saint Peter's Jan. 2, with nine of those points coming from the free-throw line.
- ▶ Fofana helped Canisius seal the victory over the Peacocks by draining seven free-throws in the game's final 36 seconds. The Blue and Gold earned their second-straight victory in that contest despite not making a field goal for the contest's final 7:25.
- ▶ Entering tonight's action, Fofana is shooting a team-high 82.1 percent from the free-throw line, which ranks sixth in the MAAC among players with at least two makes per game.

NO. 3 FOR THREE

- ▶ Junior guard Jordan Henderson scored a season-high 19 points in the win over Fairfield Feb. 19t, with six of those points coming on the power of two made 3-point field goals.
- ▶ Entering tonight's game, Henderson leads the team with his 42.9 percent success rate from 3-point range, which ranks third-best in the conference. His 16 makes from behind the arc also leads the squad.
- ▶ Henderson enters this contest with 73 career makes from 3-point range, which ranks second on the team's active roster behind teammate Majesty Brandon, who has 76 three-balls to his credit.

- ▶ Sophomore Jacco Fritz matched a career-high with 18 points in Canisius' win over Quinnipiac on Feb. 12. That 18-point effort was highlighted by a career-high 10 makes from the free-throw line.
- ▶ Prior to that effort on Feb. 12, 2021 Fritz had scored 18 points in one other game in his career. That contest was at Niagara, on Feb. 12, 2020.
- ▶ In the team's last five games, Fritz is averaging 10.2 points, 7.2 rebounds, 2.6 assists and 1.0 blocks per game. In that stretch, he's shooting 53.6 percent (15-for-28) from the field and 73.1 percent (19-for-26) from the free-throw line.

A FULL SENIOR CLASS FOR THE GRIFFS

- ▶ Canisius' 2020-21 roster features three seniors with two of those players having played their entire careers on Main Street.
- ▶ Senior forwards **Scott Hitchon** and **Jalanni White** have combined to play 185 career games in Blue and Gold, with Hitchon playing in 90 career contests and White seeing the floor in 95 games over the previous three seasons.
- ▶ Senior guard Majesty Brandon played all 42 games for the Griffs after starting his college career at Monroe Community College in Rochester, N.Y.

CLOSE, BUT NOT AS MANY CIGARS

- ▶ In 2018-19, Canisius played in 14 games decided by five-points or less, and the Griffs led the nation with 11 wins in those 14 contests.
- ▶ The 2019-20 season resulted in different outcome for the Blue and Gold in close games, as Canisius closed out the campaign with a 6-9 record in games decided by five points or less, with eight of those losses coming in MAAC play.
- ▶ This season, Canisius has played two games decided by five-points or fewer. The Griffs are 1-1 in those two games, including the team's 63-60 victory over Saint Peter's Jan. 2.

THE SLIMMEST OF MARGINS

- ▶ The Griffs' 69-68 loss to Saint Peter's on Feb. 29, 2020 was one of five games last season where Canisius played a game decided by one-point, with all five of those games coming against MAAC opponents. The Blue and Gold went 2-3 in those contests.
- ▶ One of the Griffs' two MAAC wins in 2019-20 by one point came at home versus Marist Feb. 2. Canisius trailed by as many as seven points in the final 4:00, but Majesty Brandon scored the Griffs' final 10 points, capped by the game-winning 3-pointer with 5.1 seconds left, to lift the Griffs to the 66-65 victory.
- ▶ The 2019-20 season marked the first time Canisius played five-or more games decided by just one point since 1985-86. In that season, Canisius also played five games decided by one point, and the team was 2-3 in those five contests.

GRIFFS GO SHARPIE

- ▶ The Griffs are 101-3 since the start of 2013-14 when leading at the 2:00 mark of the second half of a game.
- ▶ The Griffs are 94-12 since 2013-14 when leading at the 5:00 mark in the second half.

PROTECT THIS HOUSE

▶ The Griffs own an all-time record of 247-152 (.619 win percentage) in the Koessler Athletic Center. The team is 126-120 (.512 win percentage) since 2001.

NOT WORKING OVERTIME

- ▶ Canisius went the entire 2019-20 season without playing an overtime game. The Griffs' last overtime contest came on March 8, 2019, when the Blue and Gold beat Manhattan 69-65 in the quarterfinal round of the 2019 MAAC Men's Basketball Championship in Albany, N.Y.
- ▶ Prior to the 2019-20 season, the last time Canisius went without an overtime contest was 2010-11.

CANISIUS PICKED 10TH IN MAAC POLL

- ▶ Canisius was picked to finish 10th in the annual MAAC Preseason Coaches Poll.
- ▶ The Griffs received 31 votes in the poll, leaving the Blue and Gold five points behind ninth-place Marist. Siena, the MAAC's defending champion, garnered all 11 first-place votes en route to being selected the MAAC's preseason favorite.

