Jennifer Montoya is entering her second decade as the head coach of the University of the Incarnate Word volleyball program. She has recorded double-digit victory totals in seven of her 10 years and has reached 20 wins on two occasions. She enters the 2013 season with a 148-172 record and a new challenge... taking the Cardinals to NCAA Division I and the Southland Conference.

Montoya is no stranger to Division I. She played four years of volleyball at the University of Florida and knows what it takes to win at the highest level.

Montoya came to UIW in the summer of 2003 and experienced one .500 campaign in her first four. Then it got good beginning with a Heartland Conference title in 2007 followed by a runnerup position in 2008 and a 2009 trip to the tournament semi-finals. Then came the transition to the Lone Star Conference.

The first year of play (2010) in the LSC proved to be a bit tough as the Cardinals dropped below the .500 mark for the first time in four years. But UIW won its final match on the schedule to secure the eighth and final spot in the championship tournament. Along the way UIW won over Southeastern Oklahoma on October 9 giving Montoya her 125th win at UIW to break the old school mark of 124. The three seasons in the Lone Star proved to be difficult as the Cardinals were unable to crack .500 in any season, but they did make two appearances in the LSC Tournament.

Everywhere she has been, Jennifer Montoya has played for winning teams and she has garnered top individual awards. That includes being voted the Heartland's Coach of the Year following the 2005

season.

Immediately before UIW, she played professionally in Maia, Portugal. Her team, Castelo da Maia Ginasio Clube, won the Portuguese League Championship and the Portuguese Cup.

Those successes were an extension of what she accomplished at the University of Florida where she was a 1998 All-American player. Three times her teams reached the NCAA Final Four and the other year the Gators were in the Elite Eight. She led Florida to four Southeastern Conference titles and three SEC tournament championships.

At Florida, she earned a bachelor's degree in graphic design in 2002.

Her list of individual accomplishments at Florida is extensive. Twice she was AVCA all-district, she was All-SEC twice, and three times All-SEC academic. In 1999 alone, she was on five different all-tournament teams. She received the Arthur Ashe Scholar-Athlete Award and the Multicultural Recognition Award.

Her high school training came right here in San Antonio. She is a graduate of Providence High School where in 1996 she was the Gatorade Southwest Regional Player of the Year and was the San Antonio EXPRESS-NEWS Player of the Year. In addition to being the school's athlete of the year, she was the scholar-athlete of the year.

Coach Montoya and husband Adrian are the parents of daughter Maia Lynn and Derek.

Shawn McLaughlin joined the University of the Incarnate Word volleyball program as their first even full-time assistant coach in July of 2013.

McLaughlin played collegiately at Lindenwood University. He has worked with three other collegiate programs prior to joining UIW and has head coaching experience at the Club level.

McLaughlin comes to UIW directly from the University of Denver where he was the Data Project Video Coordinator and assisted with team travel, recruiting, budgeting and scouting reports. During the 2011 season, he was with University of Nevada-Reno where he started as an assistant coach and moved up to Director of Volleyball Operations. His first collegiate job was as a volunteer assistant coach at University of California-Davis for the 2009 and 2010 seasons. He helped the team to a second place conference finish in 2009.

McLaughlin has worked extensively at the Club level since 2001. He has been the head coach for Colorado Volleyball Association (2009-11), Silver State Volleyball Club (2001-04, 2011-13), Force Volleyball Club (2009-11) and St. Charles United Volleyball Club (2006-08). He coached a Regional championship team with Colorado Volleyball Association and led the Force Volleyball Club to a 10th place finish at USA Junior Nationals in 2009.

McLaughlin graduated from Lindenwood in 2009 with a degree in history education with a minor in social studies. He played setter and libero for the four-time Heart of America Conference champions. He helped lead the team to three NAIA Final Four appearances and a pair of Runner-Up finishes.

McLaughlin has worked with USA Volleyball at the 2013 USA Junior National and A2 National Tryout, the 2012 USA High Performance Tryout and as a USA High Performance Select Camp Coach.

Jenny Banse is working with the Incarnate Word volleyball program as a graduate assistant for a second straight season.

Prior to coming to UIW she played collegiately at Texas A&M and one year of professional volleyball in Europe for the ATSC Sparkasse Wildcats Klagenfurt, a member of the Austrian Volleyball Federation in Klagenfurt, Austria.

A product of San Antonio's Churchill High School, she received her bachelor's degree in allied health at Texas A&M University. With the Aggies she was an AVCA Honorable Mention All-American as a senior. She also was first team All-Big 12 after leading the team to a berth in the NCAA regional semifinals. She averaged 3.42 kills per set and posted a .272 hitting percentage in 2008.

