## NOTABLE NOTES

### QUICK STOP BACK HOME

The Canisius women's basketball team returns home for their lone game of the week against Iona on Feb. 4, before heading back on the road next week. Tip-off from Buffalo, N.Y., is set for 1 p.m. with the game streaming on ESPN3.

### COMEBACK COMPLETE

Last season against Iona on March 5, 2022, the Blue and Gold used a 30-point fourth quarter to come back and defeat the Gaels, 71-62. Of Canisius' 30 points in the fourth quarter, 18 came in the final 4:18 of the contest. **Dani Haskell** scored a team-high 21 points for the Griffis while **Shaunae Brown** added 14 points and **Athina Lexa** chipped in 11. That win was the Griffis fourth in the last seven contests against Iona.

### STARTING TO MAKE AN IMPACT

Sophomore guard **Cheyenne Stubbs** has started the past two games for Canisius (at Niagara Jan. 25/at Fairfield Jan. 28) and has quickly established herself in the lineup. In that span, she has averaged 13 points, 2.5 assists and 4.0 rebounds per game. She notched a season-high 13 points against Niagara on Jan. 25, before tying the mark the following game against Fairfield on Jan. 28.

### HOME COOKING

This season, the Blue and Gold have won their first home game of each month. Canisius defeated Buffalo, 57-55, in its first home game of November. They opened December with a 85-47 victory over St. Bonaventure and kicked-off January with a 79-74 overtime dub against Saint Peter's.

### MAKING WAVES IN THE MAAC

Multiple members of the Griffis rank within the top-ten of multiple stat categories in the MAAC. Leading the way is graduate student guard **Vannessa Garrelts** who is tied for first with Jessica Tomasetti of Mount St. Mary's in the MAAC for free-throw percentage at 84.6%. Senior guard **Jane McCauley** is sixth in the MAAC for 3-point percentage at 36.3% with a minimum of 50 attempts. Junior guard **Dani Haskell** is ranked top-ten in multiple categories as she is fifth in the MAAC for minutes played per-game (33.4), ninth in 3-pointers per game (1.8) and tenth in points per-game (12.6). As a team, Canisius leads the MAAC in free-throw percentage at 75.7%.

## SOPHOMORE FORWARD - #33 RHAY PORTER



A defensive stalwart, sophomore forward **Rhay Porter** has her name etched in the Canisius record book for blocks. Porter tied the all-time single game record for blocks with six last season against Niagara on Jan. 9, 2022 and ranks ninth all-time for single season block average with 1.2 blocks-per-game last season.

## WHAT IS A GRIFFIN?

The Griffin is a mythical creature of supposed gigantic size that has the head, forelegs and wings of an eagle and the hindquarters, tail and ears of a lion. They are well known for their speed, ability to fly and having eyes like an eagle as well as the strength and courage of a lion.

Griffins have been known for centuries as symbols of strength and vigilance, have been called "The Hounds of Zeus" in Greek mythology and are said to have mastery of both the land and sky.

They are thought to be from India, where the natives of the land made their talons and claws into drinking cups because the talon of a Griffin was said to detect poison in a liquid. Griffins would find gold in the mountains and line their nests with it and as a result, were forced to become great guardians of the nests to keep the hunters away.

## FINALLY AT THE FREE-THROW LINE

Senior guard **Jane McCauley** attempted her first two free-throws of the season against Niagara on Jan. 25, going 1-of-2 from the line. Previously, the New Rochelle, N.Y., led the nation in minutes played without attempting one shot from the charity stripe at 315. Anna Nelson of Dartmouth is the next closest player to McCauley's mark, playing in 219 minutes and not attempting a single free-throw. Before Jan. 25, McCauley had only ever attempted two free-throws, going 1-for-2 while at Vermont.

## ONE LAST HURRAH

Graduate student guard **Vannessa Garrelts** is compiling an impressive final season of NCAA basketball. Through 20 games with Canisius, she has scored 212 points, 76 assists and 35 steals. Through four years at Miami (OH), Garrelts scored 161 points and in her senior season, totaled 39 steals and 61 assists. This year, she has also established new career-highs in points (18, at Detroit Mercy Nov. 13) and rebounds (10, at Robert Morris Nov. 26).

