

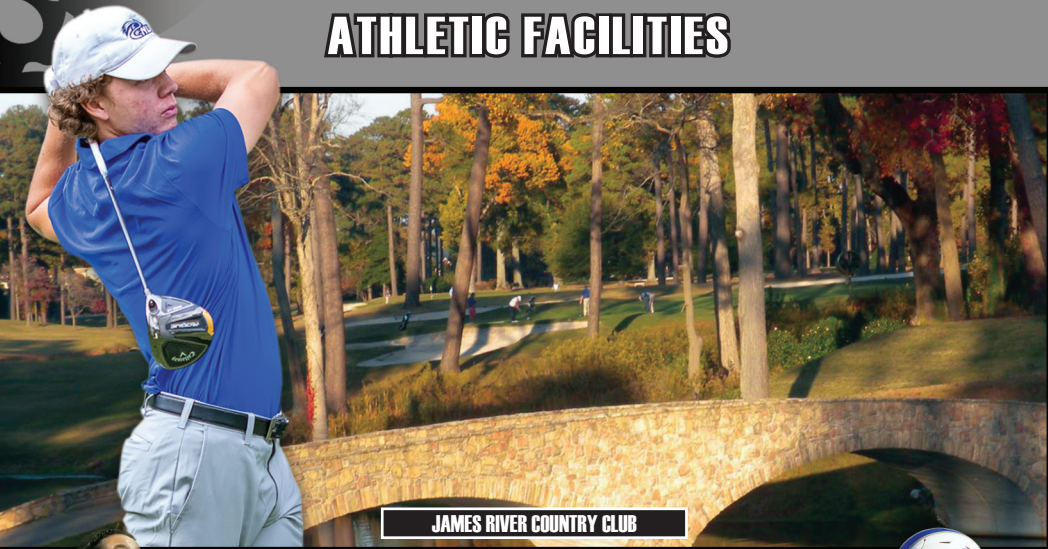

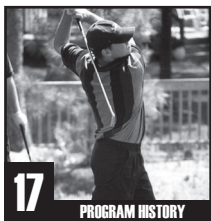

JAMIE COLEMAN

LIBERTY '00
15TH YEAR AT CNU

Entering his 15th season as the head coach of the Christopher Newport University golf program in 2022-23, Jamie Coleman has helped the Captains men's golf team reach an unprecedented measure of success while overseeing the construction and development of the women's golf program since its inception in 2017-18 through the 2021-22 campaign.

During his tenure, Coleman has guided the men's program to five league championships, including four straight Capital Athletic Conference titles from 2014-17. The Captains have also qualified for six NCAA Championship appearances, highlighted by a program-record 8th-place finish at the national tournament during the 2020-21 campaign.

Meanwhile, on the women's side, Coleman's crew quickly established itself as one of the finest programs in the region. During their very first year of competition, the Captains won the CAC title in 2017-18 before sending an individual qualifier to the NCAA Championships the following year.

Along with their postseason success, Coleman's squads have captured 18 tournament titles on the men's side since 2008, while the women have walked away with four, including an incredible victory in the program's first-ever competition at the 2017 Bay Creek Invitational.

In addition to the overall team success under Coleman's watch, he has also helped recruit and coach some of the finest individual competitors in school history. Since 2008, Christopher Newport has produced nine All-Americans, including national runner-up Robb Kinder in 2021 and first team selections Brian Jaeger, David Rabil, and Alex Price. Additionally, 20 Captains have taken part in the NCAA Championships, including Kinder's second place finish and Joseph Evans' sixth-place showing at the 2012 competition.



Under the tutelage of Coleman, Alex Price made history for CNU golf by qualifying for and playing in the 122nd U.S. Amateur over the summer of 2022. Price became the only Division III player to reach the U.S. Amateur Quarterfinals since at least the 1990's in what was arguably one of the finest runs ever by a DIII student-athlete.

Along with the national success, Coleman's student-athletes have received 41 All-Conference honors and 21 All-Region plaudits. Four Captains have also walked away with league championships since 2014, including CNU women's golf coach Jonathan Howard who kicked off that run.

Equally impressive on the women's side, Christopher Newport has seen six different competitors earn All-CAC accolades over the last three seasons, including two-time Player of the Year Erica Whitehouse. Whitehouse also became the program's first All-American and national qualifier after finishing ninth at the NCAA Championships in 2019. Additionally, she became the first-ever recipient of the VaSID Virginia State Player of the Year award as a sophomore, while teammate Shreya Ganta was named the top freshman in the conference in 2019.

