GAME PREVIEW

- The Central Michigan women's basketball team will look to extend its win streak to four games on Friday (5 p.m.) when it goes to Michigan State for a nonconference game.
- The Chippewas are 3-1 and coming off a 69-51 victory over Miami (Ohio) on Tuesday. That win lifted CMU to 2-0 in the Mid-American Conference.

SOLID D

- While the Chippewas have long been known as one of the most explosive teams in the MAC, they have flexed their defensive muscle in their past two games.
- They held the RedHawks to more than 15 points below their season average in Wednesday's game. In their previous game, the Chippewas held Cincinnati to six points below its average in a 79-62 victory.

RETURN TO FORM

- Senior guard Micaela Kelly scored 29 points to lead the Chippewas in their win over Miami. That came after a 13-point performance against Cincinnati and a 17-point output in the Chippewas' 82-71 win on Dec. 9 over Western Michigan.
- Kelly, the reigning MAC Player of the Year, is averaging 22.3 points per game. She ranks third in the league in scoring.
- CMU sophomore guard Molly Davis is averaging 20.3 points per game and ranks ninth in the league.
- Senior guard Maddy Watters ranks third in the league averaging 3.3 triples per game.

ANOTHER DOUBLE

• CMU senior forward Kyra Bussell scored 12 points and grabbed 10 rebounds against Miami. It marked her second-consecutive double-double and the sixth of her career.

RANKINGS

- The Chippewas, who are seeking their fifthconsecutive MAC championship, are ranked fifth in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll this week.
- CMU is the highest-ranked of the fourth MAC teams in the poll. Ohio is 12th, Buffalo is 15th, and Bowling Green is 23rd.

SCOUTING THE SPARTANS

- The Spartans, who are coached by former CMU standout Suzy Merchant, are 4-0, 2-0 Big Ten after an 86-82 win on Saturday at home against lowa. The Hawkeyes entered the game unbeaten.
- MSU is off to its best start since 2013-14 and is among others receiving votes in both the Associated Press and Coaches polls.
- Nia Clouden, a junior guard, leads the Spartans in scoring at 19.0 points per game, while Alyza Winston, a sophomore guard, averages 18.7. Mardrekia Cook, a 6-foot senior, is MSU's top rebounder at 6.5 per game.
- Winston scored a career-high 25 points in the win over Iowa. She had 20 in the Spartans' 81-68 victory over Minnesota in their Big Ten opener.

CMU PICKED PICKED NO.1 IN PRESEASON POLL

- The Central Michigan women's basketball team was picked to win the Mid-American Conference regular-season championship and the leaguetournament title in a poll of league coaches
- The Chippewas received 10 first-place votes and 142 points from the 12 league coaches in the regular-season poll. They were picked by six coaches to win the league tournament. The Chippewas are vying for their fifth-consecutive MAC regular-season championship.
- CMU's Micaela Kelly was selected to the All-MAC Preseason First Team, while teammates Kyra Bussell and Molly Davis each were named to the second team.
- Kelly, a senior guard from Detroit, is the reigning MAC Player of the Year and has been named to the 2020-21 Nancy Lieberman Award Watch List. The award goes annually to the top point guard in college basketball.
- Kelly ranked second in the MAC and fifth nationally in scoring at 21.5 points per game in 2019-20, earning First Team All-MAC and All-MAC Defensive Team honors.
- Bussell, a senior from Grand Rapids, averaged 13.2 points and 7.0 rebounds per game last season, earning All-MAC Third Team honors. She was the Chippewas' top rebounder and ranked 10th in the league in that category.
- Davis, a sophomore from Midland, made a splash in her freshman campaign, ranking second on the team and 12th in the league in scoring at 14.3 points per game. She averaged 4.4 assists per game, which was fifth in the conference, and made 39.5 percent of her 3-point attempts, which was third. She was named to the All-MAC Second Team and the MAC All-Freshman Team.

CHIPPEWAS SIGN DYNAMIC DUO

- Central Michigan women's basketball coach Heather Oesterle announced on Thursday her 2021 signing class comprising two Chippewas-to-be.
- Both Tiana Timpe of Stockton, Ill., and Hanna Knoll of Angola, Ind. — are guards who hail from the Midwest. They will join a program that has won four-consecutive Mid-American Conference

- regular-season championships.
- Knoll, Oesterle said, will join sophomore-to-be Molly Davis at the point guard spot. Davis was named to both the MAC All-Freshman Team and All-MAC Second Team last season.
- Adding Hanna gives us the ability to have multiple ball handlers on the court together," Oesterle said. "Hanna has a very high basketball IQ and can score in a variety of ways. Her brother Konner also attends CMU so we are thrilled to have him as her biggest supporter in Mount Pleasant.
- Timpe is a sniper. She can flat out shoot the ball.
 She has a quick release and with her size she's going to be a tough matchup for people. She has deep 3-point range and people had better guard her when she enters the gym. Tiana also gives us another ball handler on the floor and someone with high basketball IQ. She's a coach's daughter so she knows the game.

