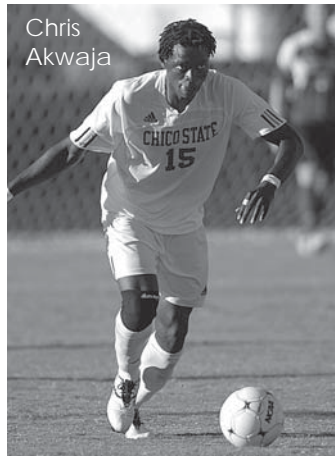

# Familiar names look to surpass 2010 success

The 2010 Chico State men's soccer team provided some of the most exhilarating moments of the year for the Chico State athletics department. And nearly the same cast of characters is back with hopes of doing the same, and then some, in 2011. Nine starters, including First Team All-American Ferid Celosmanovic, All-West Region selection Chris Akwaja, and All-California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) pick Tyson Crim return from the team that advanced to within a game of the NCAA Championship Final Four.

The Wildcats treated a season-best crowd of 1,126 to a 2-0 win against rival Sonoma State in the opening round of the NCAA Championship West Regional and then garnered their sixth regional crown and first since 2003 with two goals in the final 3:46 against Grand Canyon two days later.

Their thrilling season ended against unbeaten Midwestern State in the NCAA Championship quarterfinals, but that loss provides motivation to a team that has NCAA Championship aspirations.

"The young guys got their feet wet and got to see what the postseason looks like and taste it. The fans and supporters kind of got the same," said Head Coach Felipe Restrepo, 36-20-5 in his three seasons at the helm. "So we're excited for the season to get rolling. We know it's going to be a tough road to get back to where we want to go, but we've got talent and experience on our side, and we're eager to start working toward it."

Perhaps the most talented player is Celosmanovic, who finished with a team-high 13 goals. But he's not the only talent. Akwaja added nine goals and Crim collected a team-best six assists. Restrepo's squad also features returning starters Mike Janjigian, Luke Palmer, Nick Tedrow, Evan Johnston, Jacob Darr, and goalkeeper Sam Evans. Key reserves Elliott Plummer, James Stroud (who both started seven times last season), and Micah Miranda are also back.

"Our veterans have a really good understanding of what the conference and region looks like and what it's going to take to come together as a team and have success," said Restrepo. "They know how we go about their business and can pass the tradition and the culture down to the new guys. I'm really excited about that."

One of the "new" guys is really anything but. Senior Ryan Struckmeyer, who missed all of last season with an injury, is ready to get back on the pitch. He started all 22 matches in 2009.

"Ryan was arguably our best player in 2009 and a team captain. So to lose him was huge, just like having him back now is huge," said Restrepo. "I'd love to see him have a great senior year and ride off into the sunset."

Including Struckmeyer, the Wildcats boast what amounts to 10 returning starters, and 11 if you include Plummer, a regular starter over the final third of last season. But Restrepo did not rest on his team's laurels. He brought in 13 newcomers to join 2010 redshirts Adam Black, Anton Dapello, Quinn Harter, and Cody Levar as reinforcements.

Those newcomers hail from all over the West, including three from the North Valley. Pleasant Valley High School product Jake Ward, Chico High School standout Kenny Rosecrance, and Hector Cibrian of Live Oak are all incoming freshmen. They join Struckmeyer (Yuba City) to give the program four athletes from within an hour's drive.

"Having local talent on the team is very important to the program and the community," said Restrepo. "I'm really proud of that and look forward to developing these players and continuing to work with the youth in town. We're making a commitment to our own."

That feeling's clearly mutual. More than 6,300 people walked through the gates of University Soccer Stadium in 2010 – the fifth most in the nation. And that number just might grow after an unforgettable season, coupled with the anticipation that goes along with being ranked No. 8 in the nation in the preseason.

## Wildcats among North Division favorites in preseason poll

The Chico State men's soccer team is aiming for a second straight California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) North Division title, and according to the conference's annual preseason coaches poll, the Wildcats and Sonoma State are expected to battle for the crown. The 'Cats received five of 12 first place votes, and were named on three coaches' ballots to win the CCAA Championship Tournament in November.

