- **Ayrton Martino** has recorded assists in 19 of the 30 games this season and a point in 21 of 30 games. The Knights are 5-1 when Marty scores and 7-0 when he has a multi point game.
- **Anthony Callin** has scored 6 of his 10 goals in the 3rd period this season.
- Clarkson is 10-5-3 when allowing under 30 shots
- Clarkson has scored first in 17 of 30 games this season, but the Knights are only 9-7-2 when scoring first
- Clarkson is 6-2-2 when outshooting opponents
- Clarkson's win at the Kwik Trip Holiday Face Off was their 4th straight title of in season tournaments.
- **Noah Beck** was named the ECAC Defender of the Month for October. He is the teams 4th leading scorer after 30 games with 5 goals and 14 assists.
- **Ethan Haider** has played in 25 games this season. He has posted consecutive shutouts for the first time in his career at Clarkson. His GAA is 2.63 on the season and 2.39 for his career. Ethan was named the MAC Goaltending/ECAC Goalie of the Week for Oct. 24th. and the ECH Goalie of the Month for Nov.
- **Mathieu Gosselin** is 16th in the nation for face-offs won. He currently is winning 58% of his draws.

The “Leonard S. Ceglarski” Head Men’s Hockey Coach Casey Jones



Casey Jones, enters his 12th year as Clarkson University’s Head Coach. Selected the Tim Taylor ECAC Hockey Coach of the Year in 2019 and named a finalist for the award several times during his career at Clarkson, Jones has established the Golden Knights program as one of the best in the nation. He has also been a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award, presented annually to the CCM/AHCA Division I Men’s Ice Hockey Coach of the Year.

Through his first eleven seasons behind the Clarkson bench, Jones has guided the Green and Gold to a 213-166-54 overall record. Jones has directed Clarkson to six 20-win campaigns, including the 2019 ECAC Tournament Championship. The Knights have placed in the top three of the ECAC Hockey standings in each of the past five years and advanced to the league’s championship tournament in Lake Placid in four of those six seasons. Clarkson won the program’s sixth ECAC Hockey Championship Tournament title in 2019. The Knights have participated in the two NCAA Tournaments and would have received a berth in 2020 had the season not been cancelled due to COVID.

Under the guidance of Jones and his staff, Clarkson skated to its best regular season in over 20 years during the 2019-20 season with a 23-8-3 overall record. The Knights place second in the ECAC standings with a 16-5-1 mark, its most league victories since winning 18 in 1998-99. The Knights were poised for postseason success and were rated ninth in the final NCAA Pairwise Rankings before the COVID 19 pandemic forced an abrupt end to the college hockey season in early March.

Renowned as a top recruiter, Jones and his staff have brought to Clarkson some of the finest student-athletes in the country. Twelve Golden Knights have been selected in the National Hockey League entry draft during Jones’ time behind the Clarkson bench. Numerous Knights have earned postseason honors during Jones’ tenure. In 2019-20 Frank Marotte was named an All-American along with earning ECAC Hockey’s GOY award. Marotte joins Rempal ’18, Summers ’18 and Sturm ’19 who have earned All-American honors over the past three seasons. For fifth consecutive season a Golden Knight was named ECAC Hockey’s Best Defensive Forward as Zach Tsekos earned the honor in 2021 and again in 2022, following two-time winner Sturm (2018, 2019) and Josh Dunne (2020).

A native of Temiscaming, Quebec, Jones worked as an assistant for the Knights under head coach Mark Morris from 1993-95. He spent 13 years (1995-2008) at Ohio State as a coach before returning to the ECAC when he joined the staff at his alma mater, Cornell, for the 2008-09 campaign. When Jones was at Clarkson from ’93 to ’95, he contributed to the Golden Knights 43-19-9 record, an ECAC Hockey Championship and a berth in the NCAA Tournament in 1995.

Jones played for the Big Red, serving as team captain in 89-90. He was selected by the Boston Bruins in the 10th-round of the 1987 NHL Entry Draft. Casey and his wife, Kimberlee, also a Cornell graduate, have a daughter, Gabrielle, who is a junior and a member of the St. Lawrence Women’s Hockey team, and a son, Bryan, who attends Northwood School in Lake Placid.



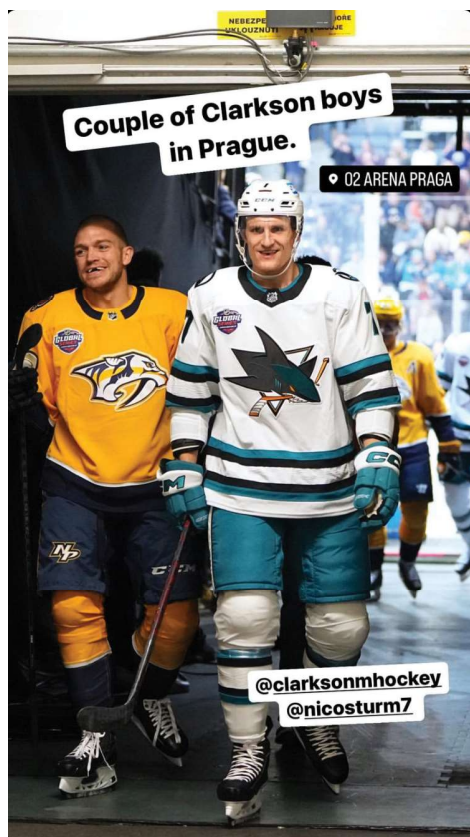
Knights in the NHL Update
