NOTABLE NOTES

FIRST CONFERENCE WIN

Canisius notched their first conference win of the season against rival Niagara last Wednesday. Four Golden Griffins scored in double-figures as the Blue and Gold surged late to register a 57-41 victory.

2025 WRAPPED

Canisius competed in 31 contests over the course of 2025, posting a 11-19 record. Nine of those victories came in the second half of the 2024-25 season, including a three-game win streak to end the MAAC slate which secured a berth into the 2025 MAAC Championship.

RECORD BREAKING NIGHT

The Golden Griffins achieved multiple milestones in Wednesday's victory over rival Niagara. **Shariah Gales'** 16 rebounds was the highest single-game total from a Canisius player since Sisi Elko grabbed 17 boards on Jan. 25, 2024. The Blue and Gold also held the Purple Eagles to three points in the final quarter of play, marking the lowest quarter point total from an opponent in program history.

COMEBACK CANISIUS

The Blue and Gold scored a late comeback over Wright State (Dec. 12) to earn their second win of the season. Trailing 60-55 with under three minutes to go, the Griff's scored 10 unanswered points to steal the victory. The come from behind effort marked the first time this season that Canisius won a game when trailing at any point in the fourth quarter.

JUNIOR SHARIAH GAILES



Junior **Shariah Gailes** was named to the 2025-26 Preseason All-MAAC Third Team. Gailes led the Golden Griffins and ranked third among the conference last season in rebounds per game (8.1) and free throw percentage (77.2).

WHAT IS A GRIFFIN?

The Griffin is a mythical creature of supposed gigantic size that has the head, forelegs and wings of an eagle and the hindquarters, tail and ears of a lion. They are well known for their speed, ability to fly and having eyes like an eagle as well as the strength and courage of a lion.

Griffins have been known for centuries as symbols of strength and vigilance, have been called "The Hounds of Zeus" in Greek mythology and are said to have mastery of both the land and sky.

They are thought to be from India, where the natives of the land made their talons and claws into drinking cups because the talon of a Griffin was said to detect poison in a liquid. Griffins would find gold in the mountains and line their nests with it and as a result, were forced to become great guardians of the nests to keep the hunters away.

LIMITING TURNOVERS

Turnovers have plagued Canisius throughout the season. The Griffis' have committed 20-or-more turnovers in 13 of their 16 games. Canisius tied a season-low in the conference opener contest against Saint Peter's, turning over the ball 18 times.

BUILDING OFF LAST YEAR

Head coach **Tiffany Swoffard** won 10 games in her first year at Canisius, including a 9-11 mark in MAAC play and a berth into the 2025 MAAC Championship, despite inheriting a roster that returned only 1% of its scoring from the previous season and being picked last in the MAAC Preseason Poll. The 2024-25 campaign was highlighted by a three-game win streak to end the regular season, solidifying a postseason opportunity.

DEFENDING THREES

The Blue and Gold have become one of the best teams in the nation at defending the three ball, holding their opponents to a combined 26.0% from deep. That figure leads the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference and ranks 18th in the nation. The Griffis' have held their opponents 20%-or-less from three point range on four occasions this season.

FROM DEEP

Canisius has hit 30.2% (73-for-242) of their three point shots through the initial 16 games this season. Sophomore **Corniya Clay** has stepped up, hitting at least one three pointer in seven of her last eight games. Clay checks into Thursday's contest at a 43.2% (19-for-44) clip from long range on the season which leads the Griffis. Sophomore **Irene Rey Pineda** has also been at the forefront of the long ball attack, knocking down 32.5% (13-for-40) of her shots this season. Rey Pineda had a career night at St. Bonaventure (Nov. 14), cashing in all three of her attempts.

CORNIYA THE CLAY-MAKER

Sophomore **Corniya Clay** is seeing more time than ever before in her collegiate career, largely due to the early season injuries that Canisius has had to endure. Clay is averaging 25.1 minutes per game this season, a change from her 4.6 minutes averaged in the 2024-25 season. In her expanded role, Clay has turned in three games with double digit scoring figures.

ALL ABOUT GROWTH

Player development remained a pillar of Coach Swoffard's coaching philosophy going into her second season. Senior **Franka Wittenberg** played the best season of her career, notching a 41.5% field goal percentage, 31.0% three-point field goal percentage (33.3% in conference play), and averaging 8.4 points per game and 2.5 assists per game. Wittenberg earned MAAC Player of the Week honors on December 29th. Junior **Mary Copple** saw significant increases as well, with double-digit increases in field goal and three-point percentage from her freshman year. Last season, Copple ranked 11th in MAAC play in three-point field goal percentage (36.6%). Additionally, the 2024-25 season was impacted by forward and post player development under the direction of Swoffard. **Shariah Gailes** led the team in rebounding, ranking third in the MAAC in rebounds per game (8.1) and second in offensive rebounds per game (2.7). Gailes also ranked 15th in field goal percentage for the MAAC (44.1%), averaging 9.1 points per game for the Griffs. Gailes scored double-digit point totals 13 times and posted a team-high eight double-double performances in the 2024-25 season.