## Felipe Restrepo - Head Coach

Felipe Restrepo is in his fourth year as head men's soccer coach. Entering the 2011 campaign, Restrepo has guided the Wildcats to a 36-20-5 record and two postseason appearances in his first three seasons at the helm, adding a California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) North Division crown, an NCAA West Region title, an appearance in the NCAA Championship Tournament quarterfinals and a top 10 national ranking in 2010. His teams have earned a reputation of being particularly difficult to beat at home, compiling a 23-7-2 mark (an impressive .750 winning percentage) at University Soccer Stadium.

Under Restrepo's tutelage, several Chico State men's soccer players have earned individual recognition, racking up a combined 12 postseason conference awards, nine West Region selections and three All-America honors. Restrepo himself was named the CCAA Coach of the Year in 2008.

Restrepo is coming off the most successful season of his Chico State career – the Wildcats, with only five returning starters and a freshman-heavy roster, were picked to finish third in the six-team CCAA North Division in 2010. But the Wildcats confounded the experts by winning eight of their first nine matches en route to a 13-5-0 regular season record and first place finish in the North Division with an 11-5-0 mark. But Chico State saved its best for last, knocking off 17th-ranked Sonoma State 2-0 Nov. 12 and scoring two goals in the final 3:46 two days later to stun No. 7 Grand Canyon 3-2 to capture the NCAA West Region title. Though the 'Cats fell to Final Four-bound Midwestern State Nov. 20, They finished the 2010 season ranked No. 8 in the final National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) coaches poll.

Several members of Restrepo's 2010 Chico State squad earned individual honors. Forward Ferid Celosmanovic was named First Team All-CCAA and the conference's Offensive Player and Newcomer of the Year, First Team All-West Region by both the NSCAA and Daktronics, and First Team All-America by the NSCAA. Forward Chris Akwaja also won All-CCAA and All-West Region First Team honors, while midfielders Zach Bradford and Ryan Nevarez wrapped up their Chico State careers by being named Second Team All-West Region.

Restrepo's 2009 Chico State team, led by All-West Region forward Evan Armstrong, posted an 8-8-4 record and finished third in the CCAA North Division.

Taking over the Chico State men's soccer program in 2008, Restrepo and the Wildcats made quite a splash, winning six of their first seven matches to open the season and finishing with a 13-5-1 record – a six-game turnaround from the year before and the most wins by a Chico State men's soccer team since 2003. The 'Cats finished second in the CCAA North Division and were ranked No. 5 in the NCAA West Region poll, earning the program's first postseason appearance since 2003.

Restrepo is the seventh men's soccer head coach in Chico State history and just the third since 1976. Prior to assuming the Wildcats' top spot, Restrepo spent seven seasons as the head assistant coach at UC Davis under Chico State alumnus Dwayne Shaffer. Restrepo helped lead the Aggies to a 70-49-15 record during a time when the school was making the challenging transition to Division I status.

The Aggies ranked among the nation's top 10 scoring teams in 2007, posting a 12-5-3 record to earn an NCAA Championship Tournament berth in their first season as a Division I postseason-eligible program.

Before arriving at UC Davis, Restrepo spent three years as an assistant coach at Cal State Monterey Bay, helping develop a brand-new program. During his tenure, the Otters made two conference tournament appearances and earned a berth in the conference title game.

Restrepo was the head coach of the York High School varsity boys' soccer team from 1998-2000, earning Mountain Trail Athletic League Coach of the Year honors in 2000. He also served as the head coach of a number of club teams in Davis and led the under-17 Davis Legacy Gunners boys team to the state final in 2007. He holds a United States Soccer Federation national "A" coaching license.

As a midfielder for UC Davis, Restrepo was a four-year letterwinner, starting 52 of his final 55 games for the Aggies, and during his junior year was a Second Team All-Northern California Athletic Conference selection. Restrepo has also been a member of the state and regional Olympic Development Program (ODP) teams, and in 1999, he attended the U.S. Soccer Festival with the U-23 Region IV ODP team.