Ganta would go on to earn All-American honors in 2021 after becoming the second player to qualify for the NCAA Championships. Alongside Katie Thome, Ganta was also named a Scholar All-American for her work in the classroom as well.

For his work at the helm of the program, Coleman has also received personal recognition. He picked up four consecutive CAC Men's Coach of the Year honors from 2014-17, while he nabbed the women's top award in 2018 and 2019. Meanwhile, he has been named the VaSID All-State Coach of the Year four times on the men's side after securing the award in 2013, 2015, 2017, and 2021.

Prior to his arrival at Christopher Newport, Coleman built an extensive resume in the region's golf community. A native of Smithfield, Va., he was the Golf Events Coordinator at Golden Horseshoe Country Club in Williamsburg from 2000-01. He also served as the Assistant Golf Professional at Two Rivers Country Club from 2001-02 and Stonehouse Golf Club from 2002-03.

A graduate of Atlantic Shores Christian High School in Virginia Beach, Coleman played golf for three years at Liberty University before graduating in 2000.

MEET THE CAPTAINS

2022-23 PREVIEW

Heading into the 2022-23 season, expectations will be high like never before as the Christopher Newport men's golf team takes on the year with the bulk of the lineup returning from a championship-caliber roster a year ago. The Captains start the year ranked No. 9 in the nation and climbed to as high as No. 7 in the 2022 poll as CNU features one of the most talented rosters in Division III golf.

This season, the Captains welcome back All-Americans Alex Price and Robb Kinder to lead a squad that also returns NCAA participants Aidan Baron and Jack Gessaman. Baron was a GCAA All-Region pick as a freshman and started in all nine tournaments as a sophomore; Gessaman vaulted into the rotation with seven starts including a strong showing in last year's championship event, finishing second on the team.

The talent is deep for head coach Jamie Coleman, but the pair at the top of the lineup card are the obvious headliners as Price and Kinder return for their senior seasons.

Price is coming off an accomplished summer that saw him qualify for the U.S. Amateur where he made history as one of the most accomplished Division III performers in the event all-time. He is the first three-time All-American in program history and continues to shatter program records as one of the top athletes in CNU Golf history.

Kinder is back after finishing second at the 2021 NCAA Division III National Championship followed by a standout season a year ago. He ranks second only to Price in career scoring average with a 73.8 mark and has registered the two best NCAA Championship scores for the Captains in each of the last two appearances.

With the veteran duo anchoring the returning group, Baron and Gessaman will add experience to the lineup. CNU will need to replace one in the starting five and Coleman will have five players to choose from. Back for his third year, Drew Parr has seen action in three tournaments during his first season and could challenge for the spot. Sophomores Owen Cook and Michael Thomas

are also options looking to take the next step with five combined starts in their rookie campaigns.

Rounding out the roster are a pair of newcomers in Austin Smith (Williamsburg, Va.) and Owen Taylor (Vienna, Va.). Smith is a two-time state champion and was named the Most Outstanding Player on the peninsula as a senior; Taylor was a multi-sport star at James Madison HS in Northern Virginia.

This year's schedule has some usual suspects alongside a fresh look for the Captains as they add several new tournaments, starting with the season opener on September 26 at the Gate City Invitational. Three more tournaments in the Fall will follow, with the NCAA Division III Championship Preview (Oct 2-4), the Golfweek Fall Invitational (Oct 16-18), and the O'Briant-Jensen Memorial (Oct 31-Nov 1). Once the calendar shifts to the 2023 portion of the schedule, the Captains will take on the field at the Savannah Invitational (Mar 6-7), the Jekyll Island Intercollegiate (Mar 17-19), and the 50th Annual Camp Lejeune Intercollegiate (Mar 31-Apr 2). The regular season will conclude locally at the Glenn Heath Memorial hosted in Williamsburg on April 17-18.

After that, the Captains will hope they've done enough to earn an at-large berth into the NCAA Championships for the third straight year. This year, the NCAA Division III Men's Golf Championship is being held in Nicholasville, Ky. at the Keene Trace Golf Course from May 16-19.

