LAST TIME OUT – at Oakland (Dec. 9)

Central Michigan continued its progress last Saturday (Dec. 9) in a heartbreaking 79-76 loss to the Golden Grizzlies. The Chippewas led by as many as 20 points midway through the third quarter until attrition set in on the eight-player roster for CMU.

Rochelle Norris and **Tiana Timpe** tied for the team-high of 17 points in the contest as two of five double-digit scorers (Gordon, 15; T. Anderson, 11; Jean, 11).



Norris, **Taylor Anderson** and **Nadege Jean** each posted a double-double, the first time three Chippewas combined for double-double efforts in over seven years.

"(Today) can be used as a teaching point," Head Coach **Kristin Haynie** said. "for us (coaches and the team). We're definitely playing better. Being up 20, we need to be able to close games out. But we saw growth in this team today, and we will continue to fight and get better. But with a short bench, our girls played their guts out and we did a really good job of staying together and trying to fight until the end."

TRIPLE DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Rochelle Norris (17p, 12r), **Nadege Jean** (11p, 12r) and **Taylor Anderson** (11p, 10r) each logged a double-double last weekend at Oakland (Dec. 9), the first time CMU has accomplished the feat since Nov. 26, 2016 in a 77-55 victory over North Dakota State. **Tinara Moore** (20p-11r), **Reyna Frost** (18p-15r) and **Presley Hudson** (11p-12r) were the trio in that contest.

The Chippewas came close to the mark three times between the last two occurrences, twice by one rebound (Jan. 29, 2020; Feb. 21, 2018) and once by one assist (Feb. 8, 2017). Between the 2017-18 and 2018-19 seasons, Frost alone accounted for 47 double-doubles.

Earlier this season, **Madisen Wardell** (22p, 10r) and **Taylor Anderson** (12p, 10r) posted double-doubles in the Chippewas' 80-57 victory over Concordia (MI) on Nov. 14, the first time two CMU players logged a double-double in the same game since Jan. 26, 2022 at Miami (OH).

ROCHELLE THE REJECTER

Rochelle Norris is second in the Mid-American Conference in blocks, both per game (1.57) and total (11), with her game-by-game average sitting inside the top 70 in NCAA I this season. Norris's dominance down low has come despite averaging just 20.3 minutes per game this season.

CLEANIN' THE GLASS

CMU is the unanimous MAC leader in rebounding this season with a +2 margin, 27.3 def. rpg, 14.7 off. rpg and 42.0 total rpg, ranking just outside the top-50 in NCAA I this season in the latter two categories. **Rochelle Norris** (8.4 rpg) and **Taylor Anderson** (8.3 rpg) sit third and fourth in the MAC individually in total rebounds.

FIFTH YEAR'S THE CHARM

Nadège Jean has set a new career mark in scoring twice this season, first with 15 points against Concordia (Nov. 14), then against Indiana State (Dec. 2).

Jean continues to break through with her first career double-double in last weekend's visit to Oakland (Dec. 9) where she logged a career-high 12 rebounds to go with 11 points. She has done the vast majority of her damage off the bench (one start through seven games), averaging nine points and 5.9 rebounds per game on a 55.8 percent clip from the field in 23.3 minutes per appearance.



NEW TEAM, NEW OUTLOOK

A transfer from DePaul for this season, **Madisen Wardell** is CMU's leading scorer (11.1 ppg) and is one of four Chippewas averaging over five rebounds per game. The sophomore has started six of seven contests, averaging the team's third-highest mark of 26.9 minutes per game.

THE CHIPPEWA-SPARTAN CONNECTION

CMU head coach **Kristin Haynie** and assistant **Jenna Allen** are both graduates of MSU, '05 and '19, respectively. Fellow CMU staffers **Jared Roane** and **Jackson Marlan** were on the Spartan staff last season alongside **Haynie**, under former Chippewa standout, **Suzy Merchant**.



THE SERIES – ONE OF CMU'S OLDEST MATCHUPS

Sunday marks the 45th game in the series between CMU and MSU since March 9, 1970, a series led 31-13 by the Spartans overall, 15-5 when played in East Lansing.

At the dawn of the series, CMU won five straight contests from 1970-72. Sunday's meeting gives MSU a chance at setting a new streak record of nine consecutive wins in the series since 1996, though each of the last two meetings have been by single-digit margins, including the first round of the 2019 NCAA tournament, which ended 88-87 MSU in South Bend, Ind.

