MARKETING AND PROMOTIONS

- The game will feature the unveiling of the 2018 Southland Conference Championship banner prior to kickoff.
- At halftime, the homecoming court will be introduced, and the king and queen will be announced.
- The first 1,000 fans will receive a free mini UIW football commemorative megaphone.
- Social House will also feature a homecoming themed drink, the Cardinal-Rita.

LAMAR HIGHLIGHTS

- UIW remains undefeated at home under head coach Eric Morris (7-0).
- The Cardinals now have a nation-leading 15 interceptions (this includes FCS and FBS – FBS is led by San Jose State, who has 13 this season).
- This marked the first time UIW has won while ranked.
- Ameer King's 90-yard reception from Jon Copeland tied Trent Brittain's program record for a single-game pass completion (at UTEP 9/26/15, vs Eastern New Mexico 9/28/13).
- King's 124 receiving yards is a season best for the team and his personal career best.
- Copeland's season-best 376 passing yards marked his third game with 300+ yards this season. This was the eighth such game of his career.
- Copeland's passing TD to Mark Sullivan was his fourth passing TD of the game, with each going to a different receiver.
- Copeland's four passing touchdowns marked his second best outing this season; this ranks second in program history (best was five TDs against Texas Southern, 9/7/19).
- Jerick Pitre snagged his first interception of the season, returning it 34 yards.
- Louis Otis picked up his second interception of the season.
- Jacob Harper led the team with 11 tackles (six solo, five ast.); he had a team high in tackles for the second time this season.
- Chance Main had 3.5 tackles for loss, which is tied for fifth in program history.
- Mason Barnes recovered a fumble off a punt return in the first quarter.
- The Cardinals have now forced a turnover in 19 consecutive games dating back to the 2017 season.
- Gerald Bowie III recovered a fumble off a kickoff in the fourth quarter for his second fumble recovery this season.
- Special teams has now recovered six fumbles this season.

UIW NAME USAGE

Please note that there are two primary versions of our institution's name: Upon first reference, we are the University of the Incarnate Word. After that, UIW is the preferred name. Any other reference, including Incarnate Word University or Incarnate Word College, is incorrect. Additionally, all teams, including women's athletic teams, are known as Cardinals.

Interviews with Eric Morris

Interviews with head coach Eric Morris or any UIW assistant football coach must be coordinated through Assistant Athletics Director of Media Relations Cari Gold. Coaches are available for interviews after practice on Tuesdays, Wednesday, and Thursdays during game weeks. No interviews will be granted starting on Friday morning until after Saturday's game. Interviews must be after practice on designated days, unless arranged in advance through Cari Gold at cgold@uiwtx.edu.

Practices

Practices are closed to the media. Members of the media may request interviews with coach Morris following practice on Tuesday, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. Interviews on Monday are prohibited unless arranged in advance.

Postgame Interviews

Coach Morris will be available for interviews following a 10-minute cooling off period at the conclusion of each game. Postgame press conferences following home games will be held in the team room in Benson Fieldhouse.

Student-Athlete Interviews

All interviews with student-athletes must be arranged through Assistant Athletics Director of Media Relations Cari Gold. Student-athletes have been instructed not to grant any interview, either in person or by telephone, unless previously arranged by the media relations staff. Student-athlete telephone numbers are private and will not be released. Student-athletes are available for interviews after practice on Tuesdays, Wednesday, and Thursdays during game weeks. No interviews will be granted starting on Friday morning until after Saturday's game.

Practices

Practices are closed to the media. Student-athletes will be available after practice on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. Thursday will be the final day for student-athlete availability until the postgame press conference.

Eric Morris | Head Coach/QBs

Eric Morris was named the head coach of the University of the Incarnate Word football program on Dec. 30, 2017.

UIW

HIGHLIGHTS

Morris guided UIW to one of the best turnarounds in the FCS, being named the 2018 American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) Regional Coach of the Year, the 2018 Southland Conference Coach of the Year, and an Eddie Robinson Award finalist (bestowed upon the STATS FCS national coach of the year) as a result.