## FIRST OF MANY

Against Mount St. Mary's on Jan. 14, freshman forward **Sisi Eleko** recorded her first career double-double, finishing the contest with 12 points and 11 rebounds. The Montreal, Quebec, becomes the second freshman this season to have a double-double. Freshman forward **Brooklyn Thrash** scored 16 points and grabbed 10 rebounds against Binghamton on Nov. 20 for her first career double-double. Twice this season, Eleko was one rebound short of a double-double (Dec. 17 vs Rider - 14 points, nine rebounds / Dec. 19 vs Marist - 15 points, nine rebounds).

## WATCH OUT BELOW

Canisius graduate student guard **Vannessa Garrelts** only stands at 5'4, but on Jan. 5 against Saint Peter's, recorded her first block of the season and fifth of her career. Across the rest of Division I this season, four shorter players have been credited with a block. Regina Walton (5'3) of Elon, Cara McCormack (5'3) of Holy Cross, Annika Shah (5'3) of Cal Poly and Nevaeh Tot of Oklahoma (5'2) are the only players shorter than Garrelts who have registered a block. Two players, Jordyn Jackson of CSUN and Angel Jones of MAAC rival Siena, also stand at 5'4 and have recorded at least one block this season.

## FAMILIAR PLACES

Both **Vannessa Garrelts** (Miami (OH)) and **Jane McCauley** (Vermont) each played Canisius while with their other schools. For McCauley, specifically, she established her then career high in points (five) and assists (two). Both guards played Canisius during their freshman seasons as well with Garrelts visiting Main Street during 2018-19 and McCauley facing the Griffs during the 2019-20 season.

## MEET CAT

Former Quinnipiac forward/center **Cat Almeida** has joined head coach **Sahar Nusseibeh**'s staff as the new director of basketball operations. She appeared in over 30 games over four seasons with the Bobcats and was a member of the 2021-22 team that defeated Rhode Island in the WNIT.

## A 3 A DAY KEEPS THE DOCTOR AWAY

Against St. Bonaventure on Dec. 7, seven different Griffs hit at least one 3-pointer during the game. Freshmen **Sisi Eleko**, **Brooklyn Thrash** and **Adrien LaMora** each had one, **Cheyenne Stubbs** and **Vannessa Garrelts** each scored two, **Jane McCauley** hit three and **Dani Haskell** notched four 3-pointers, the most she has made in a game since Nov. 22 at Colgate where she also had four makes from deep.

## OVER 40

Junior guard **Dani Haskell** became the first player to play over 40 minutes in a contest since **Shaunae Brown** and (41:20) and **Erika Joseph** (40:13) did so on Feb. 5, 2022 at Fairfield. The Franklinville, N.Y., native played in 41:48 of a possible 45 minutes.

## ICE IN HER VEINS

Down 68-65 with less than ten seconds remaining in the fourth quarter against Saint Peter's on Jan. 5, senior guard **Jane McCauley** inbounded the ball to graduate student guard **Vannessa Garrelts**, who moved past her defender and fired off a make from beyond the arc to tie the game 68-all and force overtime. In overtime, the Golden Griffins limited Saint Peter's to just six points in the extra frame to post a 79-74 victory. This was the first overtime win for Canisius since Feb. 1, 2018, when the Blue and Gold defeated Battle of the Bridge rival Niagara, 64-60.

## MEET SHAREESE

Head coach **Sahar Nusseibeh** grew her staff this offseason with the addition of assistant coach **Shareese Ullis-McBrayer**. Ullis-McBrayer comes to Main St. after spending the previous four seasons as an assistant coach at Owens Community College. During the 2021-22 season, she was part of the coaching staff that helped lead the Express to the NJCAA Division III national championship after the team posted a 27-4 overall record. While serving as the program's head of recruiting, she worked with and developed five All-America honorees, a national Player of the Year award winner and multiple all-conference, all-district and all-tournament team selections.