Central Michigan's last win in the series came on Nov. 29, 1993 (W, 60-59) in Mount Pleasant, last time in East Lansing was Dec. 7, 1985 (W, 86-76).


The series is tied 1-1 when the CMU-MSU contest is the eighth regular season game for the Chippewas. MSU is 2-0 when playing CMU on a Sunday (Dec. 14, 1997; Nov. 15, 1998) and 10-5 on weekends.

ANOTHER FAMILIAR NAME

Michigan State is also under a first-year staff this season, under Head Coach Robyn Fralick. She spent the previous five seasons at MAC foe Bowling Green. The Falcons posted a 4-3 record over the Chippewas by winning the last three in the series since CMU won the last MAC tournament matchup in 2021, 77-72. She went 88-73 at BGSU, with a 31-7 2022-23 season that tied both the school and MAC record for wins in a single season.

A GREAT FIRST IMPRESSION

Tamara Ortiz burst on the scene for the Chippewas against South Alabama (Nov. 9), scoring 20 points along with three steals. Ortiz is just the second CMU freshman to reach 20 points in a season-opener in the last 15 seasons.



Ortiz has been sidelined due to a knee injury suffered during the Milwaukee contest (Nov. 25). Her timeline for return is TBD.

THE RETURNING CHIPPEWAS

Central Michigan returned 42.4 percent of last season's minutes played, 39.7 percent of points, and 49.4 percent of rebounds. **Rochelle Norris** accounted for 56 percent of last season's blocked shots singlehandedly, the only Chippewa with double-digit blocks in 2022-23.

NORRIS: ANCHOR IN THE PAINT

Only two returners rendered double-digit starts in 2022-23, led by senior center **Rochelle Norris** with 17 starts in 26 appearances. Norris was last season's leading rebounder (7.0 per game) and shot blocker (1.73 per game) and is the leading scorer (8.7 per game last season) among the 2023-24 returning roster.

Norris has averaged 7.8 rebounds per game this season in just 18.7 minutes, and has 10 blocks through six games.

ANDERSON: ROOKIE NO MORE

Taylor Anderson is the Chippewas' leading returner in both steals (1.52 per game) and assists (1.83 per game), second to Norris in points (6.1 per game) and rebounds (5.6 per game).

CHIPPEWA NAME

The Central Michigan University Board of Trustees has approved the continued use of the nickname "Chippewas" in association with CMU. The university's goals are to use the name with honor and respect, increase supportive connections between CMU and Native Americans, and improve efforts to sensitize students, faculty, and staff to Native American traditions and cultures.

Media representatives have been extremely cooperative as we have worked to address this important issue. In nearly all cases, print and broadcast reporters have supported CMU's efforts to eliminate the use of symbols, headlines, and copy that present inappropriate and inaccurate images of Native Americans.

Central Michigan University is grateful for your help, and we ask for your continued cooperation and sensitivity. With your assistance, we can continue to use the Chippewa name with dignity and respect.

The do-it-all wing leads CMU with eight rebounds, 2.16 steals and 3.5 offensive rebounds per game this season, with three double-digit rebounding performances.

Anderson is the only remnant of a standout freshman class from the 2022-23 campaign as MAC Freshman of the Year Sydney Harris and Bridget Utberg each hit the transfer portal during the offseason, now at TCU and Marquette, respectively.

WELCOME ABOARD

Central Michigan brought in three new members ahead of 2023-24: freshmen **Tamara Ortiz** (Columbus, Ohio / Westerville South) and **Desrae Kyles** (Benton Harbor, Mich. / Benton Harbor), and transfer sophomore **Madisen Wardell** (Detroit, Mich. / Edison / DePaul).

Ortiz: named Ohio Division I second-team All-State (2023) ... named All-Ohio Capital Conference Capital Division Player of the Year (2023) ... two-time All-OCC first-team selection

Kyles: two-time Michigan Division II All-State honoree (2023: first team, 2022: honorable mention) ... four-sport athlete: basketball, volleyball, softball and track & field

Wardell: appeared in 12 games as a freshman at DePaul ... two-time state champion at Detroit Edison ... nominated for McDonalds All-American Game as a senior



A NEW ADDITION

While CMU awaits the return of **Tamara Ortiz** (knee) and **Desrae Kyles** (knee) from injury, and the two-semester transfer waiting period of **Capria Brown**, the Chippewas have added sophomore **Alina Anderson** to the roster after recently finishing her first season with the Central Michigan Volleyball team.