- Morris was also named the 2018 *San Antonio-Express News* Sportsman of the Year on Jan. 1, 2019.
- He took over a team with a 1-10 overall record (1-7 in SLC action) in 2017 and guided it to a 6-4 regular season record, a conference championship and the program's first FCS Playoff appearance in his first season.
- Morris' high-powered offensive philosophy led to QB Jon Copeland being named Southland Conference Freshman of the Year, a first in school history. The team was awarded four first team all-SLC honorees: RB Ra'Quanne Dickens, WR Phillip Baptiste, OL Brandon Floores, and DL Justin Alexandre, along with three second team selections: QB Copeland, OL Terence Hickman II, and LB Silas Stewart.
- Morris set records from the beginning, when he started a true freshman quarterback, Copeland, against New Mexico in week one. It was the first time that a true freshman started at quarterback for the Cardinals in a season-opening game.
- Copeland went on to throw for over 400 yards in two consecutive games (vs. SLU and at Lamar), and finished the season with five games of over 300 passing yards, becoming the first quarterback in program history to throw for 300 yards in four or more games in a single season.
- The offense featured two 200+ yard rushing performances from Dickens in 2018: 213 yards at Central Arkansas (Nov. 10); 220 yards vs. SFA (Sept. 15). Dickens went on to set multiple single season records through the 2018 season.
- After 11 weeks (the conclusion of UIW's regular season), the Cardinals led the FCS with 29 turnovers gained.
 - The Cardinals recorded at least one turnover in every game played in the 2018 season (playoffs included) for the first time in program history.
 - The turnover streak now sits at 12 consecutive games.
 - The defensive highlight of the season came against Sam Houston State on Nov. 3, when UIW forced a program-record seven turnovers.

TEXAS TECH

Morris joined UIW from Texas Tech, where he spent the previous five seasons as offensive coordinator for the prolific Red Raiders offense.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Morris produced one of the most high-scoring offenses in the country, guiding Tech to annual top 20 rankings in total offense and top 10 rankings in passing offense.
- Morris helped Tech to three bowl appearances, including a 2017 Birmingham Bowl bid, an appearance in the 2015 AdvoCare V100 Texas Bowl, and a berth in the National University Holiday Bowl.

2017 (OC)

The Red Raiders ranked 10th in passing offense and 16th in total offense that season, racking up 474.6 yards per game, including 333.7 through the air.

2016 (OC)

- Tech led the nation in 2016 with an average of 566.6 yards of total offense, including 463 passing yards per game.
- Morris tutored Jonathan Giles and Keke Coutee.
- Giles earned All-Big 12 second team honors after recording 1,158 receiving yards and 13 touchdowns, both of which ranked in the top 10 in Tech single-season history.
- Coutee finished second on the team with 890 receiving yards and seven touchdowns.

2015 (OC)

- The Red Raiders averaged over 30 points per game during Morris' tenure and set the single-season school record with 45.1 points per game in 2015.
- The Red Raiders closed the 2015 campaign ranked No. 2 nationally in total offense, scoring offense and passing offense.
- Morris created a balanced attack that featured a 4,000-yard passer in Patrick Mahomes II, a 1,000-yard rusher in DeAndre Washington and a 1,000-yard receiver in Jakeem Grant.
- It marked the first time in Tech history that three different Red Raiders reached those marks in the same season.
- Grant ended his career as the all-time leading receiver in Tech history. An All-America honoree by several publications, Grant totaled 3,164 receiving yards over his four seasons.

2014 (OC)

- Texas Tech finished with a No. 10 national ranking in total offense after the Red Raiders averaged 504.1 yards per game.
- Texas Tech also averaged 351.1 yards per game through the air to end the season with a No. 5 national ranking.
- Washington rushed for 1,103 yards over 12 games, marking the first time a Red Raider running back reached the 1,000-yard mark since Ricky Williams in 1998.

2013 (Co-OC)

- The Red Raiders displayed the nation's second-ranked passing attack (392.8 yards per game) and the eighth-best unit for total offense (511 yards-per-game).
- Jace Amaro, a second-round selection in the 2013 NFL Draft by the New York Jets, set an NCAA FBS record for most receiving yards (1,352) in a single season by a tight end and was named a NCAA Consensus All-American.