She was named Texas A&M's Most Improved Player in 2007 and also earned Academic All-Big 12 Second Team honors the same season.

In addition to her work at UIW she is an assistant coach for the Alamo Volleyball Association's 15 Kaepa Premier squad.

While in high school she was twice TCGA all-state and a two-time lonestarovolleyball.com All-Texas player. Four times she was all-district and four times all-city. As a senior she was a PrepVolleyball All-American and was a member of Volleyball Magazine's Fab 50 team. She played in the TCGA state all-star game.

2012 (Junior): Cardenas earned a trio of academic awards including Lone Star Conference All-Academic Team, LSC Commissioner's Honor Roll and D2ADA Academic Achievement Award. For the majority of the season, she was one of the team's two setters reaching double figures in

assists in 23 matches and finished the year averaging 4.14 assists per set for the year. She had five double-doubles on the season and unfortunately the team was 0-5 in those matches. She had a season high 27 assists and 11 digs in a five-set loss at Tarleton State. She registered 20 assists in four-set wins over Midwestern State and Tarleton State at home.

2011 (Sophomore): Cardenas saw action in all but one match serving as the team's defensive specialist and back-up setter. She earned All-LSC Academic Team honors. She finished third on the team with 112 assists and was second with 2.64 digs per set. She posted her only double-double of the year in a five set loss to Nova Southeastern when she had 25 assists and 15 digs. She had at least 10 assists in three matches and at least 10 digs in nine matches. She registered a season high 23 digs against New Mexico Highlands and at Texas A&M-Commerce. In the service game she had 13 aces against only six errors for the year. She was named to the LSC Commissioner's Honor Roll after posting a 4.00 GPA in 2011-12.



2010 (Freshman): Cardenas played as one of the team's two setters in their 6-2 offensive scheme. She played in 23 of 24 matches and finished second on the team with 4.35 assists per set. She contributed 2.31 digs per set and had a spectacular 11-to-3 service ace-to-error ratio. She had double digit assist totals in each of the last 19 matches of the year and reached 20 assists in five matches. Her best performance of the season came in a five set win over East Central when she had 20 assists, 17 digs and three kills. She posted a total of eight double-doubles on the season including an 18-assist, 11-dig performance in a 3-0 sweep at Texas A&M-Commerce.

High School: Cardenas was a highly touted setter out of O'Conner High School. She was a three-time Express News Super Team selection and two-time All-Texas team selection. She earned All-State honors as a senior. She also played basketball and softball.

Personal: Cardenas is the daughter of Javier and Denise Cardenas and is studying communications. She has a brother, Xavier, and she was born on January 23, 1992. Her father played football at East Texas State now Texas A&M-Commerce. She is involved in the UIW SAAC and UIW Math club.

During her high school career, the Red Raiders claimed the Regional Championship title in 2009 and 2011, reaching the Sectional Championship match in 2011 and the Sweet 16. At one point in 2011, Huntley was ranked #42 in the nation after beating Cary Grove High School to end its two-season winning streak. She led the Red Raiders as a junior in solo blocks with 36 denials and posted a 91.3 serve percentage. and fourth in kills (184). She had five double-doubles during the season including a 13-kill, 19-dig performance in a five-set win at Eastern New Mexico. She had nine kills and a season high 22 digs in a five-set loss at Tarleton State. She posted a season best .421 attack percentage and had four blocks in a straight set victory at home against Eastern New Mexico. She reached double figures in kills six times over the final month of the season.

2011 (Sophomore): Soukup had a solid all-around season posting significant contributions on offense and defense. She had a season-high 17 kills and chipped in 13 digs in a win over Texas A&M-Commerce. She had 11 kills without an attack error in a win over Nova Southeastern. She posted a double-double with 13 kills, 11 digs and a .407 attack in a win over Abilene Christian. She picked up a season high 19 digs in a win over Texas Woman's. She served up five aces in a five-set loss at Texas A&M-Kingsville. She was named to the LSC Commissioner's Honor Roll.

2010 (Freshman): Soukup started the final 18 matches of her first season at UIW. She averaged 2.16 kills and 2.57 digs per set for the season. Every time she had at least 10 kills in a match she also had at least 10 digs. She pounded 15 kills, had 13 digs and posted a .333 attack in a sweep at A&M-Commerce. She had 10 kills, 11 assists and a .350 attack in a win over Southeastern Oklahoma.

