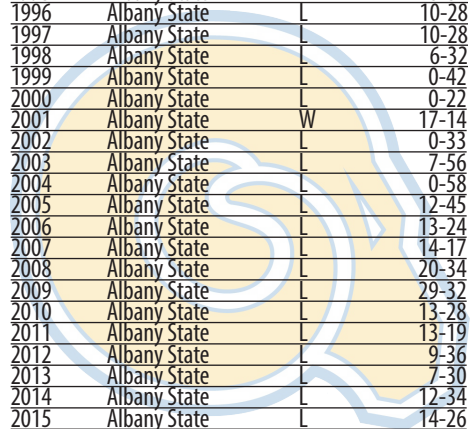

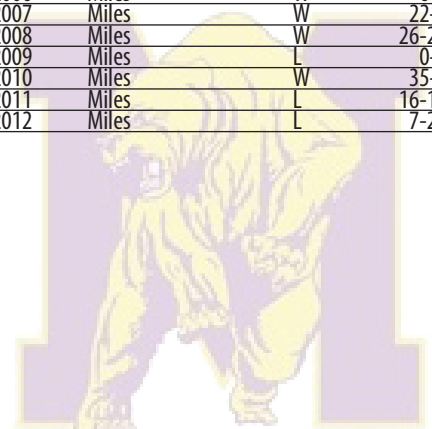

HEAD COACH | KEVIN RAMSEY



Kevin Ramsey takes over as Interim Head Coach of the Clark Atlanta University Panthers football team on July 13th, 2015 after spending the previous three seasons as the defensive coordinator at Alabama State University, a NCAA Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) member school.

Last season Ramsey formed the ASU defense into one of the top in the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC), finishing the season second in scoring defense (24.7). ASU was also second in the SWAC in rushing defense as well as defensive pass efficiency.

In 2013 Ramsey's defense showed improvement over the previous season as it finished second among SWAC schools in scoring defense allowing 25.8 points per game.

During his first season with ASU in 2012, Ramsey's attacking style of defense made it hard on the opposition's running game as the Hornets allowed just 110.1 yards rushing per game,

which not only led the SWAC but was good enough for 11th nationally. ASU led the SWAC in quarterback sacks (50), a 4.17 per game average that placed ASU second among all FCS teams.

Ramsey served in the same capacity at Texas Southern Univ. from 2009-10, and during part of the 2012 season, with a stint as interim head coach during the 2011 season. Ramsey's Tigers led the FCS in total defense in both 2010 (204.9 yards per game allowed) and 2011 (245.0 ypg allowed), and in fewest first downs allowed (140 in 2010, 141 in 2011).

His 2010 squad led the nation in six statistical categories: total defense, fewest first downs allowed, sacks (45), tackles for loss (112), third down percentage conversion percentage against (22.5), and pass efficiency defense.

Prior to Texas Southern, Ramsey spent five seasons as defensive coordinator at Carson-Newman (2004-08), where his units ranked in the top 20 in several national categories each season.

Ramsey began his coaching career at Kansas State (1984-85) as a graduate assistant, before moving on to serve as junior varsity defensive coordinator at Mission High School in Mission, Texas (1986). Ramsey would then continue his career at some of the nation's biggest schools - Kansas State (1987-89, outside linebackers), Northwestern (1990-92, defensive line/defensive backs), West Virginia (1993-94, defensive backs), Tennessee (1995-98, defensive backs), Georgia (1999, defensive coordinator) and Michigan State (2000, defensive backs).

Ramsey, who participated in NFL coaching internships with the Green Bay Packers, Chicago Bears and Philadelphia Eagles, coached three seasons as secondary coach for the Arizona Cardinals (2000-02) before returning to the college ranks at Arizona State in 2003.

Teams that Ramsey has coached have been to a number of bowl games, including the Outback Bowl with Georgia (2000), the Carquest Bowl (1995) and Sugar Bowl (1994) with Big East Champion West Virginia, two trips to the Citrus Bowl (1996, 97), the Orange Bowl (1998) and the Fiesta Bowl National Championship Game with Tennessee (1999).