PRIOR TO TEXAS TECH

- 2012 - inside receivers coach under Coach Mike Leach at Washington State.
- The receiving corps hauled in 3,965 receiving yards and 23 touchdowns.
- 2011 - offensive quality control assistant under Kevin Sumlin at the University of Houston.
- The Cougars led the country in passing (443.8 yards per game), total offense (599.0 yards per game) and scoring average (50.8 points per game).
- Houston concluded the season with a 12-1 record, which included a win over Penn State in the TicketCity Bowl.
- 2010 - offensive graduate assistant under Kevin Sumlin at the University of Houston.
- Coached with Kliff Kingsbury in 2010-11.

PRIOR TO COACHING

- Morris played in the Canadian Football League for the Saskatchewan Roughriders in 2009.
- Played as a wide receiver for four years at Texas Tech (2005-08).
- Also played basketball and football at Shallowater High School in Shallowater, Texas.

PERSONAL

- Morris received his bachelor's degree in Communications Studies from Texas Tech in 2008
- He and his wife, Maggie, have a son, Jack.

**Josh Kirkland | Assistant Head Coach/
Running Backs/Recruiting Coordinator**

In his first year at UIW, Kirkland tutored first team All-SLC and two-time All-American selection Ra'Quanne Dickens, who broke the program record for single season rushing yards (1,117), becoming the program's first 1000-yard rusher. Prior to UIW, Kirkland, a Levelland, Texas, native, was the athletic coordinator and head football coach at Lehman High School (Texas). Prior to Lehman, Kirkland was the athletic coordinator and head football coach at El Paso Parkland High School.

**Cody Crill | Offensive Coordinator**

In his first season with UIW, Crill helped guide UIW to multiple season records, including total offense (5,315), total points (357), and touchdowns (48). The Cardinals also received multiple postseason awards, including seven All-SLC honors and a Southland Conference Freshman of the Year selection (QB Jon Copeland). Copeland went on to shatter the single season passing record, amassing 2,984 yards and earning FCS freshman All-American honors from HERO Sports. Crill comes to UIW after nine seasons at Navarro College, the final three of which he served as the head coach. He has guided 30 offensive linemen to the Division I level and several former players have played in the NFL.

**Justin Deason | Defensive Coordinator**

In Deason's first year with UIW, he helped orchestrate one of the best turnarounds in the nation when the Cardinals posted a 6-4 record (six wins ties the program record). Following the conclusion of UIW's regular season (week 11), the Cardinals led the FCS with 29 turnovers forced. UIW recorded at least one turnover in every game played, including the playoffs, for the first time in program history. The turnover streak sits at 12 consecutive games following the 2018 season. Deason comes to UIW from Texas A&M-Commerce, where he spent four seasons as the defensive coordinator.

**Brandon Lechtenberg | Linebackers Coach/
Special Teams Coordinator**

Brandon Lechtenberg worked with a defense that led the FCS with 29 turnovers gained following the conclusion of the regular season. Of these 29 turnovers, 18 were interceptions. This broke the previous program record of 16 picks, set in 2011. Prior to UIW, Lechtenberg spent the 2017 season as the safeties coach at UT Martin.

**Brett Watson | Interior Defensive Line/
Academic Coordinator**

In Watson's first year with UIW, the Cardinals led the FCS with 29 turnovers gained. The defensive highlight of the season came against Sam Houston State on Nov. 1, when UIW forced a program-record seven turnovers. These seven turnovers led the SLC in 2018. The Cardinals also recorded four interceptions at Central Arkansas (Nov. 10), setting the program record for picks in a single game. Prior to UIW, Watson spent two seasons at Southeastern Oklahoma State University.

**Darren Garrigan | Pass Game Coordinator/
Defensive Backs**

Garrigan helped the UIW staff engineer one of the best turnarounds in the FCS in 2018. The Cardinals went from a 1-10 overall record in 2017 to a 6-4 regular season mark, a Southland Conference Championship, and an FCS Playoff berth. In addition, two defensive backs, Malick Phillips and Louis Otis earned all-conference honorable mentions. Prior to UIW, Garrigan spent four seasons as the secondary coach at Texas A&M-Commerce.