RECAPING NON-CON

Canisius concluded their non-conference slate against Wright State on Friday. Canisius faced multiple power-five opponents in its seven-game slate. The Blue and Gold hosted four of its seven non-conference contests against programs such as Eastern Michigan, Cornell, Mercyhurst and Wright State. The early portion of the season was highlighted by former Canisius head coach Sahar Nusseibeh's return to Buffalo when the Griffs hosted Eastern Michigan on Nov. 7. Nusseibeh coached the Griffs for three seasons (2021-2024).

CONFERENCE ACTION

Canisius is scheduled to host ten conference contests inside the Koessler Athletic Center in the 2025-26 season. Canisius opened up MAAC play on Dec. 19, hosting Saint Peter's. For the second-straight year, the MAAC schedule will be unbalanced. Each school in the 13-team league will play eight conference opponents twice (one at home, one on the road) and four other conference rivals one time, each. Per MAAC scheduling policy, each school is guaranteed to play its closest geographic opponent, but the rest of the opponents that a school plays only one time were chosen at random. For this season, Canisius will not host Marist or Merrimack, and the Griffs will not play road games at either Rider or Saint Peter's.

TRUSTING THE BENCH

Through the first 16 games of the season, eight of Canisius' 12 active players are averaging double digit minutes per game. Individuals such as **Irene Rey Pineda**, **Corniya Clay** and **Evie van der Woude** have provided the Golden Griffins with a cushion of depth. Head coach **Tiffany Swoffard** has used all active players in 12 of the Griffs' 16 games.

HEAD COACH - TIFFANY SWOFFARD



Tiffany Swoffard was named the 11th head coach in women's basketball program history on April 17, 2024.

A long-time assistant coach with 14 years of NCAA Division I coaching experience at both the Power 5 and mid-major levels, Swoffard takes over the Golden Griffins program after spending the 2023-24 campaign as a member of the Penn State women's basketball coaching staff.

In her one season on staff at Penn State, Swoffard helped lead the Nittany Lions to their first 20-win season since 2016-17, which resulted in a WBIT berth and an appearance in the tournament's semifinal round. Swoffard oversaw the development of the Penn State post players and served as the team's rebounding coordinator, as the Nittany Lions finished the year in the top half of the Big Ten in both rebounds per game and rebounding margin.

Before joining the staff at Penn State, Swoffard spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Miami (Ohio) in the Mid-American Conference (MAC). From 2019-23, six RedHawks earned All-MAC accolades, while 20 student-athletes earned All-MAC Academic honors. In addition to her role as recruiting coordinator, Swoffard was the team's offensive coordinator in 2022-23, where Miami (Ohio) ranked fourth in the MAC in league scoring average, as the RedHawks posted an average of 72.1 points per game against conference rivals.

Swoffard joined the RedHawks' staff after spending four years as an assistant coach at Toledo, where she played an integral role in all aspects of the program, including perimeter-player development, recruiting, academic support and opponent scouting. She served as Toledo's recruiting coordinator and worked with both the guards and post players.

During her time with the Rockets, Swoffard helped lead Toledo to an 81-49 overall record and a 43-29 mark in MAC play, including a pair of 20-win seasons in 2016-17 and 2018-19. Swoffard was in her second year as an assistant coach with the Rockets when the team won the MAC Tournament following the 2016-17 season. During her tenure, Toledo garnered 12 All-MAC selections, made an NCAA Tournament appearance and earned two WNIT berths.

Prior to Toledo, Swoffard spent five seasons at Mercer, where she handled recruiting, on-court development, academic support and in-office administration and worked with both the guards and post players. She mentored five all-conference athletes and 17 academic all-conference recipients. Swoffard helped lead Mercer to its first 20-win season in two decades in 2012-13, and its first appearance in a postseason tournament since 1985.

Before her stint at Mercer, Swoffard spent four seasons (2007-10) as an assistant coach at the University of Arkansas – Fort Smith. There, she was responsible for arranging team travel, updating game statistics, scouting opponents, organizing film exchange, ordering equipment, scheduling community service projects and assisting with scheduling. Swoffard also coordinated recruiting visits, identified possible recruits, facilitated camps and served as the program's recruiting coordinator. While on staff there, Arkansas – Fort Smith finished third at the 2008 NJCAA National Tournament and she also assisted with the program's transition to the NCAA Division II level.

Swoffard started her collegiate coaching career at NCAA Division III Rowan University in Glassboro, N.J., where she was a graduate assistant coach from 2005-07. Before that, she spent two seasons as the junior team head coach of the Georgia Metros Nike Elite AAU Basketball program.

A native of Chattanooga, Tenn., Swoffard was a four-year letterwinner at Austin Peay from 1998-2002, including two consecutive years in which the Lady Governors captured the Ohio Valley Conference Tournament championship and went on to play in the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Tournament (2000-01 and 2001-02).

An active member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA), Swoffard earned her bachelor's degree in business administration with an emphasis in marketing from Austin Peay in 2002. She went on to earn her master's degree in business administration from Rowan in 2007.