Ramsey was a three-time All-Missouri Valley Conference selection at defensive back while playing at Indiana State from 1980-83. He was a second team All-American as a senior, in addition to playing baseball for the Sycamores. He graduated from Indiana State with a degree Physical Education in 1984.

A native of East St. Louis, Illinois, Ramsey and his wife Doreen have four daughters: Kajavia, Samiya, Tresnae and Amariell.

OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR | RICHARD MONCRIEF



Richard Moncrief enters into his 19th year of coaching overall as he takes over as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach for the Panthers this season.

Moncrief's coaching experience has come at both the high school and collegiate level. After coaching the wide receivers at NCAA Division I University of Alabama-Birmingham from 2001-03, he moved on to serve as athletic director and head football coach at Sidney Lanier High School in Montgomery, Alabama.

Following a four-year stint in the high school ranks, Moncrief returned to the NCAA Division I level, serving as quarterbacks coach at Alabama State University from 2007-13. During the 2009 season he added offensive coordinator to his duties for the Hornets.

Before embarking on a coaching career, Moncrief was an All-State and State Player of the Year performer at quarterback, still holding the record for most passing yards at his high school.

Following his high school career, Moncrief attended Clemson University where he was a member of the 1991 Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) Championship team. While at Clemson, his teams participated and won four bowl games (1989 Gator Bowl, 1990 Hall of Fame Bowl, 1991 Tokyo Bowl, 1993 Peach Bowl), with Moncrief taking home Most Valuable Player honors in the 1991 Tokyo Bowl.

Moncrief graduated with a degree in Sociology with a minor in Business Administration from Clemson University. His goal as a coach is to graduate 100% of his players.

OFFENSIVE LINE | JONATHAN CARR



Johnathan Carr was hired at Clark Atlanta University prior to the 2015 season and serves as the coach of the offensive line. A three-year letter winner during his playing days at Alabama State, Carr claimed a pair of SWAC Eastern Division Titles (2003, 2004) along with the conference championship in 2004.

His coaching career began in 2007 as the offensive line coach at St. Jude High School in Montgomery, Ala. He moved to G. W. Carver High School, also in Montgomery, for the 2007-08 year as the Co-Offensive Coordinator.

After two seasons on the high school level, Carr returned to Alabama State to complete his degree in Criminal Justice while serving under current CAU Offensive Coordinator Richard Moncrief as an offensive assistant (tight ends, wide receivers, and offensive line).

In 2011, Carr returned to Carver and served one season as associate head coach before moving on to Jefferson Davis High School for three seasons as the offensive coordinator and assistant head coach.

Originally from Milwaukee, Wis., Carr moved with his family to Mobile, Ala. and has been coaching for over a decade with seven seasons on the high school level and three more collegiately.

RUNNING BACKS | DARNELL JENNINGS



Darnell Jennings joined Clark Atlanta University prior to the 2015 season and will take over as the coach of the running backs in 2016 after previously working with wide receivers in 2015 as an intern. Prior to Clark Atlanta University, Jennings served as the receivers coach at Pace Academy High School located in Atlanta, Ga. in 2014. Pace won the first playoff game in school history with the receiving core catching 12 touchdowns in three playoff games.

Jennings was a 4-Year Letterman at Western Michigan University from 1997 to 2001. The Broncos were MAC West Champions in 1999 and 2000. Jennings earned All-MAC Scholar Athlete Honors in 2000 and 2001. His tenure wrapped up with 57 receptions for 656 yards while scoring four times. After college, Jennings earned a camp workout invitation with the Buffalo Bills in 2002.

A native of Mount Holly, N.J., Jennings earned his bachelor degree in Integrated Supply Chain Management from Western Michigan University in 2001. He earned his master's degree in Business Management from Drexel University in 2006.