**Steve Foley | Defensive Ends**

In Foley's first season with the Cardinals, UIW recorded at least one turnover in every game, including the playoffs, for the first time in program history. Darrius Montgomery, a defensive lineman, accounted for two interceptions and an interception returned for a touchdown. Prior to UIW, Foley spent one season as the volunteer assistant coach at the University of Louisiana Monroe. Before ULM, Foley played in the NFL for seven seasons.

**Jordan Shoemaker | Offensive Line Coach/
Run Game Coordinator**

In his first year with UIW, Shoemaker was in charge of an offensive line that helped block for All-SLC selection/two-time All-American (FCS STATS and HERO Sports) Ra'Quanne Dickens and SLC Freshman of the Year/All-American (HERO Sports) Jon Copeland. Dickens broke the program record for single season rushing yards (1,117), becoming the program's first 1000-yard rusher. Prior to working at UIW, Shoemaker worked at Magnolia West. Before Magnolia West, Shoemaker spent five seasons working in the Baylor football program. In his final two seasons with the Bears, he was an assistant director and analyst.



Jordan Davis | Wide Receivers

In his first year with the Cardinals, Davis helped guide UIW to multiple season records, including total offense (5,315), total points (357), and touchdowns (48). Senior wide receivers Kody Edwards (932 yards) and Phillip Baptiste (905 yards, first team All-SLC) each set records on the outside in 2018. Baptiste broke single season program records in receptions (59), receiving touchdowns (9), and receptions per game (5.36), while Edwards set program bests with five 100-yard receiving outings and 1,389 all-purpose yards. Prior to UIW, Davis was an offensive graduate assistant at Texas Tech University, where he worked closely with Eric Morris, then the offensive coordinator for the Red Raiders, during the 2016 and 2017 seasons.



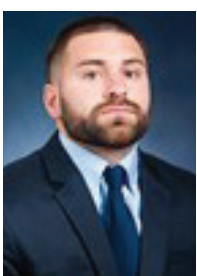
Mack Leftwich | Quarterbacks Coach

Mack Leftwich was elevated to assistant coach for the University of the Incarnate Word football program in February 2019. Leftwich spent the 2018 season as a graduate assistant for the Cardinals. The Denton, Texas, native helped tutor freshman quarterback Jon Copeland, who won Southland Conference Freshman of the Year, earned second team all-conference honors, and was runner-up for the Jerry Rice FCS Freshman of the Year Award. Prior to UIW, Leftwich was the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Lehman High School (2017). He was the youngest coordinator in the state of Texas.



Clint Killough | Quality Control/On Campus Recruiting Coordinator

Clint Killough -- a Cardinal alum -- helped guide UIW to multiple season records, including total offense (5,315), total points (357), and touchdowns (48) in 2018. Phillip Baptiste broke single season program records in receptions (59), receiving touchdowns (9), and receptions per game (5.36), while Edwards set program bests with five 100-yard receiving outings and 1,389 all-purpose yards. Edwards also broke the program record for career receiving yards (2,353) and receptions (140), and he tied the program record for receiving touchdowns (14). Prior to returning to San Antonio, Killough was a defensive and offensive graduate assistant at Bowling Green State University from 2017-18.



Scotty Yates | Quality Control

Scotty Yates joined the University of the Incarnate Word football program as quality control coach in June 2019. Yates works with the defensive backs. Prior to UIW, Yates spent two seasons at Richardson Pearce High School as the co-defensive coordinator and cornerbacks coach. Before Pearce, Yates coached at Texas A&M-Commerce, where he won three consecutive Lone Star Conference Championships. He started as a student assistant in 2014 before being a graduate assistant working with cornerbacks. He later was promoted to associate director of football operations.



