ELITE SKILLS CAMP

Grades 10-12, July 30-31

This is a two-day/five session camp for the advanced player, who must be entering grades 10-12 in Fall 2022. INTERMEDIATE SKILLS CAMPS

Grades 8-9, Aug. 6

Basic offense and defensive systems will be introduced and integrated into offensive and defensive situational development and competitive play.