Anderson was a standout for Rockford High School in both sports but chose volleyball in signing with NCAA II Ferris State for her freshman season in 2022. She transferred to CMU prior to the 2023 volleyball season and suited up for her first collegiate basketball game at Oakland Dec. 9.



A NEW ERA BEGINS

Head Coach **Kristin Haynie** began her head coaching career Nov. 9 leading the Chippewas at South Alabama. The former Michigan State standout was named to the post in April 2023.

VICTORY NO. 1 FOR HAYNIE

Central Michigan marked the first career win of Head Coach **Kristin Haynie** in the home-opener against Concordia-Ann Arbor (Nov. 14), 80-57 on Nov. 14.

HAYNIE BACK IN MOUNT PLEASANT

Kristin Haynie was a member of CMU Hall of Famer Sue Guevara's staff from 2014-17. The Chippewas went 58-38 (36-18 MAC) in that time with two MAC West titles (2016, 2017), a MAC regular-season title (2017) and a trip to the MAC tournament final (2017).

WINNING AT ALL LEVELS

Kristin Haynie led Michigan State to the 2005 NCAA Championship contest, as the first woman to record a triple-double in the NCAA tournament. Haynie graduated eighth all-time at MSU in scoring (1,199 pts.) and was just the fourth player in Big Ten history to reach 1,000 points, 500 assists, 500 rebounds and 300 steals.

Drafted into the WNBA by the Sacramento Monarchs that same year, Haynie helped the franchise collect a WNBA title in her rookie season. She played in 160 games in the WNBA from 2005-09 between the Monarchs, Atlanta Dream and Detroit Shock and added international play in Italy, Lithuania, Russia and Greece during that time.





NEXT-LEVEL PERSPECTIVE

Assistant Coaches **Jenna Allen** and **Toccara Ross** have professional playing backgrounds to go along with their head coach. Ross played in 20 different countries, notably winning a Swiss League championship on the EuroCup Circuit; Allen played four years for Baxi Ferrol in Spain, earning Import Player of the Year honors and a regular season title.

STAFF ROUND-UP

Chelsie Butler, CMU's recruiting coordinator, came to Mount Pleasant from Youngstown State, who shared a Horizon League title in '22-'23. Butler played at Marquette 2011-15, graduating with a bachelor's in broadcasting.



Toccara Ross made her collegiate coaching debut at Boston University last season, aiding the Terriers to a Patriot League regular season title. She was a three-time NCAA tournament competitor at Iowa State (2007-09), graduating with a bachelor's in communication studies. Much of her life has been dedicated to philanthropy with Athlete Ally and Athletes Unlimited.

The 1983-84 Central Michigan squad was inducted into the Marcy Weston CMU Athletics Hall of Fame in the 2023 class on Sept. 29.

The benchmark season for the program, the Chippewas logged what is still the only undefeated MAC season in program history (27-3, 18-0 MAC) and its second berth into the NCAA tournament, the season prior marking the first.

CMU posted another feat since unmatched, winning



26 straight games after a 1-2 start, defeating Michigan, Purdue, Minnesota and Notre Dame in the process. *The loss that led to the streak?* **Dec. 3, 1983 at Michigan State, 76-72.** Sixteen of its 18 MAC contests were won by 10-plus points.



Haynie, who has won at every level of basketball, takes over a Central Michigan Women's Basketball program that has made seven NCAA Tournament appearances, won five Mid-American Conference Tournament titles, captured eight MAC regular season overall/division championships, and advanced to five WNIT appearances.

In her previous stint at Central Michigan as an assistant coach under Sue Guevara (2014-17), Haynie helped lead the Chippewas to the 2017 Mid-American Conference championship with guard Presley Hudson earning MAC Freshman of the Year honors. CMU also claimed the 2016 MAC West Championship. During her time in Mount Pleasant, the Chippewas totaled a 58-38 combined overall record and 36-18 league record.

Haynie completed the 2022-23 season as an assistant coach at her alma mater Michigan State University, where she spent the past four seasons under head coach and Central Michigan graduate Suzy Merchant.

The Spartan legend has cultivated strong coaching ties in the state of Michigan as she came back to East Lansing after working as a basketball skills trainer in western and central Michigan. She worked as a mentor to inspire and motivate athletes to reach their full potential and help them realize their impact off the court.