Restrepo received his bachelor's degree in human development at UC Davis in 1998, and his master's in multicultural education at Cal State Monterey Bay in 2001. Restrepo is currently working on his dissertation for a Doctorate in social organization and educational policy through UC Davis, which he plans to complete in June.

Restrepo and his wife, Mandi, have a son, Diego, and a daughter, Eliana.

## Donny Ribaudo - Assistant Coach

Donny Ribaudo is in his sixth year as Wildcats assistant coach. In addition to on-the-field work, his many responsibilities include recruiting, overseeing the team's daily training and weight program, coordinating travel and fundraising efforts, and serving as co-director of the program's youth camps.

A speedy midfielder, Ribaudo played at Chico State from 2000-01, netting four goals and four assists. He was a California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) All-Conference selection, and received the Patty O'Malley award in his senior year. Ribaudo went on to play professionally for the California Gold of the USL D3 Pro League. He then logged four seasons with the Chico Rooks, and in 2004 helped lead the Rooks to the Men's Premier Soccer League championship. Ribaudo was also a member of the National Premier Soccer League's Sacramento Knights during 2007 season.

Ribaudo earned his Advanced National Diploma from the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) in January 2008, and received the organization's Premier Diploma in 2010. He has spent several years coaching at the youth level for Chico's Butte United Soccer Club, and since 2001 Ribaudo has served as a staff coach for the Cavitt Soccer Academy Camps.

After earning his bachelor's degree in Liberal Studies from Chico State in 2003, Ribaudo completed his master's degree in Kinesiology in 2008.

## Robbie Handy - Assistant Coach

Robbie Handy returns for his second season as part of the Chico State men's soccer coaching staff.

Handy brings a wealth of soccer experience and extensive first-hand knowledge of California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) play to the 'Cats. Handy was a standout defensive specialist and midfielder for Cal State Stanislaus from 2002-06, earning All-CCAA Second Team honors in 2006 as well as a Far West Region Honorable Mention. Handy was also selected to the conference's All-Academic team as a junior.

Handy received his bachelor's degree in physical education/health and wellness from Cal State Stanislaus in 2006. He is currently working on his master's in sports management from the University of San Francisco.

# 'Cats capture conference's Commissioner's Cup



For the first time in school history, the Chico State Athletics Department officially distinguished itself as the best in the California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA). The Wildcats sports programs combined to claim the 2010-11 Commissioner's Cup, awarded to the CCAA member institution with the highest aggregate ranking in eight of the conference's 12 championship sport offerings.

Chico State had been close on a number of occasions, finishing second to UC San Diego four times since the Commissioner's Cup came into existence in 2005. But the Wildcats halted the Tritons' five-year reign

on the strength of securing several CCAA titles and high conference finishes in a number of conference-sanctioned sports during the 2010-11 athletic year.

"We're honored and very excited to win this award," said Chico State Director of Athletics Anita Barker. "Chico State Athletics has always been a team effort and everyone contributed to this year's success."

An institution's Commissioner's Cup ranking is calculated using its top two league finishes in the fall, winter and spring sports seasons, as well as the highest two remaining finishes, regardless of season. An institution's numerical finish for team sports is determined by regular season standings. Individual sports finishes are determined by the finishes of the season-ending championship event.

Chico State totaled 20.5 points to win the Commissioner's Cup, thanks to CCAA titles in men's and women's cross country and men's and women's track & field, second place finishes in men's soccer and men's golf, and third place finishes in softball and baseball. The women's basketball team and men's basketball team also finished in the top half of the conference standings.

The Commissioner's Cup, presented in association with Apple Computer, was presented with a glass trophy and Apple laptop computer to Chico State during an official ceremony in September.

## Wildcats post 10th straight Directors' Cup top 30 finish

The Chico State Athletics Department finished 26th out of 310 NCAA Division II schools in the final 2010-11 Learfield Sports Directors' Cup standings, marking the tenth straight year the Wildcats have finished among the top 30 D-II schools in the nation.