FROST RETURNS HOME

- One of the very best in Central Michigan women's basketball history has returned to the fold.
- Reyna Frost, who in 2019 wrapped up a brilliant collegiate career with All-America honors and the Mid-American Conference Player of the Year Award, has joined coach Heather Oesterle's CMU staff as the director of player of development.
- The volunteer position is being underwritten by Oesterle, who in 2019-20, her first year at the helm, earned the MAC Coach of the Year Award in leading the Chippewas to their fourth-consecutive league regular-season championship.
- Frost will be with the Chippewas on a daily basis, including coaches meetings and team practices, and will be on the bench during games, both home and away. She will also handle duties that fall under the director of basketball operations job description.
- Frost, who earned a bachelor's degree in mathematics from CMU, is one of the most-decorated players in program history. She is the MAC's all-time leading rebounder and ranks 12th in NCAA history with 1,526 career rebounds, was an Academic All-America selection in 2019, and is the only player in program history to score 1,500 career points and 1,500 career rebounds. She is the fourth-leading scorer in CMU history.
- She helped lead the Chippewas to four-consecutive MAC West championships, three-straight overall MAC regular-season titles, and in 2017-18 a MAC Tournament crown and a berth in the Sweet Sixteen of the NCAA Tournament. She spent 2019-20 playing professionally in Italy.

HEATHER OESTERLE

Head Coach 2nd Season

Heather Oesterle's first season in charge of the Central Michigan women's basketball program was nothing short of extraordinary.

Oesterle, a longtime assistant in the program, was named the Chippewas' head coach in July, 2019, and proceeded to lead CMU in 2019-20 to a 23-7 finish, a fourth-consecutive Mid-American Conference regular-season championship, a fifth-straight MAC West title, the No. 1 seed in the MAC Tournament, an NCAA Tournament berth, and a slew of individual postseason awards.

Oesterle served under long-time head coach Sue Guevara for nine years, the final seven of which were as the Chippewas' associate head coach. Oesterle helped to build CMU into the MAC's premier program and a mid-major power.

The Chippewas' 2020 NCAA Tournament berth was their third consecutive and their fourth since 2013. In 2018, the Chippewas knocked off both LSU and Ohio State en route to the Sweet Sixteen and a program-record 30 victories.

Oesterle's '19-20 squad finished 10th in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll and carried an RPI of 22, far and away the best among MAC teams and fourth best among all mid-majors.

The Chippewas put together a remarkable streak during which they won 22 of 23 games, including a 15-0 start in MAC play. They clinched the regular-season crown with three games remaining, and finished 16-2 in league play, extending their five-year mark in MAC regular-season games to an incredible 77-13.

Oesterle was named the MAC Coach of the Year and her players were amply rewarded on the individual front as well.

Junior guard Micaela Kelly earned the MAC Player of the Year Award, was named to the All-MAC First Team and the league's all-defensive team; senior forward Gabrielle Bird picked up the Sixth Player of the Year Award; guard Molly Davis was named to the all-conference second team and its all-freshman squad; and junior forward Kyra Bussell earned a spot on the all-league third team.

Oesterle and Kelly made it a three-peat with regard to their respective MAC individual awards. Guevara was named the MAC Coach of the Year in each of the previous two seasons, and Kelly followed Tinara Moore (2018) and Reyna Frost (2019) as the MAC Player of the Year. Both capped their brilliant careers at CMU by earning All-America honors, the first from the Chippewa women's program to be so honored.

Moore and Frost are among the recent Oesterle-coached former Chippewas to have made a professional career in the game, joining Presley Hudson, Cassie Breen and Crystal Bradford.

Bradford became the first CMU player and just the second in MAC history to be selected in the WNBA draft when she was taken by the Los Angeles Sparks with the seventh overall pick in the 2015 draft.

Frost graduated from CMU as the MAC's career rebounding leader, while Hudson is the top scorer and assist-maker in program history.

Oesterle is the 11th coach in program history; her first Chippewa squad did not miss a beat in the excitement and/or statistical departments.

The Chippewas averaged 76.4 points per game to lead the MAC and rank 20th nationally all while playing a rugged scheduled that included the likes of Louisville, which finished sixth in the final AP poll, and traditionally strong mid-majors such as South Dakota State, Marist, Bethune-Cookman, Green Bay, Western Kentucky and Dayton.