2012 (Junior): Suarez was the team's top setter starting every match of the season. She reached double figures in assists in all 31 matches and posted 10 double-doubles for the year. She reached 30 assists in three different matches including 35 as-

sists and 17 dis in a five-set win at Eastern New Mexico. She had 26 assists and 20 digs in a four-set win at Midwestern State. She averaged 5.56 assists and 2.42 digs per set for the season and served up 24 aces against only nine service errors. She directed the offense to a .300 attack percentage in wins over Southeastern Oklahoma and Eastern New Mexico. She earned Lone Star Conference Honorable Mention and LSC All-Academic Team honors. She was named to the LSC Commissioner's Honor Roll and took home the D2ADA Academic Achievement Award. She was named the LSC Setter of the Week on September 25.

2011 (Sophomore): Suarez led the Cardinals with 584 assists on the season and also contributed 2.24 digs per set. She was named to the LSC Commissioner's Honor Roll. 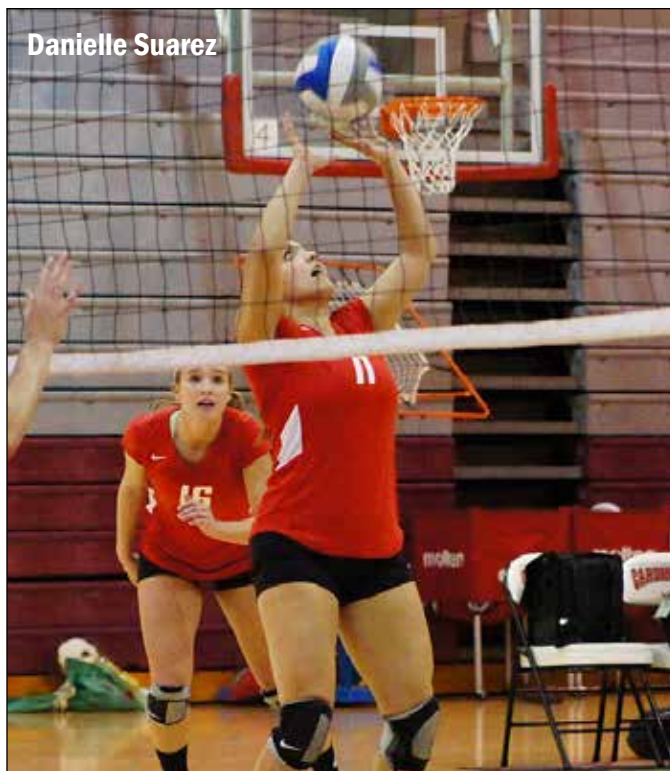

2013 Preview

Although head coach Jen Montoya is entering her 11th season running the UIW volleyball program, it feels like a new start this year with the move to NCAA Division I and the Southland Conference. In addition to the move up a division, the Cardinals volleyball program was able to hire their first full-time assistant coach over the summer in Shawn McLaughlin.

The Cardinals were only 10-21 in 2012, but enthusiasm is running high in the program. "We are competing in a bigger and more prestigious league, plus we have a lot of freshmen and newcomers," said Montoya.

With excitement running high for the change to Division I, Montoya has been cautious in integrating her young squad. "We have started our schedule a little later than normal and we are opening up the season at a DII tournament to give our freshmen and newcomers a chance to get used to the campus and to playing together," added the coach.

The Cardinals only return four regulars from 2012 in seniors Sarah Cardenas, Beth Soukup and Danielle Suarez and sophomore Angelique Vidaurri. Another returner, sophomore Taylor McClelland should see a lot of playing time this year as well.

One of the high points in the season will come right at the start when the Cardinals host Texas Tech on September 16 for their home opener. "It is a really exciting way to open the home season," said Montoya. "We are looking forward to it and the players will be ready to tackle the challenge."

The Cardinals schedule has only six matches before they get into the Southland schedule. They open at the BritKare Lady Buff Classic in Canyon, TX before playing UT-Pan American and Texas Tech. The Southland schedule begins on the road at Oral Roberts and Central Arkansas before the team returns home for four straight home games between September 26 and October 1.

The remainder of the schedule rotates between weeks on the road and weeks at home. They close out the season with road matches at former conference rival Angelo State and Grand Canyon, a program also in their first year of NCAA Division I. They sprinkled in a home-and-home matchup with Texas A&M-Kingsville in the middle of the conference season.