The Wildcats scored 404 points behind NCAA Championship runs by seven of their 13 programs: men's cross country, women's cross country, men's soccer, softball, men's track & field, women's track & field, and men's golf.

Each Chico State cross country program finished fifth in the national rankings, while the men's soccer program advanced to the NCAA Championship Tournament quarterfinals. The Chico State men's track & field team finished 21st in the nation and the women's team 37th. The softball team advanced to the NCAA West Regional for the second season in a row. The men's golf team finished seventh in the NCAA West/Central Super Regional.

Chico State earned its first top-20 Directors' Cup ranking by finishing 17th in 2001-02, and followed that up with finishes of 28th, fifth, third, eighth, 17th, 25th, 22nd, 12th, and 26th, respectively.

# Administration



## University President - Dr. Paul J. Zingg

Dr. Paul J. Zingg, California State University, Chico's 15th president, is in his eighth year of service at the University. CSU, Chico, one of 23 campuses in The California State University System, is a comprehensive, four-year university whose motto "Today Decides Tomorrow" guides 16,000 students through their undergraduate and graduate education.

Prior to being named president at CSU, Chico, Zingg was provost and vice president for academic affairs at California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo from 1995 to 2004. Before that he served as the dean of the College of Liberal Arts at Cal Poly, 1993-1995.

Zingg served as dean of the School of Liberal Arts at Saint Mary's College of California from 1986-1993. Previously, he spent several years at the University of Pennsylvania, serving as assistant to the president from 1984-1986, as an American Council on Education Fellow in Academic Administration and special assistant to the president in 1983-1984, and as vice dean of the School of Arts and Sciences, 1979-1983.

Zingg received his Ph.D. in history in 1974 from the University of Georgia, Athens; an M.A. in history in 1969 from the University of Richmond, Virginia; and a B.A. in history in 1968 from Belmont Abbey College, North Carolina.

He has published ten books and nearly 100 articles on American higher education, student learning, educational leadership, sports history, and intercollegiate athletics. He has also acted as a sports history consultant to several presses, the media, museum curators, and on Ken Burns' acclaimed television documentary series, *Baseball*, in 1994.

Zingg was appointed a fellow of the American Council on Education in 1983-1984, has received support for his research from the National Endowment for the Humanities, and has served on several national boards and commissions for higher education.



## Athletic Director - Anita Barker

Anita Barker is in her 10th year as the Athletic Director for the University's 13 intercollegiate athletics teams. Barker has successfully worked to build on the prior success of the program and continues to focus on improving the department's fundraising and marketing efforts to offer more athletic grant-in-aid to deserving student-athletes.

2010-11 was another banner year for Chico State – under Barker's guidance, the Wildcat Athletics Department captured its first-ever California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) Commissioner's Cup, awarded to the conference's member institution with the highest aggregate ranking in eight of the CCAA's 12 championship sport offerings. Nationally, the Chico State Athletics Department finished 26th out of 310 NCAA Division II schools in the final 2010-11 Learfield Sports Directors' Cup standings.

During the 2009-10 school year, Barker helped direct the Athletic Department to its seventh straight top 25 Directors' Cup finish, and Barker herself was honored by the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA) as the 2009 Division II West Region Athletic Director of the Year.

A priority of Barker's is to continue to improve the student-athlete experience at Chico State, and that is being accomplished through a focus on the Student Athlete Advisory Council (SAAC) and the implementation of fall kickoff and spring wrap up barbecues to thank all the athletes who give so much to the University.

Prior to her current position, Barker served as the University's associate athletic director, serving as the senior women's administrator, supervised staff, and developed departmental policy and procedures, among numerous other duties. Barker has worked in the athletic department since 1990, when she was hired as the assistant athletic trainer. She began working in athletic administration in 1995, when she was appointed the assistant athletic director and senior women's administrator. In 1997, she was promoted to associate athletic director.

Barker graduated from Ohio Northern University in 1985 and received her master's from the University of Arizona in Tucson in 1987. She has worked at all three divisions in the NCAA.

Barker and her husband, Scott, the head athletic trainer at Chico State, have two children, Luke and McKena.