BRANDON EARNS PRESEASON ALL-MAAC HONORS

- ▶ Canisius senior guard **Majesty Brandon** was named to the 2020-21 Preseason All-MAAC Second Team, the league office announced during its annual preseason awards on ESPN3.
- ▶ Brandon wass the Griffs' returning leading scorer after he averaged 13.9 points per game a season ago. He is one of five returners in the MAAC who averaged 13.5 points per game or better last year.

TWO GRIFFS EARN LOCAL AWARDS

- ▶ Canisius senior Majesty Brandon and sophomore forward Jacco Fritz were honored as members of the 2020-21 Preseason All-Big 4 Teams, which were voted on by college basketball media and the athletic communications staffs from Buffalo, Canisius, Niagara and St. Bonaventure.
- ▶ Brandon was the lone Canisius player to be named to the Preseason All-Big 4 First Team. Fritz earned Preseason All-Big 4 Second Team honors after he averaged 7.1 points and 4.5 rebounds per game last year in his rookie campaign with the Canisius program.

SILVER ANNIVERSARY FOR THE MAAC CHAMPS

- ▶ The 2020-21 season marks the 25th anniversary of the Canisius men's basketball team winning its lone MAAC Men's Basketball Championship.
- ▶ The 1995-96 edition of the Blue and Gold went 19-11 on the year, highlighted by a 52-46 win over Fairfield in the MAAC Championship game in Albany, N.Y.

LOSS OF A GRIFFS LEGEND

- ▶ Canisius lost one of its all-time greats on May 9 when Canisius Hall of Famer John McCarthy passed away from natural causes. He was 86 years old.
- ▶ A Buffalo native, McCarthy starred at Bishop Timon High School before playing 61 games as a Griff from 1953-56. He scored 1,160 career points and helped lead the Blue and Gold to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances in 1954-55 and 1955-56.
- ▶ McCarthy was drafted in the fourth round of the 1956 NBA Draft by the Rochester Royals. He went on to play for three NBA teams, including the Boston Celtics, where he was on the team that won the 1964 World Championship.
- ▶ McCarthy made NBA history on March 16, 1960, as a member of the St. Louis Hawks. In a playoff game against the Minneapolis Lakers, McCarthy became the first player in NBA history to record a triple-double in his first career playoff game after he scored 13 points to go with 11 rebounds and 11 assists.

MAAC UNITED FOR JUSTICE

- Canisius, along with the other 10 member schools of the MAAC, will take part in the MAAC's United for Justice campaign this season.
- ▶ The MAAC and the MAAC Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC) launched its multi-year program over the summer, with elements of the campaign being displayed on school campuses, live game broadcasts, online and through social media.
- ▶ The Canisius men's basketball team will be wearing Black Lives Matter (BLM) uniform patches throughout the season. There will also be a "Black Lives Matter" floor decal on the court at the Koessler Athletic Center throughout the season.

HENDERSON REPRESENTS THE GRIFFS IN MAAC READING PROGRAM

- ▶ Junior guard Jordan Henderson served as Canisius' representative in the MAAC's virtual reading program titled "Time Out For Black Lives".
- ▶ The "Time Out For Black Lives" programs is geared toward elementary and middle school children, and features MAAC coaches and student-athletes raising awareness to the cause while also promoting the importance of reading.
- ▶ Henderson read the book titled "Cool Cuts" by Mechal Renee Roe.

Reggie Witherspoon, a Buffalo native and a 24-year veteran of the college basketball coaching ranks, was named the 24th head coach in Canisius College men's basketball history on May 28, 2016.

In his four previous seasons as head coach of the Golden Griffins, Witherspoon has guided the program to 66 wins, 43 of which have come in MAAC play, a share of the 2017-18 MAAC regularseason championship and a pair of national postseason appearances (CIT in 2016-17, CBI in 2017-18).

The Griffs' 66 total wins since the start of the 2016-17 campaign rank fourth-most among the MAAC's 11 schools in that time frame, and only three former Canisius head coaches (Joseph Curran, John Beilein and Jim Baron) have won more games in their first four years as Canisius' bench boss than Witherspoon.

Additionally, Canisius also has shown a tremendous ability to win on the road under Witherspoon's guidence, as the Griffs have collected 31 "true" road victories since the start of the 2016-17 campaign, which ranks among the top-25 of all Division I teams in the nation during that time period.