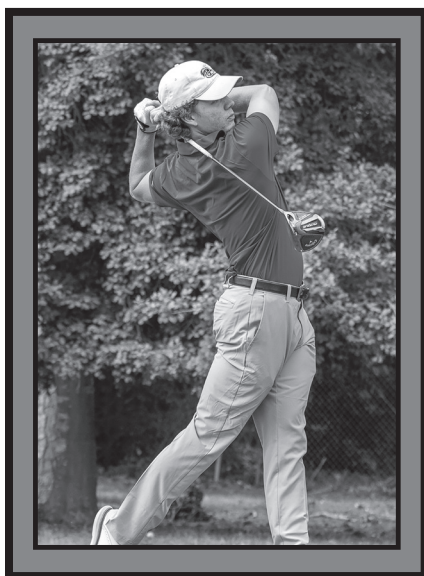

Helped the Captains log the second lowest single season scoring average in program history as a team ... Averaged 77.0 in his second season over 26 rounds of play with 2001 total strokes ... Helped CNU qualify with an at-large berth into the NCAA Championship ... Tied for 77th in the postseason event with a 313 (81-78-77-77) ... 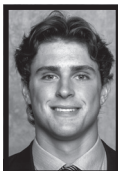

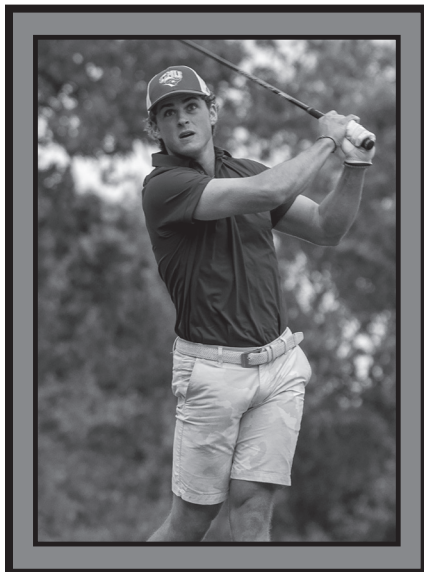

2021-22 - JUNIOR SEASON - After another standout campaign, became the fifth player in program history to garner multiple All-American certificates in his career ... Earned second team GCAA All-American plaudits ... Also collected All-Region and VaSID first team All-State honors ... Became just the second Captain in program history to record multiple sub-300 rounds at the NCAA National Championships and the first since 1996 ... Led CNU in the 2022 version of the event for the second straight year, finishing with a top-25 effort and a 298 (74-72-79-73) ... That mark ranks tied for sixth all-time at Christopher Newport for a 72-hole tournament ... Led the championship tournament in total pars with 50, including 17 in the final round ... Finished his third year with a 73.3 stroke average with four top-ten finishes ... Earned his second career win with medalist honors at the Glenn Heath Memorial with a 147 (72-75) ... Fired nine rounds at par or better in 26 played during the year ... Lowered his career average to 73.8 over 46.5 rounds of play, which ranks second in program history

2020-21 - SOPHOMORE SEASON - Pieced together a breakout campaign while garnering honorable mention All-American accolades ... Also picked up All-Region nods and became just the second Captain in school history to earn the VaSID All-State Player of the Year award ... Named to the first-team All-State squad as well ... Finished with the seventh-lowest scoring average in program history after wrapping up the year with a 74.0 mark over 11.5 total rounds of action ... Capped off the season with one of the finest efforts in school history at the NCAA Championship ... Tied for second at the national tournament with a four-round 287 (77-71-70-69), which marked the lowest score by a Captain at the title competition in program history ... His fourth-round 69 was the top score by any of the nation's 96 competitors on the final day of the tournament ... Posted five birdies in each of his final two rounds at the NCAA Championship while helping the Captains place eighth in the team standings, which marked their best finish in program history ... Registered a victory at the VSGA Intercollegiate in April after winning the state tournament with a 27-hole 104 (72-32) ... That score placed him 4-under-par for the competition ... Opened the year with a three-round 230 (75-75-80) at the Jekyll Island Invitational ... Also came in 23rd at the Golfweek Spring Invitational in April after completing the tournament with a similar three-round 230 (76-75-79).

2019-20 - FRESHMAN SEASON - Was the lone freshman to compete in all four tournaments during the school year ... Compiled a 75.1 scoring average over nine total rounds ... Pieced together his finest showcase at the Don Scalf Invitational after registering a two-round 147 (73-74), which placed him 11th in the field ... 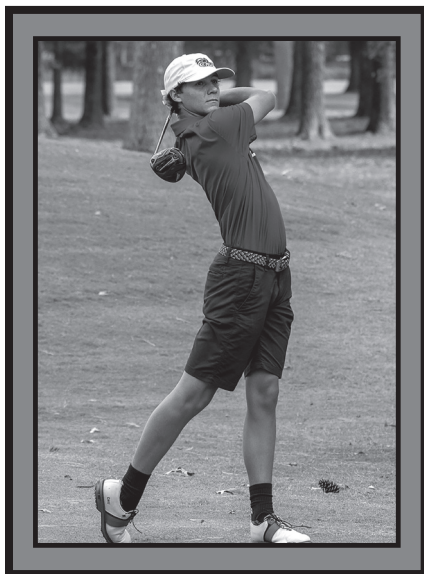

2021-22 SEASON REVIEW

2021-22 REVIEW

After finishing with a program-best eighth place finish at the 2021 NCAA Division III Men's Golf Championships, the Captains returned all but one starter heading into the 2021-22 season. Looking to replicate that success behind All-Americans Alex Price and Robb Kinder, the nationally-ranked CNU squad made a return trip to the championship event after another fantastic season overall.

In one of the most impressive runs through the regular season in program history, the Captains posted a win of the Glenn Heath Memorial and a couple second place finishes in eight total outings. CNU finished lower than sixth only once and earned a Pool B bid into the 2022 NCAA Championships after the strong performance over the course of the year.

At the postseason tournament, the Captains made the cut for the 13th time in program history and went on to finish with a top-20 showing out of the 43 teams entered in the event. CNU was led by Kinder, who became only the second CNU player in program history to record multiple sub-300 rounds at the NCAA Championship event, and the first since Scott Scoville accomplished the feat in the 1994 and 1996 tournaments.



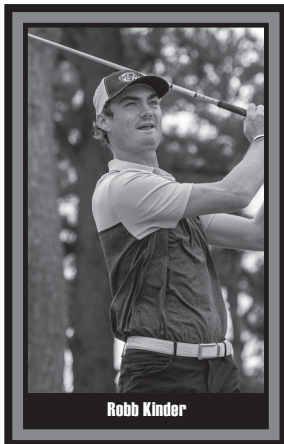

As a team, the Captains finished 17th overall with an 80-over 1,228 (311-301-310-306). It was the second-best overall finish for the Captains in the last decade.

finish at the O'Briant-Jensen Memorial where sophomores Carrter Morris and Aidan Baron helped lead the way. The second-year pair scored matching 75's on the second day to help Christopher Newport finish at 30-over par in the 36-hole event. Morris notched a career-best effort with a 146 (71-75) and tied for third place overall. Baron added a top-20 showing with a +11, tying for 18th.

In the spring, the Captains caught fire at the start of the schedule with a second-place, five-over par effort in the 54-hole Savannah Invitational and followed it up with a sixth-place, four-under finish at the Jekyll Island Collegiate. The hot streak continued when Kinder and Price tied for medalist honors, headlining a group of four Captains in the top five at the Glenn Heath memorial as CNU won the event by 40 strokes. Jack Gessaman tied for fourth with Aidan Baron while Price and Kinder dued in a playoff before Kinder squeaked out the win.

As a team, the Captains put together a 297.6 average in 2022-23 over 26 rounds of play. Among seasons with at least ten rounds played, that is a program record by over two strokes, besting the previous mark held by 2001-02 with a 299.8 average.

Prior to the culminating event, the Captains were led by Price, who earned first team All-American plaudits and became only the second three-time All-American in program history. He set the program scoring average record for a single season by finishing with a 72.6 in 26 rounds of play. Price added five top-ten finishes in nine events including a win in the prestigious Jekyll Island Collegiate this Spring. He fired an 11-under 205 with three straight sub-70 cards.

Price was named the VaSID State Player of the Year, becoming just the third Captain to garner the recognition behind David Rabil (2017) and Kinder (2021). The latter added another outstanding season to collect first team All-State plaudits and second team All-American laurels. The CNU veteran averaged 73.3 strokes per round with four top-ten finishes. He added one win and nine rounds at par or better during the season to lower his career average to 73.8, second behind only Price.

The fall season was capped by a second-place