# Blend of talent, depth, leadership highlights 2011 'Cats

If more twins equal more wins, the Chico State women's soccer program is in good hands. Four twins are among the 14 newcomers to the program in 2011. Twins Mackenzie and Morgan Edwards are both incoming freshmen. Megan Tabler's twin sister is also a Chico State student. And Alyx Williams' twin sister is a freshman volleyball player at Cal Poly San Luis Obispo.

But the Wildcats' deep returning group, 16 strong, knows that it's going to take more than reinforcements for the team to achieve its goals in the ultra-competitive California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA). So they set high standards in the offseason to make sure that a North Division title, CCAA Championship Tournament crown, and strong run in the NCAA Championship Tournament are attainable.

"This leadership is some of the best we've ever had in my years here," said 11th year Wildcats Head Coach Kim Sutton. "We have a solid core of outstanding leaders, and it's really paid off in terms of commitment level, goal setting, and setting the tone for our new players. The team dynamics are terrific."

Senior standouts Blake Lopes, Molly Downtain, and Lisa Webster are helping to provide that leadership. All three earned All-CCAA honors in 2010 despite the team's frustrating 8-9-1 season.

The team was as strong as any between the penalty areas, but struggled to put the ball in the net while allowing more than its fair share of soft goals. Sutton worked doubly hard to address both issues in the offseason.

"Last year we didn't have enough depth. That's all changed. We have great depth. We feel we have a very solid new class coming in," said Sutton. "We feel like our newfound depth is going to create competition for playing time that will improve our team. Plus, that depth will allow us to try different things when something is not working."

The aforementioned trio of All-Conference returners are not among the things Sutton is thinking of changing. Webster led the Wildcats with eight goals and also dished out a trio of assists. She boasts career totals of 14 goals and 14 assists. Those 14 helpers put her eighth on the school's career assists list. Downtain, a two-time All-West Region selection, anchors the defense. And Lopes sets the tone in the middle of the field with her tough-minded defense and five career assists.

Those three are among eight returning starters. Denni Jo Berger was second on the team with

three goals and led the way with four assists. Carly Singer started 17 times as a freshman and registered a goal and three assists. Kasey Wall, Shelby Dunlap, and Downtain give Sutton three quarters of her returning back third. And Sydney Oliver started 16 games between the pipes as a true freshman.

"The dedication and drive of the returners reminds me of the 2009 season," said Sutton. "The year before that was disappointing because we sort of had an attitude that we were going to make the postseason just because we had the year before. When we didn't, the team came back the following year determined to make sure they didn't miss out again. I'm seeing a lot of similarities this year."

That's a good omen, specifically if those similarities carry over to the postseason. In 2009 the Wildcats won the CCAA North Division title and went on to advance to the second round of the NCAA Championship Tournament for the first time in the program's history.

Maybe 2009 and 2011 will be similar seasons, perhaps even twins.



## 'Cats expected to challenge for North Division crown

According to the annual California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) preseason coaches poll, the Chico State women's soccer team will be very much in the mix in the battle for the conference's North Division title. The Wildcats received two of 11 first place votes, as well as being picked by eight conference coaches to be one of the four CCAA Championship Tournament participants.

## Kim Sutton - Head Coach

Kim Sutton is in her 11th season as Chico State's head women's soccer coach and 17th at the NCAA Division II level. Sutton has established herself as one of the top coaches in the nation – entering the 2011 season, she owns a 101-67-35 record in her 10 years with the Wildcats and an overall mark of 228-133-50 in a coaching career that has spanned over 20 years. Sutton has led the Wildcats to five California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) North Division crowns, four CCAA Championship Tournament finals (winning the program's first-ever CCAA conference title in 2007) and four NCAA Championship Tournament appearances.