Haynie began her coaching career as an assistant at Eastern Michigan from 2012-14.

As a point guard, Haynie had a stellar collegiate career at Michigan State, ranking as the career leader in assists (574) and steals (346). She finished her career ranked eighth in MSU history in scoring (1,199 points) and is still 15th in career scoring.

At the time of her graduation, she was just the fourth player in Big Ten history to reach career totals of 1,000 points, 500 rebounds, 500 assists and 300 steals. She is also the Michigan State leader in single-season steals with 117.

The point guard is still one of just three Spartan women's basketball players to record a triple-double and became the first woman to complete a triple double (points, assists, and steals) in the NCAA Tournament.

In 2005, she guided the Spartans to a 33-win season, the Big Ten Championship, the program's first-ever Final Four appearance, and berth in the NCAA Championship Game.

Just weeks after the 2005 National Championship game, Haynie was selected with the ninth pick in the 2005 WNBA Draft by the Sacramento Monarchs. She helped the Monarchs capture the WNBA title in her first season as a pro. She played in 160 games during her WNBA career, spending five seasons in the WNBA from 2005-09 with the Monarchs, Atlanta Dream, and Detroit Shock. During her stint in the WNBA, Haynie played professionally in Italy, Lithuania, Russia, and Greece.

Haynie was inducted into the Michigan State University Hall of Fame in 2017 and the Greater Lansing Sports Hall of Fame in 2016.

CHELSTIE BUTLER

ASSISTANT COACH

FIRST SEASON

Central Michigan Women's Basketball announced the addition of Chelsie Butler in September 2023. The 2015 graduate of Marquette joined the 2023-24 bench after a two-year stint at Youngstown State.

Butler handled the Penguins' recruiting efforts on head coach John Barnes' staff. She also held key roles with scouting, practice preparation, camps and individual workouts.

YSU earned the Horizon League's automatic bid into the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT) through a 24-win campaign and share of the conference title. Youngstown state opened the 2021-22 season with 15 wins through its first 16 games, marking three separate five-plus game winning streaks for just the second time in school history for a single season.

Butler spent the previous four seasons at Southeastern Louisiana. Prior to her time in Hammond, La., Butler was the graduate manager on the women's basketball staff at Akron, where she collected a master's degree in coaching.

During Butler's tenure with the Lady Lions, the team went from 12th place in the Southland Conference up to second. Butler oversaw Southeastern's post players, opponent scouting and out-of-bounds plays.

Butler spent four seasons playing at Marquette, capped her tenure with a bachelor's degree in broadcasting.

She was the All-Ohio Co-Player of the Year at Minerva High School in Ohio as a senior and was inducted into her alma mater's Hall of Fame in 2017.

FIRST SEASON


Toccara Ross was named to the Central Michigan Women's Basketball staff in June of 2023. Ross came to Mount Pleasant following a one-year stint at Boston University.

In her lone season with the Terriers, Boston recorded a 24-9 record, including a 17-1 mark en route to a Patriot League regular season championship and a Women's National Invitation Tournament bid. Two Terriers earned first-team All-Patriot League honors, including 2023 Defensive Player of the Year Caitlin Weimar.

A three-time NCAA Tournament participant at Iowa State (2007-09) with 15 years of professional basketball experience, Ross spent the 2022 campaign with Athletes Unlimited, and played alongside WNBA athletes and captains such as DiJonai Carrington, Isabelle Harrison, Tianna Hawkins, and Lexie Brown.

In addition to her strengths on the court, Ross has served as an advocate for the athlete experience and community development. Since 2009, she has served as an advocate and speaking for Athlete Ally, helping to provide public awareness campaigns and educational programming to foster inclusive sports communities while intersecting all aspects of human rights. While with Athletes Unlimited, she played for the NAACP Legal Defense Fund.

A native of Chicago, Ill. and recently living in Los Angeles, Calif., Ross earned her bachelor's degrees from Iowa State in Communication Studies, Speech Communication, and Women & Gender Studies. In 2020, she received her Master of Sciences in Cultural Foundations of Education from the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee.



JENNA ALLEN

ASSISTANT COACH

FIRST SEASON

Jenna Allen joined the Central Michigan Women's Basketball Coaching Staff in May 2023. Allen will work closely with the Chippewas' post players while being tasked as the team's liaison to strength & conditioning and athletic training.