SETTERS

The Cardinals appear to be set at the setter position, pardon the pun, with Suarez and McClelland penciled in to fill the 6-2 role in the 6-2 formation. Suarez has been a four-year starter for UIW and should reach 2,000 career assists this year. She has led the team in assists in all three of her seasons, including 5.56 assists per set last year. McClelland was the team's #3 setter a year, but showed enough

promise to allow Montoya to move her into a bigger role.

If something were to happen to Suarez or McClelland, the Cardinals even have a bonafide backup waiting in the wings in Cardenas who has split time at setter and defensive specialist throughout her career.

OUTSIDE HITTERS

Vidaurri and Soukup both return at outside hitter for the Cardinals. Vidaurri led the team with 2.56 kills per set, but only had an attack percentage of .137 something she must improve upon. It is expected that she will only be a front row player for the Cardinals in 2013, but will likely be the team's top attacking threat.

Soukup, a lefty, has been a solid all-around player for UIW and her playing time will depend upon her attacking consistency as well as the matchup with the opponent.

The Cardinals have a pair of freshmen that Montoya is very excited about in Brittani Dear and Shaina Garza. Dear is an extremely athletic player with good jumping ability and she will be able to play all the way around the rotation if needed. Garza is not a player that will jump out at the opposition, but when all is said and done she will produce strong attacking and defensive numbers for the squad.

MIDDLE BLOCKERS

Middle blocker will be a position of uncertainty for the Cardinals. Meaghan Patterson is entering her second year in the program, but red-shirted last season so it has been awhile since she played a true match. Transfers Jaina Jackson and Jordan Ruiz could be good, but it will likely take some time for them to be completely integrated with the team.

When she is on her game, Patterson came be a difference maker at the net for the Cardinals. Tall and athletic, she is an excellent blocker who needs a little more consistency on the attack.

DEFENSIVE SPECIALISTS

Cardenas is slated to be the team's libero this year taking over for graduated Lydia Werchan who accumulated over 1,700 digs in her three-year career. Cardenas enters her senior season needing 370 digs to reach 1,000 for her career.

Freshman Claudia Hernandez could see some time in a defensive specialist role. In addition, if Dear and Garza have struggles on the attack they could be moved into a straight back row role.

THE CONFERENCE

In an era of considerable change in intercollegiate athletics, the Southland Conference continues to be a model of innovation, stability and consistent achievement as it celebrates a half-century of the academic and athletic accomplishments of its member institutions.

Commemorating its 50th anniversary in 2013, the Southland Conference has transformed itself into a dynamic and respected consortium of 14 member universities in four states. Beginning with a historic meeting of five institutions in Dallas on March 15, 1963, the Southland Conference set on an extraordinary course that has proven successful well into its five decades of existence.

The successful transformation continues, as the Southland Conference welcomed the addition of Oral Roberts University in 2012-13, marking the league's first entry into the state of Oklahoma. Also, on July 1, 2013, the Southland welcomed four additional members: Abilene Christian University, Houston Baptist University, the University of Incarnate Word in San Antonio, and the University of New Orleans.

In addition to its newest members, the Southland Conference also consists of the University of Central Arkansas, Lamar University, McNeese State University, Nicholls State University, Northwestern State University, Sam Houston State University, Southeastern Louisiana University, Stephen F. Austin State University and Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi.

An original Southland member, Abilene Christian rejoins the league as one of the most decorated athletic programs in NCAA history, and the addition of Houston Baptist, Incarnate Word and New Orleans gives the Southland a regular competitive presence in the key metropolitan areas of Houston, San Antonio and New Orleans. Southland cities encompass approximately 14.5 million people, and seven of its television markets rank among the top 100 in the U.S.

All told, the membership of the Southland encompasses nearly 140,000 current students and an alumni base of nearly 800,000. Famous alumni from current Southland Conference schools include former CBS news anchor Dan Rather (Sam Houston State), NBA executive Joe Dumars (McNeese State), ABC news anchor Robin Roberts (Southeastern Louisiana), Major League Baseball star Wade Mile (Southeastern Louisiana), NBA legend Scottie Pippen (Central Arkansas), and track and field Olympians Kenta Bell (Northwestern State), and Bobby Morrow and Billy Olson (both Abilene Christian).