DEFENSIVE LINE | ERIC SOLOMON



A veteran high school football coach in the southeast, Eric Solomon joined the Clark Atlanta football coaching staff prior to the beginning of the 2015 football season. While at CAU, Solomon will have positional responsibility for the defensive line while assisting on special teams.

Prior to the college ranks, Solomon coached at high schools in Tennessee, Georgia, and Florida - always on the defensive side of the ball. Of keynote experience, Solomon spent three seasons coaching the defensive backs at Valdosta HS in Valdosta, Ga. - the winningest high school football program in the United States. During his tenure, the VHS Wildcats reached the state playoffs in 2012, 2013, and 2014. He orchestrated the summer workout and nutrition plans under the guidance of coach Rance Gillespie. Solomon also coached at Austin East HS in Knoxville, Tenn., Peach County HS in Fort Valley, Ga., and Bayside HS in Palm Bay, Fla.

Solomon is in his second stint under head coach Kevin Ramsey, having been a graduate assistant at his Alma Mater Carson-Newman College during the 2008 season working with the defensive backs and linebackers.

Along with football coaching experience, he has served as a head track and field coach at Valdosta and Austin East high schools.

Coach Solomon will also oversee the Clark Atlanta University strength and conditioning program for the entire athletic department. He serves as a member of the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA), Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA), and Personal Trainer for Future College Athletes (PTFCA).

LINEBACKERS | BRAXTON KELLEY



A native of LaGrange, Georgia, Braxton Kelley enters his fourth season on the Panthers coaching staff as linebackers coach. During his stellar football career at the University of Kentucky (2005-2008), the All-American linebacker was named to the SEC All-Freshman Team (2008), All-SEC team (2008), SEC Honor Roll and the Wildcats' 300-plus tackle club. He was also tabbed as Kentucky's Most Outstanding Freshman and team captain.

Kelley had a three year stint with the Denver Broncos (2009-2011) before suffering a career-ending injury. He then returned to his alma mater in 2012 as linebackers and special teams coach where also completed his bachelor's degree in Kinesiology and Communication Leadership.

Kelley and his family, wife Sophia Kelley and daughter Londynn Kelley reside in Atlanta.

DEFENSIVE BACKS | DEXTER JACKSON



Dexter Jackson serves as the defensive backs coach for Clark Atlanta University since the 2015 season.

Jackson concluded a star-studded professional football career with accolades such as being selected in the 4th Round of the NFL Draft in 1999 (No. 113 overall by Tampa Bay), being named Super Bowl XXXVII MVP as Tampa Bay defeated Oakland, Defensive Player of the Week honors multiple times during his career, serving as team captain, 17 career interceptions and over 400 tackles while suiting up for three teams (Tampa Bay, Arizona, and Cincinnati).

During his time with the Bengals (2007-09) Jackson was the NFL Player Representative for the team. Within this role he met with directors from the NFL, board members, and other administrative members voicing questions and concerns from the NFL Players. He was responsible for reporting back to the players the meeting details.

Following his playing career, Jackson entered the coaching ranks as a volunteer with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers from 2010-2014. His first collegiate coaching opportunity came during the 2014 season at Alabama State where he mentored All-SWAC players Najee Bright (1st team; honorable mention All-American) and Marcus Berg (3rd team). The secondary at Alabama State transitioned from last in the league to second overall in fewest passing yards allowed while also ranking second in interceptions and fewest TD passes allowed.

After one season he joined Clark Atlanta and turned Joshua Tate into an All-SIAC First Team selection, Second Team on the NCAA Division II All-Super Region Two squad, and All-American.

Away from football, Jackson is a certified Counselor and Case Manager and frequently works with a crisis center as a youth activity manager - helping to find assistance for at-risk youth. He graduated from Florida State University in 2001 with an undergraduate degree in Family and Child Services. He was selected to the ACC All-Academic Team while playing for the Seminoles.