Bret Huth | Director of Strength and Conditioning

Huth designed and implemented a workout program that helped guide the Cardinals to the most successful season in program history. UIW went from 1-10 in 2017 (prior to Huth's arrival) to 6-5, a Southland Conference Championship, and an FCS Playoff berth in 2018. Prior to the Cardinals, Huth worked as the assistant director of strength and conditioning with the Rice football team (2017). Before Rice, Huth spent three seasons with the football program at Cal.



Tad Blaylock | Director of Football Operations

Tad Blaylock was promoted to assistant athletics director of football operations for the University of the Incarnate Word in January 2019. He joined the Cardinal football program as the director of football operations in 2018. He does everything from the day-to-day operations to responsibilities including budget control, team travel, office organization and facility management. He also serves as the football program's liaison to university departments and all other units within the athletic department. Blaylock planned and executed an FCS Playoff trip for 140+ football student-athletes, staff, trainers, and other travel party members over Thanksgiving 2018. The trip included a Thanksgiving meal, study time, and team bonding experiences.

UIW RANKED

- For the second week in a row, the Cardinals enter the weekend ranked. UIW lands at No. 20 in the latest AFCA FCS Coaches Top 25 Poll. This marks the Cardinals' highest ranking in program history. UIW is receiving votes in the STATS FCS Media Top 25 Poll.
- The Cardinals are coming off four consecutive wins in conference play. Following a defeat at Sam Houston State (9/21), UIW has won four straight league contests. First, UIW had a home victory against Abilene Christian (31-24 on 9/28). Then, back-to-back road wins against ranked opponents: at No. 25 Houston Baptist (38-36 on 10/5) and at No. 23/25 Southeastern Louisiana (27-21 on 10/12). Last, the Cardinals secured a 35-17 home win over Lamar (10/19).

TURNOVER STREAK

- The Cardinals have forced at least one turnover in 19 consecutive games, dating back to the 2017 season.
- UIW leads not only the FCS, but all Division I football with 23 forced turnovers (tied with SHSU). The Cardinals also lead Division I with 15 interceptions.
- Special teams has six takeaways on the season.
- UIW forced four turnovers against Lamar, with two interceptions and two fumble recoveries, including one on special teams.
- The Cardinals forced six turnovers against No. 23/25 Southeastern Louisiana on Oct. 12. This ranks second in program history for single game takeaways.
- UIW had four interceptions (Isaiah Paul, Ashton Preston 2x and Jaylon Jimmerson) and two fumble recoveries (Isaiah Paul and Kristian Drake) against the Lions.
- With No. 25 Houston Baptist driving and the score tied 7-7, Louis Otis stepped in front of a pass and snagged his first interception of the season. Jimmerson recorded his third consecutive game with an interception, grabbing one in the fourth quarter.
- In the first quarter against ACU, Colby Anthony recovered a fumble on a kickoff for UIW's first turnover of the game.
- The Cardinals went on to grab three interceptions (Tre Richardson, Shawn Holton and Jimmerson) for four forced turnovers against the Wildcats.
- In the third quarter against Sam Houston State, Gerald Bowie III snatched an interception and returned it 11 yards. Richardson then forced and recovered a fumble in the fourth quarter.
- In the second quarter against Texas Southern, Kaleb Drucos forced a fumble off a kickoff and Holton recovered it and returned it for a touchdown. Mar'kel Cooks also had a fumble recovery, while Jimmerson recorded his first interception as a Cardinal.
- Ashton Preston tallied his first interception for UIW against UTSA, returning the ball 20 yards. Kyle Covington snagged UIW's second interception against the Roadrunners.

SHORT-DOWN PHILIO

- Keyondrick Philio uses his strength to power his way through the defense during short-yard plays.
- Philio used a two-yard score against Lamar to put UIW up, 20-7, in the second quarter. He now has five short-yard TDs this season.
- With UIW holding a 21-17 lead against No. 25 Houston Baptist, Philio barged his way into the end zone for a two-yard score and a 28-17 Cardinal advantage.
- Although he only rushed for 29 yards, with one long run of 20 yards, against Abilene Christian, he scored three of UIW's touchdowns to account for 18 points (not including PATs or 2pt conversions).
- Two of those touchdowns were on fourth-and-short.
- Overall, Philio has just 269 rushing yards (274 gained and only five lost), but he leads the Cardinals with seven rushing touchdowns.

