NOTABLE NOTES

FIRST WIN OF THE NEW ERA

The start of the 2024-25 season for the Golden Griffins marks a new era for Canisius women's basketball. Head coach **Tiffany Swoffard** enters her first season as a head coach after successful assistant coaching stints at both the power conference and mid-major levels. With the fresh start, the Griffis roster also boasts 12 newcomers to the program. Sophomore **Mary Copple**, sophomore **Saige Randolph** and senior **Xanthippi Karatasiou** round out the returning members of the 2023-24 squad. Swoffard and the team picked up their first win of the season and the first of Swoffard's head coaching career at Saint Francis (Pa.) on November 15.

GRIFFS VS ILLINI

The Golden Griffins and Fighting Illini have squared only once before, with the first meeting coming last season on Nov. 26, 2023. The Griffis took a 90-58 road loss to the Big Ten opponent. Monday's contest will be the third game power-conference matchup for the Griffis this season. The team opened the season with games at Pitt and Penn State





LAST TIME OUT

The Griffis are coming off a 68-58 loss to regional foe Binghamton last Monday. The Bearcats led the Griffis wire-to-wire and shot 50.2 percent from the floor in the Koessler Athletic Center. The Griffis rallied in the fourth quarter, outscoring their opponent 24-21, but failed to over take the lead established by the visiting team. Graduate student **Jaela Johnson** tallied a season-high 19 points for the Griffis to lead all scorers.

JOHNSON GETTING BUCKETS

Graduate student **Jaela Johnson** continues to lead the way for the Griffis offensively after her season-high 19 point performance. She has recorded double figure points in four of the past five games for the Griffis, while also leading the team in assists with 23 and three-point field goal percentage, shooting at a 40.6 percent clip. Her three-point shooting percentage ranks seventh in the MAAC.

WHAT IS A GRIFFIN?

The Griffin is a mythical creature of supposed gigantic size that has the head, forelegs and wings of an eagle and the hindquarters, tail and ears of a lion. They are well known for their speed, ability to fly and having eyes like an eagle as well as the strength and courage of a lion.

Griffins have been known for centuries as symbols of strength and vigilance, have been called "The Hounds of Zeus" in Greek mythology and are said to have mastery of both the land and sky.

They are thought to be from India, where the natives of the land made their talons and claws into drinking cups because the talon of a Griffin was said to detect poison in a liquid. Griffins would find gold in the mountains and line their nests with it and as a result, were forced to become great guardians of the nests to keep the hunters away.

GAILES ON THE GLASS

Sophomore **Shariah Gailes** is leading the MAAC in rebounding after recording 10-or-more rebounds in the past three games. She recorded her second double-double of the season versus Binghamton, scoring 12 points and getting 11 rebounds. She tallied eight offensive and three defensive rebounds in the contest. She is averaging 8.5 rebounds per game and has two of the top 10 rebounding games in the MAAC this season with her 12 rebounds against St. Bonaventure and 11 versus Binghamton.

GRIFFS VS RANKED TEAMS

Coming into the game, Illinois is ranked No. 19 in the women's college basketball AP poll. This game will serve as the first time a ranked team has traveled to the Koessler Athletic Center to play the Griffis. The Griffis are 0-11 against nationally ranked teams. Their last game against a ranked team was last season when they played MAAC rival Fairfield, who received a ranked vote in the AP poll. Prior to that contest, they played No. 12 Ohio State on Dec. 11, 2016.

RETURN OF THE GOAT

Monday's game will also serve as a homecoming for Illinois head coach Shauna Green, who played college basketball at Canisius from 1998-2002. Green was one of the best basketball players to ever grace to Koessler Athletic Center court and was inducted in the Canisius Sports Hall of Fame in 2012. A four-year starter for the Griffis, she was a four-time All-MAAC honoree selection and three-time All-MAAC First-Team honoree and led the team in scoring and rebounding all four years at Canisius. She is the program's all-time leading scorer with 2,012 points and Ranks second in career scoring average (18.8 points per game) and career rebounds (910). After her illustrious career at Canisius, she had head coaching stints at Loras College and Dayton before she was hired as the Illinois head coach in 2022. In her time at Illinois, she holds a 47-26 record and claimed the 2024 WBIT championship last season.

MAAC LEADERS

A few Griffs have put up solid single game stat performances in their three-game home stand. Johnson's 19 points in the Griffs most recent game versus Binghamton came off of five three point makes. This is tied for third in the MAAC in single -game three-point field goals this season. It is also the most for a Canisius player since Feb. 15, 2024. Junior **Franka Wittenberg** recorded a season-high eight assists versus Binghamton, the second best mark for MAAC player this season.

BLOCK PARTY

A key factor in the Griffs defense is their rim protection. Junior **Mariam Sanogo** is averaging 1.2 blocks per game, leading the team that averages 3.0 blocks per game. In their loss to Buffalo, she had two blocks and five steals on defense. Overall, the team ranks fifth in the MAAC in blocks per game.

REDUCING TURNOVERS

The Griffs have struggled with turning the ball over this season, averaging 24.8 per game through six games. Against Binghamton, the Griffs won the turnover battle, causing 19 turnovers and only giving up the ball 15 times. Canisius found success against Saint Francis when they generated 22 turnovers and 10 steals.