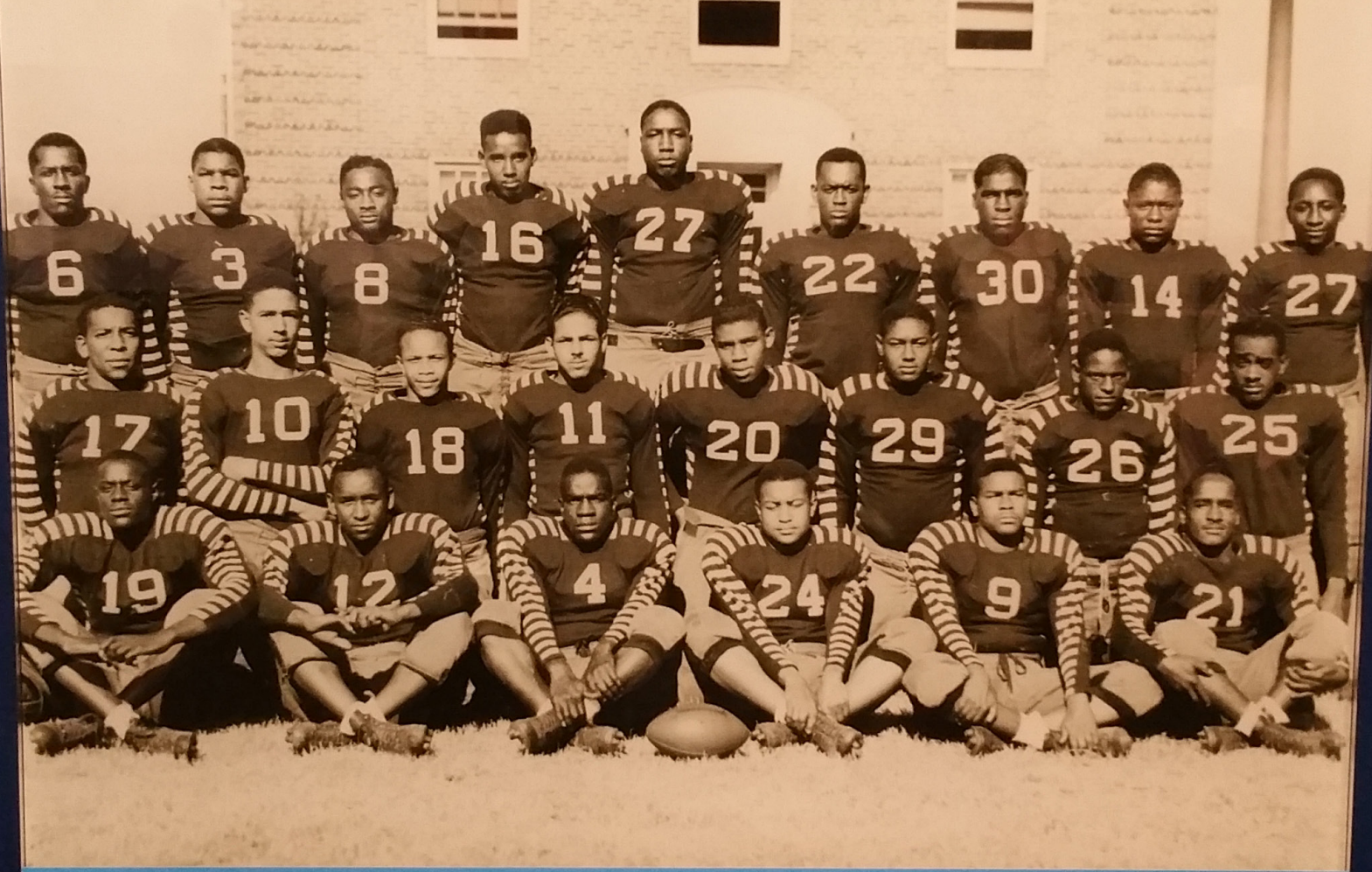