QB COPELAND

- Jon Copeland threw for 376 yards and four touchdowns against Lamar on Oct. 19. This is his third 300-plus yard game this season, and the eighth of his career.
- He has broken numerous records for the Cardinals. On Sept. 7 against Texas Southern, Copeland completed 25-of-40 passes for 344 yards and an astounding five touchdowns. He had zero interceptions.
- Those 344 yards helped UIW amass 746 total offensive yards, which shattered the previous program record of 656 yards (at Central Arkansas, 11/10/18).
- The five touchdowns broke the individual single game passing record for touchdowns.
- In just his 11th game as a Cardinal, Copeland surpassed 3,000 passing yards. Through 18 contests in his career, he has thrown for 4,801 yards.

LONG PLAYS

- The Cardinals have recorded 66 long plays over the first six games, with a long play of 90 yards against Lamar (pass from Jon Copeland to Ameer King).
- Lamont Johnson and Kam Williams lead UIW with nine explosive plays each, all receiving.
- The Cardinals have recorded the following long plays: 12 against Lamar, nine at No. 23/25 Southeastern Louisiana, five at No. 25 Houston Baptist, four against Abilene Christian, nine against Sam Houston State, 16 against Texas Southern and six against UTSA.
- UIW's longest running play was a 56-yard dash by King (Texas Southern, Sept. 7).

RECORDS BROKEN

- As a team, the Cardinals entered the record books in several categories against Texas Southern.
- Using a three-pronged approach with running backs Ameer King, Kevin Brown and Keyondrick Philio, UIW registered 402 rushing yards against the Tigers, which surpassed the 396 yards the team tallied at McMurry in 2013 (Nov. 2).
- Those rushing yards contributed to 746 total offensive yards, which shattered the previous record (656 yards set at Central Arkansas, Nov. 11, 2018).
- Jon Copeland threw for five touchdown passes against TSU, which tied the single game record for team touchdown passes (Sam Houston State, Oct. 8, 2016) and broke the single game individual record (4, Jon Copeland, Sam Houston State, Nov. 3, 2018).
- Kam Williams caught three touchdown passes against Texas Southern, tying the program record (Kody Edwards, Sam Houston State, Oct. 8, 2016).

IN THE CONFERENCE

- The Cardinals lead the conference in defensive touchdowns (two).
- UIW has a conference-best 15 interceptions.
- The Cardinals' rushing offense ranks fourth in the league with 161.3 yards per game.
- UIW's 1.86 turnover margin and 23 turnovers gained both lead the conference (turnovers gained is tied with SHSU).
- Jaden Smith averages 23.2 yards on kickoff returns, good for third in the SLC, while his 9.5-yard punt return average is second.
- Ameer King averages 5.55 rushing yards per carry, which leads the conference.

IN THE NATION (FCS)

- UIW's two defensive touchdowns rank ninth in the nation.
- The Cardinals have recovered eight fumbles, good for 11th nationally.
- UIW's 15 interceptions lead the nation (all Division I, including FBS).
- The Cardinals have a nation-best 1.86 turnover margin and lead the nation with 23 turnovers gained (all Division I, including FBS; tied with SHSU).
- Jon Copeland averages 21.71 completions per game, good for No. 25 nationally. His 15 touchdown passes rank No. 21 in the nation.
- Copeland is No. 24 nationally in passing yards (1,817) and No. 25 in passing yards per game (259.6).
- Jaden Smith ranks 24th nationally with an average of 9.5 yards per punt return.
- Keyondrick Philio has seven rushing touchdowns, ranking No. 20 in the nation.

IN THE RANKINGS

- In addition to UIW, three other Southland Conference opponents are ranked in the AFCA FCS Coaches Poll: Central Arkansas (10), Nicholls (15) and Sam Houston State (25).
- Three Cardinal foes are also ranked in the STATS FCS Poll: Central Arkansas (12), Nicholls (15) and Sam Houston State (21). UIW and Southeastern Louisiana also received votes.