The Oesterle-led Chippewas finished a combined 4-3 against those seven teams, five of which finished the 2019-20 season an RPI of 71 or better. Six of those seven teams won 20 games — the other won 19 — in '19-20 and they posted a combined 166-52 won-loss record (a .761 win percentage).

In Oesterle's 10 seasons with the program, the Chippewas have posted eight 20-win seasons and one 30-win season. CMU has made eight postseason appearances and is a combined 217-109 (131-43 in MAC regular-season games) during



Oesterle's decade with the program. Over that span, the Chippewas hold a .752 win percentage in league play and have claimed a dozen pieces of conference-championship hardware — six divisional titles, four overall MAC crowns, and two MAC Tournament titles.

During Oesterle's tenure, the Chippewas have experienced a remarkable number of individual achievements, including:

- Back-to-back-to-back MAC Player of the Year Awards (Moore, '18; Frost, '19; Kelly, '20).
- Two MAC Freshman of the Year Awards (Niki DiGuilio, 2011; Hudson, 2016).
- Two MAC Tournament Most Valuable Player Award winners (Bradford, 2013; Frost, 2018).
- Five MAC Sixth Player of the Year Award winners (Taylor Johnson, 2011, 2014; Jalisa Olive, 2012; Jewel Cotton, 2016; Bird, 2020).
- Three MAC Defensive Player of the Year Award winners (Bradford, 2014; Moore, 2017, 2018).
- In Oesterle's 10 years with the program, five Chippewas have been named to the All-MAC First Team a combined nine times; six have earned All-MAC Second Team honors a combined six times; seven times has a Chippewa been selected to the All-MAC Third Team; Chippewa players have garnered All-MAC Honorable Mention seven times; nine times a Chippewa has made the MAC All-Freshman Team; and 11 times has a CMU player been named to the MAC All-Tournament team.

Before joining the Chippewas for the 2010-11 season, Oesterle served as an assistant at Northern Illinois from 2008-10, and at Miami (Ohio) from 2003-08.



She was a volunteer assistant coach at Stanford in 2002-03, helping the Cardinal to a 27-5 finish, Pac 10 regular-season and tournament titles, and an NCAA Tournament berth.

Oesterle played at Michigan during Guevara's tenure as the Wolverines' coach. She served as the Wolverines' team captain in 2001-02 and was honored with the program's Leadership Award following her senior season. She helped the Wolverines to a four-year record of 76-45 (.628) that included two NCAA Tournament and two WNIT appearances.

Oesterle, a native of Mason, earned her bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Michigan in 2002 and her master's in sports studies from Miami in 2008. She was a Detroit Free Press Class A All-State selection as a senior at Mason High School, where she was the program's career scoring leader with 1,451 points.

LANDING A LEGEND

One of the biggest names in women's college basketball has joined the Central Michigan coaching staff.

Gail Goestenkors, a member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association Hall of Fame, will be the Chippewas' associate head coach, working alongside second-year coach Heather Oesterle in a program that has become the class of the Mid-American Conference and a mid-major power.

'I am very excited and thankful to Heather and to Central Michigan for the opportunity to get back in the college game," Goestenkors said. "I'm excited to become a part of the CMU family.

'I have had so many incredible experiences with basketball, coaching college and in the WNBA and the Olympics and then working for ESPN and then consulting. But nothing compares to coaching women's college basketball. There's an incredible energy about it. I'm just so excited to get back in."

Goestenkors' resumé is among the most impressive in the game. She coached Texas from 2007-12 and Duke from 1992-2007 before working as a consultant and then assistant coach with the WNBA's Los Angeles Sparks and Indiana Fever.

She served as an analyst for ESPN women's basketball broadcasts from 2014-18 and has been the co-owner since 2018 of Coaching Full Circle, working with members of the MAC, Big Ten, Southeastern and Atlantic Coast conferences. She was an assistant coach for the U.S. Olympic team at the 2004 Games in Athens and at the 2008 Games in Beijing, helping the Americans to gold medals in both instances.



boestenkors is a two-time Associated Press National Coach of the Year Award winner and seven times was named the ACC Coach of the Year at Duke. She took the Blue Devils to the Final Four four times, to the national title game twice, to eight ACC regular-season championships, and won five-consecutive ACC Tournament titles.

he led Duke and Texas to a combined 496-163 record. In 2006, Goestenkors was named by USA Basketball as its Coach of the Year.

