Last time out - Edinboro 78, Clarion 66

- Feb. 27, 2010 at McComb Fieldhouse, Edinboro
- In the 2010 season finale the Golden Eagles were outscored 42-35 in the second half and Edinboro claimed the final PSAC Playoff berth away from the Eagles.
- Senior Janelle Zabresky had a double-double in her final collegiate game with 19 points, 10 rebounds. Bethany Koch and Rachel Graeff each added 13 points with Sara Pratt contributing 9 points and 10 rebounds.
- Clarion finished the season 14-13, 5-9 PSAC-West

Eagles strong in home openers

- Clarion is 24-12 in home openers since 1975 (locations for games in Clarion's first season in 1974 are not available)
- The Golden Eagles are even better in home openers under 22nd year head coach Gie Parsons going 19-2 including 11-1 since 1999. Clarion has won four straight home openers since suffering a 71-63 loss to Charleston (W. Va.) in 2005-2006.

Clarion also tough in season openers

- The Golden Eagles are also tough in season openers going 26-11 in program history including 18-3 under Parsons.
- Clarion has won 11 of 12 season opener with the lone loss coming to Charleston (W. Va.) in 2005-2006.

Eagles win 68% of home games since '02

- Clarion has won 67.8 percent (82-39) of its home games since the start of the 2001-02 season, and the Golden Eagles have had a winning record at home in each of the last nine seasons.
- In Parsons' 21 years at Clarion, the Golden Eagles are 174-93 at home (65.2 percent).
- All time, the Golden Eagles are 232-173 at home and have had just 13 losing seasons at home in 36 years.

Clarion replacing 92.5% of scoring

- The Golden Eagles must replace 92.5 percent of their scoring from last year with only junior post players Courtney Healy (122 points) and Joanna Catalano (20 points) back.
- Clarion also must replace 90.8 percent of its rebounding and 88.9 percent of its minutes from a year ago.

This date in Clarion History

Nov. 13, 1998 at Clarion

Clarion 93, Westminster 46

- Clarion used a 24-3 first-half run to take a 44-21 halftime lead and then outscored Westminster 49-25 in the second half.
- Six Golden Eagles, including all five starters, scored in double figures. Alison Campbell led the way with 24 points, 14 rebounds, 4 steals. Also reaching double digits were Erica Johnson (13), Bobbi Schneider (12), Heather Jensvold (12), Krista Archibale (11) and Miesha Henry (10).
- Clarion shot 43.4% from the floor and out-rebounded Westminster 61-37 while forcing 25 turnovers.

About the 1999 Season

- Clarion finished 9-17 overall and 2-10 in the PSAC-West.
- The highlight of the season was a seven-game stretch that saw Clarion win 5 of 7 from Nov. 30 to Jan. 6 including an upset of highly-ranked Edinboro 71-67 at home Jan. 6 in the PSAC-West opener.
- Henry led Clarion averaging 12.2 points per game while handing out 117 assists. Schneider contributed 12.1 ppg and 5.3 rpg while Johnson (11.8 ppg) and Campbell (10.1 ppg) also reached double-digit scoring averages for the year.

Golden Eagle player notes

Healy lone returning starter

- Jr. F Courtney Healy is the lone returning starter for Clarion having started 19 games last year before an injury in late January ended her season.
- She averaged 6.4 points and 4.3 rebounds per game and blocked 30 shots, which was third on the team despite missing eight games on the year.
- In her career, Healy has started 36 of 43 games and has averaged 5.2 ppg and 4.4 rpg
- Her 60 career blocked shots are the 7th most in school history

Catalano also brings experience

- Also bringing experience to an other-wise young Golden Eagle team is junior forward Joanna Catalano, who has seen limited action in her first two seasons with the Golden Eagles.
- Last year, Catalano played in 22 games but averaged just 4.2 minutes per game and scored 20 points while hauling in 23 rebounds. In her career, she has played in 48 games with 73 points and 57 rebounds.

Jones is new point guard

- Red-shirt freshman Raven Jones is the new PG.
- Jones was an All-Philly Public League performer her senior season after leading her team to a 25-5 record.