## WIRE TRANSFER WINS

Against Colgate on Nov. 22, the Blue and Gold defeated the Raiders while also not allowing Colgate to take a lead at any point of the game. The Griffs held their largest lead at the 2:56 mark of the first quarter with their 12 point advantage. This is the first time under head coach **Sahar Nusseibeh** that the Blue and Gold won a game without ever trailing.

Ahead of the 2022-23 season, the Canisius women's basketball team was surveyed about major issues of today such as are you a dog or a cat person, which 100% of the team said they are dog people with no one picking cats.

When it came to what sport they would play if it wasn't basketball, 1/3 of the team said they would pursue volleyball, another third said softball, three players said soccer, and only one, sophomore guard **Athina Lexa**, said she would hit the clay and play tennis.

Pancakes and waffles was about evenly divided the Golden Griffins with 40% of the team picking pancakes and 60% picking waffles for their breakfast foot options. More divisive was the issue on what season is the best with 1/3 players picking fall, 1/3 picking summer, but only one player picked winter, and again it was guard **Athina Lexa** as the odd one out. Freshman forward **Adrien LaMora** could not pick just one season and said her favorite time of year is the transition from summer to fall.



On social media, the team is almost evenly split with 40% of the team choosing Instagram and another 40% picking Tik Tok. Only two members of the team picked Snapchat as their preferred social media with **Sisi Eleko** and **Giana Hernandez Boulden** selecting the app. When asked if they prefer to sing or dance, 45% of the team picked singing while another 45% said dancing. Graduate student **Vannessa Garrelts** said she can't sing or dance while freshman forward **Chloe Chard Peloquin** said she loves both equally.



On gameday, almost the entire team says that shoes make a gameday outfit with only **Rhay Porter** and **Xanthippi Karatasiou** saying that a shirt makes or breaks a gameday outfit.

The most divisive issue was the question of what is the best postgame meal with nearly everyone on the team answering something different. Local pizza place Francos had the support of **Dani Haskell** and **Cheyenne Stubbs**. ## HEAD COACH - SAHAR NUSSEIBEH



**Sahar Nusseibeh** (pronounced new-SAY-bay) enters her second season as the head coach of the Canisius women's basketball program.

Nusseibeh was officially named the 10th head coach in program history on July 23, 2021. A long-time assistant coach with 12 years of Division I coaching experience, Nusseibeh took over the Canisius program after spending the previous two seasons at Miami University where she also held the title of defensive coordinator.

In her first season on Main Street, Nusseibeh led the squad to a MAAC Women's Basketball Championship opening round win, becoming the first No. 11 seed to win a game in the tournament's history. Two Golden Griffins also received all-conference accolades as sophomore **Dani Haskell** was named an All-MAAC Third Team honoree and freshman **Athina Lexa** was a unanimous selection to the All-MAAC Rookie Team.

The 2021-22 campaign saw the Griffs set a program record for 3-pointers made in a contest with 15 in an 81-78 win versus Siena on Jan. 29, 2022. The team was also one 3-pointer shy of tying the program record for 3-pointers made, set during the 2008-09 season (252). Canisius also led the MAAC and ranked 28th in the nation with its 251 three-point field goals made.

As the defensive coordinator at Miami University in Oxford, Ohio, Nusseibeh was responsible for developing and implementing all aspects of team and individual defensive concepts. She also worked on game planning the team's defensive strategies and was in charge of all defensive play calls and in-game adjustments during timeouts and in-game action. Prior to joining the Redhawks' staff, she spent three seasons (2016-19) as the associate head coach, recruiting coordinator and defensive coordinator at Manhattan College in Riverdale, N.Y.