'I haven't stopped smiling in two weeks since I talked to Gail for the first time," said Oesterle, who led the Chippewas to their fourth-consecutive MAC regular-season title in 2019-20, her first season at the helm of the program. "It's big for our program, it's big for our university — you're talking about someone with a lot of credibility in the women's basketball world coming to Mount Pleasant, Michigan, and I can't tell you how excited I am to work with her every day, to learn from her.

'I think it says a lot about where our program is, and I think it also says a lot about the people that we have here -- the players. We have really good people here from the staff on bown and we're really excited about this opportunity to work with Gail."

Goestenkors, who hails from Waterford, played at Saginaw Valley State from 1981-85. During her first three years at SVSU, former Chippewa coach Sue Guevara was an assistant coach. The two remained friends as they made their respective climbs through the coaching ranks.

Guevara, with Oesterle by her side, built the CMU program into the power that it has become. Goestenkors and Oesterle met two years ago when Goestenkors' Coaching Full Circle company performed consulting work for Guevara and the Chippewas.

"We watched most of their practices, all of their games, we came on campus and met with the staff and we were so impressed with the way that they run their program,"
Goestenkors said. "It's first class and it's so much fun to watch. They think outside the box and their offense is so high powered with the 3-point shooting and the creativity that they
use. Really, with everything that they do, I was always very impressed with them.

'Last year we continued to watch Heather and I couldn't have been more impressed with a first-year head coach. Sue did such a good job mentoring Heather. (Oesterle) took the eins, she's wise beyond her years, and she's a student of the game; she's always asking questions and she's curious and she wants to continue to grow.

'For me, it's a really good fit where I can help Heather in every way and any way possible, also get back in the game and do what I'm most passionate about, and that's helping young women — players -- explore their talent, find their voice, stand in their power, become the very best version of themselves both on the court and off the court."

After earning a bachelor's degree with a major in physical education from SVSU, Goestenkors served as a graduate assistant at lowa State and then as an assistant coach at Purdue from 1986-02.

Goestenkors' players have accumulated an impressive array of individual awards. Included in that total are eight National Player of the Year Awards, five Kodak All-Americans, seven AP All-Americans, seven National Freshman of the Year Award winners, and five ACC Player of the Year Award winners.

n addition, her players earned a combined 53 all-conference honors in the ACC and in the Big 12 and a combined 75 academic all-conference accolades in the two leagues. Eleven of Goestenkors' former players went on to play in the WNBA.

Ann Arbor, Mich. • Crisler Center • Nov. 25, 2020 Central Michigan 73, Michigan 93

- The Central Michigan women's basketball team opened the 2020-21 season on Wednesday with a 93-75 nonconference loss to 25th-ranked Michigan at the Wolverines' Crisler Center.
- The Chippewas trailed through most of the game but remained within striking distance. Michigan used a 14-3 run over the final 2:50 of the third quarter to put CMU in a 75-59 deficit entering the fourth.
- The backcourt duo of Micaela Kelly and Molly Davis led the Chippewas, scoring 30 and 24 points, respectively, on a combined 22-of-42 (52 percent) shooting performance.
- The Wolverines finished with a decided 41-23 rebounding advantage.
- Naz Hillmon, a 6-foot-2 junior, scored 26 points and grabbed 11 rebounds to lead Michigan. Leigha Brown, a 6-1 junior, added 22 points. Hillmon and Brown finished a combined 20-for-26 from the floor.
- Redshirt junior Annika Weekes made her first career start for the Chippewas. She scored eight points and grabbed a team-high six rebounds in 35 minutes.
- Weekes, who took a medical redshirt last season and did not appear in a game, started in place of senior guard Maddy Watters, who was unavailable.
- All four freshmen on the Chippewa roster Maryama Turkstra, Rachel Loobie, Carlee Crabtree and Sydney Graber – played in the game.
- Oesterle said she saw many areas in which the Chippewas need to improve, which is no different than any team, win or lose, playing its first game of the season.

GAME 2

Mount Pleasant, Mich. • McGuirk Arena • Dec.9, 2020 Central Michigan 81, Western Michigan 71