Sutton's 2010 team posted an overall record of 8-9-1, with six of its wins coming on its home pitch, University Soccer Stadium. The Wildcats finished third in the CCAA North Division standings with a 7-8-1 mark. Chico State was led by defender Molly Downtain, who garnered All-CCAA honors and was named to the All-West Region second team for the second straight season. Midfielders Lisa Webster and Blake Lopes were All-CCAA Honorable Mentions for their outstanding play in 2010. Sutton achieved a personal milestone Oct. 25, 2010, notching her 100th victory as Chico State head coach in the Wildcats' 4-2 win over Cal State Monterey Bay.

Under Sutton's guidance, Chico State captured the 2009 CCAA North Division title, earned a No. 5 ranking in the West Region, competed in its fifth CCAA Championship Tournament in six years, and advanced to the NCAA Championship Tournament for the fourth time since 2004. The Wildcats capped off the season with an exciting shootout victory over Seattle Pacific Nov. 12, 2009 to notch the first NCAA Tournament win in the program's history.

The CCAA's Coach of the Year in 2004 and 2007, Sutton has averaged nearly 10 victories a season in her 16 years as a Division II college coach. She begins the 2011 season with a career winning percentage of .575, and her 156 victories ranks Sutton 25th among active D-II coaches nationwide. Figuring in her five years as a junior college coach, Sutton's all-time career winning percentage is an even more impressive .616.

On September 17, 2005, in just her 11th year at the Division II level, Sutton earned her 100th NCAA coaching victory with a 1-0 victory at San Francisco State.

Prior to her 2001 arrival at Chico State, Sutton spearheaded the Humboldt State women's soccer program during its first six years of existence (1995-2000), and led the Lumberjacks to two Pacific West Conference titles, two NCAA Tournament appearances, and an overall record of 55-42-14.

Sutton got the Lumberjacks off to a fast start – in just the program's third season as an intercollegiate sport, Humboldt State posted a 12-4-4 record in 1997 and reached the NCAA Championship Tournament quarterfinals. Sutton led the Lumberjacks to a third consecutive 10-win season in 1998, culminating in her being named the Pacific West Conference Coach of the Year.

Sutton took on her first head coaching job at Santa Rosa Junior College, guiding the Bear Cubs from 1990-1994. She led the team to three conference titles and a pair of state championship matches while compiling an overall mark of 72-24-1.

As a player, Sutton earned All-Conference honors playing soccer for Sonoma State in 1986, and competed for Team USA on its 1987 tour of Europe and the Soviet Union.

Sutton received her bachelor's degree from Sonoma State in 1989, with an emphasis in teacher preparation and minor in chemistry. She earned her master's degree in physical education with an emphasis in biochemical kinesiology from Sonoma State in 1993.

## Jenna Hunter - Assistant Coach

Jenna Hunter joins the Chico State women's soccer coaching staff for the 2011 season. She plays a significant role in all aspects of the program, including on-field instruction, recruiting, fundraising, and player academics. Hunter will also be instrumental in coordinating various Wildcat youth soccer camps and clinics throughout the year.

Hunter has nearly a decade of coaching experience to her credit. Prior to joining the 'Cats, she served for two seasons as head women's soccer and badminton coach at Mission Community College in Santa Clara. Hunter logged five seasons (2004-08) as assistant soccer coach at her alma mater, Humboldt State, and in 2004 also held head varsity coaching duties for the Eureka High School girl's team. For the past three years, Hunter has coached youth soccer for the Almaden Valley Soccer Club in San Jose, and is part of the SoccerPlus summer camp staff.

As a player, Hunter starred for four seasons at Humboldt State. As a freshman playing for current Chico State head coach Kim Sutton, Hunter was named to the All-Pacific West first team. She went on to win three consecutive All-Great Northwest Athletic Conference first team accolades, and in 2003 was named the All-American Athlete of the Year by the National Strength and Conditioning Association. Hunter currently ranks as Humboldt State's all-time career assists leader (27), and her 31 goals are second most in the program's history.

Hunter received her bachelor's degree in kinesiology/pedagogy from Humboldt State in 2005, then earned a master's degree in kinesiology/pedagogy from Humboldt in 2008.

## Analise Farmer - Assistant Coach

Analise Farmer is another new edition to Kim Sutton's 2011 Chico State women's soccer coaching staff. Analise will contribute to Wildcat player development, help with recruiting endeavors, assist in putting on youth soccer camps and clinics, and help oversee the team's fundraising and academic endeavors.

A native of Paisley, Scotland, Farmer has coached in California for the past several years. She has been part of the Almaden FC coaching staff from 2009-11, and from 09-10 served as junior varsity coach of the Mountain View High School girls soccer team. Farmer has had two stints in the college coaching ranks, assisting at Humboldt State in 2007 and Cal State East Bay during the 2010 season. Farmer coached the California U14 ODP state team in 2010, and has coached at camps and clinics for the U.K. International Soccer Camps organization.

Farmer played her college ball at the University of Cincinnati, spending three seasons as a forward for the Bearcats from 2004-06. She also played club football in Scotland for Glasgow City, Saint Mirren and Arsenal North after graduating from Paisley Grammar School in 2001.

Farmer received her bachelor's degree in criminal justice from the University of Cincinnati in 2007.



## Jen Ogren - Goalkeepers Coach

Jen Ogren joins the Chico State women's soccer coaching staff in 2011 as the team's goalkeepers coach. In addition to her on-field duties, Ogren will be part of the Wildcat recruiting and fundraising efforts, help oversee student academics and assist in Chico State's youth soccer camps and clinics.

Though her playing career ended last fall, Ogren is no stranger to the coaching ranks. The Missouri native helped run several youth and summer club camps in her hometown of Raymore, and served as a volunteer coach at her alma mater, Raymore-Peculiar High School, while attending the University of South Dakota.

Ogren played for the University of South Dakota from 2007-10, and was the Coyotes' starting goalkeeper in her final three seasons. Ogren earned a combined six Great Northwest Conference Player of the Week awards during her junior and senior seasons, and set the school's career record for saves with 367.

Ogren received her bachelor's degree in physical education from the University of South Dakota in May, 2011. She is currently working on her master's in adaptive physical education at Chico State.

Rarely does one find a single setting which combines the best of location, setting, tradition, opportunity, and people. Chico State is one of those special places. Despite an enrollment of about 16,000 students, Chico State strikes a balance between the warm, social atmosphere of a small campus and the educational and cultural opportunities of a large school.

Chico is located 90 miles north of Sacramento, eight miles from the Sacramento River, and two miles from the foothills of the Sierra Nevada. Several creeks flow through the community, including Big Chico Creek, which winds through a canopy of trees across the Chico State campus and downtown Chico. The campus was declared an arboretum in 1982, an indication of the desire to preserve and enhance its natural beauty. The city of Chico is the proprietor of Bidwell Park, which, with its 3,600 acres, is one of the largest municipal parks in the nation. An 18-hole golf course; softball diamonds; picnic areas; equestrian, jogging, mountain biking and hiking trails; and natural swimming holes along the creek, among other recreational facilities, are available.

The atmosphere on the Chico State campus is determined in part by its rural setting. The general openness and friendliness found in the campus community sometimes surprises those familiar with larger, more urban campuses. This openness extends to academic matters, where students find that their professors are accessible to them, that instructors are willing to spend time with them on an individual basis, and that Chico State is a place where teaching and learning really matter.

Chico's 16,000 students are divided about equally between men and women. Eighty-five percent are full-time students. Eighty percent come from hometowns over 100 miles from Chico. Seventy-six percent live within walking or bicycling distance of campus. Over half receive letters of acceptance from other colleges but choose Chico's dynamic intellectual and social environment.

The university has a traditionally strong and varied academic instructional program. Chico's library contains more than 950,000 books, serial back files, electronic documents and government documents; 23,117 current serial subscriptions; and 1.27 million historical photos, maps, and other items in archives. Facilities for music, drama, and art enable students to participate in cultural and educational experiences. A planetarium, working farm, two satellite telecommunications broadcast antennae, and a rich complement of laboratories, computers, and other modern equipment help students test and confirm theoretical learning. The university sponsors more than 240 student organizations. Over 500 cultural festivals, exhibits, concerts, and other public events occur on campus each year.