During her time at Manhattan, Nusseibeh played a key role in recruiting and coaching five All-MAAC selections, two MAAC All-Rookie Team honorees and the 2019 MAAC Women's Defensive Player of the Year. One of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's (WBCA) "Thirty Under 30" honorees in 2016, Nusseibeh led the Jaspers' defensive efforts which saw Manhattan rank among the top-five in the MAAC in scoring defense, blocked shots and turnovers forced in three straight seasons. In her final year at Manhattan, the Jaspers ranked 17th nationally in scoring defense (56.3 points per game allowed), while also placing in the top-100 nationally in field goal percentage defense (75th), steals per game (76th), blocked shots per game (63rd) and turnovers forced (79th).

Nusseibeh was a part of the Bowling Green coaching staff for three seasons (2013-16) and helped lead the Falcons to a 2013-14 Mid-American Conference regular-season crown after the team went 30-5 overall and 17-1 in league play. She recruited and coached five All-MAC honorees, including an All-America selection, and she played a key role in helping Bowling Green earn three-straight WBCA Top-25 Team Academic Awards.

Nusseibeh began her collegiate coaching career as a graduate assistant at Cincinnati, where she was the video coordinator, academic liaison and assisted in coaching the post players. She then spent two seasons at Holy Cross as an assistant coach where she also handled video operations and worked with the posts.

Prior to beginning her collegiate coaching career, Nusseibeh completed internships with the WNBA's Atlanta Dream (2007) and Washington Mystics (2009), and worked with USA Basketball on preparing the U19 World University Games teams for competitions in Thailand and Serbia.

A member of the 2006 Patriot League All-Rookie Team, Nusseibeh played 116 career games at American, where she won a pair of league regular-season titles as a member of the Eagles' program. She was a member of the program when it made a pair of WNIT appearances, the first two postseason berths in program history.

Nusseibeh earned her undergraduate degree in international relations/international business from American in 2009 and then went on to earn her MBA from Cincinnati in 2011.

Former Cincinnati guard Shareese Ulis-McBrayer joined the Canisius women's basketball staff as an assistant coach in July, 2022.

Ulis-McBrayer comes to Canisius after spending the previous four seasons as an assistant coach at Owens Community College in Perrysburg, Ohio. She will focus her attention on the Golden Griffins' point guards and combo guards.

During the 2021-22 season, Ulis-McBrayer was part of the Owens Community College coaching staff that helped lead the Express to the NJCAA Division III national championship after the team posted a 27-4 overall record. While serving as the program's head of recruiting, she worked with and developed five All-America honorees, a national Player of the Year award winner and multiple all-conference, all-district and all-tournament team selections.

"We are thrilled to welcome coach Shareese Ulis-McBrayer to our Griff family," Canisius head coach Sahar Nusseibeh said at the time of her hire. "Coach U brings a wealth of knowledge, and will not only develop our perimeters and help take them to the next level on the court, but she will use her experience to connect with our team off the court as well. college and high school level. In 2013-14, she was an assistant women's basketball coach at Moberly Area Community College in Moberly, Mo., helping the squad finish with an overall record of 21-7. The Greyhounds also had five players sign with Division I programs following that season. She previously served as an assistant coach with her alma mater Waite High School (2012-13) and Start High School (2011-12) in her hometown of Toledo, Ohio.

Ulis-McBrayer began her collegiate playing career at Trinity Valley Community College (2007-09) in Athens, Texas, where she guided the Lady Cardinals to the NJCAA National Tournament as a freshman and sophomore. As a sophomore, she averaged 12.0 points, 3.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 3.0 steals per game, en route to being named all-conference and honorable mention All-Region 14. She later transferred to Cincinnati, where she started all 59 games in her two years with the Bearcats, averaging 11.4 points as a junior and 13.7 points in her senior campaign.

In high school, she was named the Toledo Player of the Year on three occasions, District Player of the Year twice, and was a member of the All-State Team two times. She was also nominated for the McDonald's All-American Team as a senior, and finished her career as the all-time leading scorer in Waite High School history.

Ulis-McBrayer earned her undergraduate degree in sociology from Cincinnati and later went on to earn her master's degree in liberal studies from Detroit-Mercy.