Allen joins the CMU women's staff after a four-year professional career for Baxi Ferrol in Spain. Throughout her career overseas she averaged double-digit points and five-plus rebounds per game while shooting well over 50 percent from the field. Her well-decorated 2022-23 campaign saw a career-high 12.6 points per contest on 51.5 percent shooting, culminating in being named the All-Spanish LF Challenge Player, Center and Import Player of the Year on top of the 2023 regular season championship.

Allen, a four-year contributor on the court at Michigan State, became the Spartans' 23rd 1,000-point scorer on March 3, 2019 at Minnesota. Over her final two seasons in East Lansing she started 57 games over 65 appearances including all 33 contests of her senior campaign. For her career, the Bedford, Ind.-native averaged 8.6 points on 50.4 percent shooting from the floor, 4.5 rebounds and 20.3 minutes per game; as a senior her line was 12.5 ppg on 49.8 percent shooting and 6.5 rpg over an average of 27.3 mpg.

The North Lawrence High School graduate, Allen earned a Bachelor's in Kinesiology from Michigan State in 2019.



JARED ROANE

**DIRECTOR OF SCOUTING
& VIDEO OPERATIONS**

FIRST SEASON

Jared Roane was added to the Central Michigan Women's Basketball Coaching Staff in May 2023. Roane will play a role in on-court tasks along with recording and maintaining practice and game film.

Prior to CMU, Roane spent four seasons at Michigan State University as the Spartan Women's Video Coordinator and Assistant to longtime Head Coach Suzy Merchant. For three seasons he served in the role alongside Coach Haynie who was an assistant coach at MSU.

From 2016-2018, Roane was the Coordinator of Operations and Video for Illinois State University, and before that was a graduate manager and video coordinator for the University of Akron—his alma mater—from 2014-16. His duties with the program included coordinating all of the squad's video needs, specializing in synergy, dv sports and fast model, as well as film breakdown and editing, recording practices and games, team playbook and film exchange.

Before returning to Akron, Roane was the video coordinator for Impact Basketball Academy in Sarasota, Florida, during the 2012-13 season, before being promoted the next year to a full-time staff member, serving as the Academy's Director of Operations/Video Coordinator.

Roane was formerly a practice player for the Akron women's basketball team from 2009-11. He earned his bachelor's degree in sports management from Akron in 2011 and was awarded his master's degree in sports administration from Akron during his graduate assistantship in May 2016.



JACKSON MARLAN

**DIRECTOR OF
BASKETBALL OPS**

FIRST SEASON

Jackson Marlan came to Central Michigan Women's Basketball in May 2023 to take on the program's Director of Basketball Operations role for the first staff under Head Coach Kristin Haynie. In his position on the Chippewas' staff, Marlan will manage and oversee the administrative and logistical aspects of the basketball program including travel, equipment, apparel and communication.

Marlan transferred from Michigan State University following the spring of 2023 to be a part of Coach Haynie's inaugural staff in Mount Pleasant after spending time with the Spartans' women's program during Haynie's tenure as an assistant coach.



MCGUIRK ARENA JOHN G. KULHAVI EVENTS CENTER

Part of the \$22.5 million John G. Kulhavi Events Center (3, 6, 7), McGuirk Arena (1) is home to Kulhavi Court. The maple hardwood surface was brand new when installed during the 2010 renovation.

The facility features a pair of club rooms, the largest of which is a 1,600-square-foot space (4) with room for 130 Chippewa fans and plush leather-chair seating for 88. It also features a 360-square-foot outdoor patio and is available for receptions, meetings and banquets.

The renovation upgraded several of the basic amenities for patrons of McGuirk Arena. In addition to 1,400 square feet of dedicated concession space, the number of restrooms in the facility was quadrupled. The chair-back seating ratio climbed from 14 percent to 41 percent, and a climate control system was installed in the facility.

Other functionality upgrades included a satellite training room, improved arena lighting, a dedicated media room (5) and a video scoreboard on the west wall.

Nods to tradition and the history of Mount Pleasant also are present throughout the building. Two facility-length murals line the north and south concourse, paying homage to figures throughout CMU history as well as other facilities and programs on campus.

An auxiliary gymnasium (2), located just feet from the locker room and main competition arena, is named after legendary CMU head coach Dick Parfitt.



TOBACCO:


