Head Coach: Jim McElwain, 5th year at CMU (24-21), 11th year overall (68-48), 38th year in coaching. In his fifth year at CMU in 2023, McElwain has guided the Chippewas to two bowl games (2019 New Mexico Bowl and 2021 Sun Bowl) in his three full seasons with the Chippewas. In his career, he has guided six teams to bowl games.

Player Representatives: junior defensive back Trey Jones and senior offensive lineman Deiyantei Powell-Woods.

TOP STORYLINES

- Central Michigan returns 14 players who started a significant amount of games in 2022, including five on offense and nine on defense.
- Head Coach Jim McElwain has guided CMU to two bowl games (2019 New Mexico Bowl and 2021 Sun Bowl) in each of the past three full seasons. He enters his fifth season as head coach at Central Michigan.
- DB Trey Jones and OL Deiyantei Powell-Woods are representing the Chippewas today in Detroit.
- CMU is coming off a 4-8 season that saw the team suffer through major injuries at several positions.

PRESEASON NOTES

THE EVENT

Head Coach Jim McElwain, junior defensive back Trey Jones, and senior offensive lineman Deiyantei Powell-Woods will travel to Detroit on Wednesday to represent Central Michigan at the 2023 Mid-American Conference Football Kickoff event. The event will take place at Detroit's historic Fox Theater on Thursday, July 20 beginning at 9 a.m. to approximately 1:30 p.m.

Fans will be able to follow along on an hour-by-hour basis by accessing CMU Football's blog. McElwain, Jones, and Powell-Woods will tape and produce several segments including a MAC Social Media Corner, appear on the Call to MACtion podcast, tape several videos for the MAC, and conduct one-on-one-interviews with the assembled media.

WHERE TO LISTEN/WATCH

Thursday's festivities will be broadcast on a tape-delayed basis on ESPN+ beginning at 11:30 a.m. The show will be hosted by broadcasters Michael Reghi and Ryan Cavanaugh and will feature segments on each of the 12 MAC programs. CMU's segment will



feature McElwain and Trey Jones. MAC Commissioner Dr. Jon Steinbrecher's press conference will be live streamed at 11 a.m. on ESPN+.

MCELWAIN DELIVERS ON PROMISE

Under Head Coach Jim McElwain and with three full seasons in charge of the program (CMU played just six games in 2020 due to COVID), the Chippewas have won or shared the MAC West Division championship two times and advanced to two bowl games (2019 and 2021). In addition, the Chippewas are 24-21 including an 18-12 record in MAC games. The 18 league wins tie for the most victories and the 24 overall wins tie for the second-most victories in the MAC when combining the last four seasons. During that four-year span, the Chippewas are the only MAC school to win eight or more overall wins and six or more league wins two times (2019-22).

McElwain guided the 2021 Chippewas to a 9-4 finish including a 6-2 record in MAC games—earning CMU the MAC West co-championship—and a 24-21 victory over Pac-12 representative Washington State in the Tony the Tiger Sun Bowl.

It marked the Chippewas' first bowl win since 2012 and their first victory over a Power 5 opponent since 2017.

CMU's 2021 ledger included wins

over in-state rivals Western Michigan and Eastern Michigan, bringing the Michigan MAC Trophy back to Mount Pleasant for the first time since 2017. McElwain and Co. put that trophy on display alongside the Victory Cannon, which CMU reclaimed with a 42-30 win over Western.

PRESEASON NUMBERS

- Central Michigan returns five starters on offense. Those starters include offensive linemen David Heinzen (12 career starts), Deiyanteri Powell-Woods (28 career starts), and Brayden Swartout (13 career starts). Quarterbacks Jase Bauer and Bert Emanuel Jr. both started games in 2022, along with tight end Marcus Young (five starts) and wide receiver Jalen McGaughy (six starts). Running backs Marion Lukes and Myles Bailey both saw extensive action last year.
- Numerically speaking on offense, Central Michigan returns players who accounted for 66 percent of rushing yards (1,253 of 1,910), 73 percent of rushing touchdowns (16 of 22), 52 percent of rushing attempts (231 of 444), 20 percent of passing yards (489 of 2,497), 18 percent of completions (39 of 219), 6 percent of passing touchdowns (1 of 16), 44 percent of receiving yards (1,111 of 2,497), 42 percent of receptions (91 of 219), 44

percent of touchdowns receiving (7 of 16), 60 percent of total touchdowns scored (24 of 40), 52 percent of total points scored (155 of 297), 42 percent of total offensive yards (1,852 of 4,407), and 60 percent of offensive line starts (36 of 60).

- The Chippewas return an experienced defense featuring nine returning starters. Those players include defensive linemen Robi Stuart (35 career starts), Jacques Bristol (31 career starts) and Michael Heldman (11 starts), both linebackers in Kyle Moretti (11 starts) and Justin Whiteside (14 starts), along with defensive backs Trey Jones (12 starts), Donte Kent (25 starts), Jayden Davis (eight starts), and De'Javion Stepney (10 starts).
- Numerically speaking on defense, Central Michigan returns players who accounted for 86 percent (712 of 831) of its tackles, 64 percent (66.5 of 104) of its tackles for losses, 54.5 percent (20 of 36.5) of its sacks, 100 percent of its interceptions (4 of 4), 80 percent of its pass breakups (44 of 54), 68 percent (17 of 25) of its quarterback hurries, 83 percent of its forced fumbles (5 of 6) and 83 percent of its fumble recoveries (5 of 6).
- On special teams, Central Michigan returns players who accounted for 17

percent of field goals made (1 of 6), 0 percent of punts (0 of 55), 86 percent of punt return yards (18 of 21), 97 percent of kickoff return yards (32 of 33), and 61 percent of all-purpose yards (3,222 of 5,240).

- Earning Second Team All-MAC honors were senior defensive lineman Robi Stuart, junior linebacker Kyle Moretti and redshirt sophomore return specialist Jordyn Williams. Earning Third Team All-MAC honors were junior running back Marion Lukes, senior defensive lineman Jacques Bristol, and junior defensive back Trey Jones. Junior linebacker Justin Whiteside was also recognized as a Fourth Team All-MAC recipient.

- Led by First Team honorees in senior offensive lineman Deiyantei Powell-Woods and junior cornerback Donte Kent, nine Central Michigan football players were named to the Phil Steele Magazine Preseason All-Mid-American Conference team, the media outlet announced on Monday. A complete list of Phil Steele's preseason All-MAC team is posted in the magazine.
- Earning Third Team All-MAC honors were senior defensive lineman Robi Stuart, senior defensive lineman Jacques Bristol, junior linebacker Kyle Moretti, junior defensive back Trey Jones, and redshirt sophomore return specialist Jordyn Williams. Earning Fourth Team All-MAC honors were junior running back Marion Lukes and junior linebacker Justin Whiteside.

LINDY'S MAGAZINE PRESEASON ALL-MAC

- Three Central Michigan football players—senior Robi Stuart (First Team), senior offensive lineman Deiyantei Powell-Woods (Second Team), and defensive back Donte Kent (Second Team)—were named to Lindy's Magazine Preseason All-Mid-American Conference team, the publication announced. A complete list of Lindy's preseason All-MAC team is posted in the magazine.
- All three players are consensus preseason All-MAC honorees as all three have been named to every publication's team.

ROBI STUART NAMED AN AFCA GOOD WORKS TEAM NOMINEE

- Central Michigan senior defensive lineman Robi Stuart has been nominated for the 2023 Allstate American Football Coaches Association Good Works Team. He is among 136 college football players at the FBS, FCS, NCAA Division II, NCAA Division III, and NAIA levels nominated for the prestigious community service award.
- A two-time All-MAC selection and four-time Academic All-MAC selection, Stuart recently earned the Mid-American Conference's Medal of Excellence Award in May, which is the league's most distinguished academic/athletic award. Last year, he was named a semifinalist for the 2022 William V. Campbell Trophy, awarded annually by the National Football Foundation to the nation's top scholar-athlete in college football. He is a three-time Academic All-MAC honoree who holds a bachelor of science degree with a major in neuroscience and minor in psychology. He has a 4.0 grade point average.
- He has been named a consensus preseason All-MAC team player by every college football media entity.
- Stuart is currently pursuing a Master of Science degree in neuroscience and will play one more season of football for the Chippewas in 2023. His career goal is to be in on the research field for head trauma for football players.

CHIPPEWA NAME

The Central Michigan University Board of Trustees has approved the continued use of the nickname "Chippewas" in association with CMU. The university's goals are to use the name with honor and respect, increase supportive connections between CMU and Native Americans, and improve efforts to sensitize students, faculty, and staff to Native American traditions and cultures.

Media representatives have been extremely cooperative as we have worked to address this important issue. In nearly all cases, print and broadcast reporters have supported CMU's efforts to eliminate the use of symbols, headlines, and copy that present inappropriate and inaccurate images of Native Americans.

Central Michigan University is grateful for your help, and we ask for your continued cooperation and sensitivity. With your assistance, we can continue to use the Chippewa name with dignity and respect.

HEAD COACH JIM MCELWAIN

FIFTH SEASON 24-21 at CMU, 68-48 CAREER

In his four seasons in charge of the Central Michigan Football program, Jim McElwain has delivered on his promise of building the Chippewas into a contender in the Mid-American Conference.

In three full seasons in charge of the program (CMU played just six games in 2020 due to COVID), the Chippewas have won or shared the MAC West Division championship two times and advanced to two bowl games (2019 and 2021). In addition, the Chippewas are 24-21 including an 18-12 record in MAC games under McElwain. The 18 league wins tie for the most victories and the 24 overall wins tie for the second-most victories in the MAC when combining the last four seasons. During that four-year span, the Chippewas are the only MAC school to win eight or more overall wins and six or more league wins two times (2019-22).

McElwain guided the 2021 Chippewas to a 9-4 finish including a 6-2 record in MAC games—earning CMU the MAC West co-championship—and a 24-21 victory over Pac-12 representative Washington State in the Tony the Tiger Sun Bowl.

It marked the Chippewas' first bowl win since 2012 and their first victory over a Power 5 opponent since 2017.

CMU's 2021 ledger included wins over in-state rivals Western Michigan and Eastern Michigan, bringing the Michigan MAC Trophy back to Mount Pleasant for the first time since 2017. McElwain and

Head Coach Jim McElwain was named the 2019 MAC Coach of the Year. It marked the third time in his career that McElwain has earned a league coach of the year award. He was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year while leading Colorado State in 2014 and he earned the Southeastern Conference Coach of the Year Award at Florida in 2015. McElwain is just the fourth individual to earn COY honors in three Division I conferences.

Co. put that trophy on display alongside the Victory Cannon, which CMU reclaimed with a 42-30 win over Western.

Those two victories highlighted a season-ending five-game win streak and, in keeping with McElwain's well-established blueprint for success, the Chippewas flexed their offensive prowess in averaging 37.6 points per game during that stretch and finished the season averaging 33.2 points per game, which ranked second in the MAC.

CMU's potent offense was spearheaded by running back Lew Nichols III, the nation's leading rusher, and receivers Kalil Pimpleton and JaCorey Sullivan. Nichols ran for 1,848 yards and scored 18 touchdowns, while Pimpleton and Sullivan combined for 111 catches, 1,647 yards, and 14 TDs through the air. The electrifying Pimpleton led the nation in punt-return average (19.1 yards) and punts returned for touchdowns (2).

McElwain's offense, which averaged 449.6 points per game, was led up front by a pair of outstanding bookend tackles in Bernhard Raimann (Third-Round NFL Draft pick by the Indianapolis Colts) and Luke Goedeke (Second-Round NFL Draft pick by the Tampa Bay Buccaneers).

The nine wins marked the most by a Chippewa squad since 2009 and the six MAC wins matched CMU's best since that season. Four times since 2009 the Chippewas have registered six conference victories; two of those six-win seasons have come during McElwain's four-year tenure.

There was no shortage of individual accolades for McElwain's charges in 2021 as Raimann earned a nod on the Sporting News All-America Second Team and was named an All-American and the Mid-American Conference Offensive Player of the Year by Pro Football Focus.

In addition, cornerback Donte Kent earned a berth on the Football Writers Association of America Freshman All-America Team, Nichols was named the MAC Offensive Player of the Year, and Pimpleton earned the MAC Special Teams Player of the Year Award. It marked the first time since 2009 that a Chippewa had garnered either award.

In all, 10 Chippewas earned All-MAC honors in 2021 and 13 were named All-MAC by Phil Steele.

In the abbreviated 2020 season, McElwain led CMU to a 3-3 finish both overall and in the MAC as 10 Chippewas earned all-conference honors, including defensive end Troy Hairston II, who earned the co-MAC Defensive Player of the Year Award; and Nichols, who was named the league Freshman of the Year.

Hairston became the first Chippewa since 2005 to earn the league's top individual award for a player on the defensive side of the ball, and Nichols was the first Chippewa since 2007 to be named the conference's top freshman.

In 2019, McElwain's first season in Mount Pleasant, he led the Chippewas to a remarkable turnaround as they won the MAC West and earned a berth in the New Mexico Bowl.

McElwain inherited a program that won one game in 2018 and transformed it immediately into a winner, leading CMU to an 8-6 record and 6-2 MAC record.

The seven-win improvement was the best among Football Bowl Subdivision programs in 2019 and the Chippewas made their first appearance in the MAC Championship Game in more than a decade. McElwain earned the MAC Coach of the Year Award and with that honor, McElwain became just the fourth individual to earn COY honors in three NCAA Division I conferences. The other coaches are Brady Hoke, Gary Patterson, and Dennis Stolz.

McElwain lived up to his reputation as an offensive mastermind as the 2019 Chippewas nearly doubled their 2018 yardage total and scored 426 points, a 246-point improvement over the previous season.

CMU running backs Jonathan Ward and Kobe Lewis both surpassed 1,000 yards rushing, marking the first time in the long and illustrious history of Chippewa football that two players reached the 1,000-yard milestone in the same season.

Pimpleton led the league in both receptions (90) and receiving yardage (934) and earned First Team All-MAC honors as both a wide receiver and as a punt returner. Sullivan also earned first team all-conference honors. They were two of eight Chippewas to earn All-MAC honors in 2019.

McElwain was named to head the program on Dec. 2, 2018, arriving with an exceptional resumé that included successful runs in heading the programs at both Florida and Colorado State, along with membership on coaching staffs of national-championship teams.

- McElwain coached at Florida from 2015-17, compiling a 22-12 overall record, two SEC East titles and two SEC Championship Game appearances, and two bowl game appearances. He earned the SEC Coach of the Year Award in 2015.
- Those titles made him the first coach in league history to reach the SEC Championship Game in his first two seasons as head coach. Just two other coaches reached the title game in their first season.
- He led Colorado State to a 10-3 finish in 2014, earning the Mountain West Conference Coach of the Year Award.
- He earned American Football Coaches Association Regional Coach of the Year awards in both 2014 and 2015.
- As the offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach under Nick Saban at Alabama from 2008-11, McElwain helped the Crimson Tide to two national titles and coached 2009 Heisman Trophy winner Mark Ingram.
- McElwain served as an assistant at Michigan under Jim Harbaugh in 2018, helping the Wolverines to a 10-2 regular-season finish and a top-10 ranking.

In nearly 30 years of collegiate coaching, McElwain has consistently displayed an ability to build winning teams with a focus on academic success, an eagerness to engage fans and the community, and a determination to maintain integrity throughout the program.

A native of Missoula, Montana, McElwain played quarterback at Eastern Washington from 1980-83 and began his climb up the coaching ladder at his alma mater, first as a graduate assistant and then as the quarterbacks/wide receivers coach from 1987-94.

He moved on to Montana State in 1995, serving as the Bobcats' offensive coordinator, wide receivers coach, and special teams coordinator.

McElwain served as the wide receivers team/special teams coordinator at Louisville from 2000-02 and at Michigan State as the assistant head coach, wide receivers coach, and special teams coordinator from 2003-05.

In 2006, McElwain moved on to the NFL as the quarterbacks coach for the Oakland Raiders. He returned to the collegiate level in 2007, helping lead Fresno State to a 9-4 finish while serving as the offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach.

In 2008, McElwain joined Saban's staff at Alabama. The Crimson Tide amassed an incredible 48-6 combined record in McElwain's four years on staff, winning national titles in 2009 and 2011.

In 2012-14, McElwain led Colorado State to a combined 22 victories including 10 in 2014. The 10 wins tied for the second most in program history. Colorado State had won just nine games in the combined three years prior to McElwain's arrival.

McElwain and his wife, Karen, have three children: JoHanna, Elizabeth and Jerret.