After the 2017-18 and 2018-19 regular seasons, Canisius traveled to the MAAC Men's Basketball Championship as the No. 2 seed, and in 2019, the Blue and Gold earned a trip to the conference tournament's semifinal round – just the third semifinal appearance for the program since 2001. One of two coaches in program history to win at least one game in every opposing MAAC building, Witherspoon earned his 250th career victory as a Division I head coach Feb. 22, 2019 after the Griffs used a late defensive stand to defeat Monmouth on the road by the score of 60-59.

In his second year at the helm of the program, Witherspoon led Canisius to a share of the 2017-18 MAAC regular-season championship, the program's first since 1993-94. In that year, the Blue and Gold won 21 games and set the program record with 15 MAAC regular-season victories. That season, three Griffs earned All-MAAC accolades, highlighted by Jermaine Crumpton being named the 2017-18 MAAC Co-Player of the Year and Takal Molson earning MAAC Rookie of the Year honors. Crumpton, who went on to become just the fifth player in school history to earn Associated Press All-America Honorable Mention honors, is one of four players in school history to be named the MAAC's Player of the Year, Molson became the first Buffalo, N.Y., native to earn the MAAC's top rookie honor, and he is one of seven players in conference history to earn MAAC Rookie of the Year honors in the same season where his team won a regular-season or conference tournament title.

Witherspoon's first season at Canisius (2016-17) saw the Griffs secure 18 wins, highlighted by a seven-game win streak that featured back-to-back overtime road wins over long-time rivals Buffalo and St. Bonaventure, and he guided the Golden Griffins to their fourth CIT appearance since 2013

With a roster that featured five players signed after June 1, Witherspoon was able to become just the second coach in program history to earn a postseason berth in his first year in charge on Main Street. The seven-game win streak, which ran from Dec. 7 through Jan. 4, is the program's longest since the 1998-99 season, and the Blue and Gold's back-to-back overtime victories were the first for the team since the 1982-83 campaign. The second overtime victory – a 106-101 win at St. Bonaventure – stands as just the eighth victory

for Canisius in 38 tries inside the Reilly Center, the Bonnies' home court.

Three Griffs earned All-MAAC honors under Witherspoon's guidance in 2016-17, the first time three Canisius players earned all-league honors in the same season since 2006-07. Since taking over, six different Griffs have earned All-MAAC accolades, with Witherspoon recruiting four of those players to Main Street.

AT CHATTANOOGA

Witherspoon spent the 2015-16 season at Chattanooga, where he was a member of Matt McCall's coaching staff that led the Mocs to a 29-6 overall record, a Southern Conference regularseason championship, a SoCon tourney title and the school's first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2009.

AT ALABAMA

Witherspoon spent the 2014-15 season at Alabama under former head coach Anthony Grant, who is currently the head coach at Dayton. With the Crimson Tide, he was part of a staff that posted 19 overall wins and eight SEC victories en route to a berth into the NIT.

AT BUFFALO

Witherspoon is best known in Western New York for his work building the basketball program at the University at Buffalo. A two-time Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year (2004, 2012), he led the Bulls from 1999-2013, where he posted a career record of 198-228 in 14 seasons. In addition, Buffalo boasted a record of 174-143 over Witherspoon's last 10 years with the program, which featured a MAC regular-season crown, two trips to the MAC Tournament title game, an NIT berth, a bid to the College Basketball Invitational (CBI) and a pair of trips to the CollegeInsider. com Postseason Tournament (CIT). In his time at Buffalo, Witherspoon led the Bulls to four 20-win campaigns in 2010-11 and 2011-12.

Witherspoon, who as a student at Erie Community College played under former Canisius head coach John Beilein, mentored a pair of All-Americans at Buffalo in Turner Battle (2005) and Mitchell Watt (2012). Battle also earned CoSIDA Academic All-America Second-Team accolades under Witherspoon's guidance. Both Battle (2005) and Watt (2012) were named the MAC Player of the Year, while Javone McCrea earned the conference's Rookie of the Year honor in 2011. Additionally, former Bull Mark Bortz was the league's top sixth man in 2005. In all, Witherspoon played a role in recruiting and coaching 18 All-MAC honorees.

AT ERIE COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Witherspoon took over as Buffalo's interim head coach five games into the 1999-00 season after a two-year term as the head coach at Erie Community College. In his time leading the Kats, Witherspoon posted a 43-15 record. He was named the Western New York Athletic Conference Coach of the Year in both of those seasons at ECC, while producing four Division I signees, two All-Americans and one academic All-American. His 1998-99 squad at ECC went 24-5 en route to the NJCAA Regional III championship and a national ranking in the NJCAA top-20 poll. He was also named the Region III Coach of the Year that season.

Born Phillip Reginald Witherspoon on Feb. 21, 1961, he is a 1995 graduate of Empire State College, where he earned his bachelor's degree in interdisciplinary studies. He also earned his associate degree at Erie Community College where he was a member of the men's basketball program.