Other notable alumni from current members include Grammy Award-winning musicians Frank Ocean (New Orleans), Don Henley and Rodney Crowell (both Stephen F. Austin), and Ronnie Dunn (Abilene Christian), television personality and actress Ellen DeGeneres (New Orleans), current NFL standouts Lardarius Webb (Nicholls State), Terrence McGee (Northwestern State), and Daniel Manning (Abilene Christian), professional golfers Shawn Stefani and Chris Stroud (both Lamar) and Colin Montgomerie (HBU), award-winning filmmaker Richard Linklater (Sam Houston State), American Idol winner Kris Allen (Central Arkansas), NFL Hall of Famer Jackie Harris (Northwestern State), former NFL standouts Bobby Hebert (Northwestern State), Gary Barbaro (Nicholls State), Wilbert Montgomery (Abilene Christian) and Gary Reasons (Northwestern State), former MLB stars Darryl Hamilton (Nicholls State) and Kevin Millar (Lamar), NCAA football coach Charlie Strong (Central Arkansas), TV personality

Kathie Lee Gifford (Oral Roberts), actors John Larroquette (New Orleans), and Ricardo Chavira and Jesse Borrego (both UIW) and NFL coaching legend O.A. "Bum" Phillips (Lamar and Stephen F. Austin).

The Southland sponsors 17 championship sports, all at the NCAA Division I level. The eight men's sports include baseball, basketball, cross country, football, golf, tennis, and indoor and outdoor track and field. The women compete for nine championships in basketball, cross country, golf, soccer, softball, tennis, indoor and outdoor track and field, and volleyball. The conference earns automatic qualification to NCAA championships in baseball, men's and women's basketball, men's and women's cross country, football, men's and women's golf, women's soccer, softball, men's and women's tennis, and volleyball.

Continuing its tradition of innovation, the league launched the Southland Conference Television Network in the fall of 2008 and has broadcast more than 160 events. The network has expanded its reach to roughly 13 million households throughout Texas, Louisiana, Arkansas and Oklahoma in recent years, and has also gained national viewership through ESPN3 and Fox College Sports. Washington Ends Central Arkansas' Historic Season

After the Sugar Bears jumped out to an early 3-0 lead, Washington came to life, tying the match at 4-4 and leading for the rest of the set. Central Arkansas was unable to hit at a positive clip, turning in a percentage of -.067 for the set, while the Huskies hit .368. Washington recorded 12 block assists in the first set.

The Sugar Bears again grabbed an early lead in the second set, this time at 2-0, before Washington again tied it at 4-4. With the teams tied at 6-6, Washington used an 8-2 run to give themselves some space with a 14-8 lead. Central Arkansas battled back though going on a 4-0 run of their own to force a Washington time out with the Huskies up 17-15. The gap would remain at two until, at 18-16; Washington went on a 7-1 run to close out the second set, taking the 25-17 victory. The Sugar Bears hit .088 for the second set and picked up their first blocks of the match, a combo from Alicia Dittrich and Jessica Nagy, and a solo block from Scout Brooks. Washington turned in a hitting percentage of .286 for the set, adding six block assists to push their total to 18 for the match.

The third set started with Washington grabbing a small early lead, and Central Arkansas coming back to tie the set at 4-4. The two teams were within two points of each other for much of the early part of the set, until Washington used a 5-0 run to push their advantage to 13-8, following a Central Arkansas run, the score difference remained at two or three points until late, when the Huskies closed out the match with a 6-1 run.

Southland in the NCAA Tournament: This will be the 19th consecutive season the Southland Conference has received an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament and it will be the 29th appearance by a Southland team dating back to 1983. Stephen F. Austin is the only current Southland representative to have a victory in the tournament when it defeated Alabama in the first round of the 2006 tournament. This will mark the first time that Central Arkansas has advanced to the NCAA tournament.

Last Year in the NCAA Tournament: After a 27-win season and 15-1 conference mark, former member Texas State saw its 2011 season come to a close following a loss to Texas. The Longhorns swept Texas State in the first round for the second time in three years.

Central Arkansas Thwarts Oral Roberts, 3-1, to Win Southland Title: No. 1 Central Arkansas earned its first bid in school history to the NCAA Volleyball Tournament after it held off a feisty No. 6 Oral Roberts squad, 25-21, 25-23, 16-25, 25-21 in the Southland Conference volleyball championship match at the Farris Center in Conway, Ark. Central Arkansas senior Jessica Hays set the school-record in kills and was named the tournament's most valuable player as UCA notched its school-record 30th win on the season. Oral Roberts finished its first year in the Southland with a 17-15 record and saw Bruna Silva win libero of the year. Central Arkansas' Collins had a match-high 50 assists and used 10 digs to notch a double-double. Hays, first-team all-conference representative, finished with a double-double as she had 28 kills and 14 digs.