- Molly Davis scored 20 points on Wednesday as the Central Michigan women's basketball team began its quest for a fifth-consecutive Mid-American Conference championship with an 82-71 win over rival Western Michigan at McGuirk Arena.
- It was the league opener and the first win of the season for CMU (1-1), which opened with a 93-75 nonconference loss two weeks ago at No. 25 Michigan.
- The Chippewas, who hit 13 3-pointers in the game, got triples from Kyra Bussell and Davis in the final 1:13 of the first quarter in building a 25-16 lead.
- Another 3-pointer, this one from Kalle Martinez, extended the lead to 12, 28-16, early in the second and a Rachel Loobie jumper shortly thereafter made it a 14-point margin, 30-16.
- Western Michigan (1-1, 0-1) never got closer than seven points the rest of the way. The Chippewa lead was double digits for the majority of the second half and CMU's largest lead, 22 points, came midway through the fourth quarter.
- Micaela Kelly and Bussell added 15 points apiece and Maddy Watters had 12 for the Chippewas. Watters led CMU with four 3-pointers, while Kelly and Bussell had three each.
- Kelly, the reigning MAC Player of the Year, led the Chippewas with eight rebounds and five steals. Davis finished with a game-high six assists.
- The Chippewas made 38.9 percent of their 3-point attempts and finished with 23 assists on 32 total field goals, an outstanding ratio. They committed just 10 turnovers while forcing the Broncos into 17.
- Because of COVID-19, the game was played without fans at McGuirk Arena. It's something that all college teams, in most every sport, will have to get accustomed to at least for the foreseeable future.
- CMU has won seven consecutive game against the Broncos and 12 of its last 13.

Mount Pleasant, Mich. • McGuirk Arena • Dec.12, 2020 Central Michigan 79, Cincinnati 62

- Micaela Kelly hit two 3-pointers during a game-closing 11-0 run on Saturday as the Central Michigan women's basketball team downed Cincinnati, 79-62, in a nonconference game at McGuirk Arena.
- It was the second-straight win for the Chippewas (2-1), who put on display their vast array of offensive weapons against a Bearcat team (1-3) that features All-American limar'l Thomas.
- The Chippewas led for most of the game but could never stretch its lead to a comfortable margin. They led 68-62 when Krya Bussell hit a 3-pointer with just under 4 minutes remaining and then Kelly followed with back-to-back triples to make it 77-62.
- Maddy Watters closed it out with two free throws with 45 seconds to play
- Molly Davis scored 25 points, Bussell finished with a double-double (19 points, 10 rebounds), Watters had 16, and Kelly finished with 13.
- Kelly missed her first eight field goal attempts, and she did not make a field goal until under three minutes remained. Still, she made seven of her eight free throw tries, grabbed seven rebounds, dished out seven assists, and made two steals while committing just two
- · Davis and Watters both finished 4-of-6 from 3-point range and it was Bussell's fifth career double-double. Davis, Watters and Bussell combined to make 20 of their 25 field goal attempts
- Cincinnati's Thomas, an Honorable Mention All-American last season, entered the game averaging 29.7 points per game. Though just 5-foot-10, the senior displayed her craftiness around the basket, making 11 of her 16 field goal attempts. Nearly all of her shots were taken from within a few feet of the basket.
- Watters, a senior guard, missed the Chippewas' season-opening loss at Michigan, but has made a major impact in the two games that she has played. She was also 4-for-6 from 3-point range in the win over Western and is averaging 14.0 points per game.

GAME 4

Mount Pleasant, Mich. • McGuirk Arena • Dec.15, 202 Central Michigan 69, Miami 51

- Kelly scored 29 points and she and her Central Michigan women's basketball teammates played lockdown defense on Tuesday in taking a 69-51 Mid-American Conference victory over Miami (Ohio) at McGuirk Arena.
- It was the third-straight win for CMU, which improved to 3-1, 2-0 MAC. The Chippewas held Miami to more than 15 points below its season average. They limited the RedHawks (1-3,
- 0-1) to three 3-pointers on 19 attempts and 30.5 percent shooting from the floor overall. The Chippewas never trailed and closed the first half on a 9-2 run for a 37-25 halftime lead.
- Kelly started the surge with a pair of free throws with 3:22 to play in the second quarter, extending CMU's lead to 30-23. The Chippewas then got a jumper from Molly Davis, a layup from Jahari Smith, and a 3-pointer from Kelly for the 12-point margin at the break.
- Miami trimmed its deficit to single digits just once in the second half, and that was nine points, 43-34, early in the third quarter. CMU led by as many 23 points in the fourth.
- Kelly hit a season-high four triples and finished 11-for-23 from the floor. She had 20 points at halftime.
- Kyra Bussell, a senior, had 12 points and 10 rebounds in posting her second-consecutive double-double and the sixth of her career. Davis finished with 10 points.
- Kelly scored 13 points in the Chippewas' 79-62 victory over Cincinnati on Saturday. The 13 points was her lowest total since she had 10 against Ohio on Feb. 1, 2020, a stretch of 20 games.
- Kelly's defensive task against the RedHawks wasn't as burdensome as it was when the Chippewas defeated Cincinnati. In that case, she was assigned to guard Ilmar'l Thomas, an All-American who entered the game averaging nearly 30 points per game.