SCORING BY COMMITTEE

Junior **Franka Wittenberg**, Johnson and Gailles have been the main sources of offense of this season but the Griffs have gotten a lot of help from their bench and with players stepping up in key moments. They rank third in the MAAC with 20.3 bench points per game and six players recorded more than five points in their contest against the Bearcats. Freshman **Yasmine Djibril** tallied a career-high seven points and Djibril is averaging 4.8 rebounds off the bench. Sopomore **Mary Copple** scored a career-high eight points with key defensive minutes for the Griffs against Buffalo. Head coach **Tiffany Swoffard** has used more than 10 players in her rotation for five of the six games this season.

THREE POINT DEFENSE

Another strength for the Canisius defense stems from their defense against the long ball. They are the best in the MAAC and 32nd in the country at three-point defense, holding their opponents to 25.0 percent (23-for-92) from beyond the arc. Buffalo failed to convert a single three-point shot in their game versus the Griffs.

A WIN WOULD....

A win on Friday would give the Griffs their first win over the Illini and the first win over a ranked team ever. The Griffs are also searching for their first home victory of the season.

LAST SEASON RESULTS

The 2023-24 women's basketball team had on of their best seasons in recent memory. The Griffis achieved a overall record of 17-14 and conference record of 11-9, granting them the fifth seed in the conference tournament. This was the first time the Griffis went above .500 in there overall and conference records since the 2008-2009 season under head coach Terry Zeh, when they went 24-9 overall and 14-4 in MAAC Play.

RETURNING PLAYERS

After the departure of previous head coach Sahar Nusseibeh, only three players returned to the Canisius roster from the 2023-24 season. Senior gaurd **Xanthippi Karatasious** is the longest tenured member of the Griffis, beginning her time in Buffalo in the 2021-22 season. Last season, Karatasious played in four games and was named to the MAAC All-Academic team. Sophomore gaurd **Mary Copple** also returned for her second season. In her freshman season, Copple appeared in 14 games and amassed a season-high five assists at Manhattan (Feb. 22). Finally, sophomore **Saige Randolph** returned to the Griffis after walking on to the team in her freshman season.

HEAD COACH - TIFFANY SWOFFARD



Tiffany Swoffard was named the 11th head coach in women's basketball program history on April 17, 2024.

A long-time assistant coach with 14 years of NCAA Division I coaching experience at both the Power 5 and mid-major levels, Swoffard takes over the Golden Griffin program after spending the 2023-24 campaign as a member of the Penn State women's basketball coaching staff..

In her one season on staff at Penn State, Swoffard helped lead the Nittany Lions to their first 20-win season since 2016-17, which resulted in a WBIT berth and an appearance in the tournament's semifinal round. Swoffard oversaw the development of the Penn State post players and served as the team's rebounding coordinator, as the Nittany Lions finished the year in the top half of the Big Ten in both rebounds per game and rebounding margin.

Before joining the staff at Penn State, Swoffard spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Miami (Ohio) in the Mid-American Conference (MAC). From 2019-23, six RedHawks earned All-MAC accolades, while 20 student-athletes earned All-MAC Academic honors. In addition to her role as recruiting coordinator, Swoffard was the team's offensive coordinator in 2022-23, where Miami (Ohio) ranked fourth in the MAC in league scoring average, as the RedHawks posted an average of 72.1 points per game against conference rivals.

Swoffard joined the RedHawks' staff after spending four years as an assistant coach at Toledo, where she played an integral role in all aspects of the program, including perimeter-player development, recruiting, academic support and opponent scouting. She served as Toledo's recruiting coordinator and worked with both the guards and post players.

During her time with the Rockets, Swoffard helped lead Toledo to an 81-49 overall record and a 43-29 mark in MAC play, including a pair of 20-win seasons in 2016-17 and 2018-19. Swoffard was in her second year as an assistant coach with the Rockets when the team won the MAC Tournament following the 2016-17 season. During her tenure, Toledo garnered 12 All-MAC selections, made an NCAA Tournament appearance and earned two WNIT berths.

Prior to Toledo, Swoffard spent five seasons at Mercer, where she handled recruiting, on-court development, academic support and in-office administration and worked with both the guards and post players. She mentored five all-conference athletes and 17 academic all-conference recipients. Swoffard helped lead Mercer to its first 20-win season in two decades in 2012-13, and its first appearance in a postseason tournament since 1985.

Before her stint at Mercer, Swoffard spent four seasons (2007-10) as an assistant coach at the University of Arkansas – Fort Smith. There, she was responsible for arranging team travel, updating game statistics, scouting opponents, organizing film exchange, ordering equipment, scheduling community service projects and assisting with scheduling. Swoffard also coordinated recruiting visits, identified possible recruits, facilitated camps and served as the program's recruiting coordinator. While on staff there, Arkansas – Fort Smith finished third at the 2008 NJCAA National Tournament and she also assisted with the program's transition to the NCAA Division II level.

Swoffard started her collegiate coaching career at NCAA Division III Rowan University in Glassboro, N.J., where she was a graduate assistant coach from 2005-07. Before that, she spent two seasons as the junior team head coach of the Georgia Metros Nike Elite AAU Basketball program.

A native of Chattanooga, Tenn., Swoffard was a four-year letterwinner at Austin Peay from 1998-2002, including two consecutive years in which the Lady Governors captured the Ohio Valley Conference Tournament championship and went on to play in the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Tournament (2000-01 and 2001-02).

An active member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA), Swoffard earned her bachelor's degree in business administration with an emphasis in marketing from Austin Peay in 2002. She went on to earn her master's degree in business administration from Rowan in 2007.
