## “Lucky” Lincoln ●

At the Entrance of Crouse stands the 16' tall "Lucky Lincoln" statue - dubbed so from the tradition of students placing pennies (face-up) on his boot for good luck before tests and important events.



## Young Hall Fossils

Young Hall is characterized by its abundance of fossils populating display cases throughout its hallways and the gigantic Mosasaur hanging in the entrance.



## Stephen Powell Memorial

On the east end of campus near the Norton Center for the Arts sits the Stephen R. Powell Memorial Garden and Outdoor Classroom. It is a tribute to late faculty member, Stephen Rolfe Powell '74, one of the foremost glass artists in the world.



## Flame of Knowledge

Between Young and Crouse Halls stands the Flame of Knowledge. Commissioned in 1969 to mark Centre's Sequicentennial, the 11' tall bronze sculpture represents the College's motto, "Learning is the light of the mind."
